# **MVC Offensive Player of the Week**

#### Lynsey Wright, Sr., MB, Missouri State

Missouri State's Lynsey Wright earned tournament MVP honors at the D.C. Koehl Classic hosted by Ohio State, averaging 3.08 kills and 0.92 blocks per set with a .462 attack efficiency and .569 kill percentage. Wright was brilliant in Missouri State's Friday victory at 20th-ranked Ohio State, finishing with 15 kills and no errors to hit .577 while adding four blocks. Wright hit .333 with 13 kills and four blocks Saturday versus Lipscomb, a team ranked just outside the AVCA's top 25, and became the 21st player in school history with 1,000 career kills in Saturday's

sweep of Oakland, hitting .467 with nine winners and three blocks.

### **MVC Defensive Player of the Week**

#### **Courtney Pence, Jr., DS, Illinois State**

Illinois State junior Pence was named to an all-tournament team for a second-straight weekend, this time at Saint Louis' Marcia E. Hamilton Classic. Pence averaged 7.18 digs per set over Illinois State's three matches at SLU, while adding 13 assists and a pair of aces. Pence recorded her best performance Saturday against Kennesaw State, tallying 36 digs in the match, a total tied for the sixth most in a match in program history. Pence currently leads the MVC and leads the nation in digs, currently averaging 7.45 per set.

Valparaiso's Rylee Cookerly continued the strong start to her rookie season as she averaged 7.10 digs/set over three matches last weekend at South Dakota State's Jackrabbit Invitational. She opened the weekend with 28 digs in a four-set match against CSU Bakersfield, and then posted 28 digs in a three-set match with Northern Arizona - just two digs shy of cracking Valpo's top-five all-time for a three-set match. She closed the weekend with 15 digs and a pair of aces in a sweep of the host Jackrabbits.



# **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag had three consecutive double-doubles over the weekend at the Ball State Tournament in Muncie, Ind., averaging team highs of 5.27 kills and 4.55 digs per set. She has now had double-doubles in four consecutive outings and is the first player in program history to record 100 kills in the first six matches of a season. Haslag had 18 kills and 12 digs while hitting at a.444 clip in a sweep of Fort Wayne. Later that same day, she had 12 kills and 14 digs in a four-set contest against tournament-host Ball State as she became the third fastes player in program history to reach 700 career kills. Haslag capped the weekend with one of the strongest performances of her career, tallying career-highs of 28 kills and 24 digs. The 28 kills and 24 higs are since 2012 and rank as the second-highest match total by a Bradley player under the 25-point set format (since 2008) and Haslag is the first player in program history to collect at least 28 kills and 24 digs in a match.

Kyla Inderski (DU) - Led Drake to a 2.1 record and an appearance in the JMU Invitational Championship games ... finished the weekend with a team-high 26 kills and was second on the team with 36 digs in the three matches ... in the Bulldogs 3-0 win over Cornell, she posted 12 kills on 30 attempts and added seven digs ... she followed that with eight kills and a season-high 20 digs in the three-set loss to tournament champion JMU ... her digs over the weekend moved her into sixth all-time at Drake in digs with 1,132.

Rachel Tam (UE) - Another nice offensive weekend saw Rachel Tam average 3.00 kills per set, recording a total of 39 for the weekend She started the weekend with 8 against UAPB before upping that to 14 versus Morgan State. Against SEMO, she had an efficient effort, hitting .371 with 17 kills. She also had two block assists on the weekend to go along with 17 diss.

Jaelyn Keene (ILS) - Keene paced the Redbird offense for the second-straight weekend as the senior middle blocker hit .369 and averaged 3.18 kills per set. Keene also delivered four service aces and 13 blocks, including two of the solo variety. Keene currently leads the Redbirds this season in kills (3.45 per set), blocks (1.05 per set) and aces (0.23 per set).

Morgan Gresham (LUC) - Gresham was named to the Rambler Challenge All-Tournament Team after putting up 2.91 kills per set (32 total), along with 2.73 digs per set (30 total) in three matches last weekend. The junior outside hitter established a new career high with 13 kills, and added nine digs, in a four-set loss to Fairfield on September 1, then pitched in nine kills and six digs against Milwaukee one del later. Gresham helped spearhead Loyola's 3-1 victory over Samford on September 3, notching 10 kills and 15 digs, while hitting .348 (10-2-23), en route to her first double-double since her collegiate debut on August 28, 2015 versus New Hampshire. This season, Gresham is averaging 2.14 kills and 2.32 digs per set.

