MVC Player of the Week

Alexa Willard, So., G, Missouri State

Missouri State sophomore guard Alexa Willard was nearly perfect in MSU's 90-59 victory against Northwestern on Saturday, scoring a career-high 21 points in 23 minutes. Willard shot 8-for-9 overall against a Wildcat defense that entered the game allowing 34 percent shooting on the season, going 3-for-3 from behind the arc and 2-for-2 from the foul line. Willard added two rebounds, one assist, one steal and a block, and scored 14 points in the first quarter.

MVC Newcomer of the Week

Kayla Casteel, Fr., G, Evansville

Entering the week looking for her first collegiate points, freshman guard Kayla Casteel recorded a pair of double-digit scoring performances. On Thursday night, the Indianapolis native came off the bench to score 14 points in 23 minutes of action, swishing four three-pointers in the Aces' 96-59 win over Oakland City. Casteel continued her strong week on Saturday as the freshman tallied 13 points on 3-5 shooting from beyond the arc in a 96-77 road loss at UIC. On the week, Casteel averaged 13.5 points while shooting 53.3% (8-15) from the field, 58.3% (7-12) from beyond the arc, and going a perfect 4-4 from the free-throw line. The freshman also showed poise in her first appearances with increased minutes, committing just two turnovers in 42 minutes of action.

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Shunseere Kent (BRAD) - Kent scored a team-high 12 points in Bradley's outing at 21st-ranked Green Bay Saturday. She scored in double figures for the first time since the Nov. 24 win vs. Nicholls State with her 12-point effort and also added four rebounds, two assists and one steal in Bradley's first contest against a ranked team in two years. Kent was 4-for-8 from the field and 3-for-4 from the free throw line.

Brenni Rose (DU) - In Drake's lone action of week against South Dakota for the second consecutive game, Rose, led the team in scoring with 17 points on 6-of-9 shooting to go with a career-high six assists, five rebounds and a career-best three blocks ... started past four games ... in those starts has scored 17, 13, 20 and 17 points, respectively ... played in all 11 games, averaging 9.7 points, 4.2 rebounds, 2.9 assists and 1.3 steals per game this season.

Megan Maahs (UNI) - Maahs earned her fourth double-double of the season, after scoring 12 points and snagging 10 rebounds against No. 25 Iowa on Sunday. The sophomore also added two assists and a block against the Hawkeyes. The double-digit scoring effort was Maah's eighth of the year, which ranks most on the team.

Maya Meredith (VALPO) - Set the bar high with her first start in a Valpo uniform on Friday night against IU Northwest. The sophomore point guard's 16 assists not only shattered Shari Toelke's program record that had stood since she dished out 14 on Jan. 15, 1992 against Marquette, but that number also ranks tied for sixth in the history of the Missouri Valley Conference. Meredith become just the 10th player in conference history to register 16 assists or more in a single game. Her 16 assists rank second in the nation this season behind only Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia, who had 17 against Vanderbilt on Nov. 24. Meredith's previous career high was five and her season best was three. In addition, Meredith played a turnover-free game, the first time Valpo's starting point guard has not committed any turnovers in a game since the season opener against IU Kokomo.

Brice Calip (MSU) - Brice Calip stuffed the stat sheet with eight points, five rebounds, five assists and two steals Saturday, helping the Lady Bears to a 90-59 win against Northwestern. She shot 50 percent from the floor and connected on both of her 3-point attempts, and became the first MSU freshman since 2010 with at least five assists and no turnovers in the win.

Another Power Five Win

The Missouri Valley Conference now has three wins over Power Five opponents this season, following Missouri State's dominating 90-59 win over Northwestern in Springfield Saturday. With Saturday's win, the Lady Bears are now 7-2 all-time at home against the Big Ten. Last season, the MVC finished the non-conference schedule with six wins over members of Power Five conferences.

This week, the MVC non-conference schedule finishes with four games against Power Five schools, including #25 Iowa (Drake), Alabama (Missouri State), Miami (Southern Illinois) and Kansas State (UNI).

Season For Giving

Valparaiso's Maya Meredith dished out 16 assists, shattering a single-game program record of 14 that had stood since 1992, in her first career start on Dec. 15. What makes Meredith's 16 assists even more impressive is that she did it without making any turnovers. Valpo's previous record-holder was Shari Toelke, who had 14 against Marquette on Jan. 15, 1992. Meredith became just the 11th player in MVC history to reach 16 assists in a game, a mark that is tied for sixth in conference history. Her 16 assists rank second in the nation this season behind only Syracuse's Tiana Mangakahia, who had 17 against Vanderbilt on Nov. 24.

