### MVC Offensive Player of the Week

**Piper Thomas, Sr., MH, UNI**  
 The Panthers went 3-0 and Piper Thomas led the way for the Panthers in all three matches. She notched a .456 attack percentage for the week with 50 kills and just nine errors, averaging 5.0 kills per set. Against Indiana State, she had 13 kills with just three errors for a .400 attack percentage. Against Loyola, she notched 18 kills and a .483 attack percentage and against Valparaiso, she had a season-high 19 kills and just two errors for a .472 attack percentage. She also tallied a season-high six block assists in the Valpo match. In conference-only stats, she is tied for first in attack percentage at .478, first in kills at 5.08 per set, and tops the league in points at 5.46 per set.

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week

**Yavianliz Rosado, Sr., L, Bradley**  
 Rosado averaged 7.43 digs per set in a pair of home victories as Bradley limited Indiana State and Evansville to a combined .163 hitting percentage to improve to 4-0 in MVC play and 14-2 overall. She posted a career-best 35 digs in a four-set victory over Indiana State Friday and also had a pair of assists against the Sycamores. The 35 digs tied for the fourth-best single match total in Bradley history and were the most by a Brave since Lauren Zerante had 36 digs in a five-set match at Northern Iowa on Nov. 22, 2013. She capped the weekend with 17 digs and three assists in a sweep of Evansville Saturday, helping BU limit the Aces to a .143 hitting percentage. In addition to helping the Braves to just the third 4-0 start to MVC play in school history, Rosado has helped Bradley to its longest win streak (8) since 2005 and the team's 14 wins are the most since that same 2005 campaign (16).

### MVC Freshman of the Week

**Chloe Rear, Fr., S, Missouri State**  
 Missouri State freshman Chloe Rear handed out assists at an elite level last week, averaging 13.83 per set while guiding the Bears to a .231 hitting percentage. Rear's assist average was a full assist per set ahead of this year's NCAA leader, and her 51 assists on Friday against Southern Illinois represented the most for a Bear in a three-set match in the 25-point scoring era (since 2008). Rear added 10 digs against SIU for the double-double, and MSU hit .355 in the match. Monday at Loyola, the rookie had 32 assists, five digs and a block.

### NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

**Hannah Thompson (BRAD)** - Thompson hit .312 for the week, while averaging a team-best 5.00 kills per set to go with 3.00 digs per set in a pair of home victories as she helped Bradley improve to 4-0 in MVC play and 14-2 overall. She opened the week by hitting .305 in a four-set win over Indiana State. Thompson collected a match-high and season-best 24 kills in the victory in addition to notching one assist, one ace, eight digs and a block. The 5-8 outside hitter followed up that effort with her team-best eighth double-double of the year in a sweep of Evansville. Thompson found the floor with 11 kills (0 errors) on 34 attacks for a .324 hitting percentage and also notched 13 digs and a block. Her 24 kills against Indiana State was the highest kill total in a match by a Bradley frosh since 2015 and ranks as the second-most kills by a Brave in a four-set match under the 25-point set format. One of two freshman in the country with 190 kills and 230 or more digs this season, Thompson has helped Bradley to its longest win streak (8) since 2005 and the team's best overall win total since that same campaign.

**Grace Schofield (DU)** - Led the Bulldogs by recording 30 kills in 11 sets to even the team's MVC record at 2-2 with a 2-1 record on the week ... she also added 31 digs, the second most on the team with two blocks ... she opened the week with 11 kills on 31 attempts in the win over Evansville ... she closed the week with a 14-kill, 14-dig double-double in the win at Loyola ... in the win at Loyola, she hit .303 as her 14 kills came on 33 attempts ... defensively, she also had just two errors on 63 total receptions.