Karlie Taylor (UNI) - Taylor earned a spot on the Bluejay Invitational All-Tournament team after leading UNI with 57 kills (4.75 kills, set) in three matches. Taylor recorded 28 kills in a five-set match vs. No. 13 Kentucky, It marked the most kills in a match by a UNI Panther in 15 years since Molly O'Brien posted 29 kills vs. Creighton in the 2002 season. Taylor began the weekend by posting 20 kills and 12 digs in UNI's first-ever win over No. 18 Southern California. Taylor hit .326 against the Trojans. Taylor followed that up with a .333 hitting percentage against Kentucky as she was fed 66 attack attempts. On the season, Taylor leads the Panthers with 110 kills (4.58 kills/set) and four double-doubles. She has tallied 20 or more kills in four of the six matches this season.

Kolby Meeks (SIU) - Meeks hit for a high efficiency in SIU's lone match of the week against Arkansas State, as she posted a team-high .565 hitting percentage. The Norcross, Ga. native finished with 14 kills on 23 attempts and just one error, and added a block assist. It marks the 10th time in her career that she has put down 10+ kills in a match.

Hannah Angeli (BRAD) - Angeli helped Bradley average 19.18 digs per set in three contests at the Ball State Tournament in Muncio, Ind., with the setter averaging 4.36 digs per set to go with her 10.82 assists. She had three double-doubles to become the first player in program history to open a season with six consecutive double-doubles. In the sweep of Fort Wayne, Angeli had 13 digs along with four kills, 35 assists and one ace. She had 10 digs, one block, 35 assists, seven kills and a pair of aces Friday in a four-set contest against tournament-host Ball State. Angeli wrapped up the weekend with a season-best 25 digs along with two blocks, four kills, 49 assists and an ace. She was the first Bradley individual with 49 assists and at least 25 digs in a match since Wendy Carney had 68 assists and 27 digs against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 29, 1988. Angeli has helped Bradley average 19.13 digs per set and the setter is just outside the top 10 in the MVC in digs per set at 4.04.

**Courtney Morehead (DU)** - Led Drake with 50 digs in three matches to record a 2-1 record at the JMU Invitational ... averaged 5.0 digs per set in the three games ... recorded 24 digs in three sets against Cornell and ended the weeken dwith 21 digs against JMU.

**Erlicia Griffith (UE)** - A great blocker in her first season of work for the Purple Aces continued that into this year as Erlicia Griffith was named to the All-Tournament Team at the Redhawks Invitational. She posted three solo blocks and 10 block assists in the tournament, notching 1.00 per set. Her average of 1.04 ranks fourth in the MVC. Her top performance was against Morgan State where she had 8 block assists.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - In three matches at the Rambler Challenge last weekend, Nunez averaged 3.36 digs per set (37 total), twice reaching double figures in digs. The libero dug a career-high 19 balls and added 12 assists for her first career double-double in a four-set setback versus Fairfield on September 1. She produced 10 digs against Milwaukee one day later, then closed out the tournament with eight digs and eight assists in a victory over Samford. Nunez leads the team with 79 total digs (3.59 per set).

Emily Butters (MSU) - Emily Butters averaged 5.33 digs per set last week to earn all-tournament honors at the D.C. Koehl Classic. The sophomore scooped a match-high 24 digs in MSU's four-set victory at No. 20 Ohio State Friday to go with one service ace. Saturday, Butters posted a perfect service reception percentage in two matches, recording 22 digs against Lipscomb and 18 in a sweep of Oakland, handing out nine total assists on the day. She finished the weekend ranked ninth in school history in career digs just six matches into her junior season.

**Kendyl Sorge (UNI)** - Sorge led the Panther defensive charge at the Bluejay Invitational with 60 digs (5.00 digs/set). Sorge added a pair digs vs. No. 13 Kentucky and 21 digs vs. No. 7 Creighton. Sorge has produced four 20-plus dig efforts through six matches this season. Sorge chipped in with five assists vs. USC, four assists vs. Kentucky and three assists vs. Creighton. Sorge leads the Panthers with 111 digs (4.62 digs/set).

Ashley Edelen (SIU) - Edelen tallied a career-best 22 digs in SIU's four-set loss to Arkansas State. Edelen, who's started at libero in all four of Southern's matches this season, also set a career-high with seven assists against the Redwolves. It marked the third-straight match that the Louisville, Ky. native has set or tied her career-best in that category.

Natalie Fry (DU) - Had 21 kills in three matches on 46 attempts for a team-high .348 hitting percentage in going 2-1 as a team at the JMU Invitational ... also led the team with six blocks in the three games ... opened the weekend with four kills on seven attempts against Hampton and finished the tournament with a season-high 14 kills on 32 attempts with a pair of blocks for 15 total points in the four-set loss to JMU ... her .333 hitting percentage on the season is tied for fourth in the MVC and is the top among freshmen.

