### MVC Player of the Week

#### Katrina Beck, Jr., G, Illinois State

Illinois State junior guard Katrina Beck secured her 500th career point in a 65-56 win over Eastern Michigan on Sunday. She tied her career-high for three-pointers in a game as she netted four out of her six attempts from behind the arc and added a season-high 17 points in the win. Beck averaged 16 points, six rebounds and six assists during the week's two contests. The Redbirds went 1-1 during the week, dropping a 61-59 decision to Milwaukee in overtime.

### MVC Newcomer of the Week

#### Hannah Noe, Gr., G, Evansville

For the third and fourth straight games, Evansville graduate guard Hannah Noe led the Aces in scoring as she averaged 20 points in a pair of non-conference contests. The Dexter, Missouri native poured-in 23 points, hitting six three-pointers, in a 100-62 loss on the road at No. 20 Kentucky. This marked the third time this season that Noe made six triples in a single game. Returning to Meeks Family Fieldhouse, Noe paced Evansville with 17 points in an 82-75 loss to Morehead State on Sunday. Noe continues to lead the MVC in scoring, averaging 18.6 points per game, while also leading The Valley in three-pointers made per game with 3.75 per contest, seventh-best in the nation.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Anneke Schlueter (BRAD)** - Schlueter helped highlight Bradley's 67-52 road win at Eastern Illinois with a season-high 18 points as she scored in double figures for the first time this season. She scored 13 of her 18 points in the first half to help the Braves to a commanding 37-19 halftime lead as BU won back-to-back games in which it never trailed for the first time since midway through the 2016-17 MVC slate. Schlueter, who was a perfect 6-for-6 from the free throw line, added a career-best eight rebounds and three assists as she moved up five spots on Bradley's career scoring list into the top 25.

**Becca Hittner (DU)** - Hittner averaged 18.0 points, 7.0 rebounds and 1.0 assists per game while shooting 42.9 percent (9-of-21) from the floor, 57.1 percent (4-of-7) from beyond the arc and 93.3 percent (14-of-15) from the free throw line ... helped Drake go 1-1 ... scored 18 points behind 6-of-11 shooting, including two three-pointers, in just 18 minutes in blowout win over Iowa Wesleyan's annual Kids Game ... added four rebounds and one assist and made all four of her free throws ... recorded first double-double of the season in double overtime defeat to Nebraska with 18 points and season-high 10 rebounds ... made career-best 10 free throws with just one miss ... ranks fifth in the MVC in scoring at 14.9 points per game ... averaging 4.9 rebounds per game while shooting 44.9 percent from the floor, 37.8 percent from beyond the arc and 79.6 percent from the free throw line ... started all 10 games.

**Wendi Bibbins (INS)** - Indiana State's Wendi Bibbins averaged 15 points per game and brought down 14 rebounds last week in a pair of tough tasks for the Trees. Bibbins set a career-high with 11 field goals made as she scored 22 points in a 77-67 loss to Central Michigan, leading a rally that brought the Sycamores from down 22 to within five points against a Chippewa team ranked ninth in the Mid Major poll. She was all over the floor with three steals and tied a career-high three blocks in the game, going 11-of-16 from the field.

**Liza Fruendt (MSU)** - Liza Fruendt averaged 17 points in three games last week, including a 31-point outburst against Oral Roberts on Sunday. She hit eight 3-pointers at a 44 percent clip, went 9-for-9 at the foul line, and added eight rebounds, four assists and four steals. The senior shot 11-for-21 overall against ORU, including 4-for-8 from distance and 5-for-5 at the charity stripe, adding three steals and three boards while becoming the ninth player in school history with multiple 30-point games in a career. Thursday Fruendt finished with 15 points, four rebounds and three assists as the Lady Bears dispatched former MVC rival Wichita State by a 94-71 final, and had five points in Monday's game at Little Rock.

**Megan Maahs (UNI)** - Maahs scored in double figures in back-to-back games for the Panthers as she poured in 11 and 15 in UNI's last two outings. Maahs' 11-point outing came on the road at Omaha, as the sophomore came a rebound shy of her fourth double-double of the season, while blocking four shots, earning three steals and dishing out two assists. At home this past Sunday, Maahs helped propel the Panthers past UW-Parkside with a 15-point effort, while grabbing six rebounds as UNI scored a season-high 92 points against the Rangers.

