Lasha Petree, Fr., G, Bradley

Petree knocked down 6-of-10 three-pointers and scored a game-high 28 points to lead Bradley to an 80-60 victory at Omaha Friday. NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including

Sara Rhine (DU) - In Drake's close loss to in-state foe, lowa State, Sara Rhine led the offense with 22 points on 8-of-13 shooting, including 5-of-5 from the free throw line, and just missed her fifth double-double this season with nine rebounds. Rhine, who has scored double figures in every game this season, added one block and one steal. She continues to lead the Missouri Valley Conference in scoring (18.9) and field goal percentage (59.0) and is fourth in rebounding (8.3).

Simone Goods (ILS) - Simone Goods was the driving force behind the Redbirds' fourth straight victory on Sunday as she tallied another 20-point game and added her eighth career double-double with 13 rebounds. Goods also dished out a career high of three assists. The senior forward averages just shy of a double-double this season with 17.3 points and 9.0 rebounds per game. Additionally, this is the fourth time this season she has had a 20+ showing and the fourth time corralling more than 10 rebounds.

Kat Nolan (LUC) - Loyola sophomore forward/center Kat Nolan scored a career-high 17 points as the Ramblers dropped an 88-74 decision to visiting UMKC on Sunday afternoon in its only action of the week. The Arlington Heights, III. native finished a perfect 8-of-8 from the field, while also grabbing five rebounds and dishing out an assist. Nolan, who is operating at a team-best 54 percent clip from the field, is playing arguably enjoying the top stretch of her collegiate career as MVC play approaches, averaging nearly a double-double (9.4 ppg, 7.2 rpg) over Loyola's last five games.

Brice Calip (MSU) - Brice Calip scored a career-high 20 points Sunday against 21st-ranked Gonzaga, going 7-for-14 from the field and 6-for-6 at the foul line with five rebounds and an assist. The sophomore scored 12 points in the second half, leading the Lady Bears back from a 14-point deficit to trailing 61-60 with four minutes left before falling 70-67.

Karli Rucker (UNI) - Karli Rucker scored a team-high 16 points on 7-14 from the field and 2-4 from the three-point line. She had four rebounds, four assists and a steal against lowa.

Addison Stoller (VALPO) - After getting close on several prior occasions, Stoller racked up 11 points and pulled down 10 rebounds on Sunday vs. North Dakota State for her first career double-double. She equaled her career best in rebounding and continues to lead the team at 7.5 per game. She is one of two Valpo players averaging in double figures with 11.4 points per game.

A'Niah Griffin (UE) - In a road game at Dayton, freshman A'Niah Griffin helped the Purple Aces get out to a fast start. On Saturday, Griffin tied a career-high with nine points, adding three rebounds and a block, scoring all nine points during a 16-3 Evansville run to open the game. This season, Griffin is averaging 4.9 points per game and 3.8 boards per game, leading all Aces' freshman in rebounds per contest.

Janae Gonzales (LUC) - Loyola freshman guard Janae Gonzales chipped in 12 points, reaching double figures in scoring for the fourth time in six games, as the Ramblers fell to UMKC by a final count of 88-74 on Sunday afternoon in Rogers Park. Out of Tolleson, Ariz., Gonzales also handed out a season-high five assists, collected two rebounds and came away with a steal against the Kangaroos. The 5-foot-8 sharpshooting guard is currently averaging 10.2 points, a mark that ranks second amongst MVC freshman.

Cynthia Wolf (UNI) - Cynthia Wolf came off the bench to score a season-high 11 points in just 14 minutes on the floor against lowa. She was 4-6 from the floor and 3-5 from the three-point line. She also grabbed two rebounds, tallied an assist and tallied a block.

Ilysse Pitts (VALPO) - The Valpo freshman finished two rebounds shy of a double-double, accumulating eight boards to go along with 10 points on Sunday vs. North Dakota State. She matched her career best with 10 points while establishing a personal watermark with the eight rebounds. Pitts also knocked two a pair of 3-pointers and swiped two steals.

