• The month of October kicks off with all 10 teams in action this weekend. There will be four MEAC contests played in addition to a pair of non-conference match-ups. All games will be streamed on ESPN3.

• Four teams enter the month holding undefeated conference records in Florida A&M (2-0), Howard (1-0), Norfolk State (1-0) and North Carolina A&T State (1-0). An early season showdown featuring a pair of undefeated teams in Florida A&M and Norfolk State takes place in Tallahassee, Fla. this weekend. The only sure thing from that contest is a team wearing green will win as green is an official color of both institutions.

• North Carolina A&T State was picked to defend its MEAC Football Championship as the Aggies received 19 first-place votes and was a unanimous choice to defend their MEAC Championship and represent the league in the annual Celebration Bowl on Dec. 15 in Atlanta, Ga. The Aggies have not won consecutive MEAC Championships since the 1991 and 1992 campaigns. Howard University was predicted to place second in head coach **Mike London's** second season followed by N.C. Central in third place and Bethune-Cookman in fourth. Florida A&M was picked fifth followed by Norfolk State, South Carolina State, Savannah State, Morgan State and Delaware State.

• Name tags will be needed this season as five MEAC teams feature new head coaches. Delaware State, Florida A&M, Morgan State, N.C. A&T State and N.C. Central will have new leaders. Both head coaches at Morgan State and NCCU coaches have the interim tag attached.

• The MEAC's streak of FBS wins continues for the third straight year after North Carolina A&T State's win over East Carolina on Sept. 2. The MEAC picked up two FBS wins last season (2017) as North Carolina A&T State defeated Charlotte (Conference USA) while Howard defeated UNLV. The 2016 North Carolina A&T State win over Kent State was the Aggies' first FBS win in school history and the first MEAC FBS win since Bethune-Cookman defeated C-USA's Florida International 14-12 in 2014.

• North Carolina A&T State remains the lone MEAC team ranked amongst FCS teams. After the loss to Morgan State, the Aggies are now ranked No. 11 in the STATS FCS and FCS Coaches polls.

• North Carolina A&T State University quarterback **Lamar Raynard** was selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while N.C. Central defensive back **Davanta Reynolds** was selected as the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

• Last year's MEAC Champions, North Carolina A&T State, finished the 2017 season with their highest national ranking ever as they finished No. 6 in the NCAA FCS Coaches Poll. They entered the 2018 season with their highest national preseason ranking ever with voters ranking the Aggies preseason No. 14 in the AFCA Coaches Poll. However, the Aggies will feature a new look as head coach **Sam Washington** takes over for the retired **Rod Broadway**. Washington was formerly N.C. A&T's defensive coordinator.

• History suggests a team has to win its conference opener in order to chart its path to the MEAC Championship. The last team that opened with a league loss was Bethune-Cookman in 2015 as they fell to N.C. Central. North Carolina A&T State, BCU and NCCU all tied for a share of the title in 2015.

• The National Football Foundation (NFF) & College Hall of Fame announced a partnership with the MEAC to reveal the league's offensive and defensive players of the year as part of the festivities surrounding the 61st NFF Annual Awards Dinner Dec. 4 at the New York Hilton Midtown in New York City. This marks the third consecutive year the players will be honored in New York.

• The 14th annual MEAC/SWAC Challenge saw North Carolina Central fall to Prairie View A&M on Sunday, Sept. 2. The SWAC holds a two-game winning streak for the first time in series history.

• The winner of the MEAC's regular season title will earn a bid to the 4th annual Celebration Bowl in Atlanta, Ga. on Dec. 15 at Mercedes Benz Stadium. The bowl, which pits the MEAC Champion versus the SWAC Champion, is the only FCS league to host a bowl game as the MEAC leads the series 2-1.

MEAC Overview

The 2018 MEAC football schedule is comprised of 71 total games, including 36 conference contests, 35 non-conference games and a minimum of one postseason contest (Celebration Bowl).

The 2018 schedule will play out over 13 weeks with the conference schedule concluding on Nov. 17. The 2018 MEAC Champion is scheduled to play on national television in the Celebration Bowl on Dec. 15 in Atlanta, Ga.

Six teams on the 2018 MEAC schedule participated in 2017-18 postseason bowl games. Two of the MEAC's 11 games scheduled against Football Championship Subdivision teams were 2017 FCS Playoff participants with one (James Madison) earning a berth in the FCS Championship game.

The MEAC schedule also features 13 games versus Football Bowl Subdivision teams with the first occurring on Aug. 30 and the finale on Sept. 22.

First-Year Head Coaches In The MEAC

Name tags will be needed this season as five MEAC teams feature new head coaches. Delaware State, Florida A&M, Morgan State, N.C. A&T State and N.C. Central will have new leaders. Both head coaches at Morgan State and NCCU coaches have the interim tag attached.

Five head coaches (**Granville Eastman, Buddy Pough, Rod Milstead, Terry Sims, Sam Washington**) made or will make their head coaching debuts in the MEAC with Sims and Pough posting winning records after their first year.

The remaining five head coaches made their debuts elsewhere before coming to the MEAC with four posting winning marks in their first year as a head coach.

