MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Lexi Varga, Sr., OH, Illinois State

Lexi Varga reached double-digit kills in both of Illinois State's wins this weekend over Drake and No. 25 UNI. She tallied a team-high 27 kills on the weekend, averaging 3.38 kills per set, while also contributing four assists and four blocks, for a team-high 30.0 total points. The senior led the Redbirds in Saturday's win against the Panthers, contributing 16 kills on .318 hitting to contribute a team-high 17.5 points, making it the third match this season Varga has led the team in kills against nationally-ranked opponents. Varga also contributed 11 kills in Friday night's sweep of Drake, aiding in Illinois State's season-high attack percentage of .392.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Yavianliz Rosado, Sr., L, Bradley

Rosado collected 8.86 digs per set and helped Bradley earn its first 20-win season in nearly two decades in addition to locking up the team's first MVC Tournament appearance since 2013. She also boasted a perfect serve receive percentage for the week, in addition to averaging 0.86 assists and 0.14 aces per set. Rosado collected 20 digs and four assists Friday against 25th-ranked UNI before turning a record-setting performance Saturday against Drake. She turned in a school single-match record 42 digs against the Bulldogs to break Briony Hammet's school record of 38 digs which had stood since 2005. In addition to tying for the ninth-best single-match total in MVC history, Rosado's 42-dig effort was just the third performance in league history of 42 digs or more in a four-set match. Her 42 digs tied for the third-most in the country this season and matched the highest dig total in the country in a four-setter in 2018 as she helped Bradley to the highest team dig total (126) in the nation this fall.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Amelia Flynn, Fr., OH, Missouri State

Amelia Flynn averaged 3.64 kills, 4.09 digs and 4.09 points per set in three MSU victories last week. Flynn began the week with 11 kills, 16 digs and three blocks in Monday's 3-1 win at Valpo. Friday, the freshman had eight kills and career-high 18 digs in a home sweep of Evansville, and she concluded the week with 21 kills on .302 hitting against Indiana State, adding 11 digs for her 10th double-double of the season. Flynn also had four assists and two aces on the week while hitting .245 from the outside.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Erica Haslag (BRAD) - Haslag averaged 5.14 kills, 0.57 digs, 0.43 blocks and 5.36 points per set as she helped Bradley earn its first 20-win season in nearly two decades in addition to locking up the team's first MVC Tournament appearance since 2013. She had a match-high 16 kills in Friday's three-set tilt with 25th-ranked UNI, hitting .261 against the Panthers. Haslag followed that up with a match-high 20 kills in a four-set win over Drake. She also had three digs and three blocks against the Bulldogs as she moved up two spots on the MVC's career kills list into 21st all-time in league history with 1,558 career kills. The 20-kill effort marked the sixth time this season and 19th time in her career Haslag had 20 or more kills in a match.

Cathryn Cheek (DU) - Led Drake with 37 kills and 39 digs on the week ... has now hit double-figure kills in 10-straight matches ... started the week with 15 kills on 36 attempts in a win over Chicago State and followed that with two 11-kill performances ... also had double-doubles at Illinois State and Bradley with 10 and 25 digs, respectively ... her 25 digs at Bradley were a career high.

Rachel Tam (UE) - Over the course of Evansville's two matches over the weekend, Rachel Tam registered 4.83 kills and 2.67 digs per set while leading the Purple Aces to a 1-1 mark. In Friday's match at Missouri State, Tam tallied 14 kills and seven digs. She hit an accurate .294. Tam added 15 more kills at Southern Illinois on Saturday, recording nine digs and four service aces. She remains second in the MVC with 4.28 kills per set.

Heather Kocken (LUC) - Kocken, who has emerged as quite a force in the Loyola arsenal this season, put up 2.62 kills and 0.88 blocks per set last week, all while hitting .320 (21-5-50) as the Ramblers split a pair of MVC outings. The redshirt junior, who ranks among Valley leaders in both hitting percentage and blocks per set, opened the week with eight kills and three blocks to help Loyola roll past Southern Illinois. Kocken closed out action Friday night with 13 kills, one shy of equaling her career high, four blocks and a .357 (13-3-28) hitting percentage, in a tough five-set loss to Valparaiso. In her most productive season to date as a Rambler, Kocken is averaging 2.17 kills and 1.12 blocks per set, hitting a team-high .313 (202-60-453).

