MVC Offensive Player of the Week



Jenna Szczesny, Sr., F, Loyola (Hoffman Estates, Ill.)

Loyola senior Jenna Szczesny turned in a two-goal performance for the second time in as many games, leading the Ramblers to a 4-0 win at Indiana State on Saturday evening. Szczesny, the reigning MVC Offensive Player of the Week, opened in the scoring in the 21st minute by heading home a throw-in from sophomore Jenna Ross before adding another tally in the 38th minute as she directed a free kick from fellow senior Taylor Lambouris into the back of the net. The Hoffman Estates, Ill. native, who moved up to second all-time on Loyola's career goal scoring list with 28 career tallies, is currently tied for first in The Valley with seven goals scored on the year.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week



Kaitlin Maxwell, So., GK, Missouri State (Lincoln, Neb.)

Goalkeeper Kaitlin Maxwell was impressive in goal collecting 10 saves, including an outstanding tip at the 88-minute mark to keep the Panthers off the board and get the Bears their first conference win of the season. The 10 saves marked Maxwell's third time reaching double digits this season. Her efforts are among the best in the country, with her save count ranking fourth nationally. This is the fifth time this season Missouri State has shut-out its opponent.

MVC Newcomer of the Week



Kennedy Orlick, Fr., F, Missouri State (Raymore, Mo.)

Kennedy Orlick's go-ahead goal in the first half helped solidify the Missouri State's 1-0 shutout against Northern Iowa to pick up its first conference win of the season. She would be the lone scorer in the contest at the 23-minute mark, bouncing the long distance shot off the post to put the Bears ahead 1-0. The goal marked her fourth game-winner of the season, and she currently ranks 25th nationally in go-ahead scoring. Orlick is also the leading goal scorer for the Bears so far this season.

In addition to the league's Offensive and Defensive Player of the Week and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

OFFENSE

Olivia Bruce, So., F, Drake (Lakeville, Minn.)

Sophomore Olivia Bruce scored the second goal in Drake's 2-0 home win over Illinois State Saturday night. After teammate Halie Reznik's shot was saved but not secured by the Illinois State goalkeeper, Bruce beat her to the ball and put it in the back of the net for her team-leading third goal in 2018. This season, Bruce has played in all 12 matches with eight starts.

Alex Eyler, Fr., F, Evansville (O'Fallon, Mo.)

In her first collegiate season, freshman Alex Eyler has impressed so far in 2018. Against Valparaiso on Saturday, Eyler, found a ball in the box and placed it in the back of the net in the 43rd minute, providing Evansville with what would be the game-winner. The goal was the second of the season for Eyler, both coming in a four-match stretch in which she has recorded seven shots. On the year, Eyler has appeared in 11 of the Aces' 12 matches, starting one, scoring twice while recording 11 shots with four on-goal.

DEFENSE

Kelsie Stone, So., GK, Drake (Hoffman Estates, Ill.)

Sophomore Kelsie Stone tallied five saves in the victory over the Redbirds. Stone time and time again came up with big saves for the Bulldogs. She recorded her second-straight shutout and third of her career. This season, Stone has played every minute in net this season for Drake.

Michaela Till, So., GK, Evansville (Avon, Ind.)

The reigning Missouri Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week, sophomore goalkeeper Michaela Till once again turned in an impressive performance for Evansville. In the Aces' 1-0 victory over Valparaiso, Till made eight saves between the posts including an important save in the 81st minute on a Crusaders penalty kick that preserved the win for UE. The shutout was the third of the season for Till and fourth in her career. For Till and the Aces, it's the second-straight shutout marking the first time Evansville has recorded back-to-back clean sheets since 2015 and the first time UE has recorded two-straight shutout wins since October 15 and 25, 2014 when the Aces earned 2-0 and 3-0 victories over Indiana State and UNI at Arad McCutchan Stadium. The Aces have gone 247 minutes without conceding a goal, the longest since holding opponents scoreless for 643 minutes from September 12 to September 28, 2014. On the season, Till has recorded 62 saves, placing the sophomore in a tie for 42nd nationally.

Madison Laudeman, Jr., D, Loyola (Chesterfield, Mo.)

Loyola junior Madison Laudeman scored her first goal of the season in the Ramblers' emphatic 4-0 blanking of Indiana State on Saturday. The Chesterfield, Mo. product found the back of the net off a free kick in the 36th minute as the Maroon & Gold rolled to a second road victory in as many games. Laudeman played a full 90 minutes along the Rambler backline as Loyola recorded its second clean sheet of the season and first of MVC play.

NEWCOMER

Alison Walls, Fr., F, Drake

Freshman Alison Walls netted the Bulldogs' first goal in the shutout of the Redbirds. Walls took a pass from Vanessa Kavan, beat the defender and fired a strike from 22 yards out. She is tied with Bruce for the team lead in goals with three. Walls, who has been named MVC Newcomer of the Week twice this season, has played in all 12 matches with seven starts. Walls has a team-best 18 shots and nine shots on goal.

