MVC Offensive Player of the Week



Lucca Lacerda, Sr., F, Valparaiso

Lacerda scored three goals and had one assist over two matches this week including a brace to lift Valpo to a 2-0 Missouri Valley Conference victory at Bradley on Saturday night. His seven-point week propelled Valpo to a perfect 2-0-0 fall break road trip. Lacerda claimed the team lead in goals (4), points (9) and game-winning goals (2) after becoming the first Valpo player with a brace this season. He started his impressive week with a goal and an assist

in a 2-1 midweek victory over Eastern Illinois. Lacerda joins Central Arkansas' Niklas Brodacki as the only MVC players with a brace in conference play this season. Valpo won back-to-back games for the first time this season.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week



Grant Stoneman, Sr., D, Loyola

Stoneman anchored the Loyola back line to two shutouts and helped hold opponents to just one shot on goal. The senior captain was featured for the full 90 minutes, and his efforts helped the Ramblers post three straight shutouts for the first time this season. Stoneman's stout play on defense helped hold opponents to a combined nine shots in this week's reporting period, including allowing just five to No. 25 Missouri State in Loyola's 1-0 win over the Bears on Oct. 13 - a win that put Loyola in first place in the MVC.

Other Notable Performances: Simon Waever (UE); Nacho Miras (VALPO)

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Adam Snow (UE) - In a pair of wins last week, sophomore Adam Snow returned to the lineup and helped push the Purple Aces to an important victory. Against Drake on Saturday evening, Snow received a cross from junior Simon Waever that looped to just inside the six and finished it into the back of the net, putting Evansville in front 2-1 with just 1:41 left in the match. The Florence, Ky. native recorded two shots in the match with both coming on-goal, scoring the game-winning goal in the 89th minute.

Chase Wright (LUC) - Chase Wright found a good time to score his first collegiate goal in Loyola's 1-0 win over No. 25 Missouri State on Saturday (Oct. 13). The junior knocked the ball in off a cross in the second half that would end up being the game-winning goal in Loyola's big win. Wright also notched a shot on goal in Loyola's 1-0 win vs. Xavier (Oct. 9), giving him an SOG in both Loyola matches this week. Wright's goal propelled Loyola to victory on Saturday, a win that put his team in first place and in the driver's seat to win the regular season MVC championship.

Simone Waever (UE) - Helping the Aces to a 2-0 record this week, junior Simon Waever continued to prove himself in the attacking and defensive thirds. In a 1-0 win over Lipscomb, Waever helped Evansville shutout a Bisons team that came into the match averaging 1.5 goals per match and had scored at least a goal in six-straight matches, while also recording a pair of shots with one on-goal. On Saturday evening, Waever powered the Aces to the win, assisting both of Evansville's goals in UE's 2-1 victory over Drake. Waever has amassed five assists on the season, placing the Holte, Denmark native in a tie for second in the Missouri Valley Conference.

Nacho Miras (VALPO) - Miras put together a 2-0-0 record in goal this week, accumulating five saves over the two matches. After a midweek win over Eastern Illinois, Miras turned in his fourth shutout of the season and the fifth of his collegiate career on Saturday night at Bradley. The 2-0 win in Peoria marked the fifth time Valpo has blanked the opposition in 2018. Miras has played every minute of Valpo's three conference fixtures, including a double-overtime tie against Loyola, and has permitted just one goal over those three Valley games. The clean sheet against Bradley was his second such performance against a Valley opponent in a seven-day span.

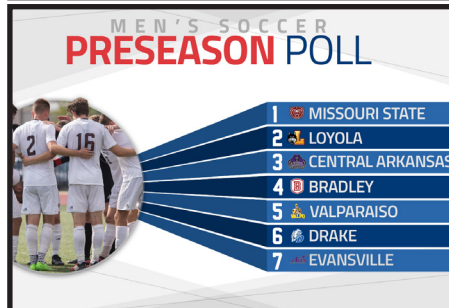

MVC SOCCER NOTES

Ramblin' On

Since starting the season with a 1-3 record, Loyola has posted a 5-1-2 record and holds an RPI of 42 entering this week's action. Saturday's win over Missouri State put the Ramblers atop the MVC standings over the previously unbeaten Bears. It was the first win for the Ramblers against a United Soccer Coaches Top-25 team since their 2016 victory over No. 12 Utah Valley. Loyola has played the 27th toughest schedule in the nation this season.

