MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Piper Thomas, Jr., MH, UNI

UNI junior Piper Thomas averaged 5.00 kills per set and hit .447 over this week's set of matches for the Panthers. Thomas set a career-high with 24 kills (.385) in a five-set match at Illinois State on Friday. Thomas came back on Sunday and delivered a team-high 16 kills (.583) in a 3-0 sweep at Bradley. Thomas notched 40 kills against six attack errors in 76 total swings in the two league matches. Thomas is the MVC leader in hitting percentage (.355 - all matches; .418 in conference only matches).

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Courtney Pence, Jr., L, Illinois State

Illinois State's Courtney Pence played a key role in helping the Redbirds to their first win over a Top 25 team in nearly 14 years on Friday, tallying a match-high 37 digs in a five-set win over No. 25 Northern Iowa. On Saturday, Pence registered 29 digs in a three-set match, with double-digit digs in the second and third sets, respectively. For the weekend, she averaged 8.25 digs per set, while adding seven assists and one service ace. Pence continues to lead the MVC and rank among the national leaders in both total digs (625) and digs per set (6.25).

MVC Freshman of the Week

Cassie Brooks, Fr., DS, Evansville

Evansville freshman Cassie Brooks was on fire this weekend as she posted an unbelievable 6.83 digs per set in leading the Purple Aces to a 3-0 win over Southern Illinois and a great effort against Missouri State on Friday. The first match of the weekend against MSU saw Brooks notch 21 digs against the undefeated Bears. She also had four assists in just three frames of work. Brooks was back at it against the Salukis as she tallied 20 more digs and six assists in another 3-set match.

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NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag averaged 4.83 kills, 2.33 digs, 0.67 blocks and 5.33 points per set in a pair of home matches last week. She tallied 14 kills with one ace, five digs and a block Friday against Drake to move into ninth in career kills at Bradley. Sunday against 25th-ranked UNI, Haslag finished one dig short of her 15th double-double of the season with 15 kills, nine digs and three blocks. She broke the Renaissance Coliseum career kills record in Sunday's outing against the Panthers and now has a league-best 451 kills this season for the seventh-best season total in school history.

Cathryn Cheek (DU) - Led Drake to a pair of 3-0 wins over the weekend with 27 kills, 23 digs, and five blocks in six sets of action ... averaged 4.50 kills per set on .250 hitting to help the Bulldogs hit .213 in the wins at Bradley and Illinois State ... her five blocks tied for the second most on the team in the two matches ... opened the weekend with a 15-kill, 12-dig double-double at Bradley and then had 12 kills, 11 digs and five blocks at Illinois State.

Mildrelis Rodriguez (UE) - Junior Mildrelis Rodriguez had a great weekend for the Aces as they fought Missouri State to the finish before earning a 3-0 win over Southern Illinois. The Juana Diaz, Puerto Rico native average 4.00 kills per set while notching 2.33 digs per frame. In Friday's contest versus the Bears, Rodriguez finished with 10 kills in 40 attempts, hitting .200. She also had six digs. Friday's win over the Salukis saw her lead all players with 14 kills as she also hit a solid .216. She was also second on the team with eight digs.

Morgan Gresham (LUC) - Gresham nearly notched her fourth double-double of the year, registering a match-high 11 kills, while adding nine digs and a pair of blocks, in a 3-0 loss at Valparaiso on October 27 in Loyola's only match of the week. Gresham has recorded 10 or more kills in four of her last six appearances and for the year is pitching in 2.07 kills and 2.25 digs per set.

Lynsey Wright (MSU) - Lynsey Wright averaged 4.67 kills, 5.17 points and 0.83 blocks per set last week, hitting a blistering .523 with a .636 kill percentage in two road victories. Wright led all players with 15 kills on 22 swings Saturday at Indiana State, hitting .636 with three blocks. She committed just one error in the 3-0 win while climbing into MSU's top 10 in career kills. Friday, the senior piled up 13 kills in 22 attempts, posting a .409 efficiency with two blocks and a dig.

Patience Brown (SIU) - Brown put together a pair of stellar performances on the road for the Salukis this past weekend. The Bloomington, Ill. native led SIU in kills in each of their two matches and set career-bests in kills and hitting percentage in the 3-1 win over Indiana State on Oct. 27. Brown put down 16 kills, against two errors for a .519 hitting percentage and added a season-high nine blocks, including two solos. She followed with seven kills and five blocks at Evansville on Saturday and for the weekend hit .441 with a 3.28 kills per set average.

Taylor Graboski (VALPO) - Graboski continued her strong senior season, needing just 14 swings to rack up eight kills in Valpo's sweep of Loyola as she hit at a .429 clip. The senior also picked up a pair of blocks as well in helping the Crusaders to their fourth sweep in the last five matches. Graboski currently ranks third in conference-only play in hitting percentage, fourth in blocks and sixth in kills.

Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD) - Rosado had a big weekend, breaking her own school record for digs in a three-set match set earlier this fall in Friday's matchup with Drake and topping the new mark in Sunday's contest against 25th-ranked Northern Iowa. She averaged an impressive 8.83 digs per set to go with 1.50 assists per set against two of the top offensive teams in the MVC. Friday against Drake, she had 26 digs and six assists in three sets to break the previous record for digs in a three-set match of 23 she had set back in September against UConn. Sunday against Northern Iowa, Rosado helped Bradley hold the Panthers 45 points below the team's hitting percentage in league matches entering the contest and collected 27 digs and three assists in the three-set contest. Rosado broke the Renaissance Coliseum season record for digs and her team-best 563 digs this fall rank as the second-best season total in school history.

Kyla Inderski (DU) - Led Drake with 36 digs in six sets and was third on the team in blocks with four in the two 3-0 sweeps ... the digs moved her closer to the 1,400-career dig mark with 1,380 to date ... all of her digs on the week were part of double-doubles as she had 10 kills and 19 digs at Bradley along with four blocks ... followed that with 11 kills and 17 digs in the win at Illinois State.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - Nunez tallied a match-best 17 digs in Loyola's three-set loss at Valparaiso last week in the team's only action of the week. The junior libero has posted double-digit digs in seven of the Ramblers' last eight matches, four times totaling 17+ digs. For the year, Nunez leads the team with 3.61 digs per set.

Aubrey Cheffey (MSU) - Aubrey Cheffey averaged a block per set last week while contributing 3.83 kills per set on .400 hitting on the offensive side of the net. She had two blocks and dig in Saturday's win at Indiana State, adding 14 kills without an error to hit .538. Friday, Cheffey had four blocks, two digs and nine kills in a sweep of Evansville.

Kendyl Sorge (UNI) - Sorge averaged 6.38 digs per set in two league matches. Sorge secured the fourth 30 more dig effort of her career at Illinois State as she was credited with 30 digs. Sorge had a perfect serve reception match against Illinois State in 34 attempts. Sorge added 21 digs in a 3-0 win over Bradley on Sunday. Sorge moved into fifth place on UNI's all-time digs list this weekend as she has accumulated 1,583 career digs.

Natalie Fry (DU) - Led Drake at the net with eight blocks in six sets in three-set wins at Bradley and Illinois State ... also had six kills on 19 attempts ... had three blocks in the win at Bradley and followed that with five blocks and three kills on nine attempts at Illinois State.

Sydney Holt (ILS) - Holt turned in a pair of strong performances over the weekend while helping Illinois State to its biggest league win of the season. Holt registered 13 kills and eight digs in Illinois State's five-set win over No. 25 Northern Iowa on Friday, the Redbirds' first win over a nationally-ranked opponent in nearly 14 years. The freshman middle blocker/right side then tallied nine kills and three blocks in a loss to Drake on Saturday. For the weekend, Holt averaged 2.75 kills and 1.25 digs per set.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - In a loss at Valparaiso last week, Van Grinsven totaled five kills, a dig, a block and an ace. The rookie middle blocker is contributing 1.91 kills, 0.41 digs and 0.62 blocks per set this season, while hitting .233. She has produced five or more kills in eight of the last nine outings.

Maggie Nedoma (SIU) - Nedoma put down 16 kills (2.28 kills/set) for the Salukis in a pair of conference road tilts over the weekend. The Brook Park, Ohio native tallied nine kills on 21 swings in a 3-1 win at Indiana State on Oct. 27, and followed with a team-high seven kills at Evansville on Oct. 28. It marked the 14th time in 22 matches this season that the freshman opposite hitter has recorded seven-plus kills.

Brittany Anderson (VALPO) - Anderson handed out 28 assists and posted three kills on just four attacks as Valpo swept Loyola in its lone match last week. She quarterbacked the Crusader offense as it hit .293 for the match, the team's second-best hitting percentage of the season. Anderson has now racked up an even 900 assists on the year, the most by a freshman setter in head coach Carin Avery's 16-year tenure.

Clinched!

Missouri State and UNI have each secured a spot in the six-team MVC Volleyball Tournament which will be held at Redbird Arena on the campus of Illinois State November 23-25. Drake, Illinois State, Valparaiso and Indiana State currently occupy the final four spots in the tournament race with three weeks remaining during the regular season.

20 Win Club

Missouri State won its 20th match of the season Saturday at Indiana State, the 18th time in the last 19 seasons that the Bears have accumulated at least 20 victories. Including 2017, only Penn State and Colorado State have won at least 20 matches in each of the last 19 years, while Nebraska, Florida and Hawaii have a chance to do so by season's end.

Drake recorded their 20th win of the season with a 3-0 win at Bradley. The milestone was the Bulldogs' first 20-win season since 2010 and the sixth in program history since 1982. Drake's 1995 owns the program record for wins with 25.

20/20/20

With Drake and Missouri State joining UNI with 20 or more wins this season, the MVC is the only Division I conference to have three teams with 20 or more victories this season. The Big Sky, Big South, Big Ten, Colonial, Conference USA, Ohio Valley and Southland each have two teams in the club.