Piper Thomas (UNI) - Senior Piper Thomas continued her efficient play last week, recording 29 total kills and a .431 attack percentage for the week. The Panthers swept Bradley Friday night with Thomas recording eight kills and a .368 attack percentage while also finishing with two block assists and two digs. Thomas's efficiency was on display against Illinois State Saturday, recording 21 kills with only three errors for a .431 attack percentage while also recording a solo block and seven block assists.

Lindsey Paulsen (SIU) - Lindsey Paulsen hit .314 on the weekend and tied for the team lead in both kills (16) and blocks (9). The junior middle hitter put down 10 kills and added five blocks in SIU's 3-1 win over Indiana State on Friday. She followed by hitting at a .500 clip on Saturday against Evansville. The Frankfort, Ill. native tallied six kills on 10 swings with just one error and added four blocks.

Katherine Carlson (VALPO) - Carlson led the way in Valpo's come-from-behind win over Loyola Friday, putting down a career-best 24 kills on .444 hitting - her best single-match hitting percentage since September of her freshman season. The 24 kills was the most by a Valpo hitter since 2015. Carlson had 11 kills alone in the fourth set to help Valpo force the fifth frame, tied for the second-most kills in a single set by a Valpo player since 2002. For the week, Carlson averaged 3.67 kills/set and added 3.44 digs/set as well.

Kylee Macke (DU) - Led Drake's defense with 57 digs in three matches for a 5.70 digs per set average ... her 19 digs against Chicago State moved her into ninth all-time in career digs at Drake in less than two seasons ... at Bradley she recorded a career-high 31 digs in four sets ... she now has 954 career digs to rank eighth all-time at Drake.

Courtney Pence (ILS) - Courtney Pence continued to be the driving force in the back court for Illinois State's defense in the Redbirds' pair of wins against Drake and No. 25 UNI. The libero helped the Redbirds hold their opponents to a combined .156 hitting, including a .158 clip by the Panthers - their lowest in a single match in Valley play all season. Pence finished the weekend with 59 digs, averaging 7.38 digs per set. The senior turned in a season-high for any Redbird of 41 digs against UNI on Saturday, and now needs just four to break the MVC career digs mark. Her 41 digs against the Panthers at home is the second-most all-time in a match at Redbird Arena, as she became the first Redbird since 2014 to collect at least 40 at Illinois State's home facility. Pence's 41 digs also ranks fourth all-time in single-match digs by a Redbird, marking the fourth time in school history that the senior has had 40 or more digs in a single match. She now ranks in the top-10 all-time in NCAA Division I volleyball in career digs, currently sitting in the No. 9 spot.

Alex Nunez (LUC) - Last week, Nunez contributed a team-best 3.62 digs per set to help Loyola split a pair of Valley contests at Gentile Arena. The senior libero inched closer to the 1,000-career-dig plateau and enters this week's action needing 106 digs to achieve the milestone. In a 3-0 victory against Southern Illinois October 29, Nunez delivered 14 digs, a pair of assists and an ace, then registered 15 digs, two assists and an ace in a heart-breaking five-set defeat at the hands of Valparaiso. Nunez is going for a team and personal-best 4.39 digs per set this season.

Emily Butters (MSU) - Emily Butters averaged 4.91 digs per set and was perfect on serve receive while helping the MSU defense limit opponents to a .147 hitting percentage in three victories last week. Monday, the senior had 16 digs in a 3-1 win at Valpo and added 13 digs in a home sweep of Evansville on Friday. Butters completed the week with 25 digs in Saturday's four-set victory against Indiana State.

Kendyl Sorge (UNI) - Senior Kendyl Sorge finished last week with 49 total digs and 5 assists in a week that saw the Panthers go 1-1 against the Bradley and Illinois State. Friday the senior libero recorded 20 digs and three assists in the three set sweep over the Braves. Sorge finished Saturday's five set match against the Redbirds with team leading 29 digs and two assists.

Patience Brown (SIU) - Brown tied for the team lead in blocks, as she averaged a robust 1.29 blocks per set, including six blocks in SIU's four set win over Indiana State Friday night. The senior middle hitter put down 11 kills and added six blocks, including three solo stuffs against the Sycamores and followed with five kills and three blocks versus Evansville. It marked the fourth -straight match in which the Bloomington, Ill. native has recorded multiple blocks.

