

# **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Gabi Haack (BRAD) - Haack averaged a team-best 17.5 points per game on 67 percent shooting, while making 9-of-14 (64.3 percent) three-point attempts in a pair of victories for the Braves. She also averaged 7.0 rebounds, 3.0 assists and 1.0 steals per game. In her first career start, Haack torched defending Summit League champion Western Illinois, which recently posted a win at #18 Stanford and was ranked 20th in the latest Mid-Major poll, with a season-best 26 points. She was 9-for-13 from the field and connected on 8-of-12 three-point attempts in the victory as she tied the Bradley single-game record with her eight triples. Haack was a perfect 6-for-6 from beyond the arc in the second half and hit her final seven three-point attempts as she helped Bradley rally from 18 points down for an 87-80 victory. Her 26 points were the most in a game by a Bradley freshman since the 2007-08 season and Haack added 10 rebounds, three assists and a steal for her first career double-double. In the MVC opener at Illinois State, Haack scored all nine of her points in the third quarter as she helped the Braves blow open what was a six-point contest at the half. She finished with nine points, four rebounds, three assists and a steal as Bradley won its MVC opener for the first time since 2008-09.

Becca Hittner (DU) - In Drake's two MVC wins on opening weekend, Hittner averaged 11.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 3.5 assists per game while shooting 8-of-12 (66.7 percent) from the floor and 3-of-5 (60 percent) from behind the three-point line ... in the win over Valparaiso, Hittner scored 11 points, grabbed four rebounds and handed out four assists in just 22 minutes ... she also was 3-for-3 from distance ... in the win over Loyola, she scored a game-high 12 points to go along with three rebounds and three assists In 23 minutes ... she made all four of her free throws ... this season, Hittner is averaging 14.3 points per game, which ranks fourth in the MVC ... also ranks fourth in the MVC in shooting at 45.7 percent, eighth in free throw percentage at 80.3 and 14th in the three-point shooting at 36.4 percent ... pulling down 4.5 rebounds per game ... scored at least eight or more points in every Drake game this season.

Kerri Gasper (UE) - Opening conference play, junior guard Kerri Gasper continued her career year. In the Aces' MVC-opener against SIU on Friday, Gasper played just eight minutes after picking up two fouls, scoring three points in the opening half. Gasper responded in the second half, scoring 14 of her 17 points in the final 20 minutes and helping lead the Aces back into the contest. To end the weekend, the Olmsted Township, Ohio native scored a team-best 19 points and a career-best 11 rebounds, while dishing out four assists. Gasper has already exceeded her total assists (52) from a season ago with 59 this year and currently leads the MVC and sits 100th in the nation in assists per game (4.5).

Simone Goods (ILS) - Simone Goods added her third double-double of the season and a career high of rebounds in a game (14) on Sunday. She has added a double-double in three out of the six games she has competed in and now averages 17.2 points per game and 9.7 rebounds per game.

Wendi Bibbins (INS) - Wendi Bibbins averaged 9.5 points per game and 10 rebounds per game as conference play opened for Indiana State. Bibbins, who averaged 29.5 minutes on the floor, shot 40 percent from the field, was 3-for-5 from the free throw line while also swiping five steals and blocking three shots. She added to her line with three assists.

Alexa Willard (MSU) - Alexa Willard averaged 18 points and six rebounds on 52 percent shooting in helping the Lady Bears to a 2-0 league start, doing so in just 47 total minutes of playing time. Friday, the sophomore scored a career-high 23 points on 8-of-15 shooting against a stingy Indiana State defense, and grabbed nine rebounds in 27 minutes. Sunday at Evansville, Willard needed only 20 minutes to tally 13 points on 6-for-12 shooting, adding three rebounds and an assist.

Mikaela Morgan (UNI) - Morgan scored in double-figures twice last weekend, earning 18 and 10 points in a pair of MVC wins for UNI. In Friday's victory over Loyola, the junior matched her career-high after scoring 18 points on an efficient 6-of-8 shooting from the floor. Morgan followed up her impressive outing with a 10-point performance to aid the Panthers to a 77-56 win against Valparaiso.

