MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Erica Haslag, Sr., OH, Bradley

Haslag had a pair of 20-kill outings, averaging 4.80 kills per set while boasting a .293 attack percentage to help Bradley pull out back-to-back five-set road wins. She also averaged a team-best 4.95 points per set as the Braves locked up third in the MVC regular-season standings to mark the best finish in program history since a third-place showing in 2001. Haslag had 20 kills, two digs and a block in Friday's five-set win at Valparaiso, tallying five of her match-high 20 kills in the deciding fifth set. She followed that up by matching her season high with 28 kills to help Bradley rally from two-sets-to-none deficit for a five-set win at Loyola. She hit .386 in the contest and also added two digs and a pair of blocks. After the Braves dropped the first two sets, Haslag notched 16 kills in the final three frames and hit .481 (16-3-27) in those sets to help Bradley to its fifth MVC road victory of the year. Haslag also became the 17th player in MVC history to reach 1,600 career kills in Saturday's outing at Loyola as she reached 20 kills for the fifth time in the last six matches.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Courtney Pence, Sr., L, Illinois State

Courtney Pence continued to pace the Redbird defense this weekend in Illinois State's pair of wins at Loyola Chicago and Valparaiso, helping hold Redbird opponents to a combined .118 hitting percentage. With her fourth dig against the Ramblers on Friday night, Pence surpassed UNI's Ellie Blankenship's (2007-10) career digs mark in the Valley record book, making the senior libero the MVC's all-time career digs leader. She finished with 12 against the Ramblers, before tallying 31 against the Crusaders on Saturday night, to average 6.14 digs per set for the weekend. Pence's guidance in the back row against Loyola Chicago helped the Redbirds hold the Ramblers to below .100 hitting (.097). Her 31 digs against Valparaiso marked the

fifth time this season that the Springfield, Illinois, native has notched over 30 digs in a four-set match. After her 43-dig performance on the weekend, Pence now ranks sixth all-time in NCAA career dig history.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Amelia Flynn, Fr., OH, Missouri State

Amelia Flynn broke her own MSU freshman single-match record with 27 kills in Saturday's win at Drake, and averaged 5.14 kills on .313 hitting, 2.29 digs, 0.71 blocks and 5.57 points per set in two matches. Flynn, who already shared the freshman kills record at 26 with Lily Johnson and Vanessa Wouters, needed just four sets at Drake to establish the new record, which marked the highest total in a four-set match for any player at MSU since 1998. She hit .328 against the Bulldogs and added 12 digs and four blocks, completing her 11th double-double of the season. Friday, Flynn hit .273 with a team-high nine kills at UNI.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Cathryn Cheek (DU) - Led Drake with 28 kills in a pair of matches to average 4.0 kills per set ... extended her streak of matches in double-figure kills to 13 ... also added a team-high 24 digs on the week and a pair of blocks ... opened the week with 15 kills on 35 attempts against SIU and added 12 digs and two aces ... followed that with 13 kills and 12 digs against Missouri State.

Rachel Tam (UE) - It was just another day at the office for Rachel Tam as she recorded 21 kills and 16 digs at Indiana State on Friday. Her 16 digs marked a season high and was just three off of her career mark of 19, set at Jacksonville State in 2016. She also added three block assists, her top mark since recording four against Loyola in September.

Kaylee Martin (ILS) - Kaylee Martin helped anchor Illinois State's big offensive weekend, aiding in a pair of wins at Loyola Chicago and Valparaiso. The newcomer hit .477, notching a team-high 23 kills to average an outstanding 3.29 kills per set, helping the Redbirds hit .332 as a team - compared to their opponents' hitting percentage of .118. Martin came off of the bench in both matches and helped pace Illinois State's offense, starting with a five-kill performance, hitting .417, on Friday night against the Ramblers. She also added a trio of block and four digs in the Redbirds' 14th sweep of the season. Martin continued to soar on Saturday, contributing a match-high 18 kills on 32 total attempts, hitting an impressive .500 in the match. She added a service ace and pair of blocks for a team-high 20.0 total points. Martin's serve was key this weekend, as the Redbirds were able to score 12 points alone against Loyola Chicago with the sophomore behind the service line, including a 6-0 run in the second set and 4-0 run in the third against the Ramblers. As a team, Illinois State ranks fourth in point scoring (.49.45%), as the Redbirds score nearly 50 percent of their points when serving.

