Brandt would score the final Panthers goal, off a header from Sydney Hayden in the final minute of action. Brandt scored two goals in the win. In Sunday' tie with North Dakota, Brandt

would have the only Panthers goal, scoring off an assist from Jamie Athliser. With her goals this weekend, Brandt has five goals this season and is in third on the UNI All-Time Goals Scored list with 15.



MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Haley Smith, SO, GK, Illinois State (Fall River, Nova Scotia) Smith posted two clean sheets in a row on the week. She earned her third shutout of the season on Friday night against then-No. 19 Marquette, tallying six saves on the match. 

Noteworthy

In addition to the league's Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

OFFENSE

Rachel Wanninger, Sr., MF, Drake

Wanninger scored a golden goal in the first overtime session to knock off UIC, 2-1, Sunday afternoon at Cownie Soccer Stadium. Wanninger took a pass from Annie Schmitz on the right side, beat the Flames defense and kicked the ball past the goalkeeper for Drake's second overtime win this season. She finished with three shots in 34 minutes of play, and earlier in the week played 55 minutes and recorded one shot in a road win at Creighton. It is the first goal of 2017 for the local product and the fourth in her career. Wanninger has played in all nine matches and has one goal and one assist.

Angel Krell, JR, F, Illinois State

Krell has been the driving force of Illinois State's offense in their past two games. She scored the game-winning goal Sunday afternoon in a 1-0 victory over Miami (Ohio). She also tallied a career-high seven shots in the double overtime draw against then-No. 19 Marquette on Friday night.

Katie Wells, Jr., F, Indiana State

The 2017 MVC Preseason Poll member had a big weekend of play for the Sycamores. In ISU's match against Fort Wayne on Sept. 15 Wells scored two goals earning her a total of four points in the match. Wells now leads the Sycamores in goals with four total and points with eight. Wells also recorded a strong match on Sunday Sept. 17 against the Butler Bulldogs.

Jenna Szczesny, Jr., F, Loyola

Loyola junior Jenna Szczesny netted a pair of game-winning goals as the Maroon & Gold downed a pair of city rivals over the weekend. Szczesny opened the scoring in Friday's 9-0 pasting of Chicago State when she found the back of the net six minutes into the first half. Two days later against DePaul, the Hoffman Estates, Ill. native again put the Ramblers on the board first as she converted from the penalty spot as part of a 2-0 triumph for Loyola. Szczesny, a two-time All-Missouri Valley Conference selection, currently has a team-high seven goals to her name, a mark that also leads the Valley.

DEFENSE

Ali Smith, Sr., D, Drake

Smith is one of the anchors on the Bulldogs' backline. She has started all nine matches this year and played at least 90 minutes in every match but one, including both wins last week over Creighton and UIC. Smith has helped the Bulldogs record three shutouts in 2017.

Madison Kimball, Jr., D/MF, Loyola

Loyola junior Madison Kimball netted a goal and contributed to a pair of sparkling defensive efforts for the Ramblers over the weekend. Kimball converted on a free kick in Friday's 9-0 rout of Chicago State, netting her third goal of the season. The Fair Oaks, Calif. product also put in a pair of full shifts as the Ramblers posted back-to-back shutouts of the Cougars and DePaul (2-0), respectively.

NEWCOMER

Natalie Vaughn-Low, FR, F, Illinois State (DeKalb, Ill.)
Vaughn-Low earned herself a starting spot in the past two
games for the Redbirds. She recorded two shots, both on goal,
in the double overtime draw at then-No.19 Marquette. She also
had the assist on the game-winning goal of the 1-0 victory over
Miami (Ohio) Sunday afternoon. She tallied two shots, both on
goal, in that match as well.

Gopika Patel, Fr., D, Loyola

Loyola freshman Gopika Patel put in a pair of impressive performances along the Rambler backline to help lead the Maroon & Gold to a pair of shutout wins over the weekend. Patel opened the two-game stretch with a 45-minute shift as part of a 9-0 win over Chicago State on Friday evening. The Darien, Ill. native played in every second of Sunday's 2-0 blanking of DePaul as the Ramblers held a traditionally high-powered Blue Demon attack scoreless. Patel has been a fixture in the Loyola lineup early on in her career, starting in all 10 contests this season.

Redshirt senior Rebecca Rodgers with her goal in the UIC win continues to climb the all-time goals list at Drake and in the MVC. Rodgers has 30 career scores, which ranks second all-time at Drake and tied for ninth all-time in MVC history.

Freshman Hannah Bormann scored her first career goal in Drake's 1-0 win at Creighton. Bormann became the fourth Bulldog this season to score her first career goal. Seven players have scored at least one goal this season.

The Crusaders open conference play this weekend with a Saturday night match at Missouri State.
Valpo's women's soccer program is the lone Crusader program with previous experience in the Missouri Valley Conference, as it was an affiliate member of the



conference from 1996 through 1998. The Crusaders' previous tenure in The Valley was highlighted by goalkeeper Amy Cavanaugh setting a school and conference record which still stands today, as she tallied 224 saves during the 1997 season.

Feast or Famine

When the Crusaders' offense has been clicking this season, it has been on all cylinders, as Valpo has scored 13 goals over the five games it has found the back of the net - an average of 2.6 goals per game. But the Crusaders have also been shut out five times in their 10 matches on the season. Valpo is 5-0-0 when scoring at least once, but 0-5-0 when being shut out.
