### MVC Offensive Player of the Week

#### Lily Johnson, Sr., OH, Missouri State

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson averaged 5.67 kills on .326 hitting, 3.67 digs and 6.33 points per set in a pair of Missouri State sweeps. She added three aces and two blocks in helping the Bears to their second consecutive MVC title. Saturday against UNI, Johnson posted a double-double with 14 kills and 13 digs, hitting .289 with two blocks and an ace. Sunday, the senior celebrated her final home match by hitting .360 with 20 kills, nine digs and a pair of aces against Drake.

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week

#### Emily Butters, Jr., L, Missouri State State

Missouri State's Emily Butters averaged 7.50 digs per set in two MSU wins, tallying 10 assists and three aces in the two matches while helping the Bears hold the opposition to .175 hitting. Saturday, Butters dug 24 balls in three sets, nearing a double-double with eight assists and adding two aces against UNI. Sunday, the junior had 21 more digs and another ace to help MSU sweep Drake to earn an outright MVC championship.

### MVC Freshman of the Week

#### Stef Jankiewicz, Fr., S, Illinois State

Illinois State freshman Stef Jankiewicz turned in a strong performance in ISU's only match over the past week, dishing out 57 assists and collecting 15 digs in the Redbirds' 3-1 win at Bradley on Saturday. The double-double was Jankiewicz's 15th of the season, and fifth over her past six matches, and the 57 assists marked a career high in four-set matches. Jankiewicz currently ranks second in The Valley, and among the national freshman leaders, in both total assists (1,191) and assists per set (10.83).

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Erica Haslag (BRAD)** - Haslag had a team-high 18 kills and tallied 13 digs, two blocks and one ace Saturday against I-74 rival Illinois State as she turned in her 16th double-double of the season. Haslag, who notched her 1,100th career kill in the outing, collected eight kills and six digs in the fourth set. With two matches remaining, Haslag needs eight kills for just the fourth 500-kill season in Bradley history.

**Cathryn Cheek (DU)** - Led Drake over the weekend with 35 kills and 33 digs to averaged 4.38 kills and 4.12 digs per set ... also hit .255 in the pair of matches ... opened the weekend by matching a career-high with 21 kills and added a career-high 24 digs in five sets at SIU ... followed that with 14 kills, nine digs and four blocks in three sets at Missouri State ... she has now recorded double-figure kills in six of the last seven matches and double-figure digs in five of those seven matches.

**Jaelyn Keene (ILS)** - Keene paced the Illinois State offensive attack in the Redbirds' lone match over the past week, a 3-1 win at Bradley on Saturday. Keene tallied a match-high 22 kills on a .526 hitting percentage in the Redbird win. She also added totals of five blocks, five digs and two aces, to finish with 27.5 points in the match. The Redbird senior currently leads her team and ranks in the top three in The Valley in hitting percentage (.329), kills per set (3.99), service aces per set (0.34) and points per set (4.88).

**Laura Gross (INS)** - Junior hitter Laura Gross put together an outstanding weekend for the Sycamores on the court as she led Indiana State to a weekend sweep of Loyola and Valparaiso at the ISU Arena. Gross went for 39 total kills and 35 digs over the two match stretch, for her 17th and 18th double-doubles of the season. Against the Ramblers Gross led the way with 22 kills and 14 digs before closing out the weekend with 17 kills and 21 digs against Valpo.

**Gabi Maciagowski (LUC)** - Maciagowski had an impressive week, recording a pair of double-doubles as Loyola University Chicago split its final two road matches of the season. The Preseason All-MVC selection averaged 4.00 kills, 3.43 digs and 1.00 blocks per set, while hitting .221 (.28-11-77) in matches at Indiana State and Evansville. Her 17 kills at Indiana State on November 10 are her most since tallying 17 in the previous meeting with the Sycamores this season back on October 14, and her 13 digs were a season high. Maciagowski also pitched in four blocks in the four-set setback in Terre Haute. She then contributed 11 kills, hitting .310 (.11-2-29) and added 11 digs and three blocks in a three-set sweep of Evansville on November 11. Over the last three matches, Maciagowski is tallying 3.90 kills, 2.60 digs and 0.90 blocks per set, while hitting .226 (.39-15-106).

