MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Karlie Taylor, Jr., OH, UNI
 UNI's Karlie Taylor recorded 61 kills and 42 digs in the Panthers three victories over Evansville, Southern Illinois, and Missouri State last week. During the Monday match against Evansville Taylor recorded 20 kills and an attack percentage of .447. Defensively the junior outside hitter added eight digs and a block assist. Friday, at Southern Illinois, Taylor finished with 25 kills, one assist, a .442 attack percentage and 15 digs. Taylor finished the week against Missouri State with 16 kills and

a service ace to go along with her 19 digs, one solo block and four block assists. Taylor averaged 5.08 kills/set, 3.50 digs per/set and 5.46 points/set during the week.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Courtney Pence, Sr., L, Illinois State
 Pence helped pace a strong defensive effort by the Redbirds, as Illinois State held its two opponents for a combined .150 hitting percentage. She collected a match-high 19 and 21 digs against Loyola and Valparaiso as Illinois State took sole possession of second place in the MVC standings. Pence averaged 5.71 digs per set in just seven sets played this weekend to improve her season digs per set average to 5.68, which ranks among the top-15 in the nation. Pence also helped set up an offense that hit .254 against the Crusaders on Friday night, contributing

a season-high seven assists. Against Loyola, Pence continued to make an impact, serving up a season-high five aces, to contribute a season-high five points in the match as a libero.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Hannah Thompson, Fr., OH, Bradley
 Thompson averaged 2.86 kills per set and hit .262 in a pair of home wins. The outside hitter also averaged a team-best 5.71 digs per set, 0.29 aces and 0.57 blocks per set as she helped Bradley move up into third in The Valley standings. Thompson opened the week with her team-best 10th double-double of the year, collecting 12 kills, two aces and 18 digs in a four-set victory against Loyola. She capped the week with eight kills, match-high 22 digs and season-best four blocks in a sweep of Valparaiso. Thompson pushed her season dig total into sixth among Bradley freshman marks and now owns the 12th-best kill total by a Bradley frosh.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Sara Maddox (BRAD) - Maddox averaged 3.71 kills, 0.29 digs and 0.29 blocks per set, while hitting a team-best .353 for the week to help Bradley to home victories over Loyola (3-1) and Valparaiso (3-0) as the Braves took over sole possession of third-place in the Valley standings. In her first start in over a month, Maddox notched 12 kills, one dig and one block in a four-set victory over Loyola Friday. She followed it up with her best outing of the year as Maddox hit .480 and collected a season-high 14 kills in a sweep of Valparaiso as the Braves moved a full game ahead of the Crusaders into third in the Valley standings. Maddox helped Bradley hit .344 as a team vs. Valpo for BU's highest hitting percentage against a Valley opponent since 2006. She also helped Bradley improve to 16-4 overall (most wins since a 16-win season in 2005) and 6-2 in Valley play.

Cathryn Cheek (DU) - Led Drake on the week with 50 kills in three matches to help the Bulldogs to a 2-1 record ... hit .268 in those three matches for a 5.0 kills per set average ... also added 32 digs, the second most on the team during the week with eight blocks ... opened the week with a career-high 23 kills on 49 attempts to hit .408 in the four-set win over Indiana State ... also added 14 digs for a double-double in that ... at Missouri State, she registered 11 kills in three sets with nine digs ... closed the week with 16 kills in three sets at SIU along with nine digs ... in serve/receive, she committed just one error in 40 attempts.

Rachel Tam (UE) - Continuing her stellar junior season was Rachel Tam as she notched 5.00 kills per set as the Purple Aces went 1-1. In an impressive effort at UNI, Tam recorded 14 kills while hitting .238. She added three digs and a block assist against the Panthers. She followed that up with 16 kills and another impressive hitting effort, finishing at .324 in a win over Indiana State. Tam added four digs to go along with an ace and block assist.

Stef Jankiewicz (ILS) - Sophomore Stef Jankiewicz averaged 13.71 assists across seven sets in Illinois State's pair of wins over Valparaiso and Loyola Chicago this weekend to remain undefeated at Redbird Arena this season. The setter helped distribute an even-balanced offense that included four Redbird hitters averaging over three kills a set, while helping a pair of teammates to 16 kills apiece in separate matches, as the team hit .280 on the weekend behind 16.71 kills per set. She tallied the second-most assists of any setter in the conference this weekend with a season weekend-best of 96, of the team's 112, while a single-match season high 54 of those came in the Redbirds 3-1 win over Valpo. Jankiewicz moved into 12th all-time in career assists (2,207), while her season total of 758 ranks sixth overall among sophomores in program history.

