



MEAC at CENTER COURT AUDITION Q&A

Q. When and where does it take place?

A. The talent search is from 1:00 p.m. until 4:00 p.m. on Saturday, January 23, 2016 at Funny Bone in Virginia Beach. The Funny Bone is located at 217 Central Park Avenue, Virginia Beach, VA 23462. Registration will begin at 12:30 p.m.

Q. Where can I register to audition?

A. Participants may register online at MEACsports.com and at MEACsports.com prior to arrival. Registration forms will also be available at the Funny Bone on the day of the audition. Registration will begin at 12:30 p.m.

Q. Who may audition?

A. Everyone is invited to participate; youth, adults, groups, instrumentalists, dancers, etc. If you have talent, we want to see it.

Q. I want to audition to perform the National Anthem. What do I need?

A. Arrive early and be prepared to perform the National Anthem, The Star-Spangled Banner, acapella. The performer must sing the National Anthem within two (2) minutes.

Q. I want to audition to perform at halftime. What do I need?

A. Performances are limited to 3-4 minutes from entrance to exit. Performance must be family oriented in nature and can be viewed by all ages. Explicit content or gestures are prohibited. Inappropriate performances the day of the game will be ceased immediately. Please note that participants are expected to perform the same audition that will be performed at the tournament.

Q. Should I bring my own music?

A. Yes. Half-time auditions that are performed with music can be used during the audition. Participants should bring music on two (2) identical CDs, as the only song, to the audition. Music must not contain any explicit lyrics or profanity.

Q. When will I know if I am selected to participate in the tournament?

A. A MEAC Representative will notify all individuals and/or groups selected to participate in the tournament of their schedule by February 19. The basketball tournament is from March 7-12 at the Norfolk Scope Arena.

Q. Can I select the date and time that I would like to perform?

A. No, the MEAC reserves the right to select the date and time of all performances.

Q. What is the attire for the performance?

A. Performers can wear appropriate family friendly attire. Please wear soft soles shoes (no heels or shoes that will leave black marks.)

Q. If selected, when would I be required to arrive for the performance at the tournament?

A. All performers must arrive no less than one half hour prior to their scheduled performance.
