MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Lily Johnson, Sr., OH, Missouri State

Lily Johnson broke Missouri State's career kills record last week, amassing 75 kills in four matches with averages of 4.69 kills, 2.81 digs and 5.19 points per set. Johnson set the MSU record in the third set of a 27-kill performance Saturday against Illinois in which she also had 12 digs and three blocks. Friday versus Washington State, Johnson tallied 23 kills and 22 digs, the second 20-20 match of her career, which are the only two such matches at Missouri State since 2006. She completed her weekend with 16 kills and a .366 hitting percentage Saturday evening in a sweep of Tennessee State, and posted nine kills without an error Thursday versus

Chattanooga, adding eight digs, two aces and two blocks. This is Johnson's 11th career MVC Player of the Week honor which surpasses UNI's Molly O'Brien (2000-03) for the most in league history.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Yavianliz Rosado, Jr., Libero, Bradley

Rosado was named co-MVP of Bradley's CEFCU Invitational, helping Bradley to a perfect 4-0 record over the weekend. She averaged an impressive 6.31 digs per set for the weekend, while boasting a 97 percent serve receive percentage and also tallied 1.31 assists per set as she helped Bradley limit opponents to a .153 hitting percentage. Rosado opened the week with a team-high 12 digs in a sweep of South Dakota State and had a match-high 23 digs, three assists and one ace in a sweep of UConn later that night to break the school record for digs in a three-set match. In Saturday's sweep of UMKC, Rosado tallied 19 digs and four assists and capped the weekend with 28 digs and seven assists in a four-set win against Grand Canyon.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Brittany Anderson, Fr., S, Valparaiso

Valpo's Brittany Anderson earned All-Tournament Team accolades at Western Illinois, her second All-Tournament Team honor of the year, as she continued to set all six rotations for the Crusaders last week. She opened the week with 47 assists, 11 digs and three blocks in a home win over Eastern Illinois. Anderson delivered 31 assists and nine digs to narrowly miss a double-double in a sweep of Western Illinois, and then closed the Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational with season-high totals of 57 assists and 19 digs in a four-set victory over McNeese State. For the week, Anderson averaged 12.27 assists and 3.55 digs per set and also chipped

in eight kills on .320 hitting.

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NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag was named co-MVP of the CEFCU Invitational, helping Bradley to a perfect 4-0 record. She averaged 4.54 kills, 0.388 aces and 2.15 digs per set as she helped power the Braves to four wins in a two-day stretch for the first time since 1985. Haslag had double digit kills in all four outings, opening the weekend with 14 kills, three aces, five digs and a block in a sweep of South Dakota State, while hitting at a .393 clip. She returned later that night to notch 14 kills, 10 digs and one block in a sweep of UConn as she turned in her seventh double-double of the season. Haslag had a match-high 10 kills along with six digs in a sweep of UMKC as the Braves posted three consecutive three-set victories for the first time since 2003. She capped the week with a match-high 21 kills and hit .346 in a four-set victory against Grand Canyon to help Bradley to its seventh win of the year, matching last year's overall win total and giving the Braves their most non-conference victories (7) since 2011.

Kyla Inderski (DU) - Led Drake to a 2-0 record at the WIU Buffalo Wind Wings Invitational by averaging a double-double with 30 kills and 24 digs in wins over McNeese State and Western Illinois ... her 30 kills came on 83 attempts for a .289 hitting percentage ... she averaged 3.75 kills and 3.00 digs per set in the pair of wins ... in the five-set win over McNeese State, she recorded 17 kills, 13 digs and three blocks ... she followed that with 13 kills on 30 attempts along with 11 digs against WIU ... her 30 kills brought her to 1,195 career kills, the third most in program history and the 24 digs brought her career total to 1,193, the fifth most in school history.

Lexi Wallen (ILS) - Wallen was named the MVP at the Arizona's Wildcat Classic as the Redbird junior helped guide the Redbirds to a perfect 3-0 record. Illinois State's wins over New Mexico State, William & Mary and Arizona all came via sweeps. Wallen tallied 29 kills, 25 digs, six blocks and four aces over the Redbirds' three matches in Tucson, Arizona. Her best match came against the host Wildcats, as she matched a career high with 15 kills, on a .536 hitting percentage, while also chipping in 14 digs and a pair of aces.