Alexis Delgado (INS) - Averaging 32.0 minutes on the court with 8.5 points per game, Alexis Delgado shot 30 percent from beyond the arc while grabbing six rebounds and dishing out five assists. The Phoenix native also was credited with a steal in scoring 17 points over two games.

Abby O'Connor (LUC) - Loyola freshman Abby O'Connor averaged 8.5 points and 6.0 rebounds, both team-best marks, in the Ramblers' two games in the state of lowa over the weekend. The South Bend, Ind. product finished with 11 points, seven rebounds, two blocks and three steals in Friday's Valley opener at Northern lowa, before adding six points, five rebounds, an assist, a block and a steal two days later against Drake. O'Connor currently ranks fourth overall amongst MVC freshmen in both scoring (8.9 ppg) and rebounding (5.5 rpg).

**Brice Calip (MSU)** - Brice Calip averaged 4.5 points, 3.5 rebounds and 4.5 assists in two MSU wins last week. Friday, Calip dished out four assists without a turnover against an Indiana State team that leads the MVC in steals and turnovers forced. Sunday, Calip went 4-for-4 from the field, finishing with nine points, three boards, five assists and one turnover.

Nicole Kroeger (UNI) - Kroeger scored in double-figures twice last weekend, earning 11 and 16 points in a pair of MVC wins for UNI. In Friday's victory over Loyola, the freshman scored 11 points off the bench to help the Panthers route Loyola. On Sunday, Kroeger knocked down four 3-pointers to net 16 points off the bench as UNI put away Valparaiso, 77-56. This season, the freshman has scored in double-figures three times.

### **Five Perfect in MVC Play**

Drake (2-0), UNI (2-0), Missouri State (2-0), Southern Illinois (2-0) and Bradley (1-0) remain perfect after the first weekend of league play. The five teams will put their undefeated MVC records on the line this weekend as Drake, UNI, Missouri State and Southern Illinois all play, while Bradley will travel to Loyola and Valparaiso.

#### **Home Sweet Home**

Since 2002, home teams have won at least 55 (.611) of the 90 league contests in all but six seasons (2003-04, 2006-07, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17). The most wins by home teams in league play came in 2008 (61-29 at home in conference play). The league was 51-39 (.567) at home in league play last year, and has compiled a 4-5 (.444) mark so far in 2017-18.

## **Quick Starts Crucial**

Since 1982-83, just three teams (Missouri State, champions in 1998-99, 1994-95 and 1990-91; Drake, champions in 1996-97 and co-champions in 1987-88; and Evansville, a 2007-08 co-champion) have won at least a share of the regular-season title without winning its regular-season opener. In fact, 12 of the last 17 regular-season champs (or co-champs) have opened 2-0 or better in MVC play, with Evansville in 2007-08, Missouri State in 2004-05, UNI in 2010-11, Missouri State in 2011-12 and UNI in 2015-16 serving as the only five exceptions.

#### **Title Town**

The league has had nine different regular-season champions in the past 11 seasons (SIU-2007, DU/UE/ILS-2008, ILS-2009, ILS-2010, UNI-2011; MSU-2012; WSU/CU-2013; INS/WSU-2014; WSU-2015; UNI-2016; DU-2017). Bradley, Loyola and Valparaiso are the only league teams not to have won a regular-season MVC championship.

# **Valley Streaks**

Drake has tied Missouri State for the longest win streak in MVC history. Listed below are the top five streaks for MVC contests only. Drake's last MVC loss was an 85-74 setback at UNI on Feb. 19, 2016.

### **Against the Field**

The MVC held a winning record against six leagues during non-conference play, including the Big 12 (2-1), Big South (2-1), Big West (1-0), Colonial (1-0), Southland (1-0) and WAC (4-0). The MVC held at least a .500 mark against four other conferences: American (2-2), Big Sky (1-1), Mountain West (1-1) and SWAC (1-1).

#### Perfect at the ARC

The Crusaders carry a seven-game home winning streak into Friday's game and enter this weekend as the only team in The Valley unbeaten at home this year (5-0). Valpo finished the nonconference portion of the season with an undefeated home record for the first time since 2007-08. This is Valpo's longest home winning streak since rapping off 11 straight victories at home spanning the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.

