MEAC WEEKLY CONFERENCE NOTES



Bethune-Cookman, the 2017 MEAC champion, made a run through the elimination bracket to make the team's 14th straight championship final appearance in 2018, but the Wildcats fell 12-9 to North Carolina A&T State to wrap up the tournament. The Wildcats, who boast Preseason Pitcher of the Year Anthony Maldonado and four members of the Preseason First Team, dropped all three games at Miami this past weekend. B-CU lost two of three at Savannah State this past weekend and did not qualify for the MEAC Baseball Championship, losing a three-way tiebreaker with Savannah State and North Carolina Central. The Wildcats finished the season 17-38.



Coppin State wrapped up its seventh season under head coach Sherman Reed in 2018 and won the MEAC Northern Division for the first time since 1996. The Eagles, who were the top seed from the North in the MEAC Championships, defeated Florida A&M to advance to the semifinals before falling to North Carolina A&T State and Bethune-Cookman. The Eagles were predicted to repeat as Northern Division champions this season. Coppin State was the division's No. 2 seed in the MEAC Baseball Championship, falling to both Savannah State and Delaware State on Wednesday to be eliminated.



Delaware State struggled in 2018, despite being picked to win the Northern Division last season, winning just seven conference games and missing out on the conference tournament. The Hornets, who boast Preseason Second Team All-MEAC honoree Darnell Maisonet, were picked to finish third in the Northern Division this season, and they swept Coppin State two weekends ago to secure a spot in the conference tournament -- before concluding the regular season this past week with a win at Richmond. The Hornets were the No. 3 seed from the Northern Division, and they ran all the way into Friday before being eliminated by Florida A&M, 9-8 in extra innings.



Florida A&M was picked to finish third in the MEAC Southern Division this season, picking up a first-place vote to snap a tie with North Carolina Central with 48 points in the preseason poll. The Rattlers placed two players on the All-MEAC Preseason First Team, and the Rattlers claimed the Southern Division's No. 2 seed. The Rattlers faced elimination in four straight games and won them all, including an 8-1 win over Northern Division top seed Norfolk State to claim the 2019 MEAC title -- their first since 2015 and eighth overall. FAMU is in the Atlanta Regional, taking on No. 3 national seed Georgia Tech.



Maryland Eastern Shore, which advanced to the MEAC Championships last year, is in its second season under new head coach Brian Hollamon, and the Hawks were picked to finish fourth in the Northern Division this season -- despite making back-to-back tournament appearances. The Hawks were swept by Norfolk State two weekends ago after falling to Pitt twice midweek, and they are officially eliminated from the conference tournament. The Hawks wrapped up the 2019 season on the road this past Wednesday, losing both games of a doubleheader at Georgetown.



Norfolk State was picked to finish second in the MEAC Northern Division this season, despite having won the division in three of the last four seasons. The Spartans notched four first-place votes in the preseason poll and had two players (Justin Hayes, Stephen Baughan) named Preseason First Team All-MEAC. Norfolk State went 17-7 in MEAC play to earn the Northern Division's top seed for the fourth time in five years, and the Spartans were one strike from their first ever MEAC title -- before FAMU came back to win that game 5-4 and then win the if-necessary 8-1 to take the 2019 MEAC baseball crown.



North Carolina A&T State, coming off its first MEAC baseball title since 2005, was picked to repeat as Southern Division champions this season, racking up 15 of a possible first-place votes and notching three Preseason First Team All-MEAC honorees in Michael Johnson, Perry "AJ" Hunt and Dawnoven Smith. The Aggies took two of three from Florida A&M this past weekend to claim the Southern Division's No. 1 seed and first-round bye. NCAT defeated Savannah State before falling to Norfolk State to fall into the elimination bracket -- before falling to Florida A&M and end its title defense.



North Carolina Central was picked to finish fourth in the MEAC Southern Division this season, despite winning a school-record 28 games in 2018 and boasting the reigning MEAC Player of the Year in second baseman Corey Joyce. The Eagles lost their conference finale this past week before sweeping a pair of games against Norfolk State. NCCU finished tied in the standings with Savannah State and Bethune-Cookman, but lost on the tiebreaker and has been eliminated from the MEAC Baseball Championship.