Cassie Kawa (INS) - Cassie Kawa led Indiana State to an undefeated record over the week for the first time this season as her 13 kills led the Sycamores to a victory over Evansville. Kawa's .343 hitting percentage led Indiana State and she posted a solo block with three block assists in the match. The Lethbridge, Alberta native also added three digs to her effort in the thrilling five-set win.

Morgan Gresham (LUC) - Gresham put together arguably her best week of the season, averaging 3.25 kills and 3.50 digs per set, while hitting .228 (26-8-79), in a pair of home league matches last week. The 6-foot-1 outside hitter totaled seven kills, six digs and an ace in a loss to Illinois State November 9, but then erupted for a career-best 19 kills, to go with 22 digs, one short of equaling a career high, in a heartbreaking five-set loss to Bradley on Senior Night the following evening. Gresham has notched four double-doubles this season and for the year is averaging 2.03 kills and 2.20 digs per set as Loyola heads into the final week of the regular season with a chance to clinch its first MVC Championship berth since 2016.

Piper Thomas (UNI) - Piper Thomas recorded two more matches with an attack percentage over .300 last week, totaling 20 matches above that mark this season. Thomas finished the week with 23 kills and a .355 attack percentage while recording two solo blocks and nine block assists. In Friday's match against Missouri State the senior middle hitter finished with 13 kills on 22 total attacks for a .409 attack percentage. Thomas added a solo block and 4 block assists against Missouri State. Thomas performed well in her final match in the McLeod Center on senior night, recording 10 kills and a .304 attack percentage. Thomas added another solo block to extend her UNI record to 94 career solo blocks and added five block assists.

Rachel Maguire (SIU) - Rachel Maguire led the Salukis in kills (2.67/set) and finished second on the team in digs (2.83/set) in SIU's final two road matches of the 2018 season. The Bloomington, Ill. native put down a team-best nine kills at Drake on Friday. She also added six digs, a block and an ace. She followed with seven kills and 11 digs- which were her most digs in a match since Aug. 25.

Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD) - Rosado averaged 5.70 digs per set in a pair of five-set road wins as she helped Bradley look up third in the Missouri Valley Conference standings for the best league finish for the Braves since 2001. She opened the weekend with a match-high 29 digs in a five-set win at Valparaiso, including 12 digs in the pivotal third set win for Bradley. Rosado capped the weekend with a match-high 28 digs in Saturday's five-set win at Loyola and also collected an ace and three assists against the Ramblers. She broke her own school record for digs in a season set last year and now owns the 14th-best season dig total (645) in Valley history. The two road wins, pushed Bradley's Valley road win total to five for the most since 2002.

Jade York (INS) - Jade York tallied 25 total digs in Indiana State's 3-2 thrilling win over Evansville last weekend, leading the Sycamores to an undefeated week for the first time this season. Her 25 digs led all players in the match and she also added four assists to her credit as Indiana State prevented a season sweep at the hands of the Purple Aces.

Delilah Wolf (LUC) - Wolf put up 2.50 digs and 0.75 blocks per set last week in a pair of matches for the Ramblers, who have tripled their win total from all of 2017 (5). The junior setter fell a dig shy of a double-double against Illinois State November 9, accumulating 27 assists and nine digs. In Loyola's home finale, a crushing 3-2 loss to Bradley, Wolf notched her seventh double-double of 2018, collecting 47 assists and 11 digs, along with six blocks, which matched a season high. In 28 matches this season, Wolf is accounting for 10.66 assists, 2.25 digs, 0.60 kills, 0.70 blocks and 0.16 aces per set.

