MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Lily Johnson, Sr., OH, Missouri State

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson totaled 50 kills and 50 digs in two road wins last week, averaging 5.56 kills, 5.56 digs, 0.67 blocks and 6.0 points per set while hitting .270 against the MVC's two other unbeaten teams. Friday at Drake, Johnson finished with 28 kills and a career-high 32 digs, becoming the second player in school history and first since 1989 to record at least 25 kills and 30 digs in a match. She also had four blocks against the Bulldogs. Saturday, Johnson piled up 22 kills, including 12 on 20 swings with no errors in the clinching fourth set, and hit .312 to lead the Bears to a 3-1 win at No. 20 UNI in a match-up between two 7-0 MVC clubs. The senior added 18 digs, an ace and two blocks against the Panthers.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Emily Butters, Jr., L, Missouri State

Missouri State junior Emily Butters averaged 7.44 digs per set and was flawless on 97 service receptions in a pair of road victories against the MVC's co-leaders. Friday at Drake, Butters lifted a career-high 44 digs, the second-best total in MSU history, fifth-highest mark in Valley history, and third-most in the NCAA this season. Butters dug a match-high 23 balls Saturday in MSU's four-set victory at 20th-ranked UNI, and had 10 assists on the weekend as the Bears improved to 8-0 in league play.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Gillian Gergen, Fr., MB, Drake

Drake freshman Gillian Gergen had 11 blocks in a pair of MVC matches to lead the Bulldogs to a split against Missouri State and Southern Illinois. Gergen also added 16 kills on 41 attempts (.317) with seven digs in the two matches. In the five set match against Missouri State, she nearly recorded a double-double with a career-high 10 kills and a career-high eight blocks. She followed that performance with six kills and a team-high three blocks in four sets against SIU. The freshman is currently leading the MVC in blocks in conference games with 1.33 per set and has posted three or more blocks in every MVC match this season.

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NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag averaged 3.89 kills, 2.44 digs and 0.44 blocks per set as Bradley kicked off a four-match MVC road swing with matches at Evansville and Illinois State. Haslag opened with week with her 12th double-double of the year as she tallied 18 kills, 14 digs and three blocks in a five-set contest at Evansville to move into 15th in career kills at Bradley. She capped the week with 17 kills, eight digs and one block Friday at I-74 rival Illinois State. Haslag now has the most kills by a Brave in a season since Lindsay Stalzer led the nation with a MVC season record 720 kills in 2005 and is the ninth Brave with at least 350 kills and 250 digs in a season.

Kyla Inderski (DU) - Led Drake with 32 kills in a splitting a pair of MVC games over the weekend and added 38 digs ... averaged 3.56 kills and 4.22 digs per set ... also added four blocks at the net ... in the five-set loss to MVC leading Missouri State, she had a team-high 27 kills and a career-best 24 digs ... nine of her kills came in the fourth-set to force a fifth set against the Bears ... she followed that with 15 kills and 14 digs in four sets against SIU to give her a second double-double on the weekend ... has recorded double-doubles in seven of eight MVC games this season.

Mildrelis Rodriguez (UE) - University of Evansville junior Mildrelis Rodriguez averaged 3.23 kills per set and 3.77 digs as the Purple Aces earned a pair of conference wins. In a 5-set win over Bradley, Rodriguez had a great 20-20 performance, notching 21 kills and 22 digs while adding three block assists. It was the first such performance for a UE player since Brooke Maher in 2010. She had another great effort at Loyola, posting 14 kills and 15 digs in the victory. The weekend finale at Valparaiso saw her notched seven kills and 12 more digs.

Jaelyn Keene (ILS) - Keene guided Illinois State to a pair of Missouri Valley Conference wins over the past week, leading her team in kills in both matches. For the week, Keene averaged 3.86 kills, 1.14 blocks and 1.00 digs per set. She led all players with 13 kills in the Redbirds' sweep at Indiana State on Monday. Keene then went for 14 kills and six blocks in a victory over visiting Bradley on Friday at Redbird Arena. The Redbirds' senior middle blocker ranks in the top five in the MVC in hitting percentage (.323), kills per set (.394), aces per set (.034), blocks per set (1.02) and points per set (.486).