**Nicole Martin (SIU)** - Nicole Martin averaged 11.0 points and 5.0 rebounds in a pair of contests last week. She began her week with a game-high 16 points to go along with eight rebounds in SIU's wire-to-wire win over Martin Methodist. She followed with six points and two boards against the defending Conference USA champion Western Kentucky Lady Toppers on Sunday. Martin has scored in double figures in six of SIU's nine games this season.

**Dani Franklin (VALPO)** - Turned in her first double-double of the season in Sunday's win over Chicago State. Also surpassed 500 career made field goals in that game and moved into third in program history in that category. In addition, she cracked the Top 15 in program history in total rebounds and now has 543 for her career.

**Jailynn Lawson (BRAD)** - Lawson provided a spark off the bench in Bradley's 67-52 road win at Eastern Illinois, collecting seven points in just 10 minutes of action. She was 4-for-6 from the free throw line and added three rebounds in the victory as the Braves posted back-to-back wins against in-state non-conference opponents for the first time since 2015-16.

**Hannah Fuller (DU)** - Fuller averaged 11.0 points, 5.5 rebounds, 3.0 steals and 2.5 assists per game ... started week in easy win over Iowa Wesleyan with career highs in points (18), steals (6), assists (5) while shooting 6-of-8 from the floor, 2-of-3 from the three-point line and 4-of-4 from the free throw line, also all high career highs, while playing career-high 23 minutes ... added then career-high five rebounds ... against Nebraska, scored four points and grabbed career-high six rebounds, including career-high five offensive rebounds in 10 minutes ... played in nine game this season, averaging 3.6 points and 2.0 rebounds per game.

**Ty Battle (INS)** - True freshman Ty Battle made her first career start on the same floor as her two-time All-Big Ten Conference father, scoring seven points and grabbing six rebounds at Illinois last Thursday. In all, Battle tallied 15 points and 12 rebounds in two games for Indiana State, adding four assists, one steal and one block over the week in games at Big Ten member Illinois and against No. 9 (Mid Major) Central Michigan while averaging 29.0 minutes per game.

**Abby O'Connor (LUC)** - Loyola freshman Abby O'Connor averaged 13 points and just under seven rebounds over the Ramblers' three games last week. In Monday's clash with DePaul, O'Connor poured in a team-high 15 points to go along with seven rebounds, three assists, two blocks and a steal. The South Bend, Ind. product surpassed her scoring total just two days later against Northern Illinois, scoring a team-high 20 points. In Sunday's weekend finale with No. 23/25 Green Bay, O'Connor posted season-high marks in both rebounds (8) and assists (5). She currently ranks third on the team in scoring (8.4 ppg) and leads the Rambler roster in rebounding (5.1 rpg), blocks (1.0 bpg) and steals (1.0 spg).

**Abby Hipp (MSU)** - Abby Hipp missed only one shot in three games last week, averaging 5.3 points, 2.7 rebounds with two assists and a steal. She was 6-for-6 from the floor, 1-for-1 on 3-pointers and 3-for-4 at the foul line. Hipp made a 3-pointer and a free throw Monday at Little Rock, and went 4-for-4 with 10 points, three boards and a steal in Thursday's win against Wichita State. Sunday, the freshman grabbed four rebounds and connected on her only shot attempt against Oral Roberts.

**Nicole Kroeger (UNI)** - Kroeger earned a career-high 19 points against UW-Parkside as she led the Panthers to their highest point total in over three years. The freshman was 6-of-8 from the floor, while making 4-of-6 from 3-point range. Kroeger also earned two rebounds and dished out one assist against the Rangers. Earlier in the week, Kroeger came a point shy of another double-digit showing as she scored nine points on the road against Omaha, while earning three assists and two rebounds. The starts for Kroeger against Omaha and UW-Parkside were only the second and third of her young career at UNI.

**Abby Brockmeyer (SIU)** - Brockmeyer averaged 7.5 points, 6.0 rebounds and a block in SIU's two games last week. The Raymond, Ill. native finished with nine points, seven boards and two blocks in SIU's win over Martin Methodist on Thursday and followed with six points and five boards against Western Kentucky.

**Bryce Blood (VALPO)** - Chipped in seven points and seven rebounds on Sunday after contributing eight points and four boards at Big Ten foe Purdue. Blood's 7.5 ppg and 5.5 rpg led all Crusader freshmen this week.

## Big Upcoming Matchups

The Missouri Valley Conference has two wins over Power Five opponents this season. UNI took down Iowa State, 57-53, in Cedar Falls and Drake claimed an 83-80 win at home over the Cyclones as well.

This week, the MVC schedule features two games hosting programs from the Big Ten. Missouri State will welcome Northwestern on Saturday, while UNI will host #25 Iowa on Sunday.