Quinn Spieker (LUC) - Spieker put together another big week, averaging 3.71 kills, 2.29 digs, 0.29 assists and 0.14 aces per set, while hitting .189 (26-12-74), as Loyola suffered a pair of losses to two of the top teams in The Valley. The 6-foot-3 outside hitter has put up double-digit kills in seven straight matches and notched her sixth double-double of 2018 when she produced 15 kills and 11 digs, to go with two assists and an ace, at Bradley on October 12. Spieker then recorded 11 kills and five digs in a three-set loss at Illinois State. Over the last three matches, she is delivering 4.00 kills and 2.08 digs per set. This season, Spieker is contributing 3.30 kills, 2.30 digs, 0.25 assists and 0.22 blocks per set.

Laynie Dake (MSU) - Laynie Dake had a career-high 11 kills in each match last week, hitting .280 and averaging 2.75 kills and 1.00 blocks per set. Dake hit .450 with six blocks in Friday's sweep of Drake, and followed that with 11 more kills and two blocks Saturday against UNI.

Patience Brown (SIU) - Brown hit at a .485 clip with 17 kills to just one error in SIU's two matches over the weekend. The senior middle hitter hit .462 with six kills on 13 swings against Northern Iowa on Friday and followed by hitting .500 with 11 kills on 20 swings against Drake on Saturday. It marked the fifth time this season that the returning All-MVC second team selection has put down 10-plus kills and the fifth time in her two seasons at Southern that she has hit at or above .500 for a single match.

Kylee Macke (DU) - Helped Drake hold opponents to .173 hitting in three matches with a team-high 55 digs in three matches for a 5.5 digs per set average ... opened the week with 21 digs against Indiana State and had 16 or more digs in each of the next two matches ... successfully received 45 serves with no errors ... more than 30 percent of her digs and 30 percent of her serve receptions resulted in Drake kills.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - Last week, Nunez racked up 4.43 digs and 0.29 assists per set in contests at Bradley and Illinois State. In a four-set defeat at Bradley last Friday, Nunez accumulated 19 digs and an assist, then pitched in 12 digs, an assist and a service ace in a setback at Illinois State. The senior libero has now delivered double-digit digs in 18 of Loyola's 20 matches this season and is contributing 4.66 digs, 0.63 assists and 0.18 aces per set.

MacKenzie Irwin (MSU) - MacKenzie Irwin led the Bears in blocking in both matches last week, averaging 1.50 per set with 12 total stuffs. Irwin needed just three sets to record seven blocks on Friday against Drake, then had five blocks and a career-high four digs in Saturday's match with UNI. The senior helped the Bears hold their opposition to a .173 attack efficiency.

Kendyl Sorge (UNI) - Kendyl Soege continued her great play at the Libero position last week, recording 47 digs and 17 assists to help the Panthers remain undefeated in the Missouri Valley Conference. During Monday's match with Evansville, Sorge finished with 15 digs and 6 assists. Sorge was a stable force for the Panthers in a 3-1 victory over Southern Illinois where she recorded 14 digs, and she finished with 18 digs in a 3-2 victory over Missouri State on Saturday. Sorge averaged 3.9 digs per set over the week.

Keera Clarke (SIU) - Clarke averaged 4.14 digs per set at libero for SIU during its two matches over the weekend. The sophomore from Santa Monica, Calif. finished with 11 digs and an ace against Northern Iowa and followed with a career-best 18 digs against Drake on Saturday. Clarke has now tallied 10-plus digs in three-straight matches and five times overall this season.

Alondra Vazquez (UE) - Alondra Vazquez continued her latest stretch with two more solid outings last week. Vazquez averaged 3.33 kills and 3.17 digs per set in games against UNI and Indiana State. She finished with 11 kills, 9 digs and a pair of service aces in the road contest against the Panthers. She hit .310 in the contest. She followed that up with 9 kills, 10 digs and three more service aces in the 3-0 victory over the Sycamores.

Marissa Stockman (ILS) - Marissa Stockman tallied 19 kills behind a team-best .366 hitting percentage in Illinois State's pair of wins this weekend against Valparaiso and Loyola Chicago to keep Illinois State unbeaten at Redbird Arena this season. In Friday night's win versus the Crusaders, the freshman was one of four Redbirds to reach double-digit kills, contributing a season-high 11 kills, while hitting at a match-best .333 clip. Stockman followed up her performance with eight kills on Saturday, behind an impressive .412 hitting percentage. The middle blocker also stood firm at the net, combining for nine total blocks on the weekend, including a match- and team-high five against the Ramblers.