Emily Butters (MSU) - Emily Butters averaged 5.14 digs per set and reached several career milestones in two road matches last week. Butters had 15 digs in three sets Friday at UNI, and followed that with 21 digs Saturday at Drake, her 50th career match with 20 or more. Butters also played in her 500th consecutive set against the Bulldogs, the 15th player in NCAA history to do that, and moved into the NCAA's career top 25 with 2,417 digs.

Karlie Taylor (UNI) - Junior Karlie Taylor recorded 28 digs and three block assists in two matches last week against MVC opponents. Taylor led the Panthers in digs against the Bears of Missouri State, recording 12 and a block assists. Saturday Taylor again led the Panthers in digs, finishing with 16 and added two block assists. Along with her defensive stats Taylor recorded 29 kills on the week.

Keera Clarke (SIU) - Clarke led the Saluki defensive efforts over the weekend with a 4.33 digs per set average and totaled 26 digs. The Santa Monica, Calif. native dug out nine balls at Drake and followed with her 11th double-digit dig output of the season at Northern Iowa. The sophomore libero finished with a team-high 17 digs and added two assists versus the Panthers.

Hannah Thompson (BRAD) - Thompson turned in two more double-doubles last week, averaging 2.50 kills, 0.50 assists, 0.20 aces and 4.10 digs per set in a pair of road victories, helping Bradley lock up third in the MVC regular-season standings. She had 13 kills, three assists, one ace, 28 digs and two blocks in a five-set victory at Valparaiso. The next night, Thompson tallied 12 kills, two assists, one ace, 13 digs and a block in another five-set road win at Loyola. Thompson now owns 18 double-double on the year, which is tied for the eighth best season total in school history. She also broke the Bradley freshman season kills record Saturday against Loyola, which had stood since 2000 as she helped the Braves to their fifth Valley road victory (most since 2002) and best conference finish since 2001. Thompson is now the second player in school history with 330 kills and 450 or more digs in a season, joining Stacey Besjak (1985) and her 455 digs this season rank 10th among Bradley season marks. In fact, her 455 digs this season are the most by a Brave other than a libero since 1985.

Caitlyn Smith (DU) - Was Drake's primary setter on the week and racked up 88 assists and 23 digs ... averaged 12.57 assists per set ... opened the week with 42 assists in three sets against SIU and then had a career-high 46 assists against Missouri State ... also had double-doubles in both matches with 11 digs against SIU and 12 against MSU ... contributed two blocks in the Missouri State contest. .

Marissa Stockman (ILS) - Marissa Stockman hit a team-high .514 this weekend in Illinois State's pair of wins at Loyola Chicago and Valparaiso. The freshman registered 20 kills, averaging 2.86 kills per set, while committing just a single error. In Friday's sweep of the Ramblers, Stockman turned in a match-high 12 kills on 21 total attempts, hitting .571 in the match. She also contributed a dig and seven blocks - the second-most stuffs in a single match by the newcomer. Stockman continued to make an impact on Saturday, notching eight kills on .438 hitting against the Crusaders, with a career-high three digs. The freshman's 1.43 blocks per set marks a weekend-best performance at the net since the first weekend of October.

Lauren Caprini (LUC) - Caprini accounted for 0.86 digs, 0.29 assists and 0.14 aces per set in a pair of Valley matches last week. The 5-foot-7 libero produced two digs and a pair of assists in a 3-0 setback versus Illinois State to open the week, and managed four digs and a service ace, her first in nearly a month, in a tough-luck, five-set loss to Bradley. Caprini is contributing 2.02 digs, 0.28 aces and 0.24 assists per set in her rookie campaign.

Tourney Outlook

UNI, Illinois State, Bradley, Valparaiso and Missouri State have each secured a spot in the six-team MVC Volleyball Tournament which will be held at Missouri State November 22-24. Loyola currently occupies the final spot in the tournament race with a week remaining during the regular season. Drake is also alive in the race for a conference tourney spot.

Battle for Final Spot

Heading into the final weekend of the regular season, Loyola controls its own destiny as it looks to secure its first berth to the Missouri Valley Conference Championship since 2016. In its first five years in The Valley, Loyola has earned a spot in the conference tournament just twice (2015, 2016).

Drake can earn the No. 6 seed with wins over Indiana State and Evansville and a Loyola loss to Missouri State.