The Lady Bears will host a Big Ten school for the first time since a third-round WNIT loss to Illinois in 2010. The Lady Bears are 6-2 all-time at home against the Big Ten, including a victory against Northwestern in 1997.

UNI and Iowa have met 22 times on the hardwood, with the Hawkeyes holding a 20-2 mark in the series. The last UNI win over Iowa came on Dec. 19, 2006, as the Panthers earned an 83-62 win in Iowa City.

## Elite Defense

Illinois State is ranked 14th nationally in scoring defense, allowing 53.8 points per game, and sits seventh nationally in field-goal percentage defense (32.5%). The Redbirds join six other teams that appear in the Top 15 nationally in both categories (Green Bay, Clemson, Gardner-Webb, Villanova, West Virginia and North Texas).

## Senior Leaders

Six league seniors are leading their respective teams in scoring, including Evansville's Hannah Noe (18.6 ppg), Missouri State's Liza Fruendt (17.2 ppg), Valpo's Dani Franklin (16.0 ppg), Illinois State's Hannah Green (14.0 ppg), Southern Illinois' Kylie Giebelhausen (13.4 ppg) and UNI's Kennedy Kirkpatrick (11.6 ppg).

## Franklin In Elite Company

Valpo's Dani Franklin has now reached the following milestones - 1,000 career points, 500 career rebounds and 500 career made field goals. She's joined in that elite group by Debbie Bolen, Jeanette Gray and Sarrah Stricklett as the only players in Valpo history to achieve all three of those feats.

## Double Your Pleasure

UNI's Megan Maahs is the only MVC player averaging a double-double this season. The sophomore is averaging 11.0 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Maahs has a league-best three double-doubles on the season. Below are players with multiple double-doubles this season.

## Home Sweet Home

Currently two MVC teams remain perfect at home: Bradley (3-0) and Valparaiso (3-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season. Valparaiso will look to improve to 4-0 at home on Friday against IU-Northwest. A win would give the Crusaders a 4-0 start at home for the first time since 2007-08 (started 5-0 that season).

## Dialing From Distance

Evansville's Hannah Noe not only leads the MVC in scoring this season, she also ranks seventh nationally in three-point field goals per game. The graduate transfer from SEMO already has 30 three point field goals this season, averaging 3.75 makes per game.

Valpo sophomore guard Grace Hales currently ranks second nationally in three-point field-goal percentage (58.6%), connecting on 17 of her 29 attempts. Hales trails Oregon State freshman guard Aleah Goodman (68.2%; 15-of-22).

## Team Long Range Success

Valpo has shot above 30 percent from 3-point range in all eight games this season and above 35 percent in seven straight. This is the first time Valpo has shot better than 30 percent from three in each of its first eight games since the turn of the century. In addition, the Crusaders are the only team in The Valley that has shot better than 30 percent from three every game this season.

## Mid-Major Top-25 Poll

Drake appears in the latest (Dec. 5) Collegensider.com Mid-Major Top 25. The Bulldogs currently sit 13th in the poll, while UNI is receiving one vote in the poll.

The latest installment of the NCAA RPI Report (Dec. 11) has three Valley teams that rank in the top-200, led by Bradley at No. 150, Drake at No. 166 and UNI at No. 174.

## Non-Conference

The Valley currently holds a combined non-conference record of 34-53 (.391), but has finished at or above .500 in non-conference action in 17 of the past 25 seasons, including six of the last 10.

## Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against four leagues in non-conference play, including the Big 12 (2-1), Big South (2-1), Southland (1-0) and WAC (4-0). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against four other conferences: American (2-2), Big Sky (1-1), Mountain West (1-1) and SWAC (1-1).

UNI's Tanya Warren is the longest tenured coach in the MVC and is climbing the career wins chart for both MVC-only wins and all-game victories. Warren is one win shy of tying Creighton's Jim Flanery for fifth in MVC history.

## Fruendt on Miller Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Missouri State senior Liza Fruendt is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2018 Cheryl Miller Award. Named after the three-time Naismith Player of the Year, the annual award in its inaugural year recognizes the top small forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2018 Cheryl Miller Award will be narrowed to just 10.

## Valley History

One of the premier women's basketball leagues in the country, the MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 20 seasons. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 11 different seasons, including a pair of bids to last season's NCAA Tournament. The league has also had two Final Four teams (Missouri State, in both 1992 and 2001), a WNIT champion (Missouri State, 2005) and three WNIT semifinal appearances (Illinois State, in 2011, 2010 and 2009).