**Stef Jankiewicz (ILS)** - Stef Jankiewicz joined the 2,000 assist club over the weekend, notching 77 total assists to average 11.00 assists per set in the Redbirds' pair of wins over Evansville and Indiana State to remain undefeated in conference play. The sophomore dished out a season-high 48 assists against the Sycamores on Saturday to go with four kills on .400 hitting and a service ace. Jankiewicz also added 10 digs against Indiana State for her sixth double-double of the season. In the Redbirds' sweep of Evansville, Jankiewicz's 29 of the team's 33 total assists helped set up Illinois State's offense, as the Redbirds registered a team hitting percentage of .341. She also contributed a block and three kills against the Purple Aces. Her 2,041 career assists currently ranks 12th all-time at Illinois State, while her season total of 592 is good for eighth all-time by a sophomore.

**Quinn Spieker (LUC)** - Spieker racked up 3.30 kills, 2.40 digs, 0.40 blocks and 0.40 assists per set in three matches last week, while hitting at a .222 (33-11-99) clip as the Ramblers posted a 1-2 ledger. The 6-foot-3 outside hitter has ripped double-digit kills in each of the last four outings and in nine of the last 11. She drilled 11 kills and added five digs and a pair of blocks as Loyola rolled past Missouri State on September 24 for just its second-ever win over the Bears. She then accounted for 10 kills and six digs in a loss to UNI before notching her fifth double-double of the season with 12 kills and 13 digs against Drake. For the year, Spieker is hitting .236 (173-56-496) with 2.84 kills and 2.34 digs per set. With 173 kills she has already surpassed her total from all of 2017 (172).

**Amelia Flynn (MSU)** - Amelia Flynn led the Bears with 3.67 kills per set on .259 hitting last week, adding 3.83 points, 2.5 digs and two total blocks. Friday, Flynn hit .438 with 16 kills and 11 digs in a sweep of Southern Illinois, her fourth double-double of the year. Monday, the freshman had six kills and four digs in three sets at Loyola.

**Maggie Nedoma (SIU)** - Nedoma led the Salukis in kills in each of SIU's two matches this past weekend. Against Valpo, the Brook Park, Ohio native finished with 12 kills and she followed with seven versus Missouri State. The sophomore opposite hitter averaged 3.17 kills, 2 digs and 1 Block per set in Southern's two matches.

**Lizzie Zaleski (VALPO)** - Zaleski hit over .400 in both of Valpo's weekend matches. She posted a team-best 12 kills on just 20 swings, hitting .500 as Valpo swept Drake on Friday night. Zaleski followed with 13 kills on .409 hitting in Valpo's battle with UNI on Saturday. Including the Crusaders' sweep of SIU on Monday, Zaleski averaged 3.00 kills/set for the week and hit .360.

**Kylee Macke (DU)** - Led Drake with 53 total digs on the week in 11 total sets ... closed the week with 22 digs in the four-set win over Loyola after notching 15 and 16 digs in the previous two matches, respectively ... had just one error in 49 reception attempts as well.

**Courtney Pence (ILS)** - Courtney Pence averaged a team-best 7.00 digs per set on the weekend in Illinois State's pair of wins over Evansville and Indiana State this weekend, to help the Redbirds remain undefeated in conference play. In addition, Pence served a key role in helping the Redbirds hold their two opponents to a combined .053 hitting percentage on the weekend, including holding Evansville to a -.075 hitting percentage and just 33 total points in the home-opening match at Redbird Arena. After digging 49 balls over the weekend, Pence is now just 29 digs shy of jumping into second all-time in the Valley in career digs. She also contributed the second-most assists (6).

**Heather Kocken (LUC)** - Kocken has established herself as one of the top blockers in The Valley this season and last week turned back 1.90 attacks per set, while adding 0.40 digs per set. In addition to her defensive prowess last week, the redshirt junior hit .317 (17-4-41) with 1.70 kills per set. In Loyola's 3-0 win over Missouri State on September 24, Kocken contributed six blocks before equaling that production in a loss to UNI later in the week. She went on to record seven blocks and pitched in 10 kills in a four-set setback against Drake on September 29. This season, Kocken is tallying 1.20 blocks and 0.18 digs per set, while throwing in 2.25 kills per set and a .317 (135-44-287) hitting percentage.

