The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) begins its 47th year of intercollegiate competition heading into the 2016-17 academic school year. Located in Norfolk, Va., the MEAC is made up of 13 outstanding historically black institutions across the Atlantic coastline: Bethune-Cookman University, Coppin State University, Delaware State University, Florida A&M University, Hampton University, Howard University, University of Maryland Eastern Shore, Morgan State University, Norfolk State University, North Carolina A&T State University, North Carolina Central University, Savannah State University and South Carolina State University.

The MEAC sponsors 16 Division I (FCS) sports with automatic qualifying bids for NCAA postseason competition in baseball, bowling, men's and women's basketball, men's and women's cross country, men's and women's tennis, men's and women's track and field, softball, volleyball and men's golf.

Annual Awards

The MEAC will name first, second and third all-conference teams (m/w), outstanding performers in track and field events and coach of the year based on performance at the 2017 MEAC Outdoor Championships.



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STARTING OFF

With the crux of outdoor season ready to heat up, the MEAC has several athletes shining on a national stage as they rank nationally.

On the men's side, Bethune-Cookman's **Kareem Fair** exploded out the blocks with a 10.28 on March 31 to rank 11th nationally in the 100. North Carolina A&T State's **Rodney Rowe** clocked a 10.3 at the Florida Relays on March 30 to rank 13th also in the 100.

Coppin State's **Joseph Amoah** ranks fourth in the 200 (20.48), Rowe 10th (20.61) and Savannah State's **Nigel Brown** 21st (20.93).

Morgan State's **Joel Roberson** is 32nd in the 400 (47.03) while **Michael James** of Coppin State ranks 27th in the 800 (1:49.16). Maryland Eastern Shore's **Taj Showalter** moved to 25th in the 110 hurdles (14.10) followed by North Carolina A&T State's **Todd Townsend** (14.14) (32nd) and **TaQuille Jackson** (36th) in the 110-meter hurdles (14.17).

Savannah State's **Morgan Ellis-Foster** is 25th in the 400 hurdles (51.76), Morgan State's **Lloyd Hylton** is 33rd in the long jump (24-5) while Bethune-Cookman's **Michael Tiller** ranks sixth in the triple jump (52-5.25) followed by North Carolina A&T State's **Lasheon Strozier** (17th) (51-3.75).

On the women's side, Morgan State's **Shenel Crooke** ranks 34th in the 100 (11.53) while NCAT's **India Brown** stands at 15th in the 200 (23.11). Norfolk State's **Martha Bissah** ranks 24th nationally in the 800 (2:08.45), Eastern Shore's **Shauntel Lucius** ranks 40th in the triple jump (41-0.25) while BCU's **Catoria Sirmon** ranks 43rd in the shot put (49-11.25).

UP FOR GRABS

After winning both the men's and women's MEAC Championship on the indoor side this past winter, North Carolina A&T State turns its attention to outdoor as the Aggies try to capture its first men's title since 1996 and first women's title since 1995.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Maryland Eastern Shore's **Khalil Rmidi Kinini** is going out in style as the senior looks to win his third consecutive MEAC Track & Field Outstanding Performer on the outdoor side.

Rmidi Kinini won the same title during indoor this past winter has cemented his legacy by becoming the first Hawk to qualify for NCAA national competition (cross country) as he finished fifth at the NCAA Mid-Atlantic Regionals.

The native of Spain is a three-time MEAC Cross Country champion and the first runner in MEAC history to win three individual titles.

LEGACY

Bethune-Cookman is the back-to-back-to-back MEAC Track & Field Champions on the men's side and is looking to extend its streak in 2017.

While that's an impressive feat, they still have a ways to go as Norfolk State won seven straight from 2006 to 2012 under head coach **Kenneth Giles**.

Florida A&M has won the past two MEAC Championships on the women's side and a win in 2017 would mark the second time in six seasons that a team has accomplished a three-peat as Hampton won three straight from 2012-2014.

Only South Carolina State and Hampton have won five consecutive outdoor titles in MEAC history on the women's side.

FRESH FACES

Several freshmen have established themselves early in the middle to long distance races as Norfolk State's **Martha Bissah** ranks 24th nationally in the 1,500-meter run (4:27.12) while Hampton has a pair of freshmen (**Janet Okeago, Faith Keitany**) rank amongst the top 100 nationally in the 10,000.