**Karlie Taylor (UNI)** - Taylor averaged a team-best 4.33 kills/set and 5.83 digs/set in helping UNI to a weekend split of two road matches. Taylor tied a career-high with 22 digs in a three-set match at Missouri State. Taylor added 12 kills, three assists, two service aces and a solo block against the Bears. Taylor came back on Sunday against Southern Illinois and posted the highest single-match hitting percentage (.483) with 14 kills and no attack errors in 29 attempts. She also recorded her team-leading 21st double-double of the season. Taylor had 14 kills and 13 digs in the 3-0 sweep of the Salukis in Davies Gym.

**Kolby Meeks (SIU)** - Meeks led the Salukis in kills over the weekend as SIU split at home. The Norcross, Ga. native put down 18 kills, against two errors for a .400 hitting percentage and added five blocks. In the comeback win over Drake, Meeks put down a team-best 13 kills, recording her 500th career kill in the process. She added five kills the following night against Northern Iowa.

**Sydney Bronner (VALPO)** - Bronner led Valpo offensively, as well as in its defense at the net, over the two matches last weekend. She opened the weekend with an errorless performance on the attack in Valpo's win at Evansville, putting down 13 kills on 28 swings for .464 hitting and tallying a match-high six blocks. She followed at Indiana State with a team-best 14 kills and added a pair of blocks as well. For the week, she averaged 3.38 kills/set on .355 hitting and an even one block per set.

**Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD)** - Rosado tallied a team-best 18 digs Saturday against I-74 rival Illinois State to pace five Bradley players in double figures in digs. Her 18-dig effort pushed her season dig total over 600 as she broke Stacey Besjak's school record for digs in a season (606), which dated back to 1985. Her 607 digs this season rank as the 26th-best season total in MVC history.

**Kyla Inderski (DU)** - Led Drake with 38 digs on the week and is now just one away from the 1,500 career dig mark ... also added seven blocks at the net ... averaged 4.75 digs per set over the weekend ... in the five sets at SIU, she had 17 digs in addition to her 20 kills and a season-high four blocks ... the following day at MSU, she notched 21 digs in three sets along with three blocks and 10 kills.

**Courtney Pence (ILS)** - Pence provided her usual strong defense from the back row in Saturday's 3-1 win at Bradley as she led all players with 19 digs. She also provided one assist and one service ace in the Redbird win. Pence was at her best in the third set of Saturday's match, posting nine digs in the set to help Illinois State rebound from dropping the second set. Pence continues to lead The Valley and rank among the national leaders in both total digs (689) and digs per set (6.26).

**Rachel Griffin (INS)** - Senior Rachel Griffin was all over the court this weekend as she helped ISU to wins over Loyola and Valpo in her final matches at the ISU Arena. Griffin wrapped up her weekend with 99 total assists (12.38 a/s) and 39 digs (4.88 d/s). Against Loyola Griffin went for 45 assists and 11 digs before eclipsing the 50-assist mark Saturday with 54 assists and 17 digs in a win over the Crusaders. She also finished with five blocks. Griffin has now 12 double-doubles on the season following her weekend performances.

**Maddy Moser (LUC)** - One week after registering her 1,000th career dig, Moser had an impressive week, producing 4.86 digs and 0.71 assists per set. In a four-set loss at Indiana State, the junior libero notched 16 digs, three assists and an ace, and then produced 18 digs and a pair of assists in a three-set sweep of Evansville on November 11. Over the last four matches, Moser

**Kendyl Sorge (UNI)** - Sorge averaged 5.00 digs/set and handed out eight assists as UNI secured the No. 2 seed for the 2017 MVC Tournament. Sorge helped UNI record its fourth-highest dig total for a three-set match with 79 digs at Missouri State. Sorge chipped in with 18 digs and an assist against the Bears. Sorge added 12 digs and seven assists on Sunday in a 3-0 win at Southern Illinois.

**Patience Brown (SIU)** - Brown was effective at the net defensively for the Salukis, as she recorded six blocks, including two solo blocks, in SIU's two matches over the weekend. She also tallied 17 kills, hit .366 and added eight digs (1.0/set). Brown had eight kills against one error and two blocks in SIU's win over Drake, and she followed with a team-high nine kills and four blocks against Northern Iowa on Sunday.