Allana McInnis (UE) - Allana McInnis has been a force across the board for UE in her first two weeks of action. Over the last week of play, McInnis posted 7.85 assists per set along with a team-best 8 service aces while chipping in 23 digs. She had three aces against UAPB and Morgan State with two more coming versus SEMO. In five frames against the Redhawks, she totaled 46 assists.

Stef Jankiewicz (ILS) - Jankiewicz turned in another weekend of strong performances as Illinois State's setter, as the freshman averaged 9.18 assists and 2.55 digs per set. Jankiewicz also added nine kills, four aces and seven blocks over the three-match stretch. Jankiewicz tallied a pair of double-doubles on Saturday, with her best performance coming against Kennesaw State. In that match, Jankiewicz tallied 42 assists and 14 digs. She currently ranks fourth in the Valley in assists per set, with 9.55.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - Freshman Elle Van Grinsven contributed 1.27 kills (14 total), 0.55 digs (6 total) and 0.73 blocks per set (8 total) in three matches at the Rambler Challenge last weekend. The 6-foot-1 middle block opened the weekend by totaling eight kills, two digs and three blocks against Fairfield, then bounced back from a tough outing against Milwaukee to hit. 571 (40-7) with an ace, three digs and a season-high four blocks in Loyola's four-set victory over Samford on September 3. Van Grinsven is pitching 1.55 kills and 0.64 blocks per set, while hitting .250 (34-14-80) this season.

Emelie Orlando (MSU) - Emelie Orlando played a key role in each of MSU's matches last week, helping the offense hit. 272 in three contests. Friday, Orlando had 19 assists, one kill and two aces in the Bears' 3-1 win at No. 20 Ohio State. She equaled her season high with 22 assists in each match Saturday, adding five digs against Lipscomb and four digs, one kill and an ace versus Oakland.

Maggie Nedoma (SIU) - Nedoma made her home debut as a Saluki a memorable one, as she hit. 286 and led the Salukis in kills (15) and attempts (35) vs. Arkansas State on Aug. 29. The Brook Park, Ohio native became the 16th Saluki since 2003 to record 15+ kills as a freshman, and of those 16, is the third-fastest to do so.

### **Against the Field**

The MVC holds a winning record against eight leagues in non-conference play (American Athletic, A-10, Ivy League, MEAC, Northeast, Summit and SWAC), and at least a .500 record against another five (Big East, Conference USA, Metro Atlantic, Pac 12 and SEC) through the first two weeks of the season.

#### Two More Top-25 Victories

The Valley earned a pair of Top 25 wins on Friday night and already have three such wins this season. UNI claimed its second win over a ranked foe with a 3-1 win over #18 USC, while Missouri State won at #20 Ohio State, 3-1.

It was the first time the MVC won two matches vs. Top 25 foes on the same day since Missouri State beat #14 Illinois and Wichita State beat #18 Creighton on August 27, 2016.

This week, Missouri State will face #8 Washington and Loyola will battle #13 Kentucky on neutral courts.

# **Tourney Success for Bulldogs**

Drake played in a tournament title game for the second straight weekend as the Bulldogs went 2-1 on the weekend with the lone loss coming to 2016 NCAA Tournament participant JMU in the title game of the JMU Invitational ... the tournament championship appearance came just one weekend after claiming the Fullerton Titan Tournament title to open the season.

## **Strong Start for Aces**

Evansville was within a point of going 6-0 in a 5-set nail-biter against Southeast Missouri State. UE enters its home schedule with a 5-1 record, matching its start from the 2011 campaign.

# Wright Joins 1,000 Kill Club

Lynsey Wright became the 21st player in Missouri State history with 1,000 career kills during the first set of MSU's sweep of Oakland on Saturday. Wright reached the milestone on an efficient .284 career hitting percentage, including .300 or higher in 48 of her 103 career matches.

### **Hook Joins 3,000 Assist Club**

Senior setter Heather Hook became the seventh UNI player to record 3,000 or more assists in her career. Hook surpassed the 3,000 mark in UNI's 3-1 win over No. 18 USC. Hook has registered 3,036 assists.

#### **More Records For Johnson**

Lily Johnson established a pair of MVC records during the season's first weekend. Johnson passed MSU's Michelle Witzke for the MVC's career lead in total attacks, and recorded her 97th and 98th career matches with at least 10 kills, breaking a tie with Witzke and Bradley's Jenny Pavlas for the most in conference history based on available records.

