1983 Coaches All-Lone Star Conference football team

BROWNWOOD, Texas--Eight players from Lone Star Conference co-champion Southwest Texas State head a list of 25 players named to the 1983 Coaches' All-Lone Star Conference football team.

Angelo State placed five players on the first team, while co-champion East Texas State placed four, along with Stephen F. Austin.

Kyle Mackey, East Texas State quarterback and son of former ETSU two-sport all-American Dee Mackey, was selected as first team quarterback and also received the "Dough" Rollins Back of the Year Award. It was the second straight selection for Mackey, who led the conference in passing with 196.0 yards per game. The 6-4, 225-lb. Alpine High graduate was also second in total offer

The "Siki" Sikes Lineman of the Year Award went to three-time All-LSC linebacker Cyril Friday, 6-0, 200 lbs. from Austin LBJ High School.

Friday was one of 11 unanimous choices to the team, along with ETSU's league-leading rusher Ricky Dirks at runningback, Southwest Texas State's Ricky Sanders at the other runningback; SFA wide receiver James Noble, Abilene Christian offensive tackle Dan Remsberg; SFA offensive guard Dennis Stavinoha; and Texas A&I offensive guard Loyd Lewis.

Defensively, David Glasco of Southwest Texas State at defensive back, R. L. Harris of Stephen F. Austin at defensive back; and Tim Staskus, Southwest Texas State linebacker, were the unanimous selections.

Other SWT players making the team were Vaughn Deary, 5-11, 170-lb. wide receiver of Austin; Scott Forster, 6-4, 255-lb. center of San Marcos; Rod Clark, 6-12, 215-lb. defensive lineman of Waller; and Van Hughes, 6-4, 270-lb. senior from Axtell. Howard Payne punter Kirk Chastain was also a unanimous choice.

Angelo State selections included four players on defense and placekicker

Mike Thomas of Brownwood. Other ASU first teamers were defensive back Glen Saterfield of Georgetown; linebacker Paul Pogue of Fort Stockton; defensive lineman Steve Ford of Abilene and defensive end Leonard Anderson of Dallas.

Besides Mackey and Dirks, East Texas State placed tight end Javier Cardenas of San Antonio and offensive tackle Alan Veingrad of Miami, Fla. on the first team.

The other Stephen F. Austin first team selection was linebacker Melvin White of Beaumont, who made the team as a freshman defensive lineman last season.

Abilene Christian first-team selections were Remsberg and defensive back Mark Wilson of Throckmorton.

Kirk Chastain, Howard Payne's punter, was also a unanimous selection at the position and was named to the team for the third straight year.

Other repeaters besides White and Chastain were Mackey and Dirks of East Texas State; Noble of Stephen F. Austin; Lewis of Texas A&I; Remsberg of Abilene Christian; Friday and Staskus of Southwest Texas State, and Mike Thomas of Angelo State.

The defensive back of the year was David Glasco of Southwest Texas State, 6-1, 190-lb. junior from San Antonio. A three-way tie for offensive lineman of the year included Dan Remsberg of Abilene Christian, Scott Forster of Southwest Texas State and Dennis Stavinoha of Stephen F. Austin.

Tollie Royal, Sam Houston State defensive back, was named Freshman of the Year by the coaches, and Ernest Hawkins of East Texas State was the runaway choice for Coach of the Year by fellow coaches and conference sports information directors.
