### MVC Offensive Player of the Week

#### Lily Johnson, Sr., OH, Missouri State

Missouri State's Lily Johnson averaged 4.45 kills, 4.45 digs and 5.23 points per set to earn all-tournament honors at the Pepperdine Asics Classic over the weekend. Johnson began the tournament with 15 kills, 18 digs and four aces in four sets against eighth-ranked Washington Friday, and added 14 digs, three aces and eight kills in a sweep of Wyoming that same day. On Saturday, the senior carried the Bears to a 3-1 win at Pepperdine, hitting .383 with 26 kills and 17 digs against the Waves. This is Johnson's 10th career MVC Player of the Week honor, tying her for first all time with UNI's Molly O'Brien (2000-03).

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week

#### Emily Butters, Jr., Libero, Missouri State

Missouri State junior Emily Butters had 70 total digs in three matches last week, averaging 6.36 per set to go with three aces and 13 assists at the Pepperdine Asics Classic. Butters scooped a season-high 27 digs and handed out seven helpers against No. 8 Washington on Friday, and added 16 more digs, four assists and an ace to help the Bears sweep Wyoming in the evening contest. On Saturday, Butters equaled her season best with 27 more digs at Pepperdine, adding a pair of aces in a 3-1 Missouri State win.

### MVC Freshman of the Week

#### Stef Jankiewicz, Fr., S, Illinois State

Illinois State's Stef Jankiewicz had strong outings in the first matches of her career at Redbird Arena, as the freshman setter averaged 11.46 assists per set while guiding Illinois State to a 2-1 record and a second-place tournament finish. Jankiewicz also averaged 2.54 digs per set and added three aces and a pair of kills. She posted a pair of double-doubles in Saturday's matches, tallying 56 assists and 10 digs against Seton Hall before going for 57 assists and a career-high 19 digs in a win over Cincinnati. Jankiewicz currently ranks third in the MVC by averaging 10.26 assists per set.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Erica Haslag (BRAD)** - Haslag averaged 4.82 kills and 2.65 digs per set while hitting .224 in four matches last week. Named the Best Attacker of the 2017 CEFCU Classic, Haslag started the week with 22 kills and 14 digs in a five-set outing against Chicago State in Bradley's home opener. She opened the CEFCU Classic with 27 kills, 18 digs and four aces in a five-setter against Illinois-Chicago as she posted the highest point total by a Brave (32.0) in a match since 2006 and was the first Bradley player with 25 kills and four aces in a match since Lindsay Stalzer in 2005. The double-double was Haslag's sixth consecutive. Later that day she helped power Bradley to a sweep of defending OVC champion Murray State with 15 kills and four digs. Haslag capped the week with 18 kills and nine digs against UIC as she tied Stalzer as the second fastest players in program history to reach 800 career kills (68 matches).

**Cathryn Cheek (DU)** - Recorded 44 kills and 65 digs in four matches at the Drake Invitational to average a double-double in helping the Bulldogs go 3-1 and finish second in their home tournament ... had 10 or more kills in each match and nine in the fourth and 19 or more digs in three of the four matches ... In the opener against Omaha, she had 12 kills and a career-high 22 digs ... she followed that with 10 kills on 21 attempts to hit .381 in just two sets against Southeast Missouri State and then had 13 kills and 19 digs against San Jose State ... on the weekend, she was second on the team in both kills and digs and added five blocks.

**Jaelyn Keene (ILS)** - Keene was named to the all-tournament team at the Redbird Classic after guiding the Redbirds to a 2-1 finish and a second-place tournament finish. The senior middle averaged 4.08 kills (on a .369 hitting percentage) and 1.15 blocks per set to pace the Redbirds. Keene reached double digits in kills in all three matches, and combined for 40 kills on Saturday in her team's matches versus Seton Hall and Cincinnati. Keene set a career high with 10 blocks in the Redbirds' win over Cincinnati. She currently leads Illinois State in several statistical categories, including kills (3.69 per set), hitting percentage (.315) and blocks (1.09 per set), ranking among the top six in the Missouri Valley Conference in all three.

