MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Jaelyn Keene, Sr., MB, Illinois State

Illinois State senior Jaelyn Keene played a leading role in guiding the Redbirds to a pair of conference wins over the weekend, leading her team in kills in each match, while setting a Redbird Arena record in Saturday's victory. For the weekend, Keene averaged 5.12 kills per set on a .411 hitting percentage, to go along with four aces and averages of 1.25 digs and 1.12 blocks per set. It was Keene's performance in a win over Valparaiso Saturday that stood out, as she tallied a career-high 29 kills in the Redbird win, matching the Illinois State Redbird Arena record for kills in a match. Keene currently ranks among the top 10 in The Valley in hitting percentage (.324), kills per set (3.95), aces per set (0.36) and blocks per set (1.01), and leads the league in total aces (27) and points per set (4.88).

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Kylee Macke, Fr., L, Drake

Drake freshman Kylee Macke led the Bulldogs with 38 digs in a pair of MVC road wins to average 5.43 digs per set in the team's 3-1 win at Evansville and 3-0 sweep at Indiana State. Macke helped hold Drake's opponents to just 0.098 hitting in the wins. The freshman opened the weekend with a team-high 26 digs at Evansville, the second-highest total of her career and highest in a four-set match, and added 12 digs in the three-set win at Indiana State. Macke remains second in the MVC in digs in conference matches this season and is the lone underclassman ranked in the top five.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Stef Jankiewicz, Fr., S, Illinois State

Illinois State's Stef Jankiewicz tallied the most assists by a Missouri Valley Conference player in a league match this season as she distributed 60 assists in the Redbirds' win over Valparaiso Saturday night at Redbird Arena. Jankiewicz averaged 10.38 assists per set over the weekend, while helping Illinois State to a 2-0 record. Jankiewicz also chipped in 24 digs (3.00 per set), four kills, two blocks and an ace over the two matches. The Redbirds' freshman setter currently ranks second in The Valley in assists, at 10.45 this season.

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag averaged 3.62 kills and 3.25 digs per set as she helped Bradley split a pair of home Missouri Valley Conference matches. She had six kills, one ace and 13 digs Friday against Valparaiso before tallying her 11th double-double of the year in Saturday's five-set victory over Loyola. Haslag had 23 kills, one ace, 13 digs and two blocks to help power the Braves to the victory. She pushed her conference-leading season kill total to 334 (most in a season at Bradley since 2006) in addition to breaking her own school mark for kills in a season at Renaissance Coliseum as she helped Bradley rally from two sets down to win in five sets for the first time since 2011.

Cathryn Cheek (DU) - Led Drake to another pair of MVC wins on the road with 23 kills, 18 digs and a team-high nine blocks in the Bulldogs' wins at Evansville and Indiana State ... averaged 3.29 kills per set in seven sets and 2.57 digs per set to nearly average a double-double on the week ... opened the road series with 12 kills, 15 digs and four blocks at Evansville ... followed that with an efficient 11 kills and five blocks in three sets at Indiana State.

Lily Johnson (MSU) - Lily Johnson averaged 4.67 kills, 5.0 digs and 5.5 points per set in the Bears' only match last week, a Saturday sweep of Southern Illinois. Johnson also hit .293 and committed just two attack errors while adding two aces, two assists and a block. She was perfect on 18 service reception chances, and ended the match with 14 kills and 15 digs for her 12th double-double of the season.

Bri Weber (UNI) - Weber had every piece of her game clicking in a pair of road victories for the Panthers. Weber recorded team-bests in kills (28), digs (29), points (31.5) and attack percentage (.414). Weber recorded the eighth-highest three-set kill total (highest in program history since moving to 25-point sets in 2008) with 20 kills at Indiana State. Weber also garnered a career-high .514 attack percentage against the Sycamores. Weber added nine digs, a block assist and an assist in the 3-0 win at Indiana State. Weber kept it going Saturday with match-high 20 digs to go along with eight kills (.261). She also posted two service aces, two assists and a solo block in a 3-0 win at Evansville. Weber averaged 4.67 kills/set and 4.83 digs/set as the Panthers played only six sets of action in two matches.