Rylee Cookerly (VALPO) - Cookerly continued her strong sophomore campaign last week with another pair of 20+ dig efforts. She led all players against Missouri State on Monday with 27 digs in the four-set match, and then paced all players with 24 digs in the five-set win at Loyola, averaging 5.67 digs/set on the week. Cookerly is now just 41 digs away from cracking Valpo's single-season top-10 in the category for the second time in as many years...

Hannah Thompson (BRAD) - Thompson turned in her team-best 16th double-double of the year and averaged 2.43 kills, 4.71 digs and 0.43 blocks per set as she helped Bradley earn its first 20-win season in nearly two decades in addition to locking up the team's first MVC Tournament appearance since 2013. She also owned a 96.2 serve receive percentage for the week on 52 attempts. Thompson turned in a double-double Friday against #25 UNI, finishing with 10 kills, 10 digs, one ace and one block. She collected seven kills, 23 digs and a pair of blocks in Saturday's four-set win against Drake as she broke the Bradley freshman record for digs in a season in addition to becoming just the fourth freshman in school history with 300 or more kills. Thompson now has 310 kills and 414 digs on the year for the first 300 kill, 400 dig season at Bradley since 1990 and just the fifth in school history.

Caitlyn Smith (DU) - Led Drake in assists on the week with 59 while splitting setting duties in 10 sets ... she also had 32 digs, the third most on the team during the week ... recorded two double-doubles on the week with 15 assists and 10 digs against Chicago State and 22 assists and 16 digs at Bradley ... her 22 assists and both Illinois State and Bradley were her second most of the season.

Marissa Stockman (ILS) - Marissa Stockman hit a team-high .474 this weekend, registering 21 kills and averaging 2.62 per set, in Illinois State's pair of wins over Drake and No. 25 UNI. In Friday night's sweep of the Bulldogs, Stockman tallied seven kills in 11 total attempts without an error, hitting at a .636 clip, before returning to the court on Saturday and hit a team-high .407 with 14 kills against the Panthers. Stockman continued to stand firm at the net, contributing eight blocks on the weekend (1.00 block/set), including a team-high six against nationally-ranked UNI.

Melina Tedrow (INS) - A true freshman that started the year as a defensive specialist, Melina Tedrow registered 86 assists over the weekend, an average of 10.75 per game, as she continues to serve as the setter for Indiana State in an emergency role due to injury. Tedrow has also been superb defensively, averaging 3.50 digs per set over the weekend and even assisting on two blocks. The 5-foot-5 freshman was even credited with a kill.

Lauren Caprini (LUC) - In two contests last week, Caprini averaged 2.12 digs and 0.12 assists per set as Loyola split two Valley matches. The freshman libero produced eight digs in the Ramblers' sweep of Southern Illinois October 29, and accounted for nine digs and an assist in a gut-wrenching five-set loss to Valparaiso November 2. For the year, Caprini is recording 2.11 digs and 0.29 service aces per set for a Loyola squad that has tripled its 2017 win total.

Haley Hart (VALPO) - Hart was instrumental in Valpo's come-from-behind win at Loyola on Friday evening. The freshman picked up two kills and a block in a four-point span late in the third set to help keep Valpo alive. Then, in the fifth set, Hart was in on blocks on the first and last points of the frame to secure the victory. For the match, Hart tallied a team-best five blocks to match her career high and added five kills on just nine swings.

UNI, Illinois State and Bradley have each secured a spot in the six-team MVC Volleyball Tournament which will be held at Missouri State November 22-24. Valparaiso, Loyola and Missouri State currently occupy the final three spots in the tournament race with two weeks remaining during the regular season.

Showdown at the Top

Illinois State topped nationally-ranked UNI on Saturday night to finish the 2018 home slate with a perfect 9-0 record. Last season, the Panthers visited Redbird Arena with the same national rank – No. 25 – and the Redbirds handed UNI a five-set loss, similarly to this weekend. The Redbirds have now posted a winning record at Redbird Arena in eight of the last nine seasons. Both teams sit atop the standings with only one league loss.