Power Five Ahead

Drake has three Power Five wins on its resume as the Bulldogs have beaten South Carolina, Rutgers and Nebraska so far this season. The conference sits 3-9 against Power Five opponents with all of the games taking place on the road or a neutral court. This week, the MVC schedule features three games against Power Five schools, including Iowa at Drake, Evansville at Wisconsin and Bradley at Purdue. The MVC earned four wins over members of Power Five conferences a year ago.

Vs. Top 25

Last season, the MVC went 0-9 against Top 25 opponents, breaking a streak of three-straight years with at least one win over a Top 25 team. Drake earned a 90-85 overtime win over No. 12/13 South Carolina in Vancouver in November. It was the highest ranked win over an opponent in the regular season by a Valley team since Missouri State beat No. 10 LSU on November 24, 2000. The league currently sits 1-6 vs. the Top 25 this year as two more chances to claim a win occur this week. Lovola will host #20 DePaul on Thursday, while Drake will host #16 Iowa Friday.

The last time the MVC recorded two wins against the Top 25 was during the 2002-03 season (Drake vs. No. 18 Iowa State & UNI vs. No. 24 Iowa State).

Still Perfect

Bradley remained the only undefeated team in the MVC with an 80-60 win over Omaha on Friday. Bradley improved to 8-0 on the year and is one of only 17 teams in the nation with a perfect record. The Braves join UConn, Northeastern, Ohio, Portland State and South Alabama as the only Non-Power Five teams to sit unblemished. The Braves are 8-0 for just the second time in program history, joining the 2001-02 squad (9-0) as the only Bradley teams to win their first eight games of a season.

The New Girl Can Score

Bradley's Lasha Petree is the league's top scoring freshman, averaging 18.1 points per game to rank second overall in the MVC. Through games of Dec. 16, she currently ranks 3rd nationally among all NCAA Division I freshmen, trailing Texas Tech's Chrislyn Carr (18.9 ppg) and Oklahoma's Taylor Robertson (18.4 ppg).

The last MVC freshman to average over 17.0 points per game was Evansville's Sara Dickey during the 2013-14 season.

Home Sweet Home

Currently five MVC teams remain unbeaten at home: Bradley (5-0), Southern Illinois (4-0), Drake (3-0), Illinois State (4-0) and UNI (3-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season. The Valley currently holds a 26-12 mark at home this season.

A Hot December

Drake's Sara Rhine is heating up during the month of December, connecting on 27 of her 35 field goal attempts (77.1%). Inside the arc, Rhine is shooting a blistering 83.3% from the field during the month, hitting on 25 of her 30 two-point field-goal attempts. Rhine is averaging 22.0 points and 7.3 rebounds per game during the month.

Rhine is also one of only four players nationally to go 10-for-10 or better in a game this season (vs. Clarke), joining Iowa's Megan Gustafson (vs. Western Kentucky), Mississippi State's Teaira McCowan (vs. Furman) and Purdue's Ae'Rianna Harris (vs. Purdue Fort Wayne).

Sweeping the Honors

Bradley's Lasha Petree registered 28 points and connected on six three-point field goals in the Braves' 80-60 win at Omaha, en route to the league's Player of the Week and Newcomer of the Week honor. Petree becomes the seventh player in MVC history to sweep the weekly awards since the Newcomer of the Week began during the 2003-04 season.

Bradley is receiving votes in this week's poll. Drake fell to No. 4 in the latest ESPNW Mid-Major poll, sitting behind South Dakota, South Dakota State and Gonzaga.

Sharp Shooters

A year after seeing Evansville lead the nation in free-throw percentage (82.0%), The Valley has three of the nation's top 15 teams in the category so far this season. Loyola currently leads the league and sits 8th nationally, while Evansville sits 9th and UNI 14th.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against eight leagues in non-conference play, including the America East (1-0), Big West (2-1), Colonial (2-0), Horizon (7-5), NEC (1-0), Ohio Valley (8-7), Summitt (7-5) and WAC (4-1). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against Conference USA (3-3) and the SEC (1-1).