Gabi Maciagowski (ILS) - Maciagowski averaged 3.80 kills, 0.40 aces and 0.40 digs per set last week as Loyola dropped a pair of MVC matches. In a five-set loss to Evansville on October 13, the Preseason All-MVC pick totaled 21 kills, her most of the year, and added four digs. She followed that performance with a 17-kill effort in a 3-2 setback versus Indiana State the next night. In her last four matches, Maciagowski has recorded 17 or more kills three times, showing signs of her 2016 form that earned her Second Team All-MVC recognition. Maciagowski, who leads the Ramblers with 168 kills this season, needs 232 kills to reach 1,000 for her career.

Bri Weber (UNI) - Weber eclipsed the 1,000 career kill mark and became only the 11th UNI Panther to join the Double Grand Club (1,000 or more digs/assists/kills). Weber averaged 3.57 kills per set and 5.43 digs per set as the Panthers split a pair of league matches in the McLeod Center. Weber secured 11 kills and 15 digs in a 3-0 sweep of Southern Illinois. Weber came back on Saturday with her 45th career double-double as she totaled 14 kills and 23 digs vs. Missouri State.

Nellie Fredriksson (SIU) - Fredriksson turned in a pair of solid performances in road contests over the weekend. The Angelhorn, Sweden native averaged 2.43 kills per set and 1.14 blocks per set. Fredriksson opened the weekend with a team-best nine kills, six digs and two blocks at No. 20 Northern Iowa. She followed with eight kills, five digs and six blocks at Drake on Saturday. Fredriksson eclipsed 650 career kills with her 17 over the weekend and has now recorded at least 100 kills in each of her four seasons at SIU.

Taylor Graboski (VALPO) - Graboski paced the Crusaders offensively in both matches last weekend to continue her strong conference season. She posted 13 kills on .310 hitting against Indiana State, and followed with 12 kills on .526 hitting in the sweep of Evansville. The .526 hitting percentage was the second-best mark of her career (minimum 10 kills). On the week, she posted 4.17 kills/set on .396 hitting. Graboski currently ranks second in the conference in MVC-only play in hitting percentage (.370) and fifth in kills/set (.379).

Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD) - Rosado averaged 5.33 digs per set in addition to boasting a 97.7 serve receive percentage in a pair of road matches. She started the week with a career-best 33 digs and five assists in a five-set contest at Evansville with her 33 digs ranking as the best total by a Bradley player since 2013. In fact, Rosado's 33 digs tied for the sixth-best single match total in school history. She followed it up with 15 digs and five assists in a four-set match at I-74 rival Illinois State. Rosado's 466 digs this season rank as the eighth best season total in program history.

Kylee Macke (DU) - Led Drake with 52 kills in splitting a pair of MVC matches ... averaged 5.78 digs per set ... in the five-set loss to Missouri State, she had 27 digs and added 25 digs in four sets against SIU ... her 27 digs were her second most in a five-set match and the 25 were also the second-most in a four-set match for her ... her 27 digs against MSU helped

set the school record for digs in a match at 130 ... has had 20 or more digs in six of eight MVC matches ... ranks third in the MVC in digs per set in conference games this season.

Courtney Pence (ILS) - Pence continued her season-long run of stellar play from the back row as she led Illinois State in digs in a pair of Redbird wins over the past week. Pence tallied 16 digs each in her team's sweep at Indiana State on Monday and a home win over Bradley on Friday. She also dished out seven assists over the past week, averaging one per set. Pence continues to lead the Missouri Valley Conference and rank among the national leaders in digs (505) and digs per set (.608).