Small Company

Only five times in Valley history has a team finished last in the standings the previous year make the MVC Tournament the following season. Bradley became the first team since Southern Illinois in 2012 to accomplish the feat.

Another Comeback

Valpo had rallied from down two sets to win just eight times in Carin Avery's first 16 years at Valpo entering this season, but on Friday night at Loyola, the Crusaders did just that against the Ramblers for the second time this season. Prior to this year, Valpo had rallied from down 2-0 to win 3-2 just once in the last five seasons.

Bears Heating Up

Missouri State's four-match winning streak equals its longest of the season, and the Bears have posted impressive numbers over that stretch. MSU has averaged 15.33 kills, 14.67 assists and 18.73 digs per set over its last four wins, figures that would rank 2nd, 2nd, & 4th nationally if done for a full season.

NCAA RPI Report

The latest edition of the NCAA RPI report has been released and The Valley has three teams featured in the top-70. UNI leads the league at No. 15, while Illinois State (No. 34), and Valparaiso (No. 68) are also among the nation's top-70. Four other teams rank in the Top 130 (Missouri State, Bradley, Drake and Loyola). As a conference, The Valley ranks eighth among 32 conferences.

With Missouri State's win against Southern Illinois, head coach Melissa Stokes passed former UNI boss Iradge Ahrabi-Fard with 504 in her career, good for second all-time in MVC history. Linda Dollar, who won 758 victories at Missouri State from 1972-95, sits atop the list.

Illinois State's Courtney Pence has been named a finalist for the 2018 Senior CLASS Award. Pence is among 10 NCAA Division I candidates in volleyball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 11 leagues, including America East (2-0), American (1-0), Big South (3-0), Ivy (2-0), Metro Atlantic (2-0), Mid-Eastern (2-0), Northeast (3-0), Patriot (1-0), Summit (9-0), SWAC (5-0) and WAC (2-0).

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 20 leagues in non-conference play (America East, American, A10, Atlantic Sun, Big East, Big South, Horizon, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, MEAC, Mountain West, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southland, Summit, Sun Belt, SWAC and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another three (Big Sky, Conference USA and Southern) through the non-conference season.

Power Five Wins

The Valley has four wins over Power Five programs this season. UNI beat Indiana and Kentucky, Missouri State beat Texas A&M and Illinois State beat Auburn.

Top of the Class

The Valley has placed multiple teams in the NCAA Tournament 10 times in the last 12 years. Since 2007, The Valley has received 30 bids into the 64-team field, trailing only the Pac 12, Big Ten, Big 12, SEC, ACC & West Coast Conferences.

Non-Conference Success

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (.55-57) and 2017 (.61-66). The MVC is 81-49 (.623) in non-league play this season, which ranks second in that span. The Valley posted a league-best .756 non-conference win percentage in 2010.

Against 2017 NCAA Field

The Valley has won five matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. UNI and Illinois State lead the conference with a pair of wins over participants in the 2017 NCAA tourney. The Panthers have wins over Creighton and Kentucky, while the Redbirds beat Coastal Carolina and Stony Brook. Valpo has the MVC's fifth win, beating Cal State Bakersfield.

Panthers Elite Offense

UNI leads the MVC in both assists per set and kills per set so far this season. The Panthers rank top 10 nationally in both categories, sitting 4th overall in assists per set (13.86) and 6th in kills per set (14.70). Rachel Koop leads The Valley in assists per set and sits 9th nationally (11.66), while Karlie Taylor leads the league in attacks per set, kills per set and points per set, ranking 16th (12.14), 8th (4.68) and 12th (5.10) nationally in each category.

The Valley Digs Deep

Currently, the MVC has six teams ranking Top 30 nationally in digs per set, including Bradley leading the MVC with 19.37 per set.

The Valley has led the nation in digs per set three times in the last four seasons (Illinois State in 2014, UNI in 2016 and Valparaiso in 2017).

