Coe guard Roger Higgins, a first team all-conference performer a year ago, is the only Coe player to be named on this year's All-Midwest conference team. The conference team, which has just been released, represents all of the nine member schools.

Higgins operated equally well on both offense or defense. He was one of the best blockers on the Coe team and also called defensive signals for Coach Wally Schwank.

John Rosenberg, a first team performer last year, was picked on the second team this year. Rosenberg was hampered by injuries this year and probably would have broken the all-conference five-man backfield had he been healthy.

Other Kohawks honored were end Ralph Pucci, tackle Jon Kohl, a second team performer last year, and halfback Ron Armstrong. All received honorable mention honors.

Included on the first team are ends David Colburn of Carleton, and Bob McKee of Monmouth; tackles Chas. Machacek, Carleton and Clark Hedgcock of Knox; guards John Larew, Grinnell and Higgins; and at center is William Gardner from Cornell.