Damad Johnson (INS) - Johnson showcased her talents on both sides of the net this weekend as she led the Sycamores to a perfect weekend on the road with wins over Valparaiso and Loyola. Johnson had 23 kills and 10 blocks from her middle blocker position. Against the Crusaders, she nearly tallied a double-double with 14 kills on a .650 attacking percentage to go along with six blocks. She then helped the Sycamores to a 3-2 win over Loyola with nine kills and four blocks to close out the weekend.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - In two matches last weekend, Nunez totaled 3.90 digs per set as she ran her streak of consecutive matches with 10 or more digs to five. The junior libero racked up 22 digs in a five-set setback to Evansville on October 13, then produced 17 digs in a gut-wrenching loss to Indiana State on October 14. For the season, Nunez leads the team with 3.60 digs per set and is also contributing 0.75 assists and 0.13 aces per set.

Kendyl Sorge (UNI) - Sorge averaged a team-high tying 5.43 digs per set in two MVC home matches. Sorge tallied 16 digs and a perfect service reception percentage in 25 attempts in UNI's 3-0 win over Southern Illinois on Friday. Sorge added 22 digs in a four-set match vs. Missouri State. It was Sorge's eighth match this season with 20 more digs.

Kolby Meeks (SIU) - Meeks pitched in 1.29 blocks and 1.86 kills per set in a pair of road league matches over the weekend. The senior middle blocker contributed four kills and four blocks at No. 20 Northern Iowa on Oct. 13, then came back to hit .533 with nine kills and five blocks against Drake on Oct. 14. Meeks currently leads the MVC with a .369 hitting percentage.

Rylee Cookerly (VALPO) - Cookerly led the way for the Crusaders as they averaged 22.17 digs/set in last weekend's pair of matches to increase their nation's leading average in the category. Cookerly tallied a team-high 18 digs and did not commit a reception error Friday against Indiana State, and followed with 16 digs in Saturday's sweep of Evansville. Cookerly ranks second in the conference, averaging 5.78 digs/set on the year.

Sydney Holt (ILS) - Holt averaged 2.71 kills per set on a .351 hitting percentage while helping Illinois State to a pair of Missouri Valley Conference wins over the past week. She also chipped in 11 digs, three blocks and two aces over the two matches. The freshman middle blocker/right side collected nine kills in a win at Indiana State on Monday before posting 10 kills in a win over Bradley on Friday. Holt has been particularly impressive since the start of league play, averaging 2.07 kills per set and a .270 hitting percentage in league matches this fall.

Nikkie White (INS) - Freshman Nikkie White continues to shine in her first season at Indiana State. The Columbus, Ohio product had 15 kills (1.88 k/s), 13 digs and six blocks as ISU swept the weekend with wins over Valpo and Loyola. White recorded a career high nine digs, six kills and three blocks against the Crusaders in a 3-1 win on the road. She added nine kills, four digs and a trio of blocks against the Ramblers in a five-set victory. She has recorded a block in all but one match this season for the Sycamores.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - Van Grinsven continued her solid play by contributing 2.60 kills, 0.60 digs and 0.30 blocks per set, while hitting .281 (.26-8-64), in a pair of five-set losses last weekend. The freshman middle blocker went for 13 kills, a season-high four digs, and a block in a 3-2 setback versus Evansville on October 13, then put up 13 kills, two digs and a pair of blocks, while hitting at a .344 clip (.13-2-32) in a heartbreaking loss to Indiana State a night later. In Valley play, Van Grinsven leads Loyola with 95 points and is posting 2.38 kills, 0.50 digs and 0.78 blocks per set. She has posted double-digit kills in three straight matches, averaging 2.87 kills per set in that stretch.

Emelie Orlando (MSU) - Emelie Orlando averaged 5.29 assists and 1.29 digs per set in pair of road wins last week. Friday, she dished out 13 helpers and dug four balls in the Bears' win at Drake. Saturday at 20th-ranked UNI, Orlando had 24 assists and five digs while helping MSU to a .232 attack efficiency in a 3-1 win.

Jaydin Seehase (UNI) - Seehase totaled 17 kills and three blocks as the Panthers went 1-1 in league play. Seehase posted six kills and three digs in a 3-0 sweep of Southern Illinois on Friday. Seehase recorded her fifth double-figure kill match of the season with 11 kills against Missouri State on Saturday. Seehase added a career-best tying two solo blocks vs. the Bears.