## BRADLEY (5-3)

### Breaking Out

Seniors Anneke Schlueter and Danielle Brewer both broke out of scoring slumps to help highlight Bradley's 67-52 victory at Eastern Illinois Tuesday. Schlueter entered the game averaging 7.1 points per game, but tossed in a season-best 18 points to go with a career-high eight rebounds as she moved up five spots on Bradley's career scoring list into the top 25. Brewer was averaging 5.0 points per outing entering the game against the Panthers, but added a season-best 13 points of her own as she made 3-of-6 three-point attempts. Schlueter's 18-point effort marked the first time the Braves were led in scoring by a senior this season. In addition, BU has led from wire-to-wire in each of the last two games, marking the first time Bradley has not trailed in consecutive games since midway through the 2016-17 MVC schedule.



### Rare Trip North

Bradley will make a rare trip to the state of Wisconsin, playing in the Badger State for just the eighth time in program history Saturday when the Braves face 25th-ranked Wisconsin-Green Bay. In fact, BU has played in Wisconsin just twice since the 1995-96 season with both of those contests going to overtime. Bradley fell in double overtime at Wisconsin-Milwaukee in the last trip to Wisconsin during the 2012-13 season and pulled out a 72-70 win at UWM in 2010-11. The Braves are 3-4 all-time in the state of Wisconsin.

### On The Rebound

Bradley leads the Missouri Valley Conference in rebounding at 45.5 boards per game and BU's +6.1 average rebounding margin is also tops in the league. The Braves collected a season-high 60 rebounds in the Dec. 5 win at Eastern Illinois to match the team's highest rebounding total in a game since the 1992-93 season. Bradley is now averaging a conference-best 14.0 offensive rebounds per outing after a season-high 23 offensive boards at EIU. Sophomore Chelsea Brackmann is third in The Valley in rebounding at 8.3 rpg and has averaged 11.3 rebounds over the last three contests.

## MISSOURI STATE (3-6)

### Big Ten At Home

Missouri State hosts Northwestern on Saturday, getting an opportunity against a Big Ten school at home for the first time since a third-round WNIT loss to Illinois in 2010. The Lady Bears are 6-2 all-time at home against the Big Ten, including a victory against Northwestern in 1997.



### 30 for Fruendt

Senior guard Liza Fruendt scored 31 points in Sunday's win against Oral Roberts, the second time in her career that she has eclipsed the 30-point barrier. Only eight other MSU players have recorded multiple 30-point games in their career, including Casey Garrison, Tahnee Balerio, Kari Koch, Jenni Lingor, Jackie Stiles, Melody Howard, Kelly Mago and Jeanette Tendai.

### Records For Accuracy & Inaccuracy

The Lady Bears went 25-of-26 at the foul line in Thursday's victory versus Wichita State, tying a 2006 game against Drake for the highest percentage in school history based on a minimum of 20 attempts. The .962 percentage is also the fourth-best in the NCAA this year, and the highest with a 25-attempt minimum. The teams were on the cusp of an NCAA record for combined free throw percentage with a 36-for-37 start before the Shockers missed a pair late. Missouri State's overall free throw shooting record is a 16-for-16 effort against Drake in March 2001. On the other side of the coin, the Shockers became to first Missouri State opponent without a 3-pointer in a game since March 4, 1999, finishing 0-for-8 from long range.

## UNI (3-6)

### Scouting the Hawkeyes

UNI and Iowa have met 22 times on the hardwood, with the Panthers taking only two decisions over the Hawkeyes. The last win over Iowa came on Dec. 19, 2006, as the Panthers earned an 83-62 win over the Hawkeyes on the road. The victory in 2006 snapped a 10-game losing skid to the Hawkeyes. Overall, Iowa has won the last 10 meetings in the series.



### Defenders of Warren

UNI is 134-19 under the direction of head coach Tanya Warren when holding an opponent to 60 points or less. Five of UNI's top-10 scoring defense averages in school history have come during the Warren era, while the Panthers ranked second in the Valley last season after holding opponents to 58.3 points per game. UNI was 19-0 in 2016-17 when holding foes to 60 points or less, so far this season the Panthers are 2-2.

### Pour On the Points

UNI scored a season-high 92 points against UW-Parkside last time out. The 92 points were the most by any UNI squad since the Panthers scored 99 against Drake on March 2, 2014. The Panthers have now scored 90 points or more in 29 total games all-time, with four of those coming under head coach Tanya Warren. UNI's 107-80 win over Creighton on Feb. 20, 1990 remains the school's record for most points scored in a game.