### **Knocking Down Freebies**

After going 29-31 (93.5%) from the free-throw line over the weekend, Evansville moved into the top spot in the nation in free-throw shooting percentage, shooting 83.6% from the charity stripe this season. Evansville is shooting 8% better than any other MVC team and is one of just five teams in the nation shooting better than 80% this season. The Aces also tied a program record with a perfect 15-15 performance from the line on Sunday against Missouri State, just one make shy of the 16-16 outing the Aces put together against UNI in the MVC Tournament on Mar. 14, 2008.

#### **Dialin' From Distance**

SIU senior Kylie Giebelhausen is continuing her climb up the Missouri Valley Conference three-point field goals made list. Napier has connected 27 times from behind the arc this season and sits No. 25 on the all-time Valley list. Giebelhausen is six makes away from passing Missouri State's Jackie Stiles for 22nd on the MVC list.

#### **Fruendt on Miller Watch List**

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Missouri State senior Liza Fruendt is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2018 Cheryl Miller Award. Named after the three-time Naismith Player of the Year, the annual award in its inaugural year recognizes the top small forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2018 Cheryl Miller Award will be narrowed to just 10.

# **Hoops In the Heartland**

The 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the third year of a three-year contract with the Quad Cities Convention and Visitors Bureau.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

### **Valley History**

One of the premier women's basketball leagues in the country, the MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 20 seasons. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 11 different seasons, including a pair of bids to last season's NCAA Tournament. The league has also had two Final Four teams (Missouri State, in both 1992 and 2001), a WNIT champion (Missouri State, 2005) and three WNIT semifinal appearances (Illinois State, in 2011, 2010 and 2009).

# **BRADLEY (7-5, 1-0 MVC)**

**MVC Opener** 

Bradley opened Missouri Valley Conference play with a 62-42 victory at I-74 Illinois State, marking the first time the Braves opened league play with a victory since the 2008-09 season (at Wichita State). The 20-point victory was the largest in the series with the Redbirds for the Braves since a 71-36 home win on Jan. 6, 2002



and Bradley's largest margin of victory at Redbird Arena since a 75-47 win on Feb. 23, 1995. Bradley will be shooting for its first 2-0 start to Valley play since that same 2008-09 campaign (4-0).

#### **Road Warriors**

One of just four Missouri Valley Conference teams with multiple road wins this season, Bradley will wrap up a heavy road schedule this weekend with contests at Loyola (Friday) and at MVC newcomer Valparaiso (Sunday). The Braves will open Valley play with a three-game road swing for the second consecutive year and just third time in program history. Each of the two previous times Bradley started the league slate with three consecutive road games the Braves went 1-2 with a victory in the final game of the road swing. One victory this weekend would give Bradley multiple wins on a three-game MVC road swing for the first time since 2014-15 (2-1). Sunday's game at Valparaiso concludes a stretch in which Bradley will have played nine of 12 games away from home and the Braves follow up the stretch with six of the next eight at Renaissance Coliseum.

With its wins over Valparaiso and Loyola to start MVC play and close 2017, Drake ended the calendar year of 2017, a perfect 20-0 in league action. Add in their three wins at the 2017 MVC Tournament in Moline, III., and the Bulldogs were 23-0 in MVC contests during 2017.



#### **Bench Crew**

Drake's bench was instrumental in its opening weekend wins over Valparaiso and Loyola. In the win over the Crusaders, the Bulldogs' reserves led by junior Nicole Miller's career-high 18 points, scored an impressive 56 points as they outscored the entire Valparaiso team. In the next victory over Loyola, the bench scored 31 points paced by redshirt junior Sara Rhine's 10 points.

#### Streak on the Line

Drake is riding an impressive 24-game winning streak in MVC action, a streak that started late in the 2015-16 season. The streak will be on the line Friday night when the Bulldogs play at Missouri State. Drake and Missouri State were picked No.1 and No. 2, respectively, in the 2017-18 Preseason MVC Coaches Poll. The last time the two teams met on March 2, 2017 in Des Moines it was a shootout as Drake held off a furious rally attempt by Missouri State for a 98-91 win. Sophomore Becca Hittner scored a then career-high of 22 points while MSU senior Liza Fruendt poured in a career-high 46 points. Hittner and Fruendt were both selected to the 2017-18 MVC preseason first team while Fruendt was tabbed the MVC Preseason Player of the Year.