Taylor Graboski (VALPO) - Graboski continued to lead the Crusaders in MVC play on both sides of the net last week. In Valpo's sweep of Bradley, she tallied eight kills and a team-high five blocks. Then on Saturday at Illinois State, Graboski posted a team-best 21 kills on .419 hitting - her second effort of at least 20 kills in Valpo's last four matches - and led the Crusaders again with five rejections. For the week, Graboski averaged 3.62 kills/set while hitting at a .344 clip, as well as 1.25 blocks/set. Graboski enters this weekend with 321 career blocks and 1,051 career kills - just four blocks and 46 kills shy of Valpo's all-time top-10 in the respective categories.

Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD) - Rosado averaged 4.62 digs, 1.25 assists and 0.12 aces per set as she helped Bradley split a pair of home Missouri Valley Conference matches and helped the Braves limit their two opponents to .196 hitting. She had nine digs, two assists and one ace Friday in Bradley's first conference matchup with Valparaiso. In Saturday's five-set victory against Loyola, Rosado nearly collected her second double-double of the season as she finished with eight assists and 28 digs. She helped Bradley rally to win a match after dropping the first two sets for the first time since 2011.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - Nunez averaged 5.38 digs per set in a pair of MVC road contests last week. The junior libero tallied 13 digs in a three-set loss at Illinois State on October 6, then produced a career-best 30 digs in a five-set setback at Bradley one night later. Nunez, who has registered 10 or more digs in five of the last six outings, is the first Rambler to record 30 or more digs since Maddy Moser notched 33 at Wake Forest on September 3, 2016. That total obliterated Nunez's previous career best of 19 digs set against Fairfield earlier this season. For the year, Nunez leads the team with 3.54 digs per set.

Emily Plock (DU) - Led Drake on the weekend with a team-high 24 kills in the matches at Evansville and Indiana State ... her 24 kills came on 54 attempts for a .278 hitting percentage ... averaged 3.43 kills per set and added two blocks ... opened the weekend with a career-high 19 kills on 36 attempts for a staggering .417 hitting percentage ... her 19 kills are the fifth-most in a four-set MVC match this season and the second most by a Bulldog this season ... had five kills at Indiana State before leaving the match due to injury.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - Van Grinsven averaged 2.62 kills, 0.88 blocks and 0.25 aces per set last week as Loyola dropped a pair of Missouri Valley Conference matches on the road. The freshman middle blocker had four kills, three digs and a block at Illinois State on October 6, then went for season highs of 17 kills, six blocks and two aces in a five-set heartbreaker at Bradley one night later. The 17 kills easily surpassed her previous season high of 11 set versus Drake on September 22. Van Grinsven is hitting .239 this season, with 1.81 kills and 0.66 blocks per set.

Jaydin Seehase (UNI) - Seehase powered the Panther offense to back-to-back sweeps of Indiana State and Evansville on the road. Seehase had five kills (.400) to go with a dig and a block assist in a 3-0 win at Indiana State. Seehase came back on Saturday night with nine kills (.667) and two block assists as the Panthers moved to 6-0 in league play with a 3-0 win at Evansville.

Rylee Cookerly (VALPO) - Cookerly paced Valpo's back-row play in both matches last week for the Crusaders. In Friday's sweep of Bradley, Cookerly recorded 19 digs, keeping a number of plays alive as Valpo limited the Braves to just .095 hitting for the match. Then on Saturday, Cookerly tallied a team-high 20 digs at Illinois State. For the weekend, she averaged 4.88 digs/set.

Three's Company

For the first time in Valley history three teams have started league play with a 6-0 record. Missouri State and Drake will meet this Friday in Des Moines in a square off of two 6-0 MVC teams. If UNI and Missouri State enter Saturday's match with identical 7-0 MVC marks, it would mark the first match of 7-0 league teams since UNI and Illinois State locked horns on Oct. 17, 2014, in Normal, Illinois. Illinois State came away with a 3-1 win over the Panthers in Redbird Arena in 2014. UNI and Missouri State were both 8-0 when the pair met on Oct. 17, 2009, in Cedar Falls. UNI posted a 3-1 win in that match in the McLeod Center.