The Celebration Bowl

For the fourth consecutive season, the MEAC Champion will participate in the Celebration Bowl against the champion from the Southwestern Athletic Conference (SWAC). Last year, North Carolina A&T State defeated Grambling State 21-14.

The contest will be televised live on ABC to open up the postseason college football bowl season and played at the Mercedes Benz Stadium in Atlanta, Ga. The all-time bowl series is tied at 2-1 as North Carolina A&T State leads the MEAC with two appearances.



FCS Playoffs

With the participation of the MEAC Champion in the Celebration Bowl, the conference does not have an automatic bid to the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS) playoffs. However, the league still has an opportunity to earn an at-large bid.

North Carolina A&T State earned the bid in 2016 as it marked the first time since South Carolina State in 2013 as both them and Bethune-Cookman participated in the playoffs that season.

The last FCS playoff win for the MEAC occurred in 1999 as Florida A&M won two games en route to a semifinal appearance while North Carolina A&T State won its opening round contest.



North Carolina\Florida Pride

The state of North Carolina and Bethune-Cookman has had a firm grip on the MEAC trophy recently as at least one of the schools from the state have claimed a MEAC Championship since 2012.

BCU has won outright or at least a share of the title in 2011, 12, 13, 14 and 15 while North Carolina A&T State and North Carolina Central has won outright or at least a share of the title in 2014, 15, 16 and 17.

NFL Rosters

Entering week three of NFL play, the MEAC has 11 former student-athletes on NFL rosters. South Carolina State leads the way with five representatives while North Carolina A&T State has three.

MEAC Lands Three On STATS FCS Preseason All-America Team

North Carolina Central cornerback **Davanta Reynolds** and the North Carolina A&T State duo of **Franklin "Mac" McCain III** and defensive end **Darryl Johnson, Jr.** were announced as members of the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Team.

Reynolds received second-team recognition coming off a spectacular junior campaign. He was voted First-Team All-MEAC, named Associated Press FCS All-American as a member of the Third Team, and announced to 11th annual BOXTOROW All-America Team, honoring the top 29 players in HBCU football.

Last year Reynolds tied for second in the nation (FCS) with a conference-high six interceptions for 141 return yards and a touchdown (31-yard TD), while also returning a fumble 85 yards for a touchdown (featured on ESPN Top-10 Plays). The safety tallied 54 tackles (35 solo), including 2.5 stops for a loss with a sack, along with a forced fumble and a pass break-up.

Reynolds was also recognized on the HBCU Gameday Preseason FCS All-America Team.

McCain and Johnson were a part of one of the best defenses in the nation last season as N.C. A&T (12-0) finished 2017 as the only undefeated Football Championship Subdivision team in the nation.

McCain earned first-team preseason All-MEAC honors, recently. The 2017 season saw him earn third-team All-American honors from the Associated Press. He also earned Freshman All-American honors from Phil Steele Magazine. He intercepted six passes and returned three of those INTs for touchdowns last season.

Johnson had a breakout 2017 season and was also recently named first-team preseason All-MEAC. Johnson earned second-team All-American honors from the American Football Coaches Association and first-team honors from Box-ToRow. He made 40 tackles (25 unassisted), 15.5 tackles for loss, 6.5 sacks, four forced fumbles and two fumble recoveries.

N.C. A&T's defense ranked fourth in the nation while also ranking third in scoring defense, fifth in rushing defense and fourth in team passing efficiency defense nationally. They also allowed the second-fewest first downs in the nation.

MEAC Lands 13 on BOXTOROW Preseason All-America Team

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) has landed 13 players on the BOXTOROW Preseason All-America Team, which was unveiled on Thursday.

Defending champion North Carolina A&T State leads the way with five honorees while N.C. Central had three honorees.

MEAC Lands 18 on Black College HOF 2018 Black College Player of Year Watch List

The Black College Football Hall of Fame (BCFHOF) announced the 2018 Watch List for the Black College Football Player of the Year Award. The award is presented annually to the most outstanding football player from a Historically Black College & University.

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) landed 18 players on the watch list, listed below by school. Defending champion North Carolina A&T State leads the way with six honorees while N.C. Central and Howard each had three honorees.

Former North Carolina A&T State and current Chicago Bears running back **Tarik Cohen** was selected as the inaugural recipient of the Award in 2016; and Bowie State sophomore quarterback **Amir Hall** was the 2017 recipient.

The winner of the 2018 Black College Football Player of the Year Award will be honored with the Deacon Jones Trophy during the Black College Football Hall of Fame induction ceremony, which takes place on Feb. 16, 2019 in Atlanta. Four finalists will be unveiled on Nov. 29.

The Watch List candidates have been selected based on past performance and future potential. Additions to the list may be made as the 2018 season progresses.

The finalists and the winner will be chosen by a Selection Committee.



NCAT's Raynard, NCCU's Reynolds Headline 2018 All-MEAC Preseason Football Team

North Carolina A&T State University quarterback **Lamar Raynard** was selected as the Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) Preseason Offensive Player of the Year, while N.C. Central defensive back **Davanta Reynolds** was selected as the Preseason Defensive Player of the Year.

