TENNIS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

WOMEN'S

Madeline Schorlemmer, Midwestern State University, JR, Argyle, Texas, Argyle HS

Schorlemmer enjoyed a stellar start to the 2015 campaign leading Midwestern State to a season-opening sweep of Central Oklahoma and close loss at Division I SMU. The junior from Argyle claimed her first collegiate win at the No. 1 singles' position rallying from a first-set loss to take a 6-7 (5), 6-4, 6-2 win over Central Oklahoma's Alina Gorina Saturday at the MSU Tennis Center. Gorina carried a national singles' rating throughout much of the 2014 season and was ranked ninth in the Central Region coming into the season opening weekend. Schorlemmer then swept former four-star recruit Anna Kate Anderson of SMU 6-3, 6-2 at the No. 2 position Sunday in Dallas. Schorlemmer competed in just four singles matches in 2014 before suffering a season-ending shoulder injury.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Samantha Wood, Cameron University, went 2-0 against number-9 Oklahoma Baptist with wins in the three singles and three doubles slot. In doubles she edged out a 9-8 win with teammate Dejana Veljic, while in singles she dominated to a 6-0, 6-2 win for her 25th singles win at Cameron.

Erika Richarme, Tarleton State University, was dominant for Tarleton over the weekend leading the TexAnns to wins over Ouachita Baptist and Delta State at the Ouachita Baptist Quad. Richarme's weekend included three wins in doubles play with a combined score of 24-8 (8-2, 8-3, 8-3) and two wins in singles play against Ouachita Baptist and Delta State, with the only loss of the weekend being dealt by No. 14 singles player in the nation Fanni Varga of Southwest Baptist.

Erika Larrera, Texas A&M University - Kingsville, began the 2015 season 4-0 in singles No. 6 as Texas A&M-Kingsville is 2-2 on the young season... the Javelinas are poised for their best year as a program since being reinstated in 2011... she also has one doubles win.

Cameron will be back in action on Monday, Feb. 23 hosting Southern Nazarene.

Midwestern State

Midwestern State opened the season with a dominating 9-0 win over Central Oklahoma Saturday at the MSU Tennis Center, then battled Division I SMU to within 5-2 claiming two singles' match victories... Junior Madeline Schorlemmer claimed her first career win at the No. 1 singles' position beating Central Oklahoma Alina Gorina 6-7, 6-4, 6-2 to complete a 9-0 win over the Bronchos. Gorina was ranked ninth in the Central Region... Schorlemmer finished off a perfect singles week by defeating SMU's Anna Kate Anderson 6-3, 6-2 at the No. 2 position... Senior Taylor Coffman beat SMU's Dasha Sharapova 6-1, 6-4 at the No. 2 spot in her 2015 singles' debut... Midwestern State takes on Division I Incarnate Word Friday in San Antonio before taking on St. Mary's (Texas) on Saturday in a matchup of the South Central Region's top two teams...