Laura Gross (INS) - Gross highlighted the weekend for Indiana State as ISU hosted its first home matches of the season during the Sycamore Invitational. Gross earned Tournament MVP after notching 39 kills (3.90 k/s) in two matches. The Potomac, Illinois native recorded her seventh and eighth double-double of the season, finishing with 28 digs (2.80 d/s). Against Cal State Fullerton, the junior nearly broke her career high in kills with 21 on a .319 hitting percentage to lead the team. She also recorded 18 kills in a loss to EIU in the finale, reaching 10+ kills in nine matches.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - Elle Van Grinsven hit .275 (18-7-40) with two digs and three blocks last week as Loyola dropped contests to DePaul, Miami (Ohio) and #15 Purdue. The 6-foot-1 freshman middle blocker tallied six kills in each of the Ramblers' three matches last week and has record six or more kills in six of the team's 11 contests this fall. She was impressive against #15 Purdue, totaling a team-best six kills on .625 (6-1-8) hitting. For the year, Van Grinsven 1.54 kills and 0.46 blocks per set, while hitting .235 (57-25-136).

Bri Weber (UNI) - Weber played a key role in helping UNI knock off two more ranked opponents as the Panthers wrapped up non-conference play. Weber totaled a double-double with 14 kills and 13 digs to go with two solo blocks in a five-set win at No. 19 Iowa State. Weber registered 15 kills, nine digs, four assists, one solo block and tied a career-high with three service aces in UNI's 3-1 victory over No. 10 Nebraska. Weber tied a career-high with 22 kills and secured 17 digs in a five-set match with Kansas State. For the week, Weber tallied 65 kills (3.61 kills/set), 62 digs (3.44 digs/set), 11 assists, six blocks and five service aces.

Kolby Meeks (SIU) - Kolby Meeks hit .545 and averaged 2.22 kills and 1.11 blocks per set to earn all-tournament honors at the Shamrock Invitational over the weekend. Meeks began her week with 10 kills in SIU's five-set win over SEMO, and followed that up with five kills and four block assists in three sets against Central Michigan Friday. She added nine kills and three block assists against Notre Dame on Saturday, and closed out the tournament by hitting .600 against the No. 23 Spartans, as she put down six kills on 10 attempts and added three block assists. It marked the sixth time in her collegiate career that she has recorded at least 10 attacks without committing a hitting error.

Sydney Bronner (VALPO) - Bronner was named Tournament MVP at Western Illinois' Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational as she continued her strong start to the 2017 season. Bronner averaged 3.71 kills/set on .296 hitting and tallied six blocks in the Crusaders' wins over Western Illinois and McNeese to claim the tournament title. The junior especially stood out in the win over McNeese, racking up a career-best 18 kills - six more than her previous career high, set just last weekend. Bronner also contributed nine kills on .500 hitting in a mid-week home victory over Eastern Illinois, finishing the week with 3.50 kills/set on .343 hitting.

Kylee Macke (DU) - Led Drake with 39 digs in helping Drake go 2-0 at the WIU Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational with wins over McNeese State and Western Illinois ... had a team-high 15 digs in the three-set win over WIU after collecting a career-high 24 digs in five sets against McNeese State ... averaged 4.88 digs per set over the weekend.

Courtney Pence (ILS) - Pence was named to her third all-tournament team after helping Illinois State post a perfect 3-0 record at the Wildcat Classic over the weekend. Pence averaged 5.89 digs per set as Illinois State swept all three of its matches in Tucson, Arizona. Pence led all players in digs in all three of the matches, including a 23-dig performance in the Redbirds' win over New Mexico State on Friday.

Maddy Moser (LUC) - Moser produced 25 digs (3.13 per set) in three matches last week. The junior libero produced 11 digs in a 3-0 loss to DePaul on September 12 before recording 13 digs, two aces and a pair of assists against Miami (Ohio) on September 16. For the year, Moser ranks second on the squad with 101 total digs (2.81 digs per set).

Emily Butters (MSU) - Emily Butters posted the top two dig totals of her career last week and averaged 5.44 per set in four matches at the Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational. She established a career high with 30 digs Friday against Washington State, becoming the 10th player in school history with at least 30 digs in a match, a feat accomplished a total of 21 times, most recently in 2013. Butters scooped 29 digs and handed out a career-best nine assists Saturday against Illinois, and began her weekend with 17 digs in three sets Thursday versus Chattanooga. Butters closed the tournament with 11 digs Saturday evening against Tennessee State, leading the Bears for the 12th consecutive match.

