MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Sydney Griffin, Jr., F, Valparaiso (Hinsdale, Ill.)

Griffin continued her hot start to the season with two more goals in a pair of Valpo wins last weekend. Griffin opened the scoring in the 13th minute of Valpo's eventual overtime win over Eastern Illinois, and then on Sunday scored the game's lone goal late in the first half of a 1-0 win over Belmont. Through her first six games as a Crusader, Griffin has scored four goals - two of which have been match-winners.



MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Kesia Gesell, Fr., GK, Valparaiso (Winnipeg, Manitoba)

Gesell stood out Sunday in her first career victory and her first career shutout, blanking a Belmont side which had scored 11 goals over the season's first three games. Gesell made nine saves to earn the clean sheet, seven of which came with the score still 0-0 and a number of which were of the highlight-reel variety. The nine saves were the most by a Valpo keeper in a shutout since October of 2012.



MVC Newcomer of the Week

Katie Sidloski, So., MF, Indiana State (Strongsville, Ohio)

Katie Sidloski had an impressive weekend of play for the Sycamores. Even though Sidloski is a sophomore, this is her first year of collegiate competition after battling through injury her freshman season. During the Sycamores 2-0 win over Green Bay, Sidloski recorded three points during the match. These points came from a goal and an assist. Sidloski is now second in points for the Sycamores.

OFFENSE

Rebecca Rodgers, R-Sr., M, Drake

Rodgers scored the equalizer in Drake's 2-1 comeback win over UMKC on Friday. Rodgers, who played in just five matches in 2016, scored early in the second half as she took a deep pass and beat the Roos' defense and blasted the ball in the far post. Rodgers, the 2015 MVC Player of the Year, received a medical hardship waiver this season. Rodgers led Drake with five shots, including two on goal, against UMKC in 74 minutes of play and against North Dakota State she played 48 minutes. She has 28 career goals, which ranks second all-time at Drake and trails Andrea Schmitz (2002-05), who had 32 goals.

Emily Dickman, SR, F, Illinois State

Dickman led the team with five shots in Friday's loss at Duquesne and two shots Sunday at Pitt. She also had the assist on the game-winning goal Sunday against Pitt. Four of her five shots at Duquesne were on goal, giving ISU some dangerous opportunities to get on the scoreboard.

Katie Sidloski, So., MF, Indiana State

Katie Sidloski had an impressive weekend of play for the Sycamores. During the Sycamores 2-0 win over Green Bay, Sidloski recorded three points during the match. These points came from a goal and an assist. Sidloski is now second in points for the Sycamores.

Katie Grall, Sr., F, Loyola

Loyola senior Katie Grall tallied her third goal of the season as part of the Ramblers' 5-2 win over Mercer this past Friday at the Marquette Invitational in Milwaukee, Wis. Grall, who was named to the event's All-Tournament Team, provided Loyola with a valuable insurance goal in the 73rd minute as she rifled home a pass from freshman Jenna Ross. She also was credited with a pair of shots in Loyola's weekend finale against Central Michigan. The Waukesha, Wis. native has now matched her goal-scoring total from all of last season and sits as part of a three-way tie for the lead in the category on the Rambler roster.

Kayleigh Putnam, So., MF, Missouri State

Putnam joined the scoring pool Friday evening against Southeast Missouri State, netting the first goal of her career to secure Missouri State's 2-0 win over the Redhawks. Returning from halftime scoreless, Putnam received a pass across the box and scorched the game-winning goal in the 48th minute from 15-yards out to give the Bears the edge they needed to hold off the Redhawks.

Sarah Brandt, Sr. F, UNI

Brandt put the Panthers on the board late in the game with a goal at the 77-minute mark against North Dakota State. With that goal, Brandt has 12 career goals as a Panther and three on the season. Brandt sits tied for third on UNI's all-time list. The Panthers won the match, 1-0.

DEFENSE

Ali Smith, Sr., D, Drake

Smith scored the game winner in the 2-1 comeback victory over UMKC. It is the first career goal for Smith, who has played in 58 career matches for the Bulldogs. Smith's goal came on a set piece on a corner kick from fellow senior Rachel Wanniger. Wanniger sent a high ball towards the box that a sprinting Smith was able to get her head on and sent it past the UMKC keeper. Smith played all 90 minutes against UMKC and then played 73 minutes against North Dakota State Sunday in helping to post a 2-0 shutout win over the Bison.

Haley Smith, SO, GK, Illinois State

Smith tallied her second shutout of the season Sunday in the 1-0 win against Pitt. She tallied three saves in the match and six saves Friday at Duquesne.

Caitlyn Eddy, So., MF, Indiana State

Caitlyn Eddy has been a defensive and offensive presence for the Sycamores all season. Eddy, the transfer from Little Rock, is currently tied for first in points with four, after recording a total of four assists on the year. Eddy has also been a relentless force defensively in the central midfield. The junior blocked multiple shots and deterred offensive attacks in both games of the weekend.

NEWCOMER

Olivia Bruce, Fr., F, Drake

Bruce scored her first career goal in the 2-0 win over North Dakota State on Sunday. Bruce, who has played in all five matches this season, took a pass from fellow freshman Hannah Bormann and beat the NDSU keeper and blasted her shot in the far corner of the net. She played 35 minutes in each of Drake's wins over the weekend.

Sarah Lafayette, FR, F, Illinois State

Lafayette scored her second career goal and second game-winning goal in the 1-0 win at Pitt on Sunday. Her lone shot of the match became the deciding factor. She also had two shots Friday at Duquesne. She has gone back and forth with a starting role but continues to be an offensive force for the Redbirds.

Jenna Ross, Fr., D, Loyola

Loyola freshman Jenna Ross dished out three assists over the final 18 minutes of Loyola's 5-2 thumping of Mercer on Friday as part of the Marquette Invitational in Milwaukee, Wis. The freshman, who also notched a shot against Central Michigan on Sunday, assisted on Katie Grall's game-winning tally in the 73rd minute before also providing the assists on goals by Kat Stephens and Avalon Senn-Raemont, respectively. For her efforts on the weekend, Ross, who leads the Valley in assists with five helpers, was one of two Ramblers recognized on the event's All-Tournament Team.