First Time In A Long Time

Illinois State secured its first win over a nationally-ranked program in nearly 14 years when the Redbirds earned a five-set victory over No. 25 UNI Friday at Redbird Arena. The Top 25 win was Illinois State's first since the Redbirds beat then-No. 8 UNI on Nov. 21, 2003, in a match that was also played in Redbird Arena and also went the full five sets.

Valley Streaks

Missouri State continues to work its way up the list of the longest regular season MVC match win streaks in MVC history. The Bears hold the sixth-longest streak in league history at 28-straight league wins following two more wins over the weekend. The streak also currently sits fourth nationally among active win streaks in league play. The 12-0 league start is the second-best MVC start in MSU history behind the 2003 club, which won its first 15 conference matches.

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

AVCA Top-25

UNI fell out of the Top 25 in the latest AVCA poll (Oct. 30) following a five-set loss at Illinois State Friday. Missouri State is receiving votes and sits 27th with 40 votes, while UNI sits 30th with 12 votes.

Mid-Major Top 25

The Valley continues to have two teams ranked in the top 10 of the VolleyballMag.com Mid-Major* Top 25 Poll (Oct. 24). Missouri State (8th) and UNI (9th) continue to hold their spots in the top 10.

Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). Bradley (Murray State), Loyola (Samford) and Missouri State (Ohio State) each claimed one win against the field.

Senior CLASS Award Candidates

Illinois State's Jaelyn Keene and Missouri State's Lily Johnson have been named candidates for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award. Keene and Johnson are among 30 NCAA Division I candidates in volleyball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.

MVC Career Kills Queen

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson broke the all-time MVC career kills record in a 3-2 win at Illinois State. Johnson pounded out 20 kills in the win and surpassed Lindsay Stalzer from Bradley (2002-05) to claim the conference record.

NCAA Record Within Reach

Lily Johnson has rocketed up the NCAA's career kill attempts list, and now ranks second all-time with 6,184 attacks. The NCAA record is still several matches away, however, as South Florida's Michelle Collier tallied 6,633 career attacks (481 sets) from 1998-2002.

More MVC Records For Johnson

Lily Johnson established a pair of MVC records during the season's first weekend. Johnson passed MSU's Michelle Witzke for the MVC's career lead in total attacks, and recorded her 97th and 98th career matches with at least 10 kills, breaking a tie with Witzke and Bradley's Jenny Pavlas for the most in conference history based on available records. Johnson's 13 career MVC Player of the Week honors are also the most in league history, surpassing UNI's Molly O'Brien (2000-03).

Another Plateau for Johnson

Missouri State's Lily Johnson had eight digs in Saturday's 3-0 win at Indiana State to become the sixth player in MSU history with 1,500 digs in a career, and the 11th player in NCAA Division I history with 1,500 digs and 2,100 kills.

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson fell to No. 2 on the NCAA active career kills leaders chart following last week's action. Johnson and Milos are the only two current NCAA players with over 2,000 kills.

Can You Dig It?

Junior Yavianliz Rosado broke her own school record for digs in a three-set match set earlier this year Friday with 26 digs against Drake, only to top the mark again Sunday with 27 digs against 25th-ranked Northern Iowa. Rosado, who now owns the Renaissance Coliseum season digs record with 301, has 563 digs this season for the second-best season total in Bradley history. She has had 25 or more digs in five of the last seven matches, averaging 5.77 digs per set during that stretch. Rosado has helped Bradley to its highest season dig total under the 25-point format and the Braves need just 92 digs for just the team's third 2,000 dig season in the last 27 seasons.



Another Record Falls

Erica Haslag already owned the Renaissance Coliseum season kills record, but the junior now ranks as the career kills record in facility history despite playing just 38 career matches in the building. Haslag broke the Renaissance Coliseum career kills record of 488 held by Alise Tupuritis (2010-13) with 15 kills Sunday against Northern Iowa. In Friday's contest against Drake, Haslag had climbed into ninth in career kills at Bradley and now has 1,066 kills, while her 451 kills this fall currently ranks as the seventh-best season total in school history. She is just the third player in school history to collect 450 kills, 300 digs, 20 aces and at least 40 blocks in a season, joining Bradley Hall of Fame members Lindsay Stalzer (2005) and Jenny Pavlas (1997) in the elite group.

Rare Air

Sophomore Hannah Angeli owns the first 1,000-assist season at Bradley since 2011 and is the first Brave with 19 double-doubles in a season since 2005, but she joined an even more exclusive group over the weekend. Bradley's first player with 95 kills, 1,000 assists, 25 aces, 325 digs and 30 or more blocks in a season since Sam Hardwick in 2001, Angeli is just the third player in program history to reach those marks. Wendy Carney eclipsed those marks both her junior and senior seasons of 1988 and 1989, but Angeli is the first Bradley player to do so as an underclassman.