BRADLEY (20-7, 10-5 MVC)

20 Wins

Saturday's four-set victory against Drake gave Bradley its first 20-win season in nearly two decades in addition to locking up the team's first Missouri Valley Conference Tournament appearance since 2013. The Braves last 20-win campaign was 2001 (24-8) and prior to this fall BU had just two 20-win seasons since the MVC went to a double round-robin conference schedule in 1992. Bradley has a school record 13 home victories this season to break the previous mark of 12 home wins last done in 2002. BU's 10-win improvement from last season and at least seven-win improvement in league play are both the largest for the Braves since the 1999 squad followed up a 9-19 overall season & 4-14 league record in 1998 with a 20-6 mark and 14-4 Valley record to tie for second in the MVC.



Turning it Around

Bradley became the third team to lock up a spot in the six-team MVC Tournament which will be held later this month in Springfield, Mo., with Saturday's win against Drake. On the heels of a 10th-place league finish last year, the Braves are just the sixth team in league history to qualify for the MVC Tournament after finishing last in the league the previous year and first to do so since Southern Illinois tied for fourth in 2012. The 2012 SIU team is the only squad in league history to earn a seed higher than #6 for the Valley Tournament following a last-place finish and one of just two teams to post a top-half finish after a last-place Valley finish with the 2003 Creighton team getting the #6 seed after tying for fifth place.

Rare Air

Freshman Hannah Thompson continues to leave her mark on the Bradley record book with the 5-8 outside hitter breaking the school record for digs by a freshman. After a 23-dig outing against Drake Saturday, Thompson now has 414 digs this fall to break the previous Bradley freshman record of 413 digs set by libero Rachelle Dejean in 2008. In fact, her 414 digs are the most by a Brave other than a libero since setter Sam Hardwick led the team with 429 digs in 2001. Thompson is also just the fourth freshman in school history to tally 300 kills and first to do since Marika Giguere had a school freshman record 326 kills in 2006. The only freshman in school history with 300 kills and 400 or more digs, Thompson is the first Brave to amass those numbers in nearly 30 years with Blythe Zajakowski the last to do so in 1990. There are now a total of five seasons in school history with an individual recording 300 kills and 400 digs with Stacey Besjak and Kathy Bickler both doing so in 1985 and Bickler also accomplishing the feat in 1984.

Illinois State topped nationally-ranked UNI on Saturday night to finish the 2018 home slate with a perfect 9-0 record. Last season, the Panthers visited Redbird Arena with the same national rank – No. 25 – and the Redbirds handed UNI a five-set loss, similarly to this weekend. The Redbirds have now posted a winning record at Redbird Arena in eight of the last nine seasons.



Final Four

Courtney Pence continued to be the driving force in the back court for Illinois State's defense in the Redbirds' pair of wins against Drake and No. 25 UNI. The libero helped the Redbirds hold their opponents to a combined .156 hitting, including a .158 clip by the Panthers – their lowest in a single match in Valley play all season. The senior turned in a season-high for any Redbird of 41 digs against UNI on Saturday, and now needs just four to break the MVC career digs mark. Pence ranks in the top-10 all-time in NCAA Division I volleyball history in career digs, currently sitting in the No. 9 spot.

Final Stretch

Illinois State has three matches left on the 2018 regular-season slate, with trips scheduled to Loyola Chicago, Valparaiso and Bradley. Over the last five seasons, the Redbirds have compiled a record of 10-5 in its final three contests of the regular season, including two perfect 3-0 marks in 2014 and 2017.

The Salukis recorded a season-high 14 blocks in their four-set win over Indiana State Friday night, which were their most in a Missouri Valley Conference match since Oct. 27, 2017 at Indiana State when Southern also recorded 14. Southern's 14 blocks are the second-most in a four-set match by a Missouri Valley Conference team this season.



No Holes

The Saluki defense was exceptional against Indiana State, as Southern recorded 83 digs and held the Sycamores to a .124 hitting percentage- the lowest it has held a MVC opponent this season. It was the lowest that SIU has held an MVC opponent in more than a year, when Southern held Bradley to a .117 hitting efficiency on Sept. 22, 2017.

Setting up the Offense

Alayna Martin played an integral role in Southern's four-set win over Indiana State that snapped a 14-match losing streak for the Salukis. The junior setter recorded her fourth-straight assist-dig double-double with 42 assists and 13 digs which marked her 13th double-double of the season and 28th of her career. It was also just the fourth time in her career that she has dished out 40-plus assists. Martin just missed her fifth-straight double-double, as she finished with 19 assists and eight digs on Saturday against Evansville.