Kendyl Sorge (UNI) - Sorge was named the Most Outstanding Libero at the Omaha Challenge after leading the Panthers with 67 digs (3.72 digs/set) in the tournament's three matches. Sorge posted 15 digs, two assists and a service ace in a 3-1 win over Omaha. Sorge then tallied 15 digs and tied her career-high with eight assists in UNI's 3-1 victory over No. 10 Nebraska. She tallied 17 digs and six assists in a five-set loss to Kansas State. Sorge began the week by leading UNI to a win at No. 19-ranked Iowa State by securing 20 digs against the Cyclones. For the week, Sorge averaged 3.72 digs/set (67 digs) and 1.11 assists/set (20 assists).

Ashley Edelen (SIU) - Ashley Edelen had a team-high 69 total digs in four matches last week, averaging 4.93 per set to go with 10 assists. Edelen tallied 22 digs, a career-best seven assists and an ace in SIU's five-set win over SEMO on Sept. 12. She followed that up with 13 digs and an assist against Central Michigan on Friday, and added 14 digs and three assists in Saturday's match against Notre Dame. In SIU's final match of the tournament against No. 23 Michigan State, Edelen recorded 20+ digs for the fourth time this season, as she finished with a team-best 20 digs and added four assists.

Taylor Graboski (VALPO) - Graboski earned All-Tournament Team honors last weekend at Western Illinois' Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational and led the Crusaders in blocks on the week. The senior opened the week with four blocks in a home win over Eastern Illinois, and then posted seven blocks over the Crusaders' two victories at WIU over McNeese and the Leathernecks. Graboski's best effort came in the tournament finale versus McNeese, as she tallied five blocks - including a pair of solo stuffs - on the defensive side of the ball while adding a season-best 17 kills on .464 hitting offensively.

Natalie Fry (DU) - Hit a staggering .444 in helping Drake to two wins at the WIU Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational with 18 kills on 36 attempts with just two errors ... also recorded a team-high five blocks on the weekend ... had an incredible match in the three-set win over WIU with 14 kills on 19 attempts for a .684 hitting percentage, the second-highest percentage in a match by a Valley player this season ... also recorded four blocks in that win to account for 16 of the Bulldogs' 69 points.

Adeline Payne (UE) - Adeline Payne earned a spot on the All-Tournament Team as she posted her best weekend of play at the Ball State/Butler Tournament. In her first eight matches at UE, Payne nine kills. In three matches over the weekend, she notched a total of 29. Payne set her career mark with eight at Ball State, hitting .231 in the game. Against Butler, Payne had six kills, but added her first career service ace along with a career-best four digs. She had the best match of her career versus Duquesne, totaling 15 kills while hitting .262 in the 5-set match.

Stef Jankiewicz (ILS) - Jankiewicz was named to the all-tournament team at Arizona's Wildcat Classic after helping guide the Redbirds to a perfect 3-0 record, with wins over New Mexico State, William & Mary and Arizona. All three of the wins in Tucson, Arizona, came in straight sets. Jankiewicz averaged 11.67 assists and 2.56 digs per set over the weekend, while also chipping in five kills, four blocks and a pair of aces.

Nikkie White (INS) - Nikkie White played some of her best volleyball of her young career over the weekend at the Sycamore Invitational. The freshman recorded a career-high 11 kills and 10 blocks in the Sycamores' 3-2 win over Cal State-Fullerton for her first double-double of her career. After playing in every set over the weekend, the Columbus, Ohio native came away nine digs, 14 blocks and 17 kills.

Jaydlin Seehase (UNI) - Seehase totaled 27 kills and seven blocks as the Panthers went 3-1 with two wins over ranked foes. Seehase posted 11 kills (.320 hitting percentage), four digs and two block assists in UNI's 3-2 win at Iowa State on Tuesday. Seehase had four kills, three digs and three blocks in a 3-1 win over Omaha. She added six kills (.222 hitting percentage), three digs and two block assists in a 3-1 triumph over No. 10-ranked Nebraska. Seehase ended the week by notching six kills and five digs in a five-set match vs. Kansas State.

Maggie Nedoma (SIU) - Maggie Nedoma averaged 2.29 kills and .50 blocks per set during SIU's four matches last weekend. Nedoma hit .281 and tallied 13 kills in the win over SEMO on Sept. 12, which marked the fourth time this season that the Brook Park, Ohio native has recorded 10+ kills in a match. At the Shamrock Invitational, Nedoma finished with eight kills, two digs and four block assists against Notre Dame, and added eight kills on a team-best 35 attempts against No. 23 Michigan State.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

Top-25 Victories

The Valley has five wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 5-8 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

UNI claimed four Top 25 wins during non-conference play. The last time UNI recorded four or more wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2002 (#8 Pepperdine, #7 UCLA, #20 Minnesota, #3 Florida, #20 Missouri).