Freshman **JaQuaveon Beachem** of Bethune-Cookman holds the top score in decathlon.

LEWIS MAKES THE MOVE ACROSS THE BAY

Norfolk State University director of track and field programs **Kenneth Giles** announced that former Olympian and local track and field legend **Yvette Lewis** has been hired as an assistant coach for the Spartans.

Lewis will primarily work with the hurdlers, jumpers and sprinters on the Spartan women's track and field team.

A two-time NCAA national champion and 2016 Olympian, Lewis spent the last four years as an assistant track and field coach at her alma mater, Hampton University. Lewis' main area of emphasis was Hampton's hurdlers, jumpers and multi-event athletes while also serving as the team's strength and conditioning coordinator. Lewis helped the Hampton women win a total of six MEAC indoor and outdoor titles while the Pirate men won two.

Lewis' stint at Hampton coincided with the final years of her own successful track career. Lewis competed primarily in the 100-meter hurdles as a professional. Her personal-best time was 12.76 seconds, which she clocked in 2011 – the same year she won a gold medal representing the USA at the Pan American Games. Later in her career, Lewis represented Panama, qualifying for the 2016 Summer Olympic Games in Brazil.

Lewis won NCAA Division I national titles during the 2006 indoor season and 2007 outdoor season in the triple jump while at Hampton. In all, she was a six-time All-American in the triple jump and 100-meter hurdles in a two-year span for the Pirates. She also won six Most Outstanding Performer Awards for scoring the most points at MEAC indoor and outdoor championship meets.

MEAC Track & Field Weekly Honors

Maryland Eastern Shore's **Taj Showalter** and Morgan State's **Shenel Crooke** were selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Men's and Women's Track Athletes of the Week. **Jacob Milton**, of Norfolk State, and **Corneisha Mitchell**, of Hampton, were named the MEAC Men's and Women's Field Athletes of the Week, the conference announced today.

Showalter (Sr., Anchorage, Alaska) posted the MEAC's top time (14.10) and set a personal record in the 110-meter hurdles this past weekend at the Embry-Riddle Spike's Classic. He ranks 25th nationally after the run and qualified for IC4A in the 110 hurdles and the 4x400-meter relay. Showalter placed second in the 400-meter hurdles and participated on a mile relay team which placed second overall. He also qualified for the MEAC Championships in the 400-meter hurdles and ranks third in the ECAC qualifying list for the 110 hurdles.

Crooke (Sr., Basseterre, St. Kitts) competed in five events at the Florida Relays. She placed 17th in the 100 (11.53) and 23rd in the 200-meter dashes (24.06). Her time in the 100 currently leads the MEAC. Crooke also helped her team in the 1,600-meter sprint medley, the 4x100-meter relay and the 4x200-meter relay teams. The 4x100 relay team ran a time of 46.26, which is the fastest in the MEAC.

Milton (Stuttgart, Germany) cleared a season-best height of 6-10.25 in the high jump at the Colonial Relays last weekend. He owns the top mark in the MEAC and ranks 20th in the East Region and 42nd nationally.

Mitchell (Fr., Laveen, Ariz.) took second place in the hammer throw, at the Colonial Relays, with a toss of 144-3 feet. She also finished ninth in the discus with a throw of 133-4 to rank fourth in the MEAC.

Other Top Performers

Michael James (CSU) set a new personal record in the men's 800 (1:49.16) at the Florida Relays. James has the top time in the MEAC in the 800 while ranking 27th in the nation.

Trey Clark (HAMP) recorded a second-place mark of 14-5.25 at the Colonial Relays which ties for best in the MEAC.

Noah Agwu (MDES) set personal records in the discus and hammer throw, while qualifying for the IC4A Championships in the discus throw. He earned three, top-five finishes, including a runner-up spot in the discus.

Jayla Lane (MDES) qualified for the 2017 MEAC Outdoor Championship after running the 400-meter dash in 57.55 seconds.

Bethany White (NCCU) recorded a first-place finish, at the VertKlasse Meeting, in the 100-meter dash (11.65).

Ronald Korrir (NSU) broke the school record in the 10,000 meters by almost two minutes, running the MEAC's best time this season in a fourth-place finish.

Tyrika Lee (NSU) ran a personal best and won the 100 (11.87) at the Colonial Relays.