Senior Leaders

Seven league seniors are leading their respective teams in scoring, including Evansville's Hannah Noe (18.1 ppg), Valparaiso's Dani Franklin (17.9 ppg), Missouri State's Liza Fruendt (17.0 ppg), Southern Illinois' Kylie Giebelhausen (13.4 ppg), Illinois State's Hannah Green (13.1 ppg), UNI's Kennedy Kirkpatrick (11.6 ppg) and Loyola's Jessica Cerda (9.7 ppg).

Double Your Pleasure

UNI's Megan Maahs is the only MVC player averaging a double-double this season. The sophomore is averaging 11.1 points and 10.2 rebounds per game. Maahs has a league-best four double-doubles on the season. Below are players with multiple double-doubles this season.

Home Sweet Home

Currently two MVC teams remain perfect at home: Bradley (3-0) and Valparaiso (4-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season. Valparaiso improved to 4-0 at home on Friday against IU-Northwest. It's the first 4-0 start at home for the Crusaders since 2007-08 (started 5-0 that season).

Leaders From Behind the Arc

Evansville's Hannah Noe not only leads the MVC in scoring this season, she also ranks 11th nationally in three-point field goals per game. The graduate transfer from SEMO already has 33 three point field goals this season, averaging 3.67 makes per game.

Valpo sophomore guard Grace Hales currently ranks second nationally in three-point field-goal percentage (58.6%), connecting on 17 of her 29 attempts. Hales trails Oregon State freshman guard Aleah Goodman (59.4%; 19-of-32).

Knocking Down Freebies

Evansville is among the best in the nation in converting opportunities at the charity stripe. On the year, the Aces currently sit third in the nation in free-throw shooting percentage, hitting 81.1% of its attempts from the line with six players shooting 80% or better individually including a pair of student-athletes in junior guard Kerri Gasper and freshman guard Kayla Casteel who are perfect from the charity stripe.

Dialin' From Distance

SIU senior Kylie Giebelhausen is continuing her climb up the Missouri Valley Conference three-point field goals made list. Napier has connected 22 times from behind the arc this season and sits No. 25 on the all-time Valley list.

The MVC holds a winning record against four leagues in non-conference play, including the Big 12 (2-1), Big South (2-1), Southland (1-0) and WAC (4-0). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against five other conferences: American (2-2), Big Sky (1-1), Mountain West (1-1), Ohio Valley (6-6) and SWAC (1-1).

Currently, Drake ranks fourth nationally in assists per game, averaging 22.5 per contest. The Bulldogs are in great company, sitting behind Iowa, Oregon State and Baylor, while ranking one spot ahead of UConn. The Bulldogs will face the top ranked assist team in the country Thursday in Iowa City.

Field Trip Day

Tuesday's home contest against Cleveland State will be Bradley's annual Field Trip Day presented by Prairie Farms. For the sixth consecutive year area school children (approximately 2,500 this year) will be in attendance with each student receiving a workbook with puzzles, games and word problems which focus on leading a healthy lifestyle, nutrition, character building and dealing with bullying. The five previous Field Trip day crowds all rank in the top seven highest attended games in the seven-plus year history of Renaissance Coliseum. Tuesday's game will be Bradley's largest Field Trip day, surpassing the previous mark of 2,402 fans for the 2013-14 event against Illinois. In fact, with over 3,000 tickets accounted for as of Monday morning Tuesday's game will be the largest stand-alone attendance at Renaissance Coliseum for the Braves and the crowd could challenge the largest stand-alone single-game home attendance record of 3,128 set Jan. 6, 2002 against Illinois State at Robertson Memorial Field House.



Home Front

After playing six of the last seven games away from home, Bradley will wrap up the non-conference schedule with back-to-back home games. The last time the Braves concluded the non-conference portion of the schedule with consecutive home games was 2014-15 and Bradley will do so for just the third time in the last 11 years. Bradley is a perfect 3-0 at home this season and the Braves own a four-game home win streak dating back to last season which is tied for the longest in the eight-year history of Renaissance Coliseum. The last five-game home win streak for Bradley concluded with the first game in Renaissance Coliseum history (win vs. Butler) and included the final four games played at Illinois Central College.

Missouri State picked up its seventh victory over a Power Five school under Kellie Harper on Saturday, beating Northwestern 90-59. The Lady Bears have an opportunity to add to that total and extend an impressive streak Tuesday when they visit Alabama. MSU has beaten a Southeastern Conference opponent in each of the last four seasons, with five total wins coming against Missouri (twice), Arkansas (twice) and Ole Miss.