All votes were submitted by the MEAC's 10 head football coaches and sports information contacts.

Raynard passed for a MEAC-best 2,932 yards and 27 touchdowns en route to an undefeated (12-0) 2017 season which included a postseason win in the Celebration Bowl. The redshirt senior from High Point, N.C. has compiled a 27-0 record as a starter and led the MEAC in six (6) statistical categories while shattering the Aggie record books as he broke the North Carolina A&T State single-season school records for touchdowns responsible, passing, total offense, touchdown passes and completions in a season. Nationally, Raynard ranked sixth in passing efficiency (140.8), seventh in yards per pass attempt (8.94), ninth in completion percentage (64.6%), 11th in passing TDs (27), 13th in both points responsible for (14.03) and points responsible per game (15.7) and 16th in completion percentage (63.7%).

Reynolds ranked second nationally in interceptions per game (.06) while finishing the 2017 campaign ranked fifth amongst FCS defenders with six interceptions.

The Tucker, Ga. native broke up a pass, returned an interception for a touchdown, recovered a fumble, defended seven passes and forced a fumble which led to an 85-yard fumble recovery for a touch-down. In addition to his success in the secondary, the FCS All-American also finished fourth on the team in tackles with 54 stops and 2.5 tackles for loss.

North Carolina A&T State led the way on the 2018 preseason team with a total of eight first team members and nine players overall. A total of 11 players from Howard University were represented on all three teams while N.C. Central had nine student-athletes selected.

MEAC/SWAC Challenge

The 14th annual MEAC/SWAC Challenge saw North Carolina Central fall to Prairie View A&M on Sunday, Sept. 2. The SWAC holds a two-game winning streak for the first time in series history.

Last year's win by the SWAC (Southern University) over South Carolina State snapped a seven-year MEAC winning streak in the annual MEAC/SWAC Challenge.

Raynard On Initial Walter Payton Watch List

North Carolina A&T State redshirt senior quarterback **Lamar Raynard** was placed on the Walter Payton Watch List by FCS STATS.

Raynard has a spot on the list for the second straight season. The Walter Payton Award is given to the best offensive player on the NCAA Division I-Football Championship Subdivision level as voted on by a national panel of more than 150 sports information and media relations directors, broadcasters, writers and other dignitaries.

Reynolds, Johnson On Initial Buck Buchanan Award Watch List

North Carolina A&T State defensive end **Darryl Johnson, Jr.** and N.C. Central defensive back **Davanta Reynolds** were both named to the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List by STATS FCS.

MEAC Announces 2018 ESPN Slate

The Mid-Eastern Athletic Conference (MEAC) announced its ESPN television package for the 2018 season which features 10 regular season match-ups on ESPN, ESPN2, ESPNU, ESPN Classic, ESPN3 and one postseason appearance on ABC. The nationally televised games are a part of the MEAC's on-going partnership with ESPN.

The 2018 Guardian Credit Union FCS Kickoff featuring defending MEAC Champion North Carolina A&T State and Jacksonville State of the Ohio Valley Conference, kicked off the season live on ESPN on Aug. 25.

The 14th annual MEAC/SWAC Football Challenge kicks off the first full week of the 2018 season featuring North Carolina Central versus Prairie View A&M of the SWAC live on ESPN2 at 12 p.m. on Sunday, Sept. 2. N.C. Central will play in the classic for the first time in university history while PVAMU makes its second appearance. The contest moves to a neutral site for the first time since 2015 as it'll be played in Atlanta, Ga. at "Pete Petit Field" at Georgia State Stadium.

The ESPN3/ESPNU Saturday slate kicks off on Sept. 15 as N.C. Central makes its second ESPN appearance of the season two weeks later as they'll travel to Orangeburg, S.C. to face South Carolina State at 6 p.m. One week later, the annual Circle City Classic will feature an all-MEAC affair as Howard and Bethune-Cookman will square off in Indianapolis, Ind. at 4:30 p.m. Both games will air live on ESPN3 and broadcast that evening on ESPNU.

The first Thursday night contest of the year will air on Sept. 27 as South Carolina State travels to North Carolina A&T State for an anticipated showdown which will air live on ESPNU at 7 p.m.

The MEAC returns to the airwaves in the month of November with four contests headlined by N.C. Central at Bethune-Cookman on Thursday, Nov. 8 at 7 p.m. live on ESPNU and the annual Florida Classic featuring Bethune-Cookman and Florida A&M in Orlando, Fla. on Nov. 17. The Florida Classic will air live at 2 p.m. on ESPN Classic.

Two wildcard contests have been secured by the MEAC in November featuring teams in contention for the conference title. The first wildcard contest will take place on Nov. 3 followed by the final weekend of the regular season on Nov. 17. Both games will air live on ESPN3 and broadcast that evening on ESPNU.

The fourth annual Celebration Bowl wraps up the season as the MEAC Champion will square off against the SWAC Champion on Saturday, Dec. 15 in Atlanta, Ga. inside Mercedes Benz Stadium. The contest will air live on ABC at noon.

MEAC Announces Agreement With ESPN3/ESPN+