Streaks Roll On

Drake, UNI and Missouri State all earned wins on Saturday to keep their winning streaks alive. The Bulldogs won their 10th-straight, the Bears their seventh-straight and the Panthers their sixth-straight match. The MVC is the only conference in the NCAA to have three teams riding a winning streak of six or more (DU-10, MSU-7 and UNI-6).

Something's Gotta Give

One streak will end on Friday as Missouri State heads to Des Moines for a matchup with Drake. The Bears currently have the longest road win streak in the NCAA, sitting at 16-straight, while the Bulldogs have the fifth longest win streak in the NCAA, sitting at 10-straight.

Record Setting

Jaelyn Keene's name already appears in multiple spots in Illinois State's record book, but she added a new entry Saturday night when she tallied a career-high 29 kills in the Redbirds' win over visiting Valparaiso. The 29 kills matched Illinois State's Redbird Arena record for kills in a match, and are tied for the fourth-most kills in a match in school history. The 29 kills are also the most recorded by a Valley player in a league match this season.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

Top-25 Victories

The Valley has five wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 5-8 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

UNI claimed four Top 25 wins during non-conference play. The last time UNI recorded four or more wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2002 (#8 Pepperdine, #7 UCLA, #20 Minnesota, #3 Florida, #20 Missouri).

AVCA Top-25

UNI moved up to No. 20 in the latest AVCA Top 25 poll (Oct. 9) following sweeps over Indiana State and Evansville last week. The Panthers have been ranked in 114 polls in the history of the AVCA Top 25 with this being their highest mark since 2011. Missouri State is receiving votes and sits 31st with eight votes.

Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). Bradley (Murray State), Loyola (Samford) and Missouri State (Ohio State) each claimed one win against the field.

Senior CLASS Award Candidates

Illinois State's Jaelyn Keene and Missouri State's Lily Johnson have been named candidates for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award. Keene and Johnson are among 30 NCAA Division I candidates in volleyball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.

MVC Career Kills Queen

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson broke the all-time MVC career kills record in a 3-2 win at Illinois State. Johnson pounded out 20 kills in the win and surpassed Lindsay Stalzer from Bradley (2002-05) to claim the conference record.

More MVC Records For Johnson

Lily Johnson established a pair of MVC records during the season's first weekend. Johnson passed MSU's Michelle Witzke for the MVC's career lead in total attacks, and recorded her 97th and 98th career matches with at least 10 kills, breaking a tie with Witzke and Bradley's Jenny Pavlas for the most in conference history based on available records. Johnson's 11 career MVC Player of the Week honors are also the most in league history, surpassing UNI's Molly O'Brien (2000-03).

Haslag Among NCAA Leaders

Bradley junior Erica Haslag ranks Top 10 nationally in four categories entering play this week. Haslag sits second nationally in total attacks (1,000), fourth in total kills (334), sixth in total points (369) and seventh in attacks per set (12.82).

Big Comeback

Bradley dropped the first two sets of Saturday's matchup with Loyola 26-24 and 25-23, before rallying to win the final three sets. The Braves snapped a five-match losing skid in five-set contests which dated back to a five-set victory over Evansville on Oct. 30, 2015. In fact, Bradley had not rallied from a two-sets-to-none deficit to win a match since doing so against Southern Illinois on Sept. 17, 2011.



Continue To Improve

Saturday's five-set victory against Loyola gave Bradley it's eighth win of the season, surpassing the team's overall win total from 2016 and marking the third consecutive season the Braves have won more matches than the previous season. Bradley has not improved on its win total in three consecutive seasons since a five-year stretch from 1990 through 1994. In addition, Bradley is 6-6 at home this season for the most home victories since 2013 (6-6). The Braves need one win at Renaissance Coliseum to tie the facility record for home victories in a season (2011) and two wins in the final five home matches would give Bradley eight or more wins at home for the first time since 2005 (10).