Impressive Freshmen

Missouri State has three freshmen with a game of at least five assists and one or fewer turnovers this season: Elle Ruffridge (5 assists/1 turnover Dec. 7 vs. Wichita State), Brice Calip (5 assists/0 turnovers Dec. 16 vs. Northwestern) and Abby Hipp (5 assists/0 turnovers Dec. 16 vs. Northwestern). Prior to this season, the feat had not been accomplished since 2010.

Scouting the Wildcats

UNI and Kansas State have split their only two meetings on the hardwood, with the Panthers taking the most recent matchup last season in Cedar Falls. The Panthers downed the then No. 24 Wildcats, 67-59 on Dec. 22, 2016. The ranked win for UNI was its first since 2014 and its third over a non-conference foe since 1992.



Defenders of Warren

UNI is 134-19 under the direction of head coach Tanya Warren when holding an opponent to 60 points or less. Five of UNI's top-10 scoring defense averages in school history have come during the Warren era, while the Panthers ranked second in the Valley last season after holding opponents to 58.3 points per game. UNI was 19-0 in 2016-17 when holding foes to 60 points or less, so far this season the Panthers are 2-2.

Tough Schedule

This season, the Panthers have played one of the toughest schedules in the country, ranking No. 11 in the nation. The next closest MVC member is Drake at No. 42. Overall, past opponents this season have earned a 52-25 record.

Return to San Juan

The Salukis are making their third appearance in San Juan, and first since 1997. In 1997, they lost to Detroit-Mercy, 73-62, before falling to Duke, 76-54. SIU rebounded with a 77-40 win over the University of Puerto Rico-Mayaguez on Nov. 30, 1997 behind 19 points from Theia Hudson. SIU has played in three other international events over the years, dating back to 1994, with it's most recent trip to the Grand Bahama Island in the Bahamas during the 2008-09 season. Saluki teams are 3-3 all-time in Puerto Rico and are 3-5 all-time during foreign trips with their last win coming against the University of Puerto Rico on 11/30/97.



Ranked Nationally Among Freshmen

Abby Brockmeyer is averaging 1.22 blocks per game, which is second to Kaylan Hoffman of Evansville for the most by a freshmen in the MVC. Not only does she rank second in the league for freshmen in blocked shots, but she ranks 27th nationally among freshmen in the category.

Climbing the Charts

Kylie Giebelhausen ranks 23rd amongst DI players with 211 career three-pointers, which is the most of any active player in the Missouri Valley Conference. Giebelhausen cracked the top-25 all-time in Valley history for career three-pointers with her two against Western Kentucky. She now ranks 25th all-time, and needs four three-pointers to pass Indiana State's Lisa Verhoff (2002-06) for 24th all-time. The East Peoria, Ill. native is 11 three-pointers shy of passing Valley great Jackie Stiles (1998-01) for 21st in Valley history.

Defending the ARC

The Crusaders upped their home record to 4-0 and extended their home winning streak that dates back to last season to six with Friday's win over IU Northwest. Valpo is off to its first 4-0 home start since 2007-08 and has its longest home winning streak since 2007. A win on Thursday against Fort Wayne would allow Valpo to finish the nonconference portion of the season undefeated at home, a feat the team also achieved in 2007-08.



Starting Strong

Valpo has secured a winning record through 10 games for the first time since 2001-02, a Valpo team that finished 26-7 overall and 13-1 in conference play, winning the Mid-Continent Conference regular season title and reaching the quarterfinals of the WNIT. The victory on Monday at Eastern Illinois also gave the Crusaders their sixth nonconference victory this season, a total they hadn't reached since 2008-09. In addition, the Crusaders have won two true road games during the nonconference slate for the first time since 2006-07. A win on Thursday would give Valpo its highest nonconference win total since 2006-07.

Hamlet Hitting Everything

When she's playing at her highest level, there's little anyone can do to stop Valpo junior guard Meredith Hamlet. She has had one 29-point performance in each of her three seasons in a Valpo uniform, again hitting that number on Friday night against IU Northwest. Hamlet had 23 before halftime and finished the night 8-of-10 shooting, 5-of-6 from beyond the arc and 8-of-8 at the free-throw line. Since the start of the 2015-16 season, there have been 11 occasions where a Valpo player has hit 5 or more 3-pointers in a game. Hamlet has accounted for seven of those, with Dani Franklin and Hannah Schaub also having a pair of five 3-pointer games apiece.