**Rylee Cookerly (VALPO)** - Cookerly averaged 6.25 digs/set over Valpo's two matches last weekend to lead the Crusader effort on the back line. She tallied a match-best 27 digs in the four-set win at Evansville and then led all players the next night with 23 digs at Indiana State. Along the way, Cookerly set Valpo's single-season record for digs by a freshman and has ascended to seventh on the Crusaders' single-season list with 621 digs this year. Cookerly also was perfect on the serve receive over the two matches as well.

**Gillian Gergen (DU)** - Hit .294 in the weekend's matches along with a team-high 10 blocks in eight sets ... in five sets at SIU, she registered seven kills on 19 attempts along with five blocks and three aces ... followed that with five kills on 15 attempts and five more blocks against Missouri State ... continues to lead the conference in blocks in MVC games with 1.27 per set.

**Elle Van Grinsven (LUC)** - In a pair of road tilts last weekend in Indiana, Van Grinsven accounted for 2.29 kills and 1.57 blocks per set to help the Ramblers to a 1-1 record. The freshman middle blocker registered nine kills and five blocks, to go with two digs and an assist, in a four-set loss at Indiana State, then pitched in seven kills, five blocks and an ace to help Loyola to a 3-0 sweep of Evansville, its first three-set victory since November 19, 2016. For the season, Van Grinsven is hitting .221 (.194-78-525) and is adding 2.00 kills and 0.74 blocks per set.

### Clinched!

Missouri State, UNI, Drake and Illinois State have each secured a spot in the six-team MVC Volleyball Tournament which will be held at Redbird Arena on the campus of Illinois State November 23-25. Valparaiso, Indiana State and Southern Illinois all remain alive for one of the final two spots in the tournament race heading into the final weekend.

### MVC Champs

Missouri State secured the program's fifth MVC regular season title with Saturday's win against UNI, and claimed the outright championship Sunday versus Drake. The Bears also won the MVC in 1992, 1993, 2003 and 2016, and pulled off the regular season/tournament double in 1993. Missouri State's 16-0 MVC start is the best in school history, and the school-record for league wins is 17, set by the 2003 squad.

### UNI Locks Up Tourney Bye

UNI secured the No. 2 seed for the 2017 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament with a 3-0 win over Southern Illinois on Sunday. By earning the No. 2 seed, UNI is guaranteed spot in the semifinals with a bye. As a result, this marks the 33rd straight MVC Tournament semifinal appearance for the Panthers. UNI's streak of playing each year in the MVC Tournament semifinals began in 1985.

### Historic Season

Drake has already secured its first MVC Tournament berth since 2010 and will begin play as either the league's No. 3 or 4 seed. With one match remaining, the Bulldogs' 23 wins are already tied for the third-most in program history. Additionally, the team's 40 wins in the last two years are the fourth-most in any two-year period in Drake history.

### Finishing Strong

Having already clinched a winning season, Illinois State would like to finish the regular season strong with a pair of wins, which would mark a 20-win season for the Redbirds. Illinois State has only topped 20 wins four times in the past 16 years. In two of those years, the Redbirds advanced to the NCAA Tournament.

### Best MVC Records

Since the start of the Missouri Valley Conference in the 1992 season, 10 league team has gone through MVC play unscathed. UNI has accomplished a perfect MVC season seven times, Wichita State twice and Illinois State once. On eight of the 10 occasions, that team went on to win the MVC Tournament.

### Bears Keep On Streaking

Missouri State's win streak extended to 17 matches on Sunday, tying last season's 17-match streak for the best in school history. The Bears won 18 consecutive matches in 1975 and 2003, 22 in a row in 1974, and a record 30 straight in 1975.

### Senior CLASS Award Finalists

Illinois State's Jaelyn Keene and Missouri State's Lily Johnson have been named finalists for the 2017 Senior CLASS Award. Keene and Johnson are among 10 NCAA Division I candidates in volleyball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

### Three Over 23

Drake, Missouri State and UNI all sit with 23 or more wins this season, the MVC joins the OVC as the only Division I conferences to have three teams with 23 or more victories this season. The Big Sky, Big South, Big Ten, Colonial, Conference USA, and Southland each have two teams in the club.