Brittany Anderson (VALPO) - Anderson averaged 11 assists per set in the Crusaders' pair of matches last weekend as Valpo split in MVC action. She tallied 31 assists and added 12 digs against Indiana State, and followed on Saturday with 35 assists, 12 digs and three kills in the sweep of Evansville. Anderson now owns 750 total assists on the year, just 33 away from topping Kelsey Berrington (2012) as the most prolific freshman setter in Carin Avery's 16-year tenure as head coach.

Streak Enders

Missouri State snapped Drake's 10-match winning streak on Friday, which was the fifth-longest streak in the nation, and put an end to UNI's seven-match win streak on Saturday. The win over the Panthers was the second-top 20 victory of the season for Missouri State and the fourth over the last two seasons. Prior to last season, the Bears had not earned a win versus an AVCA top-20 team since 2009.

Second Place On the Line

The winner of Tuesday's match between Drake and UNI will take over sole possession of second place in the MVC standings halfway through the league season. The Bulldogs and Panthers have matching 7-1 MVC records entering Tuesday's match in the McLeod Center. The top two finishers in the MVC regular season standings receive a bye into the semifinals of the MVC Tournament set for Nov. 23-25 in Normal, Illinois.

Road Dominance

Missouri State continues to hold the longest road win streak in the NCAA, sitting at 18-straight. The Bears will return to the road on Friday, October 27 at Evansville.

More Streaks of Note

With its 17th win on Friday, UNI guaranteed the program would have a .500 or better record for the 37th consecutive season. UNI, Hawaii, Nebraska, Stanford, Penn State and UCLA lead the nation with 37 consecutive non-losing seasons in NCAA Division I volleyball. UNI has also posted 33 straight NCAA Division I winning seasons – the sixth-longest active streak in the nation behind Hawaii (37), Nebraska (37), Penn State (37), Stanford (37) and UCLA (35).

School Records & More

Friday's Missouri State at Drake match featured numerous statistical superlatives, including the Bears establishing single-match school records for digs (153) and attacks (266), both of which stood since the 1980s. The Bulldogs also set a program record with 130 digs in the match. Emily Butters (44), Lily Johnson (32) and Daniele Messa (29) all set career highs for digs, becoming the first three teammates in school history to all reach 25 digs in the same match. Butters and Johnson also became the first duo with 30 digs in the same match, while Butters' dig total was two shy of the MVC record, the second-most in MSU history, and the third-best in the NCAA this season.

NCAA RPI Report

The latest NCAA RPI report for the 2017 season has been released (Oct. 16) and the Valley has two teams featured in the top-50. Missouri State leads the league at No. 46, while UNI sits No. 49 this week.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

Top-25 Victories

The Valley has five wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 5-8 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

UNI claimed four Top 25 wins during non-conference play. The last time UNI recorded four or more wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2002 (#8 Pepperdine, #7 UCLA, #20 Minnesota, #3 Florida, #20 Missouri).

Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). Bradley (Murray State), Loyola (Samford) and Missouri State (Ohio State) each claimed one win against the field.

Hitting the Century Mark

Junior Yavianliz Rosado had a career-best 33 digs to pace five Bradley players in double figures in digs last Monday at Evansville as the Braves collected 100 digs in a match for the first time since 2010. Rosado topped 30 digs for the fourth time this season with her 33 digs the most at Bradley since 2013 and tying for the sixth-best match total in school history. On the season, Rosado has 466 digs which already ranks eighth among Bradley season marks and she enters the weekend needing 33 digs for just the sixth 500-dig season in program history.

Streak Snapped

Drake suffered its first MVC loss of the season, a 3-2 setback to first-place Missouri State, Friday evening that snapped the team's 10-game winning streak that was the fifth-longest in the nation at the time ... Saturday, Drake won its 18th match of the season, surpassing last year's win total and marking the most wins by the program since 2010 ... the 18 wins are also the sixth most in a season by the Bulldogs since 1982.