**Morgan Gresham (LUC)** - In two matches at the Marquette Invitational last weekend, Gresham averaged 3.17 kills and 1.50 digs per set against some tough competition. The junior outside hitter recorded a team-high 10 kills and added six digs in a loss to Marquette on September 8 before contributing a team-best nine kills and three digs against No. 13 Kentucky. Gresham leads Loyola with 66 total kills and ranks second on the club with 2.36 kills per set this season. She ranks third on the team with 2.14 digs per set.

**Bri Weber (UNI)** - Weber totaled 50 kills (3.57 kills/set) in four matches as the Panthers went 3-1 in 14 sets of action. Weber led the Panthers with 15 kills in a 3-0 sweep of Northern Illinois on Tuesday in the McLeod Center. Weber secured a double-double with 18 kills and 19 digs in a 3-1 triumph over South Dakota. Weber finished the weekend with another double-double against UMKC (13 kills, 20 digs). Weber earned a spot on the Kangaroo Klassic All-Tournament team.

**Brittany Anderson (VALPO)** - Anderson continued to set all the way around for the Crusaders last weekend as Valpo tied for the best record at the Cornell Invitational, going 2-1. Anderson opened the weekend with 27 assists and seven digs versus St. John's. She recorded 43 assists and 13 digs, along with five kills on as many swings, in the win over Binghamton, and then closed the tournament with season highs off 49 assists, 14 digs and four blocks in a win over Cornell. For the weekend, Anderson averaged 10.82 assists, 3.09 digs and 0.82 blocks per set.

**Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD)** - Rosado continued her stellar defensive play, averaging 5.71 digs per set in the first four home matches of her Bradley career. She helped the Braves average 18.00 digs per set and limit opponents to a .186 attack percentage. In her Renaissance Coliseum debut, Rosado tallied 31 digs and also collected three assists and one ace as she became the first player in program history to have three outings in the same season with 30 or more digs. Named the Best Libero of the 2017 CEFCU Classic, Rosado had 27 assists and six assists in a five-set contest against Illinois-Chicago. Later that day, she had 18 digs, one ace and five assists to help Bradley to a sweep of defending OVC champion Murray State. Rosado capped the week with 21 digs and four assists in a four-set outing against UIC.

**Kylee Macke (DU)** - Named to the Drake Invitational All-Tournament team after leading all players with 75 digs in the five-team tournament ... did not start the Bulldogs first match of the weekend, but finished with 15 digs against Omaha ... followed that with 18 digs against Southeast Missouri State and 21 digs against both San Jose State and Montana.

**Courtney Pence (ILS)** - Pence continued her run of stellar play by averaging 5.08 digs per set to help the Redbirds to a pair of wins over 2016 NCAA Tournament qualifiers over the weekend at the Redbird Classic, where Illinois State earned a second-place finish. Pence led the Redbirds in digs in all three matches and totaled 53 over Illinois State's two matches on Saturday, which included a win over Cincinnati. Pence also chipped in 11 assists over the weekend. She currently leads the Missouri Valley Conference and ranks among the national leaders in digs, at 6.57 per set.

**Maddy Moser (LUC)** - Moser produced 13 digs (2.17 per set) in two matches at the Marquette Invitational last weekend. In a three-set loss to host Marquette on September 8, the junior libero recorded seven digs and four assists, and the very next night accounted for six digs and an assist against No. 13 Kentucky. For the year, Moser ranks second on the squad with 76 total digs (2.71 digs per set).

**Kendyl Sorge (UNI)** - Sorge secured a team-high 71 digs (5.07 digs/set) as the Panthers went 3-1 to move to 7-3 on the season. Sorge notched 18 digs in a 3-0 win over Northern Illinois. Sorge posted 25 digs against South Dakota as the Panthers tied a school record in a four-set match with 107 total digs. Sorge also tallied eight assists against the Coyotes. Sorge completed her week of action with 17 digs against UMKC. Sorge was named to the Kangaroo Klassic All-Tournament team.