AVCA Top-25

UNI leaped into the AVCA Top 25 poll and sits No. 22 this week (Sept. 18) following wins over Iowa State and Nebraska last week. The Panthers have been ranked in 111 polls in the history of the AVCA Top 25. Missouri State continues to receive votes, sitting No. 35 nationally with seven votes.

Mid-Major Top 25

The Valley has two teams ranked in the top 10 of the VolleyballMag.com Mid-Major* Top 25 Poll (Sept. 12). UNI (9th) and Missouri State (10th) each make an appearance. Illinois State is receiving votes.

.500 or Better

Seven Valley teams – Drake, UNI, Missouri State, Valparaiso, Illinois State, Bradley and Evansville – will head into the first full week-end of conference play with a non-conference record at or above the .500 mark.

Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). Bradley (Murray State), Loyola (Samford) and Missouri State (Ohio State) each claimed one win against the field.

Streaking!

Four teams will enter MVC play this weekend riding win streaks of three or more matches. Valpo is riding a league-high five-match win streak, their longest since opening the 2015 campaign with nine consecutive victories. Bradley has won four in a row, while Drake and Illinois State enter league play on three match win streaks.

Improved Braves

After going 4-0 over the weekend, Bradley's 7-7 record in non-conference play matches their overall win total from the entire 2016 season. The last time Bradley won at least seven non-conference matches was (2011) and the Braves finished the non-conference slate with a .500 record or better for the first time since 2013 (6-3).

Top Non-Con Mark in MVC

Drake ended the bulk of its non-conference season with a 10-3 record, the program's most non-conference win since the 2010 season. Additionally, the Bulldogs are now 34-17 in non-conference tournaments since 2013 after going 2-0 in the WIU Buffalo Wild Wings Invitational.

Break Out the Brooms

Illinois State won all three of its matches at Arizona's Wildcat Classic in Tucson, Arizona, over the weekend, winning all three matches in straight sets. Six of Illinois State's seven wins this season have come via sweeps.

Milestone For Weber

Junior outside hitter Bri Weber became the 17th UNI Panther player to reach the 1,000 dig mark in her career. Weber has totaled 1,046 digs to rank No. 14 on UNI's all-time digs chart.

Johnson Sets MSU Kills Mark

Lily Johnson became Missouri State's all-time leader in kills Saturday afternoon, breaking Michelle Witzke's record of 1,919 in the third set of a 27-kill performance against Illinois. Johnson finished the weekend with 1,945 career kills, three shy of the record held by Lindsay Stalzer of Bradley, and also established a new MSU record with her 38th and 39th career matches with at least 20 kills.

MVC Career Kills Watch

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson moved into second place on the all-time MVC career kills list. Johnson pounded out 75 kills in matches vs. Chattanooga, Washington State, Illinois and Tennessee State over the weekend. Johnson is four kills away from breaking the MVC record held by Bradley's Lindsay Stalzer (2002-05)

Career Kills

CEFCU Invite Title

Bradley wrapped up the non-conference schedule by going a perfect 4-0 to claim the 2017 CEFCU Invitational title. The Braves opened the weekend with three consecutive sweeps, marking the first time Bradley won three straight matches in straight sets since 2003. In fact, the Braves went on to top Grand Canyon in four sets Saturday night to give Bradley its first four-match win streak since 2013. The Braves had not won four matches over a two-day period since 1985. Junior outside hitter Erica Haslag and junior libero Yavianliz Rosado were named co-MVP of the CEFCU Invite.



Wrapping Up the Non-Con Slate

Saturday's four-set victory against Grand Canyon gave Bradley a 7-7 record in non-conference play as the Braves matched their overall win total from the entire 2016 season. The last time Bradley won at least seven non-conference matches was (2011) and the Braves finished the non-conference slate with a .500 record or better for the first time since 2013 (6-3). Bradley's 5-3 home record in 2017 matches the team's home win total from the last two seasons combined and the Braves need just two wins at Renaissance Coliseum in MVC play to match the most home wins in the eight-year history of the facility.

MVC Opener

Bradley will open Missouri Valley Conference play Friday with a home match against Southern Illinois. The Braves are 16-18 in conference openers, which includes a 9-7 mark when opening league play at home. Bradley will start Valley action at Renaissance Coliseum for the sixth time in the eight-year history of the facility. Despite the 2017 season marking the 35th season Bradley and SIU have been conference members, the Braves have played the Salukis in their first conference match just once previously. Bradley swept Southern Illinois at home to open the 2001 Valley slate.
