### MVC Offensive Player of the Week

#### Piper Thomas, Jr., MH, UNI

UNI junior Piper Thomas powered the Panther offense with a .354 hitting percentage and a team-best 36 kills (5.14 kills/set) as UNI secured a pair of road wins to begin Missouri Valley Conference play over the weekend. Thomas tallied a career-high 23 kills (.373 hitting percentage) to go along with three blocks in a 3-1 win at Valparaiso. Thomas added 13 kills (.323 hitting percentage) and four blocks in a 3-0 sweep of Loyola Saturday. Thomas ranks fifth in the league in total kills (234) and seventh in hitting percentage (.308) on the season.

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week

#### Courtney Pence, Jr., DS, Illinois State

Illinois State junior Courtney Pence continued her run of stellar play by averaging 7.38 digs per set over the weekend to solidify her ranking atop the Missouri Valley Conference and among the national leaders. Pence tallied 36 digs against Missouri State on Friday, marking the fourth-highest single-match dig total in Redbird Arena history. She registered 23 digs in a sweep of Southern Illinois Saturday night. Pence currently leads the Valley in total digs (356) and digs per set (6.36), while ranking second nationally.

### MVC Freshman of the Week

#### Stef Jankiewicz, Fr., S, Illinois State

Illinois State's Stef Jankiewicz continued to direct the Redbirds' offense over the weekend as she averaged 11.12 assists per set. The freshman setter also contributed 29 digs (3.62 per set), two kills and two blocks. Against Missouri State, Jankiewicz dished out a match-high 55 assists while setting a career high with 21 digs. She currently ranks fourth in the Valley, averaging 10.34 assists per set.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Erica Haslag (BRAD)** - Haslag opened Missouri Valley Conference play with a pair of double-doubles, averaging 3.25 kills and 4.12 digs per set in the first two Valley matches of 2017. She had 14 kills, 18 digs and a pair of blocks in the MVC opener against Southern Illinois Friday. Haslag followed it up with 12 kills and a team-best 15 digs Saturday against pre-season Valley favorite Missouri State for her ninth double-double of the season. Haslag moved into 17th in career kills at Bradley in Saturday's outing against the Bears.

**Kyla Inderski (DU)** - Led Drake to a pair of wins to open the conference season with 30 kills and 43 digs in wins at Loyola and Valparaiso ... her 30 kills came on 70 attempts for a .300 hitting percentage ... in the two wins, she averaged 4.29 kills and 6.14 digs per set ... in the four-set win at Loyola, she had 17 kills on 34 attempts with 19 digs ... the next evening, she had 13 kills on 36 attempts along with a career-high 24 digs and a pair of blocks in just three sets ... she ranks second in the MVC in digs after the first week of the season ... Inderski's week added to her lofty totals in the Drake record book as her 1,225 career kills ranks as the third most in school history and just seven away from second place ... her 1,236 digs are the fifth most in program history.

**Jaelyn Keene (ILS)** - Keene turned in a pair of stellar performances over the weekend, averaging 4.25 kills per set with a .366 hitting percentage. Keene collected 15 kills in a five-set loss to Missouri State on Friday before leading all players with 19 kills in a sweep of Southern Illinois on Saturday. The Redbird senior currently ranks among the top five in the Valley in several key statistics: third in points (4.63 per set), fourth in kills (3.71 per set), fourth in blocks (1.04 per set), fourth in aces (0.32 per set) and fifth in hitting percentage (.311).

**Laura Gross (INS)** - Junior Laura Gross picked up her ninth double-double in 13 matches this season as the Indiana State volleyball team opened Missouri Valley Conference play with a 3-2 win over Evansville. The Potomac, Illinois native finished the match with 16 kills and 20 digs.

**Gabi Maciagowski (LUC)** - In two Missouri Valley Conference matches last week, Maciagowski averaged 3.00 kills and 2.14 digs per set, while hitting .164 (21-11-61). The Preseason All-MVC pick collected 12 digs, her highest total since September 3, and added nine digs, in a 3-1 loss to Drake on September 22, then contributed a team-best nine kills and added six digs against #22 UNI a day later. The 6-foot-1 junior has totaled 10 or more kills five times this season and currently leads the team with 2.69 kills per set. Maciagowski enters this week's action needing 295 kills for 1,000 in her Loyola career.

**Lily Johnson (MSU)** - Lily Johnson became the Missouri Valley Conference's all-time leader in career kills and helped the Bears to a pair of MVC road wins with averages of 4.33 kills, 4.11 digs and 4.72 points per set. Johnson passed former Bradley standout Lindsay Stalzer for the MVC record during the first set of Friday's 3-2 win at Illinois State, and finished with 20 kills and 17 digs against the Redbirds, Saturday. Johnson hit .364 with 19 kills and 20 digs at Bradley, adding two aces and two blocks in the win.