**Aubrey Cheffey (MSU)** - Aubrey Cheffey led the Bears with 1.17 blocks per set in two matches last week. Monday at Loyola, the junior recorded five stuffs in only three sets, and had two more blocks in Friday's win against SIU. Cheffey added two digs in each match and averaged 3.00 kills per set on the offensive side.

**Kendyl Sorge (UNI)** - Kendyl Sorge had 34 digs over three matches, including 18 against Valparaiso to close out a strong weekend for the Panthers.

**Emma Baalman (SIU)** - Emma Baalman was a force at the net defensively for the Salukis. She averaged 1.33 blocks per set in SIU's two matches last week, which included a career-high eight blocks versus Valparaiso.

**Rylee Cookerly (VALPO)** - Cookerly posted 6.40 digs/set over Valpo's three matches last week, in the process surpassing 1,000 career digs. The sophomore opened the week with 17 digs in a sweep of Southern Illinois, and then recorded 18 digs in Valpo's sweep of Drake Friday night. In the first set against the Bulldogs, Cookerly registered her 1,000th career dig in just her 52nd career match, tying her with Valpo record-holder Taylor Root for the fastest in program history to four figures in digs. She then ended the week with a match-high and Valpo season-high 29 digs in the four-set contest against UNI. Cookerly also committed just one service reception error over the week's three matches.

**Caitlyn Smith (DU)** - Had a pair of double-doubles on the week and finished with 54 total assists and 26 digs in the Bulldogs' 11 sets ... she began the week with 23 assists, one shy of a career-high, against Evansville along with 11 digs ... she also had an 11-assist, 11-dig performance against Evansville ... closed the week with 20 assists at Loyola on just 37 attempts for a .541 assist percentage.

**Carley Nicholson (ILS)** - Carley Nicholson made an appearance in all seven sets for the Redbirds this weekend, as Illinois State remained undefeated in conference play with a pair of wins over Evansville and Indiana State. The freshman accounted for four of the team's six service aces this weekend. In the Redbirds' match against the Purple Aces, an Evansville was forced to use a timeout after Nicholson's service ace had ISU at a 19-9 advantage in the first set. Again, Nicholson provided an ace as part of the Redbirds' 20-1 run to close the second set and open the third set. In Illinois State's four-set win over Indiana State, Nicholson registered back-to-back service aces in the opening frame as part of a 7-0 run by the Redbirds to help Illinois State to a 25-11 opening-set win over the Sycamores.

**Lauren Caprini (LUC)** - Caprini contributed 1.50 digs, 0.50 assists and 0.20 aces per set in three matches last week as Loyola went 1-2 and picked up only its second-ever win over Missouri State. The 5-foot-7 libero totaled three digs, two assists and an ace in a 3-0 victory over the Bears and had six digs and an ace in a hard-luck loss to UNI. The rookie wrapped up the week with a half dozen digs and three assists in a 3-1 loss to Drake. For the season, Caprini is averaging 2.25 digs and 0.39 aces per set.

**Inga Rotto (UNI)** - Inga is seeing an increased role. She had four kills against Indiana State, three against Loyola and two against Valparaiso. The three-match stretch is the longest multi-kill stretch of the season. She also had a solo block and three block assists in the stretch.

## Still Perfect...

Bradley, Illinois State and UNI all remain unbeaten in MVC action after the second week of league play. The trio all hold a 4-0 record in MVC contests. After this coming weekend, only one team will have the opportunity to keep that status, as the Redbirds and the Braves are set to travel to Iowa to face UNI and Drake. The last time Illinois State opened its conference slate with a perfect 4-0 record was back in 2014, when the Redbirds won the league outright with a perfect 18-0 record in Valley play. UNI opened last MVC season 7-0, finishing second in the standings at 15-3.