Tourney Spots Secure

Helped by a Bradley loss on Saturday, Loyola and Missouri State have each officially earned a spot in the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament which will be held November 7, 9 and 11 at the University of Evansville. The top six teams in the standings will advance to the league tournament.

Home Success

In league play, the home team has posted a 7-2-3 mark on their own pitch. The lone home defeats were by Bradley to Loyola and Valparaiso. Overall this season, Missouri State (5-0-1), Central Arkansas (4-1-1) and Evansville (3-1-3) have been the best at home this season.

NCAA RPI Report

The latest NCAA RPI report has been released and The Valley has three teams featured in the top-100. Loyola leads the league at No. 42, while Missouri State (No. 67) and Drake (No. 98) are also among the nation's top-100. The MVC ranks 12th among 24 conferences.

Earning a Result

Evansville's five draws this season are the second-most in a season in program history. The program record is six when the Aces amassed a 9-5-6 record in 1979. Currently, the Aces are tied with Colgate, Saint Louis and Xavier for the second most ties nationally with five, Cal State Fullerton leads the nation with six draws (6-3-6).

National Team of the Week

Loyola's Grant Stoneman and Valparaiso's Lucca Lacerda each earned a spot on this week's College Soccer News National Team of the Week. Stoneman anchored the Ramblers' back line during a pair of shutouts, while Lacerda scored the game-winner against Eastern Illinois and added two more goals in a win at Bradley.

Early and Often

The Missouri State offense has outscored its opponents early and often this season. The Bears hold a 10-1 advantage in goals scored in the first half this season. The only goal MSU has allowed in the first half came in the first minute of a 4-1 win over UMKC in Springfield on Sept. 15.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against eight leagues in non-conference play (American, Atlantic Sun, Horizon, Ivy, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast and WAC) and at least a .500 mark against the Big East, Big West and Southern.

Against the 2017 NCAA Field

The Valley has won four matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. Drake beat Butler and UIC, while Missouri State beat Omaha and Evansville beat Lipscomb. The MVC sits 4-5-5 against NCAA tourney teams from a year ago with two more chances on the schedule.

Top 25 Success

The Valley holds a 4-3 record against Top 25 teams this season. The four Top 25 wins is the most during a season since Valley teams posted a 5-8-1 record vs. the Top 25 during the 2013 season.

Scoring Drought

Since Bradley's 2-1, overtime victory Sept. 14 at Purdue Fort Wayne extended the team's overall unbeaten streak to 12 games, the Braves have gone into a severe scoring drought ... The Braves have managed just one goal, a Gerit Wintermeyer penalty kick Sept. 29 versus Loyola Chicago, in their last five matches ... The scoring drought has coincided with an injury bug that bit the Braves – the team's second-leading scorer, Alex Ciaramitaro, went down with a season-ending knee injury during the Purdue Fort Wayne match, while 2017 scoring leader, Roman Schindler, has played only 93 minutes in two games during the drought.



Warming's Return

Bradley will close its brief, 2-game home stand by hosting Omaha in non-conference action Tuesday night at Shea Stadium ... Although Bob Warming is in his first year as Mavericks head coach, he is a familiar face on Bradley's opposing sideline ... Warming served as the head coach of Bradley's former Missouri Valley Conference rival Creighton from 1990-94 and 2001-09, facing the Braves 20 times in his two stints with the Bluejays.

Tourney Chase

Though Bradley will be searching for its first MVC win of the season Saturday night at Drake, the Braves remain four points out of the 3-way tie for fourth in the league standings ... As Bradley chases one of the league's six postseason tourney slots, the Braves still must face two of the three teams in the fourth-place log jam, Saturday at Drake and Nov. 3 at home versus Evansville ... Bradley likely will need to win both matches to secure its spot in the MVC Tournament.
