OFFENSE

Kelli Zickert, SR, M, Illinois State

Zickert scored her first goal of the season, which was the game-winning goal in ISU's 2-0 victory over Illinois on Sunday. She tallied 4 shots in the match with 2 on goal.

Alina Steffen, Fr., F, Indiana State

Steffen came away with the game winning goal in the Sycamores comeback win over defending Horizon League Champs, Northern Kentucky. Tessa Leong found herself on a breakaway down the right flank. Leong slotted a cross into the box where Alina Steffen slid in just beating an NKU defender for a goal. Steffen had two shots during the match with both being on goal.

Sienna Cruz, So., MF, Loyola

Loyola sophomore Sienna Cruz opened her account for the 2017 season in the Ramblers' 4-1 win over Akron on Sunday afternoon in the final game of the Loyola Invitational. The Cottage Grove, Wis. product headed home a corner kick from Taylor Lambouris in the 27th minute to give the Maroon & Gold an early 2-0 lead en route to victory. Cruz, who also notched a shot in Friday's clash with Drexel, was one of three Ramblers named to the event's All-Tournament Team.

Mary Disidore, Sr., MF, Missouri State

Scoring the second goal of her Missouri State career, senior Mary Disidore netted a shot from 22-yards out to give the Bears the only goal they would need to earn a 1-0 shutout victory at Central Arkansas. The Lenexa, Kan., native leads the team with eight shots and ties with two other Bears with one goal on the season. Disidore is one of two Bears that has put in a full 360 minutes on the pitch.

DEFENSE

Hannah Sullivan, So., GK, Indiana State

Sophomore Hannah Sullivan had another big weekend for the Sycamores. Sullivan came away with six saves in the match vs. Northern Kentucky and then came away with another six in ISU's loss to Purdue. Sullivan now holds a .733 save percentage as the Sycamores have a 2-1-1 record.

Taylor Lambouris, Jr., D, Loyola

Loyola junior Taylor Lambouris played in every minute of both games as part of the Loyola Invitational this past weekend. First Half Domination

Despite allowing at least one goal in each of its first four matches, UE has owned first halves this season. The Aces have yet to allow a first half goal in 180 minutes of action this season, while scoring one of its own.



Worldwide Aces

Of the four goals scored by the Aces this season, three different countries are represented by the goal-scorers. The first two goals scored by UE in the Aces' 2-1 win over UT Martin were both scored by Americans in Nicki Baham and Sarah Osinski. In UE's 2-1 win over Fort Wayne, Jayme-Lee Hunter of New Zealand scored the first goal, while Montana Portenier of Canada recorded the second.

Till's Early Experience

Freshman goalkeeper Michaela Till has played and started in each of the Aces' first four matches. With her start in the season-opener, Till became the first freshman goalkeeper to start a season-opener for the Aces since Theresa Bagby started against Austin Peay on August 31, 2007 in a 2-1 UE win. Between the posts, Till has made 14 saves while recording a 1.25 goals-against average, earning a pair of victories.

Yount Scoring

Junior Brynell Yount (Aurora, Colo.) has scored in each of UNI's games this season, with three goals. Yount also nabbed an assist in Sunday's 2-0 victory over South Dakota.



3-0 Start

UNI (3-0 overall) has started a season with three straight victories for only the third time in school history. UNI opened the 2003 and 2012 seasons with a trio of victories. UNI has notched nine goals on the season.

Snapping Streaks

UNI snapped both Omaha and South Dakota's winning streaks against the Panthers this weekend. Friday marked only the second all-time win for UNI against Nebraska-Omaha. The first victory came in the 2000 season and was UNI's first triumph in its program's history. The Panthers posted a 3-1 win over the Mavericks on Sept. 10, 2000. UNI is 2-2-1 all-time vs. Nebraska-Omaha. Omaha fell to 0-3. Prior to Sunday's match, South Dakota had won three of the last four, including two straight in Vermillion. South Dakota falls to 0-4 on the year.

Juniors Natalia Kontul and Kelsey Jahn, as well as sophomore Adi Johnson, were named to the All-Tournament Team for their performances against FGCU and Florida Atlantic. It was the first All-Tournament accolade of their collegiate career for all three Crusaders.



Limiting Opponents' Chances

While the Crusaders dropped both games in Florida against a pair of strong sides in FGCU and Florida Atlantic by 1-0 finals, Valpo defensively did a great job limiting the number of opportunities it surrendered over the two matches. The Crusaders' two opponents combined for just 14 total shot attempts, only three of which were on goal, while Valpo also gave up just four corner kicks over the two matches.
