ATHLETES OF THE WEEK

MEN'S TRACK

Randall Kadlecek, Tarleton State University, JR, Riesel, Texas, Riesel HS

Kadlecek established himself as not only the best hurdler at the East Texas Dual meet, but as one of the best in the nation Saturday with his performances in the 110m and 400m hurdles. The junior hurdler kick started the meet with a first-place finish in the 110m hurdles clocking 14.88. Kadlecek would return to the track a few hours later in the 400m hurdles and win in come from behind fashion to record a personal best 52.80 - the No. 1 time in NCAA Division II this season.

MEN'S FIELD

Seth Pearson, Angelo State University, SR, Big Spring, Texas, Big Spring HS

Pearson recorded the top mark in NCAA Division II in the decathlon this at the ASU Spring Break Multi with a NCAA Division II provisional score of 7,011 points. The top collegian at the meet set personal-best marks in the pole vault (13-11) and the javelin (178-4). His 7,011 points is the second-best score of his career.

WOMEN'S TRACK

Jaylen Rodgers, Angelo State University, SR, Hamlin, Texas, Hamlin HS

Rodgers won the 800-meter title at the Cactus Cup with a NCAA Division II provisional time of 2:11.85. It is the fourth-fastest time this season in Division II.

WOMEN'S FIELD

Jordan Gray, Angelo State University, SR, Marble Falls, Texas, Faith Academy

Gray automatically qualified for the NCAA Division II Outdoor Track & Field Championships in the heptathlon with a personal-best score of 5,229 points. The senior set personal bests in the shot put and javelin while also recording a NCAA Division II provisional mark in the long jump at 19-2.50 (5.85m). She is currently No. 2 nationally in the heptathlon and No. 3 in the long jump.

OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Dexter Lee, Texas A&M University - Commerce, made his 2015 outdoor debut at the A&M-Commerce vs. Tarleton State dual meet on Saturday, winning the 400m with a time of 48.20 which currently stands number two in the Lone Star Conference. The sophomore didn't stop there, as Lee also participated in the 4x400m relay as first leg, helping the Lions reach a provisional qualifying mark of 3:13.84, which is the fifth-fastest mark in Division II to date.

William Carlton, Tarleton State University, is 2-for-2 on the season after earning his second-straight first-place finish in the men's pole vault Saturday at the East Texas Dual meet in Commerce. The freshman cleared a meet best 15-0 (4.57m), recording a new personal best.

Jamal Curtis, Texas A&M University - Commerce, made his outdoor debut for the Lions in emphatic fashion at the A&M-Commerce vs. Tarleton State Dual Meet on Saturday. The freshman won the high jump with a height of 6-11 (2.11m), which is the second highest mark in Division II to date.

Tylo Farrar, Tarleton State University, set a new personal best in a second-place finish at the East Texas Dual Saturday in Commerce. Farrar finished second in the 1500m, needing only 4:48.65 to go the distance for the TexAnns.

Kamryn McKee, Texas A&M University - Commerce, wrapped up the A&M-Commerce vs. Tarleton State Dual Meet as the Lions' most decorated athlete. The freshman secured three wins on the day in the 200m, 400m and long jump with marks of 25.33, 58.32 and 18'5.75" (5.63m) respectively, as well as a second place finish as part of the 4x400m relay with a time of 3:54.92. Her times in the 200m and 400m currently stand at third-best in the conference, while her leap in the long jump is the second best time in the LSC.

Sarah Vann, Tarleton State University, now has two wins on the season following the East Texas Dual meet in Commerce. Vann, the school record holder in the pole vault, cleared a meet best 11-6.25 (3.51m) on her way to a first-place finish and is currently the No. 5 pole vaulter in the nation.

Anitha'a Robins, Texas A&M University - Commerce, pulled off a win in the discus throw at the A&M-Commerce vs. Tarleton State Dual Meet this Saturday. The freshman's winning throw went for 133-0 (40.55m).