Lauren Caprini (LUC) - In two appearances last week, Caprini accounted for 1.86 digs and 0.29 service aces per set. The freshman libero totaled five digs, two assists, an ace and her first career kill in a tough, four-set loss at Bradley on October 12. She then went on to produce eight digs and an ace in a loss at Illinois State one night later. For the season, Caprini is averaging 2.22 digs, 0.37 aces and 0.25 assists per set.

Chloe Rear (MSU) - Chloe Rear continued to fill the box score with averages of 11.38 assists, 0.88 kills, 2.12 digs and 0.62 blocks per set in two matches last week. Friday, she handed out 40 assists and added three kills on .600 hitting, seven digs and four blocks in a sweep of Drake. Saturday against UNI, Rear had 51 assists and 10 digs for the double-double. She also had four kills and a block while reaching 50 assists for the fourth time in five matches.

Baylee Petersen (UNI) - Baylee Petersen finished the week with 19 digs and 2 assists. In limited action against Southern Illinois the freshman recorded 6 digs. On the road against a tough Missouri State team, Petersen recorded 13 digs and 2 assists to help the Panthers secure the 3-2 victory.

Perfection in League Play

UNI remains unbeaten in MVC action after another perfect week of league play, sitting at 9-0. The last time UNI opened MVC play 9-0, they went on to finish 18-0 in league play in 2011, which was the program's third straight 18-0 MVC campaign. The Panthers have only dropped five sets in league play, posting a 27-5 mark in conference sets.

Redbirds Keeping Pace

Illinois State is currently alone in second place in the conference standings with a 7-1 mark, suffering its lone loss in league play to unbeaten UNI. Illinois State's start to league play matches its best since 2014, when the Redbirds won the MVC outright with an 18-0 record.

On A Roll

Bradley took over sole possession of third-place in the MVC standings with a pair of wins over the weekend. The Braves have their most overall wins since 2005 (16) and have tied their highest win total since closing the 2002 season with a 19-12 record. The last time Bradley won at least six Valley games was 2013. The Braves have won six MVC contests in the first half of the league schedule for the first time since 2005 and just the fifth time since the Valley has had an 18-match regular-season schedule (1996). The only season in which Bradley won at least seven matches in the first half of Valley play was 1999 (7-2), during a season in which the Braves tied for second in the league standings at 14-4.

NCAA RPI Report

The latest edition of the NCAA RPI report has been released and The Valley has three teams featured in the top-60. UNI leads the league at No. 22, while Illinois State (No. 47), and Valparaiso (No. 60) are also among the nation's top-60. Four other teams rank in the Top 120 (Drake, Bradley, Missouri State and Loyola). As a conference, The Valley ranks eighth among 32 conferences.

Totally Tested

UNI's RPI sits No. 22 this week. The Panthers are one of only nine teams nationally to have seven matches against teams ranked in the Top 25 of the RPI, joining Stanford, Illinois, USC, Texas, Wisconsin, Nebraska, Creighton and Oregon. UNI is also one of only 20 teams nationally to have at least two Top 25 RPI wins. UNI's schedule is rated as the 14th toughest nationally.

Stokes Moving On Up

On Friday, Missouri State's 20th consecutive October victory also served as the 503rd in Melissa Stokes's career, tying her with former UNI coach Iradge Ahrabi-Fard for second all-time in total wins among MVC coaches. Stokes can move into second place all by herself with a win over Bradley on Friday.

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 11 leagues, including America East (2-0), American (1-0), Big South (3-0), Ivy (2-0), Metro Atlantic (2-0), Mid-Eastern (2-0), Northeast (3-0), Patriot (1-0), Summit (9-0), SWAC (5-0) and WAC (2-0).

The Valley has two wins over top-25 opponents this season as UNI topped #13 Creighton 3-0 and #5 Kentucky 3-2 in Los Angeles.

Power Five Wins

Top of the Class

The Valley has placed multiple teams in the NCAA Tournament 10 times in the last 12 years. Since 2007, The Valley has received 30 bids into the 64-team field, trailing only the Pac 12, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC, ACC & West Coast Conferences.

Non-Conference Success

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (55-57) and 2017 (61-66). The MVC is 80-48 (.625) in non-league play this season, which ranks second in that span. The Valley posted a league-best .756 non-conference win percentage in 2010.

The Panthers have wins over Creighton and Kentucky, while the Redbirds beat Coastal Carolina and Stony Brook. Valparaiso has the leagues fifth win, beating Cal State Bakersfield.