### **Best in the Nation**

After going 29-31 (93.5%) from the free-throw line over the weekend, the Purple Aces moved into the top spot in the nation in free-throw shooting percentage, shooting 83.6% from the charity stripe this season. Evansville is shooting 8% better than any other MVC team and is



one of just five teams in the nation shooting better than 80% this season. The Aces also tied a program record with a perfect 15-15 performance from the line on Sunday against Missouri State, just one make shy of the 16-16 outing the Aces put together against UNI in the MVC Tournament on Mar. 14, 2008.

### The Emergence of Gasper

With a few Aces missing time early this season due to injuries, Evansville required someone to step-up as a facilitator. Enter junior guard Kerri Gasper. The Olmsted Township, Ohio native tallied just 52 assists all last season and has already surpassed that total this year with 59 dimes through 13 games. The junior leads the MVC and ranks in the 100 nationally in assists with 4.5 per contest.

#### **Vs. Indiana State**

After a four-game losing streak to the Sycamores, Evansville captured a pair of victories over Indiana State last season. The Sycamores lead the all-time series, 37-17, and have won 21 of 27 matches taking place in Terre Haute. The Aces have shown some recent success in games at Indiana State, winning three of the last five on the road.

### **Tying a Freshman Record**

Abby Brockmeyer's career-high 27 points on 11-of-14 shooting tied the program record for points by a freshmen in a single game. Brockmeyer tied Cartaesha Macklin's school record of 27 points, set during a 77-63 win over IUPUI on Dec. 8, 2011. It marks the



most points by a Saluki freshman in a Missouri Valley Conference game, and the third time a Saluki freshman has scored 20-plus points in a Valley contest. It is the 14th time in program history that a freshmen has scored 20-plus points.

### **Getting Off to a Good Start**

The Salukis are now 5-0 in conference openers under fifth-year head coach Cindy Stein. Overall the Salukis hold a .567% winning percentage (21-16) in conference openers since 1981-82. The Salukis last opened five-straight conference seasons with a win from 1982-87. With SIU's 64-45 win at Indiana State, the Salukis opened conference play 2-0 for the second time in Stein's five seasons, and the first time since the 2015-16 season

#### **Moving On Up**

Kylie Giebelhausen ranks 25th amongst DI players with 216 career three-pointers, which is the most of any active player in the Missouri Valley Conference. The East Peoria, III. native moved past Indiana State's Lisa Verhoff (2002-06) for 24th all-time with her two treys in SIU's win over Evansville on Sunday. The East Peoria, III. native is six three-pointers shy of passing Jackie Stiles (1998-01) for 21st in Valley history.

#### **Franklin Continues To Climb**

Dani Franklin turned in a team-high 18 points on Sunday at UNI, in the process continuing her ascent of Valpo's all-time scoring list. Franklin, who played in her home state of lowa for the first time in her collegiate career this weekend, surpassed Jeanette Gray (1999-



2003) for third in program history. The Valpo senior, who became the first Valpo player in 15 years to crack the program's Top 3, has 1,461 career points. The only two players with more in the history of Valpo women's basketball are Debbie Bolen (2,008) and Sarrah Stricklett (1,498).

### **Defending the ARC**

The Crusaders carry a seven-game home winning streak into Friday's game and enter this weekend as the only team in The Valley unbeaten at home this year (5-0). Valpo finished the nonconference portion of the season with an undefeated home record for the first time since 2007-08. This is Valpo's longest home winning streak since rapping off 11 straight victories at home spanning the 2006-07 and 2007-08 seasons.

#### **Dorow to Face Former Team**

Valpo head coach Tracey Dorow will face her former team on Friday night against Illinois State. She played for the Redbirds from 1990-1993, leading the Redbirds in assists as a sophomore while finishing seventh in the Gateway Conference in assists that season.
