### NOTEWORTHY

- Drake returns 18 letterwinners, including five starters from last season's squad that won the program's fifth Missouri Valley Conference Regular Season title. Three seniors, Alyssa Brand, Linda Fiorito and Elaine Gorom, lead the group of returning starters and are joined by sophomore Hannah Bormann and junior Annie Schmitz.
- Brand, a dynamic midfielder, is a three-time ALL-MVC selection who has played in 53 career matches with 44 starts. Fiorito, a defender, has helped anchor the Bulldogs' backline in her first three seasons, playing in 56 career matches with 55 starts. Gorom joined Fiorito on the backline and played in all 19 matches. Bormann burst onto the scene in her first season with three goals and four assists and was named MVC Freshman of the Year. She is just the second Bulldog ever to be named the MVC's top freshman. Schmitz played in all 19 matches with 18 starts in 2017 and scored her first career goal.
- Brand enters her senior season with 13 career goals and seven assists and is already in the program's record books. She is No. 10 all-time in career goals and has a chance to climb the chart in that category. Her seven assists are just outside the all-time top 10.

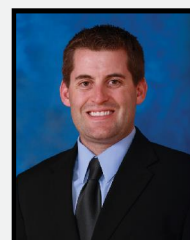

### NOTEWORTHY

- The Purple Aces will have a veteran group of student-athletes set to take the pitch for the 2018 season. UE returns 81% of its goal scoring from last season, led by Montana Portenier who led the Aces with six goals. Evansville also returns a pair of student-athletes in sophomore Michaela Till and junior Julie Rabe who split all 1,533 minutes for UE between the posts.
- Evansville offense found its spark during the 2017 campaign. The Aces recorded 21 goals last fall, the most since UE scored 28 goals in 2014 when it amassed an 11-6-3 record.
- In its non-conference slate, the Aces' contests are full of regional matchups. Evansville's first four matches of the season, including exhibitions, are against teams from the Ohio Valley Conference with six of UE's 13 non-conference contests coming again OVC competition. The Aces' remaining seven non-conference games feature a pair of teams from the Summit League (IUPUI and Purdue Fort Wayne), and sides from the MAC (Miami (OH)), Big East (Butler), and Conference USA (Western Kentucky).

- Head coach Brad Silvey is entering his second season at the helm, after two seasons as an assistant coach at Illinois State.

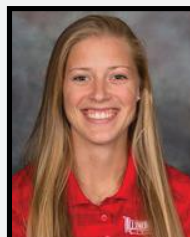