## **MVC Career Kills Watch**

Missouri State senior Lily Johnson sits in third place on the all-time MVC career kills list. Johnson pounded out 38 kills in matches vs. Ohio State, Lipscomb and Oakland over the weekend. Johnson is 99 kills away from passing Missouri State's Michelle Witzke (1994-97) and 128 kills away from breaking the MVC record held by Bradley's Lindsay Stalzer (2002-05)

## Diggin' It

Valpo freshman libero Rylee Cookerly set a school-record and posted the sixth-best dig performance in MVC history, registering 43 digs in a 3-1 loss at Notre Dame. Cookerly's 43 digs is tied for the sixth-best in league history with Wichita State's Kelly Broussard. The freshman's 43 digs broke Valpo's previous single-match record, which was set by Karen Kulick against UIC in November of 1991, back in the sideout-scoring era. Cookerly ranks third nationally this season, averaging 6.86 digs/set.

# **BRADLEY (2-4)**

#### **Historic Start**

Junior Erica Haslag is not only leading the Missouri Valley Conference in kills per set (4.96), but is doing so at a historic pace. Haslag is the first player in program history to record 100 kills (114) in the first six matches of a season, topping the previous record of 98 kills by Lindsay Stalzer in the first six matches of 2005. Haslag had a career-best 28 kills and 24 digs Saturday against Navy, notching the second-best kill total by a Bradley player since the 25-point set format was adopted in 2008. She



reached 700 career kills Friday in the outing at Ball State, eslipsing the mark in 63 career matches to become the third fastest player in Bradley history to 700 career kills. Haslag has turned in four consecutive double-doubles.

#### **Doubling Up**

Sophomore transfer Hannah Angeli has had double-doubles in each of the first six matches of 2017 and is now the first player in program history to open a season with six consecutive double-doubles. The last Brave with six consecutive double-doubles at any point in a season was Stephanie Behrns midway through the 2002 campaign. Angeli's 49-assist and 25-dig performance Saturday against Navy was the first 45-assist & 25-dig outing by a Bradley individual since Wendy Carney had 68 assists and 27 digs against Eastern Illinois on Oct. 29, 1988.

#### **Down Goes USC**

UNI secured the program's first-ever win over the University of Southern California on Friday with a 3-1 triumph at the Bluejay Invitational. UNI entered the match vs. USC having lost all four previous matchups. This time around it proved to be UNI's time to shine as the Panthers were paced by 20-kill efforts from Karlie Taylor and Piper Thomas. Bri Weber contributed with a season-high 18 digs.



#### **Two Ranked Foes Have Fallen**

UNI has recorded a pair of victories over ranked foes this season with triumphs over No. 19 Missouri (3-2) and No. 18 USC (3-1). It marks only the third time in school history that UNI has knocked off at least two ranked opponents in the same season. UNI defeated five ranked opponents in 2002 (No. 8 Pepperdine, No. 7 UCLA, No. 20 Minnesota), No. 3 Florida, No. 20 Missouri) and 2003 (No. 11 Notre Dame, No. 23 Missouri State, No. 20 UC Santa Barbara). UNI is 2-2 against ranked opponents this season.

### **Hook Joins 3,000 Assist Club**

Senior setter Heather Hook became the seventh UNI player to record 3,000 or more assists in her career. Hook surpassed the 3,000 mark in UNI's 3-1 win over No. 18 USC. Hook has registered 3,036 assists.

#### **120 From 1,000**

Abby Barrow is 120 kills from becoming the 15th Saluki to reach the 1,000-kill milestone. The Metamora, III. native has finished in the top-16 of the Missouri Valley Conference for kills in each of the past two seasons and is one of four Salukis with 25+ kills during the first four matches of 2017.

#### 15+ Kills From Freshman

Maggie Nedoma put down 15 kills on 35 swings against Arkansas State in just her fourth career match. She became the 16th Saluki since 2003 to record 15+ kills in a single match as a freshman, and the first to do so since Ginger Perinar put down 16 against Evansville on Nov. 19, 2016. Doing so in her fourth career match ties her for third with Andrea Estrada in terms of quickest to put down 15+ kills in a match at SIU. Estrada notched 16 kills at Middle Tennessee in her fourth career match on Sept. 2, 2014. Former Saluki standouts Haley Hann and Chandra Roberson each put down 15+ kills in their respective debuts. Hann tallied 15 kills vs. Austin Peay on Aug. 29, 2003, while Roberson followed with 16 kills vs. IUPUI three years later on Aug. 25, 2006.