## Historic Start for Bradley

The Braves are 4-0 to start conference action for just the third time in program history (last in 2005) and have already surpassed last year's Valley win total. In fact, BU's 14 wins are the most since ending the 2005 campaign with a 16-17 mark. Bradley brings its longest win streak in over a decade (8) into Friday night's match at Drake. The last time Bradley had an eight-match win streak was 2005 and the Braves have not had a win streak longer than eight since 2002 (11).

## Valpo's Best Start

This year's squad became the first Valpo team to ever go 17-2 through its first 19 matches of the season with the win over Drake on Friday. Despite the Saturday setback against UNI, the team is still tied for the best record through 20 matches with the 2004 and 2014 teams. The 2014 team was 17-3 before taking its fourth loss in match number 21, while the 2004 squad made it to 20-3 before falling for the fourth time.

## Most Wins in the Nation

Valpo enters the week tied with Stephen F. Austin for the most wins by a D-I team in the nation, sitting on 17 victories going into Friday night's match. The Crusaders were the first team to reach the 17-win mark, doing so Friday night with the win over Drake.

## NCAA RPI Report

The first edition of the NCAA RPI report for the 2018 season has been released and the Valley has three teams featured in the top-65. UNI leads the league at No. 20, while Valparaiso (No. 55) and Illinois State (No. 63) are also among the nation's top-65. Four other teams rank in the Top 150 (Drake, Missouri State, Bradley and Loyola). As a conference, The Valley ranks eighth among 32 conferences.

## Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 11 leagues, including America East (2-0), American (1-0), Big South (3-0), Ivy (2-0), Metro Atlantic (2-0), Mid-Eastern (2-0), Northeast (3-0), Patriot (1-0), Summit (9-0), SWAC (5-0) and WAC (2-0).

## Top-25 Victories

The Valley has two wins over top-25 opponents this season as UNI topped #13 Creighton 3-0 and #5 Kentucky 3-2 in Los Angeles.

## Top of the Class

The Valley has placed multiple teams in the NCAA Tournament 10 times in the last 12 years. Since 2007, The Valley has received 30 bids into the 64-team field, trailing only the Pac 12, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC, ACC & West Coast Conferences.

## Non-Conference Success

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (.55-.57) and 2017 (.61-.66). The MVC is 80-48 (.625) in non-league play this season, which ranks second in that span. The Valley posted a league-best .756 non-conference win percentage in 2010.

## Against 2017 NCAA Field

The Valley has won five matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI and Illinois State lead the conference with a pair of wins over participants in the 2017 NCAA tourney. The Panthers have wins over Creighton and Kentucky, while the Redbirds beat Coastal Carolina and Stony Brook. Valparaiso has the leagues fifth win, beating Cal State Bakersfield.

## Panthers Elite Offense

UNI leads the MVC in both assists per set and kills per set so far this season. The Panthers rank top 15 nationally in both categories, sitting 11th overall in assists per set (13.58) and 12th in kills per set (14.42). Rachel Koop leads The Valley in assists per set and sits 10th nationally (11.51), while Karlie Taylor leads the league in kills per set and points per set, ranking 12th (4.58) and 14th (5.01) nationally in each category.

## Tough Defenses

Bradley and Valparaiso are ranked among the top 10 nationally in both digs per set and opponent hitting percentage. The Braves sit 5th in digs per set (18.63) and third in opponent hitting percentage (0.143), while Valpo sits seventh in both categories (18.31 & 0.145). Bradley and Valpo join Cleveland State as the only teams nationally to rank top 10 in both categories.

## Milestones Reached

Valpo's Rylee Cookerly and Bradley's Abby Ihrke both hit the 1,000-dig milestone for their respective careers over the weekend. Cookerly surpassed 1,000 career digs in the win over Drake Friday, while Ihrke joined the club against Evansville Saturday.