**Patience Brown (SIU)** - Patience Brown hit .386 and averaged 2.86 kills and .86 blocks per set to lead the Salukis to a split on the opening weekend of Valley play. Brown tallied season-bests in hitting percentage (.462), kills (14), blocks (4) and attempts (26) in SIU's four-set win over Bradley on Friday. She followed with a team-best six kills and two blocks against Illinois State on Saturday. She has now put down at least five kills in seven of the nine matches she's appeared in this season.

**Alex Nunez (LUC)** - Nunez pitched in 4.29 digs per set in a pair of league matches last weekend. The junior libero contributed 12 digs in a four-set setback versus Drake on September 22, then came back to record 18 digs, one shy of equaling her career high, in a three-set loss to #22 UNI. For the season, Nunez leads Loyola with 3.24 digs per set and with 136 total digs this fall has already surpassed her career total heading into this season (134).

**Emily Butters (MSU)** - Emily Butters averaged 5.89 digs per set and was nearly perfect on serve receive with a .984 percentage in wins at Illinois State and Bradley. Butters matched her career high with 30 digs and successfully received all 47 serves directed at her in Friday's win at Illinois State, then dug 23 balls in four sets Saturday evening in MSU's 3-1 win at Bradley.

**Kendyl Sorge (UNI)** - Sorge averaged 5.29 digs per set (37 total digs) as UNI opened league play with a pair of road victories. Sorge registered 24 digs and a .964 service reception percentage on 28 attempts in a 3-1 win at Valparaiso. Sorge added 13 digs and a perfect reception percentage in 22 attempts in a 3-0 sweep of Loyola on Saturday. Sorge ranks sixth in the league in digs/set (4.54) on the season.

**Ashley Edelen (SIU)** - Ashley Edelen had a team-high 40 total digs in two matches over the weekend, averaging 5.71 per set to go with three aces. Edelen tied her career-highs for digs (24) and service aces (2) in the win over Bradley on Friday, as she recorded multiple aces in a match for the third time in her career, and the first since Oct. 31, 2015, also at Bradley. On Saturday, the Louisville, Ky. native followed with 16 digs and an ace against the Redbirds.

**Emily Plock (DU)** - In her first Valley games, she was third on the team in kills with 19 kills on 54 attempts in wins at Loyola and Valparaiso ... in the league opener, she had six kills and a game-high four blocks ... the next evening, she had 13 kills and added three blocks to give her four total blocks on the week and currently ranks fourth in the MVC in blocks.

**Allana McInnis (UE)** - In UE's lone match of the week, freshman Allana McInnis set her career mark with 54 assists at Indiana State. It was the most for a Purple Aces player since Jelena Merseli registered 62 against Bradley last year. The effort surpassed her previous high of 48 set against Chicago State in the season opener. McInnis ranks 7th in the MVC with 8.15 assists per set.

**Elle Van Grinsven (LUC)** - Van Grinsven hit .250 (15-5-40) with 2.14 kills and 0.71 blocks per set in two Missouri Valley Conference contests last weekend. The freshman middle blocker registered a season-high 11 kills and added a pair of blocks in a 3-1 loss to Drake on September 22. One night later, she recorded four kills, three digs and three blocks versus #22 UNI. Van Grinsven is accounting for 1.64 kills and 0.50 blocks per set this season, while hitting .239 (72-30-176).

**Jaydin Seehase (UNI)** - Seehase posted 12 kills and three blocks to help UNI begin Missouri Valley Conference play with a pair of road triumphs. Seehase secured eight kills (.278 hitting percentage) and three blocks in UNI's 3-1 victory at Valparaiso. Seehase came back with four kills (.375 hitting percentage) in a 3-0 sweep at Loyola on Saturday.

**Rachel Maguire (SIU)** - Rachel Maguire dished out 35 assists (5.0/set) and added 17 digs (2.43/set) to help the Salukis split on the opening weekend of Valley play. Maguire notched her second career assists-digs double-double in the win over the Braves on Friday, as she tallied 25 assists and a career-high 15 digs. She followed with 10 assists and two digs against the Redbirds on Saturday.

## Historic MVC Start for Bulldogs

Drake opened MVC play 2-0 for the first time since 1999 with wins at Loyola and Valparaiso and just the third time since the formation of the MVC. The back-to-back road wins also made Drake 5-1 in its last six MVC matches dating back to last season. The Bulldogs have also now won back-to-back MVC road series going back to 2016. Drake last won back-to-back MVC road matches to open a the MVC schedule in 1996.

## New MVC Career Kills Queen

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson broke the all-time MVC career kills record in Friday's 3-2 win at Illinois State. Johnson pounded out 20 kills in the win and surpassed Lindsay Stalzer from Bradley (2002-05) to claim the conference record.

## Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American Athletic, A-10, Big Sky, Conference USA, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Southern, Southland, Summit, SWAC and West Coast), and at least a .500 record against another four (Big West, Colonial, Metro Atlantic and Mountain West).

## Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 10 other leagues, including America East (1-0), American Athletic (3-0), Big Sky (1-0), Ivy League (2-0), MEAC (2-0), Northeast (2-0), Southern (2-0), Southland (2-0), SWAC (1-0) and West Coast (1-0).