Record Digs

In the five-set loss against Missouri State, the Bulldogs set a program record with 130 digs ... four Bulldogs recorded 19 or more digs in the loss with freshman Kylee Macke leading the way with 27 ... the Bulldog defense, which entered the weekend ranked seventh in the nation and first in the MVC in conference games in digs, held MSU to .195 hitting, its lowest output against an MVC opponent this season ... this season, MVC opponents are hitting a league-low .150 against the Bulldogs ... Drake also only allowed one service ace against the Bears, who came into the match averaging an 1.19 aces per set ... the Bulldogs have allowed just two aces in the last nine sets of play.

Program's Best

Over the weekend, senior Kyla Inderski surpassed the 1,300 mark in both career kills and digs ... she now has 1,323 career kills and 1,351 career digs ... her combined 2,674 career kills and digs are the most in program history, jumping past Brandy Ossian's 2,621 combined career kills and digs.

School Records & More

Friday's match at Drake featured numerous statistical superlatives, including the Bears establishing single-match school records for digs (153) and attacks (266), both of which stood since the 1980s. Emily Butters (44), Lily Johnson (32) and Daniele Messa (29) all set career highs for digs, becoming the first three teammates in school history to all reach 25 digs in the same match. Butters and Johnson also became the first duo with 30 digs in the same match, while Butters' dig total was two shy of the MVC record, the second-most in MSU history, and the third-best in the NCAA this season.



Another Ranked Win

Missouri State defeated 20th-ranked UNI on Saturday for its second-top 20 victory of the season and fourth over the last two seasons, three of which came on the road. Prior to last season, the Bears had not earned a win versus an AVCA top-20 team since 2009.

Win Streaks of Note

While MSU's current MVC and road win streaks have been well documented, the Bears' current nine-match overall win streak is special for another reason. Missouri State has now had a streak of at least nine consecutive wins in each of the last three seasons, with a nine-match streak in November 2015 and a 17-match streak from Sept.-Nov. 2016.

The Bulldogs and Panthers have matching 7-1 MVC records entering Tuesday's match in the McLeod Center. Closing the Block

The Salukis hold a 45-18 lead over the Braves in the all-time series and have won eight-straight over the Braves, including four-straight at home. In total, Southern has won 12 of its last 14 home matches against Bradley dating back to the 2004 season.

Spreading the Ball Around

Nellie Fredriksson became the sixth Saluki hitter with at least 100 kills on the season. It marks the third-straight season, and 10th season since the Missouri Valley Conference formed in 1992, that the Salukis have had at least six hitters with 100 kills.

Digging Deep

For the seventh consecutive week, Valpo leads the nation in digs per set as the Crusaders remain the only squad in D-I volleyball posting more than 20 digs a frame. The Crusaders are averaging 20.22 digs/set, well ahead of Bowling Green in second position (18.81 digs/set). Valpo has a long tradition of strong defensive play, as the program has ranked among the top-20 nationally in digs/set in each of the last seven seasons - including a sixth-place placement in 2015 and a fourth-place finish in 2010.



Moving Up the Charts

Senior Taylor Graboski and redshirt junior Allison Ketcham are poised to crack Valpo's all-time top-10's in a trio of categories over the coming weeks. First up will likely be Graboski's entry into the career blocks chart, as with 323 career blocks, she is just two rejections away from that top-10 list. Graboski is also just 21 kills shy of the top-10 in that category, and would be one of just three players in program history to rank in the top-10 in both kills and blocks. Meanwhile, Ketcham continues to move up the career digs chart and enters this week just 54 digs away from Katie Bova's 10th-place total of 1,308.

Freshmen Step Up

A pair of Crusader freshmen stepped up off the bench with strong performances in the sweep of Evansville. Jaclyn Bulmahn, who has just 13 kills total in Valpo's first seven MVC matches, posted a season-best eight kills Saturday. In the back row, Melissa Flynders tallied 10 digs in the win over the Purple Aces after entering the match with just 15 digs on the year.