Aly Kilburg, Fr., D/MF, Loyola

Loyola freshman Aly Kilburg continued to impress as the Ramblers moved to 2-0 in MVC play after downing Indiana State by a final count of 4-0 on Saturday evening. A native of Park Ridge, Ill., Kilburg played 79 minutes as Loyola recorded its second clean sheet of the season and first of the conference season. Kilburg was part of a Rambler defensive unit that limited the Sycamores to just four total shots on the night.

DRAKE (5-7-0, 2-0-0 MVC)

Its Been Awhile

Drake beat Illinois State in back-to-back campaigns for the first time since 2004 and 2005. Last season, the Bulldogs rallied for a 3-2 win that clinched the MVC regular season title. Saturday night's win over the Redbirds is also the first home win in the series for Drake since back in 2004. That season Drake edged Illinois State, 1-0.



Back-to-Back Shutouts

Drake recorded back-to-back shutouts in its past two matches. It is the first time this has happened since the 2015 season when that squad beat Kansas State, 1-0 and then battled UNI to a scoreless draw.

Battle of the Unbeatens

Drake visits Loyola Oct. 6 for its next match. The Bulldogs and the Ramblers along with Evansville are at the top of the Missouri Valley Conference standings with 2-0 records in league play. The meeting at Loyola Soccer Park will be the 14th all-time in the head-to-head series.

EVANSVILLE (4-7-1, 2-0-0 MVC)

A Force In Goal

Coming off earning Missouri Valley Conference Defensive Player of the Week honors a week ago, sophomore goalkeeper Michaela Till registered her second-straight shutout in a 1-0 win over Valparaiso. Recording eight saves in the match, Till helped keep the Crusaders off the board in the 81st minute with a save on a Valparaiso penalty kick. The sophomore has kept the opponent off the scoreboard for the last 247 minutes, the longest streak since Evansville went 643 minutes without conceding a goal from September 12 to 28, 2014. Till's eight saves increased her season total to 62, good for fourth in the MVC and 42nd in the nation.



Back-to-Back

With Evansville's 1-0 victory over Valparaiso, the Aces opened the Missouri Valley Conference season 2-0. The two wins to open MVC play mark the fourth time in the past 10 seasons that UE has picked up a pair of wins to begin conference action.

Home Sweet Home

Evansville has found success this season playing at Arad McCutchan Stadium where the Aces have a 3-2-1 record. Since August 30, The Aces have reeled off a 3-0-1 mark at home, including wins over Tennessee Tech, Indiana State, and Valparaiso. Through six home games, UE has matched its home win total from last season with three victories at Arad McCutchan Stadium.

Smith Ranked at No. 19 in the Nation in Total Saves

Junior goalkeeper Haley Smith is ranked in the top 20 for total saves so far this season according to the Sept. 30 NCAA D-I Soccer Stats with 68 saves. Smith has won two MVC Defensive Player of the Week awards this year and her 225 career saves rank her third in Illinois State history.

INDIANA STATE (6-5-2, 0-2-0 MVC)

Road Tested, Road Approved

Of Indiana State's six victories so far this season, four have come on the road. The Sycamores went undefeated in four consecutive road contests earlier this season for the first time in the history of the program. The Sycamores' four road wins are the most for the program since 2012. The Indiana State school record of five road victories in one season was set back in 2006. The Sycamores next road chance comes on Saturday, October 6 at Missouri State.



Katie Wells -- Owing The Sycamore Record Book

Senior Katie Wells, an Indianapolis (Warren Central HS) native currently ranks second best in school history with 56 career points scored and second all-time with 0.86 points scored per match. Her 19 career goals are tied for third most in school history. She is only 14 points off Laura Podolski's school record for career points scored. With her next goal, she will tie Maddie Orf for second all-time in career goals scored and is only six behind the school record, currently held by Lauren Podolski. She also owns 18 career assists which is second-best on the ISU career chart and only two behind Podolski for a share of the school record. Wells is vying to become just the third Sycamore in program history to record at least 20 career goals scored. Additionally her 52 career shots on goal are the fourth most ever at ISU.

Senior Jenna Szczesny scored a pair of goals in the victory, while juniors Madison Laudeman and Aleksa Tataryn each recorded single tallies. The Maroon & Gold held the Sycamores to only four shots en route to recording their second clean sheet of the season.



Jenna Jumping Up The Charts

As noted above, Jenna Szczesny found the back of the net twice in Loyola's victory over Indiana State. The two goals brought Szczesny's career total to 28, a mark which ranks second all-time at Loyola behind only Cynthia Morote-Ariza, who racked up 45 goals during her four-year stay in Rogers Park. Szczesny is currently tied for the MVC lead with a team-high seven goals scored.

Senior Moment

Loyola and Drake will face off on Saturday night in a clash of MVC unbeaten at Loyola Soccer Park. The Ramblers will honor their seven graduating seniors in a special pregame ceremony prior to the 7 p.m. kickoff against the Bulldogs. In three-plus seasons, Loyola's senior class has accounted for 32 victories.
