MID-EASTERN ATHLETIC CONFERENCE WEEKLY HONORS

SSU's Wright, DSU's Tursellino and Washington earn Top Weekly Honors

Savannah State's Torrian Wright was selected the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Softball Player of the Week, the conference announced on Monday. **Delaware State's Tara Tursellino** earned Pitcher of the Week honors, while **teammate Vanessa Washington** earned Rookie of the Week.

Wright (1B, 5-6, Jr., McDonough, Ga.) registered a .750 batting average (6-for-8), including one home run and one double, with five runs scored and three RBI, in a series sweep of South Carolina State. Defensively, she recorded 33 put-outs and two assists.

Tursellino (P, 5-7, So., Moreno Valley, Calif.) earned two victories and one save against Maryland Eastern Shore. She allowed six hits and one earned run, with 12 strikeouts, in 14.2 innings pitched.

Washington (1B, 5-6, Fr., Elk Grove, Calif.) went 4-for-6 at the plate, including two doubles, with two RBI and three runs scored in a three-game sweep of Maryland Eastern Shore. She also recorded 15 putouts and one assist.

Other Top Performers

London Booker (NCCU) retired the first 13 batters in a 7-0 complete-game shutout win over North Carolina A&T State.

Ashley Eichenlaub (SSU) tossed a complete-game shutout, scattering six hits and fanning three, in a 6-0 victory against South Carolina State.

Vanessa Gomez (UMES) went 2-for-3 from the plate, including one double, in a 4-0 loss to Delaware State.

Brianna Harris (SSU) notched two hits, including one home run and one double, in a 5-4 win against South Carolina State.

Marissa Marrero (NSU) pitched 7.0 innings, scattering three hits and allowing one unearned run, in a 5-1 victory over Hampton.

Megan Przeslawski (NSU) allowed two hits and one run in a 2-1 win against Hampton.

Jordan Stamps (DSU) belted two home runs, with four RBI and scored twice, in a 9-1 victory over Maryland Eastern Shore.

Whitney Williams (NSU) registered three hits, including one home run and one double, in a 5-1 victory over Hampton.

Dominique Wilson (NCCU) notched four hits, including three home runs, in a three-game series against North Carolina A&T State.

SSU's Wright selected Preseason Player of the Year *Hampton and B-CU predicted to win Divisional title*

The Hampton Lady Pirates and the Bethune-Cookman Lady Wildcats were predicted to win the northern and southern divisions, respectively, in the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC). All preseason honors were voted on by the conference's head softball coaches and sports information directors.

Savannah State's Torrian Wright was selected as the conference's Preseason Player of the Year, while Jailynn Jackson of Hampton earned Preseason Pitcher of the Year accolades.

Wright was selected the 2014 MEAC Player of the Year after leading the conference in runs batted in (41) and home runs (13) last season. She batted .346 with 35 walks, 31 runs scored and five doubles. Wright ranked 13th in NCAA Division I in on-base percentage (.536), 14th in walks per game (0.81), 27th in home runs per game (0.30) and 33rd in slugging percentage (.757).

Jackson started 30 games as a junior, compiling a 2.79 ERA in 203.0 innings and an 18-12 record. Jackson was the 2014 MEAC Pitcher of the year and led the MEAC with 135 strikeouts. She registered 25 complete games, with five shutouts, in 35 appearances.

Hampton was the 2014 MEAC northern division co-champions. The Lady Pirates finished the season with a 35-17 overall record and 15-3 MEAC mark. Delaware State earned a share of the northern division last season and is picked to finish

second this season, followed by Norfolk State in third. Coppin State, Morgan State, Howard and Maryland Eastern Shore complete the northern division predictions.

Bethune-Cookman captured the top seed in the 2014 MEAC Softball Championship. The Lady Wildcats finished last season with a 12-4 MEAC record and a 25-31 overall mark. Bethune-Cookman has won eight MEAC Softball tournament championships.

Florida A&M, the defending MEAC Tournament Champions, was picked to finish second in the southern division, followed by Savannah State, North Carolina A&T State, North Carolina Central and South Carolina State.

Wright (SSU) and Jackson (Hampton) are joined by Tara Tursellino (DSU), Sandy Hawthorne (DSU), Danielle Budden (Hampton), Whitney Williams (NSU), Margaret Wilkins (Hampton), Calesha Shelley (B-CU), Nicole Gazzola (DSU), Heather Dunning (NSU) and Amber Fullwood (FAMU) on the 2015 Preseason All-MEAC team.

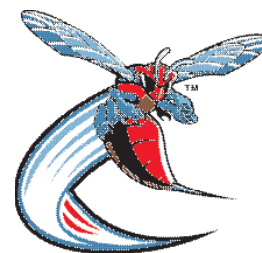