Panthers Elite Offense

UNI leads the MVC in both assists per set and kills per set so far this season. The Panthers rank top five nationally in both categories, sitting 4th overall in assists per set (14.0) and 4th in kills per set (14.89). Rachel Koop leads The Valley in assists per set and sits 6th nationally (11.72), while Karlie Taylor leads the league in attacks per set, kills per set and points per set, ranking 16th (12.01), 8th (4.78) and 12th (5.20) nationally in each category.

On the Mark

Junior Hannah Angeli has averaged 11.21 assists per set in Valley play and has helped Bradley boast a .217 hitting percentage on the year, which would rank as the team's best attack percentage since 2002 (.232). The Braves hit .344 in Saturday's sweep of Valparaiso for BU's most efficient outing against a Valley opponent since hitting .366 against Drake on Nov. 4, 2006. Angeli, an Omaha transfer, is already 10th in career assists at Bradley and is one of just two Braves to boast a career assists-per-set average of better than 10.00 (10.09), joining all-time assist leader Michelle Pack (11.07).



On A Roll

After suffering a pair of road losses, Bradley got back in the win column with a four-set victory over Loyola Friday and a sweep of Valparaiso to take over sole possession of third-place in the MVC standings. The Braves have their most overall wins since 2005 (16) and have tied their highest win total since closing the 2002 season with a 19-12 record. The last time Bradley won at least six Valley games was 2013. In addition, the Braves have won six MVC contests in the first half of the league schedule for the first time since 2005 and just the fifth time since the Valley has had an 18-match regular-season schedule (1996). The only season in which Bradley won at least seven matches in the first half of Valley play was 1999 (7-2), during a season in which the Braves tied for second in the league standings at 14-4.

And Then There Were Two

Senior Erica Haslag continues to leave her mark on the Bradley record book, moving into third in career kills at Bradley Friday with an 11-kill outing in the win against Loyola. Haslag passed Betsy Buckhold (1,407 career kills) in the outing against the Ramblers and the MVC's active career kills leader now has 1,428 career kills. Haslag is the only Brave to own 280 or more kills in all four seasons on The Hilltop. She currently ranks third in the Valley in kills per set (3.82) and is 10th in hitting percentage (.259), joining UNI's Piper Thomas as the only players to rank among the top 10 in the league in both kills per set and attack percentage.

Drake remains among the top-10 nationally in attacks per set at 39.56 attacks per set to rank sixth in the nation ... of Drake's 3,086 attacks this season, 23.5 percent have come from Cathryn Cheek while Grace Schofield has accounted for 17.4 percent ... five other Bulldogs have 300 or more attacks this season to each account for more than 10 percent.

Calm Week Ahead

After playing five matches in the last nine days, the Bulldogs have just one match this week when they travel to UNI to begin the second half of the MVC season. The Bulldogs navigated the first half of the MVC season with a 5-4 record, their second-most wins through the first half of the MVC season since 2010. Last season, the Bulldogs started the MVC season 7-2 and finished with a 12-6 mark.

Home Sweet Home

Illinois State picked up a pair of wins this weekend against Valparaiso and Loyola Chicago to improve to 4-0 at Redbird Arena this season. The Redbirds are historically known for playing well at their home facility, as Illinois State has posted a winning record in Normal in seven of the last eight seasons, including a perfect 10-0 mark in 2014. Illinois State is currently in the middle of a five-match home stretch, the longest of its kind in at least a decade.



Sets Up

Stef Jankiewicz averaged 13.71 assists across seven sets in Illinois State's pair of wins this weekend. The setter helped distribute an even-balanced offense that included four Redbird hitters averaging over three kills a set, while helping a pair of teammates to 16 kills apiece in separate matches, as the team hit .280 on the weekend behind 16.71 kills per set. She tallied the second-most assists of any setter in the conference this weekend with a season weekend-best of 96, of the team's 112, while a single-match season high 54 of those came in the Redbirds 3-1 win over Valpo. Jankiewicz moved into 12th all-time in career assists (2,207), while her season total of 758 ranks sixth overall among sophomores in program history.

Halfway There

At the conclusion of Illinois State's home stand this week, the Redbirds will be at the midway point of the Missouri Valley Conference slate. The Redbirds are currently alone in second place in the conference standings with a 7-1 mark, suffering its lone loss in league play to unbeaten UNI. Illinois State's start to league play matches its best since 2014, when the Redbirds won the MVC outright, and the 2013 season.