## BRADLEY (14-2, 4-0 MVC)

### Historic Start

Bradley continued its strong start to the 2018 season, pickup up a pair of home victories to improve to 4-0 in Valley play and 14-2 overall. The Braves are 4-0 to start conference action for just the third time in program history (last in 2005) and have already surpassed last year's Valley win total. In fact, BU's 14 wins are the most since ending the 2005 campaign with a 16-17 mark and the last time the Braves posted four or more MVC victories was 2013 (7). Bradley is already guaranteed an improved conference record in three consecutive seasons, marking the first time since 1992-94 the Braves have had a better conference record in three straight years.



### Streaking

Bradley brings its longest win streak in over a decade into Friday night's match at Drake after the Braves claimed their eighth consecutive victory with a sweep of Evansville Saturday night at Renaissance Coliseum. The last time Bradley had an eight-match win streak was 2005 and the Braves have not had a win streak longer than eight since 2002 (11), with both of those seasons marking the only other seasons in which BU opened league play 4-0 or better. Saturday's win against Evansville also improved Bradley to a perfect 8-0 at home this season as the Braves broke the Renaissance Coliseum record for home wins. The last time the Braves won eight or more home matches in a season was 2005 (10). Bradley's eight-match home win streak is the squad's longest since winning the final two home matches of the 2001 season and first and the first eight home matches of 2002.

### Climbing the Charts

Bradley entered last week's contests fourth in the nation in digs per set and averaged 20.14 digs per set in victories against Indiana State and Evansville to push the team's average to a league-best 18.63 digs per set. Senior defensive specialist Abby Ihrke has helped anchor the Braves back line, averaging 2.84 digs per set and recorded her 1,000th career dig in Saturday's matchup with Evansville. Ihrke is the 16th player in program history to reach 1,000 career digs and is two digs from passing Julie Penn for 15th in Bradley history. Senior libero Yavianliz Rosado is also closing in on 1,000 career digs, needing 27 to push her two-year total as a Brave to the 1,000 mark.

### ILLINOIS STATE (12-4, 4-0 MVC)

#### Then There Were Three

Illinois State is only of three MVC programs to remain undefeated after the second week of league play. Bradley and UNI join the Redbirds at the top of the conference standings, as all three hold a 4-0 record in MVC competition. After this next weekend, only one team will have the opportunity to keep that status, as the Redbirds and the Braves are set to travel to Iowa to face UNI and Drake. The last time Illinois State opened its conference slate with a perfect 4-0 record was back in 2014, when the Redbirds won the league outright with a perfect 18-0 record in Valley play.



#### Long Time Coming

For the first time since the 2013 season, Illinois State is sitting at 12-4 overall. The Redbirds' only losses have come to teams that are currently in the AVCA Top-25, or are currently receiving votes. Two Redbirds - Marissa Stockman and Ali Line - are currently hitting over .300 on the season with a minimum of 200 attack attempts. The two are sitting at one and two in the Valley in the category.

#### Welcome to the Club

Over the weekend, Stef Jankiewicz joined the 2,000 assist club, notching 77 total assists to average 11.00 assists per set in the Redbirds' pair of wins over Evansville and Indiana State to remain undefeated in conference play. The sophomore dished out a season-high 48 assists against the Sycamores on Saturday to go with four kills on .400 hitting and a service ace. Jankiewicz also added 10 digs against Indiana State for her sixth double-double of the season. In the Redbirds' sweep of Evansville, Jankiewicz's 29 of the team's 33 total assists helped set up Illinois State's offense, as the Redbirds registered a team hitting percentage of .341. She also contributed a block and three kills against the Purple Aces. Her 2,041 career assists currently ranks 12th all-time at Illinois State, while her season total of 592 is good for eighth all-time by a sophomore.