Savannah State is entering its final season as a member of the MEAC, and the Tigers were picked to finish fifth in the Southern Division. Savannah State dropped two of three this past weekend to Southern Division leader North Carolina A&T State, and the Tigers closed out their final regular season as a MEAC member this weekend by taking two of three from Bethune-Cookman, forcing a three-way tie in the standings and winning the tiebreaker to claim the final tournament slot. Savannah State defeated Coppin State in the first round before falling to Southern Division top seed North Carolina A&T State and then being eliminated in walkoff fashion by Delaware State.

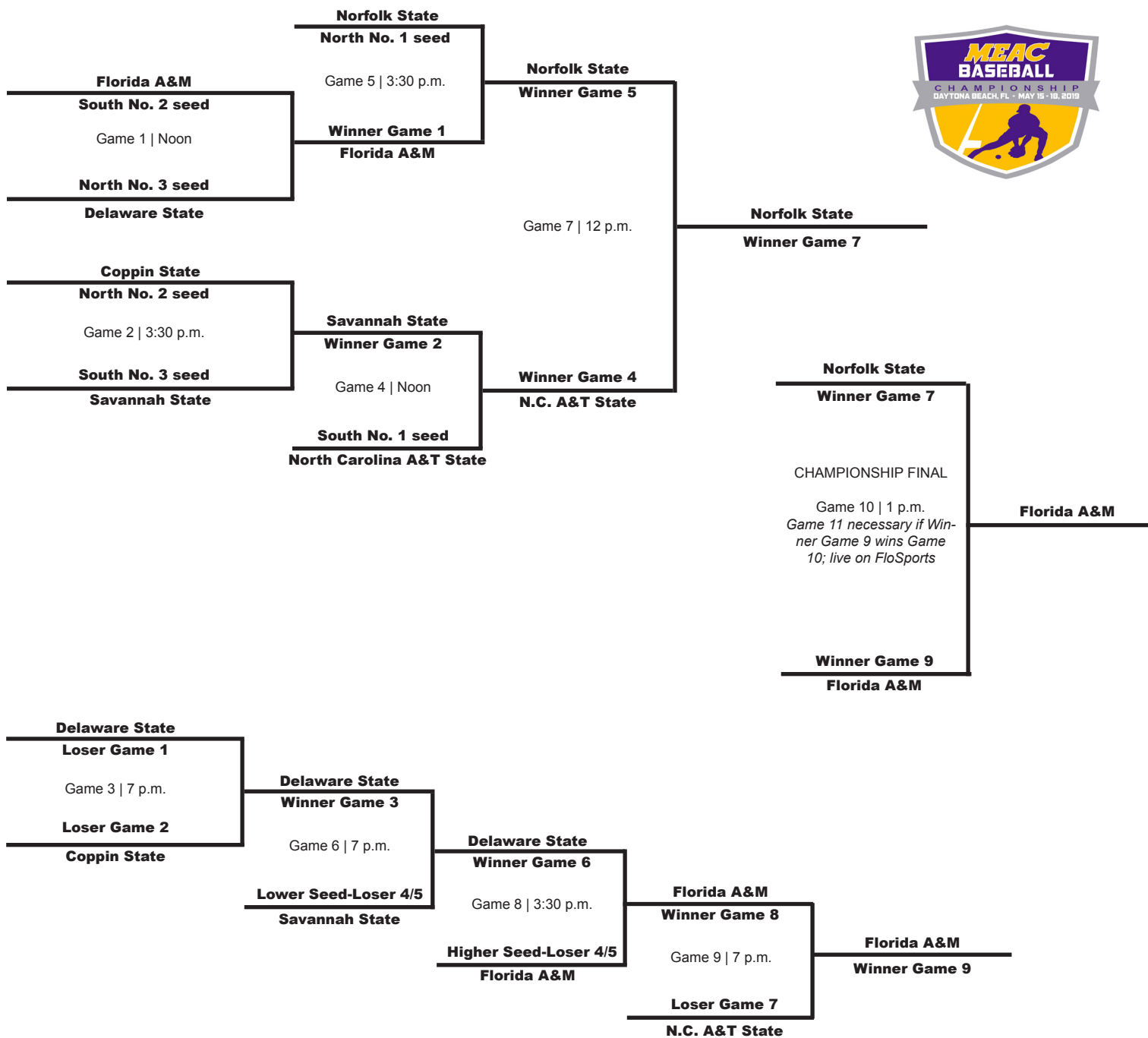