**Andrea Estrada (SIU)** - Andrea Estrada finished with 37 digs (3.08/set), 27 kills (2.25/set) and two service aces in SIU's three matches last week. She finished with 13 kills and eight digs at Murray State, and followed with eight kills and a season-high 21 digs against Oakland. It marked the fifth time in her career that the Bogota, Colombia native has recorded 20+ digs in a match. In doing so, she passed Debbie Barr (1996-99) for fifth in program history with 1,123 career digs.

**Sydney Bronner (VALPO)** - Bronner earned All-Tournament Team accolades this past weekend at the Cornell Invitational, averaging 1.73 blocks per set as the Crusaders posted a 2-1 record. Bronner posted five blocks in the opener against St. John's and added four rejections in the Crusaders' victory over Binghamton. She saved her best for last, setting a new career best with 10 blocks in the win over Cornell. The 10 rejections was one shy of cracking Valpo's top-five all-time in a four-set match, while it was the first time a Crusader reached double figures in the category since October of 2014. Bronner added 12 kills on .524 hitting against the Big Red as well for her first career double-double.

**Allana McInnis (UE)** - As the Purple Aces opened their home schedule, Allana McInnis continued her strong contributions as the setter for UE. In three matches, she posted a total of 89 assists, 7.42 per set. She also contributed a total of 16 digs, seven kills and four block assists. She started off with 20 assists versus Indiana University before tallying 47 helpers and four kills versus UAB. That assist total was one short of her career high. In the weekend finale, she had 22 assists against UT Martin. She was named to the All-Tournament Team for the Dunn Hospitality Invitational.

**Elle Van Grinsven (LUC)** - Elle Van Grinsven hit .062 (5-4-16) with a block and a dig in a pair of matches at the Marquette Invitational last weekend. The 6-foot-1 freshman middle blocker posted three kills, a dig and a block against Marquette on September 8, then notched a pair of kills against No. 13 Kentucky one day later. For the year, Van Grinsven is hitting .219 (39-18-96) with 0.54 blocks per set.

**Jaydin Seehase (UNI)** - Seehase averaged 2.29 kills per set and had a .244 hitting percentage in helping the Panthers to a 3-1 mark. Seehase had six kills (no errors) and a .353 hitting percentage in a 3-0 sweep of Northern Illinois. Seehase notched eight kills in a 3-0 win over Rutgers at the Kangaroo Klassic. Seehase secured 10 kills in a 3-1 triumph over South Dakota. Seehase posted eight kills and a block assist at UMKC.

**Maggie Nedoma (SIU)** - Maggie Nedoma finished first on the team in kills and hitting percentage during SIU's two matches at the Western Michigan Invitational en route to earning All-Tournament Team recognition. The freshman from Brook Park, Ohio hit .348 and put down 23 kills (3.28/set), including a career-high 18 kills against Oakland (Mich.) on Friday. She became the 16th Saluki freshman since 2003 to record 15+ kills in a single match and has tallied 10-plus kills in three of her last four matches.

### Road Warriors

With a victory at Pepperdine on Saturday, Missouri State improved to 4-0 in true road matches this season, extending their win streak in away matches to 13 in a row after going 9-0 on the Valley road last year. MSU's last loss in an opposing gym was Sept 17, 2016 at Marquette, and with no road matches until Sept. 22, the Bears are guaranteed to go more than a calendar year without suffering a road defeat.

### Panthers Dig In

UNI tied a school record (four-set matches) with 107 team digs in a 3-1 victory over South Dakota at the Kangaroo Klassic. The 107 digs by the Panthers is the second most by an NCAA Division I school this season in four-set matches (Ohio State with 109). UNI previously tallied 107 digs at Creighton (Oct. 27, 2000).

### Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 12 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Southern, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another two (Metro Atlantic and Mountain West) through three weeks of the season.

### Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (2-0), Atlantic 10 (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (1-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

### Top-25 Victories

The Valley has three wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 3-6 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

This week, UNI will face #19 Iowa State Tuesday and #10 Nebraska on Saturday. Southern Illinois will battle #23 Michigan State Saturday, while Loyola will travel to #15 Purdue Sunday.

UNI already has claimed two Top 25 wins this season heading into this week's matches vs. Iowa State and Nebraska. The last time UNI recorded three wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2003 (#11 Notre Dame, #23 Missouri State, #20 UC Santa Barbara).

### Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won four more matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament participants during the third weekend of play (Illinois State beat Cincinnati & Dayton, UNI beat Northern Illinois and Bradley swept Murray State). ### Haslag Among NCAA Leaders

Bradley junior Erica Haslag ranks Top 5 nationally in four categories entering play this week. Haslag sits second nationally in total points (213.5) and total kills (196), third in total attacks (537) and fifth in attacks per set (13.43). The junior standout also ranks 11th in kills per set (4.9).

### More Records For Johnson

Lily Johnson established a pair of MVC records during the season's first weekend. Johnson passed MSU's Michelle Witzke for the MVC's career lead in total attacks, and recorded her 97th and 98th career matches with at least 10 kills, breaking a tie with Witzke and Bradley's Jenny Pavlas for the most in conference history based on available records.

### MVC Career Kills Watch

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson sits in third place on the all-time MVC career kills list. Johnson pounded out 49 kills in matches vs. Washington, Wyoming and Pepperdine over the weekend. Johnson is 50 kills away from passing Missouri State's Michelle Witzke (1994-97) and 79 kills away from breaking the MVC record held by Bradley's Lindsay Stalzer (2002-05)

### Diggin' It

Valpo freshman libero Rylee Cookerly set a school-record and posted the sixth-best dig performance in MVC history, registering 43 digs in a 3-1 loss at Notre Dame. Cookerly's 43 digs is tied for the sixth-best in league history with Wichita State's Kelly Broussard. Cookerly currently ranks third nationally this season, averaging 6.44 digs/set.

## Challenging Slate

Bradley's opponents to date have combined for a 59-38 (.608) record through Sept. 10 and the Braves have played seven consecutive contests against teams with winning records. In fact, the last seven opponents own a 47-23 (.671) record, which includes a 34-14 (.708) mark for the last five foes.



## Home Tournaments

Bradley will host home tournaments on back-to-back weekends for the first time in program history, following up last weekend's CEFCU Classic with the CEFCU Invitational this weekend. The Braves have hosted an in-season tournament in 11 of the last 12 years and 15 of the last 17 seasons. The Braves own a 51-36 (.586) record when hosting an in-season tournament. The 2017 CEFCU Invitational is the team's 16th home tournament in the last 13 years and Bradley has hosted 10 tournaments in the eight-year history of Renaissance Coliseum.

## Rare Air

Junior Erica Haslag followed up her career-best 28 kills against Navy (Sept. 2) with 22 kills in the home opener vs. Chicago State and 27 kills against Illinois-Chicago last Friday. Bradley's first individual with four 20-kill outings in a season since 2007, Haslag is the first Brave with three consecutive 20-kill efforts since Lindsay Stalzer in 2005. In fact, Haslag had 32 points against the Flames Friday for the highest point total by a Bradley individual under the 25-point set format (since 2008) and most points by a Brave since 2006. She had a career-best four aces against UIC to notch the first 25-kill performance with at least four aces since Stalzer against Drake on Nov. 18, 2005. Haslag has five of the top nine single match kill totals for Bradley over the last 10 years with three of those performances coming this season.

The Salukis recorded a season-high 13 blocks at Murray State, with three Salukis recording at least three blocks a piece. It marked the 70th time in the past six seasons that Southern has notched double-digit blocks in a match.

## Career Milestones

Andrea Estrada tallied 21 digs against Oakland, which marked the fifth time in her career that she has recorded 20+ digs in a match. In doing so, she passed Debbie Barr (1996-99) for fifth in program history with 1,123 career digs. Abby Barrow, meanwhile, needs just eight kills to reach 900 for her career.
