## GOLFERS OF THE WEEK

### MEN'S

**Oscar Spolander, West Texas A&M University, FR, Sollentuna, Sweeden, Korrespondens Gymnasiet Skola**

Spolander paced the Buffs this week at the Mustang Intercollegiate at Palm Valley Golf Club in Goodyear, Ariz. Spolander finished tied for fourth with a 5-under 211 on rounds of 69, 69 and 73. He paced the Buffs to a sixth-place finish among 16 teams as the Buffs carded a team-low final round of 2-under 286 on Tuesday. Spolander ranks 71st nationally with a 73.3 stroke average for the year.

### WOMEN'S

**Beatriz Prados, Tarleton State University, SO, Madrid, Spain, Ortega y Gasset School**

Prados finished first overall in the Western New Mexico Mustang Invitational by shooting even par in the two rounds to capture the individual title. Prados' performance helped the TexAnn team win their first tournament of the year with an overall score of 581 (+5), 16 strokes ahead of the second-place finisher. The sophomore from Spain shot a 73 in the first round and a 71 in the second to be the only player to shoot par. Prados' four birdies topped leader board on the final day.

## OTHER TOP PERFORMERS

Bradley Ferrell, Cameron University, finished tied for third place overall at the Dallas Baptist Patriots Classic after carding a two-under, 214 (69-68-77). His stellar play helped guide Cameron to their second tournament win in a row and Ferrell paced the 15 team field through the first two rounds of play with career numbers. In his last five rounds played Ferrell has averaged a 70.6.

Liz Chavarria, Angelo State University, recorded her second straight top-10 finish after carding a 76-79 - 155 which placed her 10th at this week's NCAA West Region Preview in Rohnert Park, California. Chavarria earned a top-5 showing at the Texas A&M-Commerce tournament last month and was this week's tournament leader through her first six holes before dropping back to 10th. A junior from Sonora, Chavarria did not play in the fall but is emerging as an ASU performance leader with two tournaments remaining in the season.

Whitlee Woods, West Texas A&M University, helped lead the Lady Buffs to a second and fifth place finish at the Sonoma State Spring Preview and WNMU Mustang Intercollegiate, respectively, this week. Woods carded a 9-over 153 and tied for eighth at the Sonoma State Spring Preview, while shooting 11-over for a 155 at the Mustang Intercollegiate and finishing tied for 21st. Woods and the Lady Buffs currently are ranked 23rd nationally this week according to Golfstat.

The Cameron men won their second tournament in a row and third this season at the DBU Patriots Classic. Both Bradley Ferrell and Corey Bounds led the Ags with a third place individual finish. In nine events this season the CU men have finished in the top-3 six times with a 291 stroke average. The Aggie men are off until the LSC Championships.

On the women's side the Aggies finished in sixth place in a deep 20 team field. Jaqueline Strickland led Cameron with sixth place finish, Katie Johnston led the over field on day one with a 71. The women's golf team will be at Tarleton State to conclude the regular season.

The Buffs and Lady Buffs both were in action this week as the Buffs finished sixth at the Mustang Intercollegiate and fired a season-best 2-under 286 in the final round for an 877 54-hole score...Freshman Oscar Spolander tied for fourth with a 5-under 211 on rounds of 69, 69 and 73 to lead the team on the Palm Valley Golf Club course in Goodyear, Ariz...WT now is 50th nationally in the latest Golfstat rankings, while Spolander is 65th nationally with a 73.3 stroke average...The Lady Buffs had two tournaments in five days as they competed in the Mustang Intercollegiate where they finished fifth with 618 score...Junior Glory Jangthongsiri paced the team with a 9-over 153 as she tied for 16th...The Lady Buffs then traveled to the Sonoma State Spring Preview where the team finished second behind No. 6 Barry...WT downed nine ranked teams in the top 42 of Golfstat in the tournament as it is a preview of the NCAA West Regional which will be held in May at the Foxtail Golf Club... WT junior Whitlee Woods finished tied for eighth with a 9-over 153 to pace the Lady Buffs...WT had scores of 308 and 315 for a 623 score...Both teams are now preparing for the Lone Star Conference Championships April 20-21 at Frisco Lakes Golf Club in Frisco, Texas.