Championship Up for Grabs

The regular season MVC title is still up for grabs heading into the final weekend of action. Illinois State can lock up at least a share of the MVC crown with a win over Bradley Friday. UNI can also earn a shared title with wins over Evansville and Indiana State. UNI would hold the tiebreaker for seeding at the MVC Tournament if both teams win their remaining contests. ISU's last title was in 2014, while UNI's was in 2011.

Third Place Braves

Bradley pulled out five-set road wins at Valparaiso and Loyola last weekend to lock up third place in the MVC regular season standings. The third-place finish is the best league showing for the Braves since 2001 (3rd) and Bradley is the first team in league history to finish among the top three in the conference standings a year removed from a last-place finish.

New Career Digs Queen

Illinois State senior Courtney Pence became the all-time MVC career digs leader with her fourth dig in Illinois State's 3-0 sweep of Loyola Friday. Pence currently ranks sixth (2,696) all-time in NCAA Division I volleyball history in the career category. She needs just 57 digs to jump into fourth all-time, passing Valparaiso's Taylor Root (2009-12). When she does so, she will become the highest-ranking player who played her entire career in the 25-point era.

Another Semifinal for UNI

UNI has secured the No. 1 or 2 seed for the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. By earning the No. 1 or 2 seed, UNI is guaranteed spot in the semifinals with a bye. As a result, this marks the 34th straight MVC Tournament semifinal appearance for the Panthers. UNI's streak of playing each year in the MVC Tournament semifinals began in 1985.

NCAA RPI Report

The latest edition of the NCAA RPI report has been released and The Valley has three teams featured in the top-75. UNI leads the league at No. 16, while Illinois State (No. 30) and Valparaiso (No. 72) are also among the nation's top-75. Four other teams rank in the Top 130 (Bradley, Missouri State, Drake and Loyola). As a conference, The Valley ranks eighth among 32 conferences.

Illinois State's Courtney Pence has been named a finalist for the 2018 Senior CLASS Award. Pence is among 10 NCAA Division I candidates in volleyball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence - community, classroom, character and competition.

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 11 leagues, including America East (2-0), American (1-0), Big South (3-0), Ivy (2-0), Metro Atlantic (2-0), Mid-Eastern (2-0), Northeast (3-0), Patriot (1-0), Summit (9-0), SWAC (5-0) and WAC (2-0).

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 20 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American, A10, Atlantic Sun, Big East, Big South, Horizon, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, MEAC, Mountain West, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southland, Summit, Sun Belt, SWAC and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another three (Big Sky, Conference USA and Southern) through the non-conference season.

Top-25 Victories

The Valley has two wins over top-25 opponents this season as UNI topped #13 Creighton 3-0 and #5 Kentucky 3-2 in Los Angeles.

Power Five Wins

The Valley has four wins over Power Five programs this season. UNI beat Indiana and Kentucky, Missouri State beat Texas A&M and Illinois State beat Auburn.

Top of the Class

The Valley has placed multiple teams in the NCAA Tournament 10 times in the last 12 years. Since 2007, The Valley has received 30 bids into the 64-team field, trailing only the Pac 12, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC, ACC & West Coast Conferences.

Non-Conference Success

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (55-57) and 2017 (61-66). The MVC is 81-49 (.623) in non-league play this season, which ranks second in that span. The Valley posted a league-best .756 non-conference win percentage in 2010.

Against 2017 NCAA Field

The Valley has won five matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI and Illinois State lead the conference with a pair of wins over participants in the 2017 NCAA tourney. The Panthers have wins over Creighton and Kentucky, while the Redbirds beat Coastal Carolina and Stony Brook. Valpo has the MVC's fifth win, beating Cal State Bakersfield.

Panthers Elite Offense

UNI leads the MVC in both assists per set and kills per set so far this season. The Panthers rank top 5 nationally in both categories, sitting 3rd overall in assists per set (13.94) and 4th in kills per set (14.83). Rachel Koop leads The Valley in assists per set and sits 5th nationally (11.76), while Karlie Taylor leads the league in attacks per set, kills per set and points per set, ranking 17th (12.04), 10th (4.69) and 13th (5.10) nationally in each category.