### League Leaders

Missouri State's 16-0 league record matches five others who have started with 16 or more consecutive league wins in 2017. Eight NCAA teams are still unbeaten in their respective leagues (through Nov. 12).

### Road Dominance

Missouri State continues to hold the longest road win streak in the NCAA, sitting at 20-straight. The Bears close the regular season on the road against Valparaiso and Loyola this weekend.

### Valley Streaks

Missouri State continues to work its way up the list of the longest regular season MVC match win streaks in MVC history. The Bears hold the fifth-longest streak in league history at 32-straight league wins following two more wins last week. The streak also currently sits third nationally among active win streaks in league play. The 16-0 league start is the best MVC start in MSU history.

### Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

### Power Conference

Over the past decade (2007-2016), the MVC joins the Pac-12, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC and ACC as the only conferences to place three or more teams into the NCAA Tournament at least seven times during that span. The MVC earned four bids in 2007, 2010 & 2015 and three bids in 2008, 2011, 2012 & 2016.

### Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

### Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

### AVCA Top-25

Missouri State made its first appearance in the Top 25 this season in the latest AVCA poll (Nov. 13). The Bears moved into the 25th spot this week. This is the fourth time the Bears have been in the Top 25 with the last appearance coming on Dec. 1, 2003.

### Mid-Major Top 25

The Valley continues to have two teams ranked in the top 10 of the VolleyballMag.com Mid-Major\* Top 25 Poll (Nov. 7). Missouri State (8th) and UNI (9th) continue to hold their spots in the top 10.

### Top-25 Victories

The Valley has five wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 5-8 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

UNI claimed four Top 25 wins during non-conference play. The last time UNI recorded four or more wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2002 (#8 Pepperdine, #7 UCLA, #20 Minnesota, #3 Florida, #20 Missouri).

## Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). ### Double-Doubles

Junior right side/outside hitter Gabi Maciagowski recorded a pair of double-doubles, her first of the season, last weekend as Loyola split matches at Indiana State and Evansville. The Toronto native totaled a season-best 13 digs, her most since September 24, 2016 (15 at Indiana State), and added 17 kills, her most since October 14, in a four-set setback at Indiana State, then went for 11 kills and 11 digs in a win at Evansville. Over the last three matches, Maciagowski is averaging 3.90 kills, 2.60 blocks and 0.90 blocks per set. Maciagowski needs 165 kills to reach the 1,000 mark for her career.

### Fresh Blocking

With 72 blocks this season, middle blocker Elle Van Grinsven is looking to become the first true freshman to lead Loyola in that category since Libby Bresser in 2011 (76). Van Grinsven's 19 kills at Southern Illinois on October 30 were the most by a Loyola true freshman since Amanda Cushen (21) versus Indiana State on October 10, 2015.

### Semis Again

UNI secured the No. 2 seed for the 2017 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament with a 3-0 win over Southern Illinois on Sunday. By earning the No. 2 seed, UNI is guaranteed spot in the semifinals with a bye. As a result, this marks the 33rd straight MVC Tournament semifinal appearance for the Panthers. UNI's streak of playing each year in the MVC Tournament semifinals began in 1985.



### Streaking vs. Drake

UNI has won 41 consecutive matches against the Drake Bulldogs. UNI head coach Bobbi Petersen owns a perfect mark of 34-0 vs. Drake. The Bulldogs's last win in the series came Nov. 23, 1996. UNI holds a 79-12-2 all-time record against Drake. UNI scored a 3-0 win over Drake in the McLeod Center on Oct. 17. The Panthers have won 10 straight sets against the Bulldogs dating back to Nov. 15, 2015.

### Digging at Missouri State

UNI tied for the fourth-most digs (79) in a school history in a three-set match on Saturday at Missouri State. The 79 digs is the most since UNI tallied 81 in a three-set match vs. Southern Illinois (Nov. 4, 2008). UNI's school record for digs (88) in a three-set match came on Nov. 29, 1995, vs. Colorado in an NCAA Tournament match in Palo Alto, California.