No Place Like Home

Junior Erica Haslag turned in her sixth performance in 2017 with 20 or more kills to highlight Saturday's win against Loyola with a match-high 23 kills. Haslag broke her own Renaissance Coliseum season record for kills in a season of 182 set as a freshman in 2015 and now had 196 kills in 12 home matches this fall. She also passed her team-best kill total from 2016 with her 334 kills in 2017 ranking as the most by a Bradley player since 2006. Haslag enters the week needing 51 kills to become the 14th individual in program history to reach 1,000 career kills.

ILLINOIS STATE (11-9, 4-3 MVC)

Record Setting

Jaelyn Keene's name already appears in multiple spots in Illinois State's record book, but she added a new entry Saturday night when she tallied a career-high 29 kills in the Redbirds' win over visiting Valparaiso. The 29 kills matched Illinois State's Redbird Arena record for kills in a match, and are tied for the fourth-most kills in a match in school history (regardless of venue). The 29 kills are also the most recorded by a Valley player in a league match this season.



Always A Fight

Illinois State has won at least one set in 19 of its 20 matches so far this season. The Redbirds have been swept just once, by Baylor, on Aug. 26, 2017, just hours after a grueling 2-hour, 49-minute, five-set loss to then-No. 15 Florida State. The Redbirds have come out on the good side of sweeps much more often, with nine of the team's 11 wins coming via 3-0 victories.

Defensive Dandies

ISU ranks at or near the top of the Missouri Valley Conference in several key defensive categories. The Redbirds lead the MVC in opponents' hitting percentage (.150), opponents' assists per set (10.80) and opponents' kills per set (11.55). ISU is second in digs per set (18.61) and opponents' service aces per set (0.76).

Bears Stay Perfect

Missouri State improved to 6-0 in MVC play for the first time since 2009 with a win Saturday, the sixth time in school history that the Bears have won their first six Valley matches. MSU started 6-0 in 2006, 8-0 in 1992, 2002 and 2009, and 15-0 in 2003.



Valley Streak Continues

Missouri State extended its regular-season MVC winning streak to 22 matches Saturday, adding to the Bears' school-record Valley win streak in volleyball and tying the MSU baseball team's 22-game win league streak from May 15, 2016-May 18, 2017 for the longest by any Missouri State program in MVC contests.

MSU Sets Defensive Record

With a 25-17 victory in the first set of Saturday's match at Southern Illinois, the Bears moved their streak of holding opponents below 20 points to 10 consecutive sets. It marked the second time in the 25-point set era (since 2008) that Missouri State prevented the opposition from reaching 20 points in 10 straight periods, and the first time that the streak did not include a 15-point fifth set.

The two-time All-MVC selection has totaled 111 kills (3.47 kills/set) and 94 digs (2.93 digs/set) in eight career matches against Missouri State, and has now recorded double-doubles in seven-straight matches versus the Lady Bears.



Middles Leading the Way

SIU's middles continue to convert attempts with great efficiency. Kolby Meeks and Patience Brown combined to hit .360 and totaled 12 kills and four blocks against first-place Missouri State on Saturday. Brown hit a team-best .500 with nine kills on 16 swings while Meeks added three kills and three blocks. Meeks continues to lead the MVC in hitting percentage at .352 and Brown ranks fifth in the league with a .326 hitting percentage. Southern is the only program in the Valley to have two hitters ranked in the top-five in the MVC in hitting percentage.

Active Career Leaders

Andrea Estrada's 1,261 career kills are the seventh-most in program history, and the 29th-most amongst active DI student-athletes. Her 1,238 career digs, meanwhile, rank her fifth in school history and are the 64th most amongst active players. Abby Barrow needs 39 kills to become the 15th Saluki to reach 1,000 career kills and her 961 kills rank in the top-100 at No. 93.