## Wins Over Power Five

The MVC earned a win over a school from each of the Power 5 conferences during non-conference play. The Valley posted a combined record of 8-17 over the ACC (1-3), Big Ten (3-6), Big 12 (1-3), Pac 12 (2-3) and SEC (1-2).

## Top-25 Victories

The Valley has five wins over Top 25 teams this season and currently holds a 5-8 record against teams ranked in the AVCA Top 25 at the time of the match.

UNI claimed four Top 25 wins during non-conference play. The last time UNI recorded four or more wins in the same season over ranked foes came in 2002 (#8 Pepperdine, #7 UCLA, #20 Minnesota, #3 Florida, #20 Missouri).

## AVCA Top-25

UNI remains No. 22 in the latest AVCA Top 25 poll (Sept. 25) following wins over Valparaiso and Loyola last week. The Panthers have been ranked in 112 polls in the history of the AVCA Top 25. Missouri State continues to receive votes, sitting No. 34 nationally with five votes.

## Haslag Among NCAA Leaders

Bradley junior Erica Haslag ranks Top 5 nationally in four categories entering play this week. Haslag sits third nationally in total points (311.0), total kills (281) and total attacks (810) and fourth in attacks per set (13.28). The junior standout also ranks 15th in kills per set (4.61).

## Against 2016 NCAA Field

The Valley won 11 matches against 2016 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI led the league with five wins against the 2016 NCAA field (Iowa State, Missouri, Nebraska, Northern Illinois & USC), while Illinois State claimed three (Arizona, Cincinnati & Dayton). Bradley (Murray State), Loyola (Samford) and Missouri State (Ohio State) each claimed one win against the field.

## More MVC Records For Johnson

Lily Johnson established a pair of MVC records during the season's first weekend. Johnson passed MSU's Michelle Witzke for the MVC's career lead in total attacks, and recorded her 97th and 98th career matches with at least 10 kills, breaking a tie with Witzke and Bradley's Jenny Pavlas for the most in conference history based on available records. Johnson's 11 career MVC Player of the Week honors are also the most in league history, surpassing UNI's Molly O'Brien (2000-03).

## Stepping Up

In addition to Erica Haslag's strong play offensively, Bradley received a couple of strong performances from sophomore Kathryn Graf and senior Jamie Livaudais during the opening weekend of MVC play. Graf had a career-best 16 kills while attacking at a .452 clip in Bradley's MVC opener vs. Southern Illinois Friday. Graf is now eighth in the Valley with a .304 hitting percentage in addition to having the most total blocks in the league. Livaudais had her highest kill total since her freshman year with a season-best 19 kills Saturday against Missouri State. Livaudais, who hit .486 in the outing against the Bears, had tallied a total of nine kills over the previous six matches before Saturday's effort and had last recorded more than 15 kills in a match late in the 2014 campaign.



## Hitting the Road

Saturday's home contest with Missouri State wrapped up a 10-match home stand for Bradley and the Braves will now play seven of the next nine matches on the road starting with Monday night's matchup with Indiana State in Terre Haute, Ind. The weekend trip to Cedar Falls, Iowa, will mark the first time Bradley will travel west in 2017. The Braves will follow the heavy road slate with five of the final seven regular-season matches of the year at Renaissance Coliseum.

## Halfway Point

Bradley's matchup with Missouri State Saturday night marked the halfway point of the 2017 regular-season schedule for the Braves. Junior Yavianliz Rosado's 336 digs this season puts her on pace to break the school record for digs in a season of 606 set by Stacey Besjak in 1985 and she is on pace to post just the sixth 500-dig season in Bradley history. In addition, fellow junior Erica Haslag already boasts 281 kills and 197 digs as she looks to become the first Brave with back-to-back seasons with 300 kills and 200 digs since Stephanie Behrns in 2001 and 2002.

### Defensive Dandies

Illinois State ranks at or near the top of the Missouri Valley Conference rankings in several key defensive categories. The Redbirds lead the MVC in opponents' hitting percentage (.143), opponents' assists (10.86 per set) and opponents' kills (11.61 per set). The Redbirds rank second in blocks (2.02 per set), digs (18.50 per set) and opponents' service aces (0.84 per set).



### Always A Fight

Through Illinois State's first 15 matches of the season, the Redbirds have been swept just once. Illinois State's lone three-set loss came at the hands of host Baylor, on Aug. 26, 2017, just hours after a grueling 2-hour, 49-minute, five-set loss to then-No. 15 Florida State. The Redbirds, conversely, have seven sweeps on their resume this season.

### She Digs History

Illinois State's Courtney Pence continues to etch her name into Illinois State record books. Her 36 digs against Missouri State Friday were the fourth most by a player in Redbird Arena history. Pence now owns the third- and fourth-highest single-match dig totals in Redbird Arena history. Pence owns six of Illinois State's top 10 single-match dig totals, including the school record of 44.