The Valley Digs Deep

Currently, the MVC has six teams ranking Top 40 nationally in digs per set, including Bradley leading the MVC with 19.36 per set.

The Valley has led the nation in digs per set three times in the last four seasons (Illinois State in 2014, UNI in 2016 and Valparaiso in 2017).

BRADLEY (22-7, 12-5 MVC)

Third Place

Bradley pulled out five-set road wins at Valparaiso and Loyola last weekend to lock up third place in the MVC regular season standings. The third-place finish is the best league showing for the Braves since 2001 (3rd) and Bradley is the first team in league history to finish among the top three in the conference standings a year removed from a last-place finish. In fact, the 2018 Braves are just the third team in Valley history to have a nine-win improvement in conference play and just the second since the Valley went to an 18-game conference schedule in 1996. The 1999 Bradley team followed up a 4-14 campaign in 1998 (9th) with a 14-4 conference mark to tie for second. The 1994 Drake squad was 14-6 (3rd) in Valley play after a 3-13 conference season (8th) in 1993.



Heating Up

Senior Erica Haslag has collected 20 or more kills in five of the last six matches and is averaging 5.23 kills per set with a .278 attack percentage during that stretch. Haslag became the 17th player in Valley history to reach 1,600 career kills Saturday, matching a season-best with 28 kills in a five-set win at Loyola. She enters the final home match of her career 17th in Valley history and third all-time at Bradley with 1,606 career kills, needing 17 kills to pass Ashley Rosch (Illinois State), Bobbi Becker (UNI) and Leah Ratzlaff (Creighton) for 14th in MVC history. Haslag's 461 kills this season rank as the eighth-best season total in Bradley history and she has joined Lindsay Stalzer and Jenny Pavalas as the only players in school history to have two seasons with 460 or more kills.

Can You Dig It?

Senior libero Yavianliz Rosado broke her own school season digs record set last year, pushing her season total to a league-best 645 digs with a 28-dig effort in Saturday's five-set win at Loyola. Rosado's 645 digs rank as the 14th-best season total in Valley history and surpassed her previous school record of 644 digs set last year. She has averaged 7.00 digs per set over the last four matches and has helped Bradley to the second-best digs per set average (19.36) in school history. Rosado has climbed into seventh in career digs at Bradley (1,289) despite playing just 61 matches as a Brave. Freshman Hannah Thompson has also helped highlight Bradley's defensive efforts with her 455 digs this season ranking as the 10th best season total in school history and most by a Brave other than a libero since 1985. Thompson joins Stacey Besjak as the only players in program history to collect 330 kills and 450 or more digs in a season and is the first Valley player with those numbers since UNI's Amy Braun in 2012.

History Made

With her fourth dig against the Loyola Chicago Ramblers on Friday night (Nov. 9), Courtney Pence surpassed UNI's Ellie Blankenship's (2007-10) career digs mark in the Valley record book, making the senior libero the MVC's all-time career digs leader. Pence currently ranks sixth (2,696) all-time in NCAA Division I volleyball history in the career category. She needs just 57 digs to jump into fourth all-time, passing Valparaiso's Taylor Root (2009-12). When she does so, she will become the highest-ranking player who played her entire career in the 25-point era.



Easy as 1-2-3

Illinois State's sweep of Loyola Chicago on Friday night marked the Redbirds' 14th three-set win of the season. The last time that the Redbirds had 14 sweeps at this point of the season, dates back to 2014, when Illinois State had swept 15 opponents in its first 29 matches. Nine of Illinois State's 14 straight-set victories this season have come during MVC play – the most since 2014 – when the Redbirds had 12 sweeps at this point in the conference slate.

One and Done

Illinois State has posted a 22-1 record this season when opening a match with a victory in the first set. The Redbirds' one loss came against then-No. 6 Wisconsin, when Illinois State fell in four. Additionally, the Redbirds have come back to win after being down 0-1 on two occasions – versus Furman and Tulsa.