Strength of Schedule

Drake and Missouri State have tested themselves with a difficult non-conference schedule. The Bulldogs have played the 32nd toughest strength of schedule so far this season, while the Lady Bears' schedule ranks 27th nationally. Drake is one of 30 teams nationally with three RPI Top 100 wins so far this season.

Poll Position

Drake continued to receive votes in this week's Associated Press women's Top 25 poll. The Bulldogs fell on the road at Iowa State and are currently receiving a single vote. Drake's next game is at home against #16 lowa on Friday.

New Valley Streak

Drake has the longest win streak in the history of the Gateway/MVC for regular season contests. The impressive streak started Feb. 26, 2016 with a win over Loyola. The Bulldogs broke SIU's 37 game streak from 1985-1987 during the Gateway era with a win over Illinois State Feb. 25. The Bulldogs will enter the 2018-19 season with back-to-back 18-0 league seasons.



Rhine on McClain Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake junior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its second year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award will be narrowed to just 10.

Senior CLASS Award Candidate

Drake's Sammie Bachrodt has been named a candidate for the 2018-19 Senior CLASS Award. Bachrodt is among 30 NCAA Division I candidates in women's basketball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.



Postseason League

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 20 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2017-18. Drake fell at Texas A&M in the NCAA Tournament, while Missouri State and UNI each received bids into the WNIT. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 11 different seasons, including a pair of bids in the 2017 NCAA Tournament (Drake and UNI).

Hoops In the Heartland

The 2019 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the fourth-straight season.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 14-17) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The MVC extended an agreement with the Quad Cities Convention & Visitors Bureau to conduct the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2019 tournament will mark the 12th-consecutive season in its 37-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

Starters Returning

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 37 of 50 starters return (74%) for the 2018-19 season. Defending champion Drake returns all five starters next season, while Illinois State, Indiana State, UNI, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso will see four starters return. Bradley, Evansville, Loyola and Missouri State will each see three starters return to the court.

Teleconferences with The Valley head coaches will be conducted twice throughout the season. The conferences begin at 11:45 a.m. (CST). To participate in the conference calls, call (877) 417-8778. Coaches call (877) 417-8756.

BRADLEY (8-0)

On Fire

Freshman Lasha Petree made 6-of-10 three-pointers in her 28-point outing at Omaha last Friday marking her fourth 20-point outing of the year. Petree has been in the starting lineup each of the last three games, averaging 22.0 points per game while shooting 15-of-



32 (46.9) from three-point range in those games. Currently third in the nation among freshman in scoring (18.1 ppg), Petree is the sixth player in program history to have four or more 20-point outings during their freshman season and has joined Connie Griffith (1977-78) as the only freshmen in school history to score 28 or more in two different contests.

Filling It Up

Through eight games, Bradley is second in the MVC in scoring at 76.1 points per game and the Braves have scored 80 or more points in five outings. Bradley is 56th in the nation in scoring through Dec. 16. The Braves have averaged better than 70 points per game just twice in the last 24 seasons (2012-13 & 2004-05) with this season's average ranking as the best on The Hilltop since the 1982-83 team averaged 82.7 points per tilt. Bradley had a total of six 80-point scoring efforts during the first two years of head coach Andrea Gorski's tenure and a total of seven contests with 80 or more points over the previous four campaigns. Freshman Lasha Petree is scoring 18.1 points per game (2nd in MVC) and sophomore Gabi Haack adds 16.1 points per game (5th in MVC). The last time Bradley had two players in the same season average 15 or more points per game was 1994-95 and the Braves are one of 15 teams in the country through Dec. 16 to have two players scoring over 16 points per game.

The Lady Bears played Gonzaga – led by head coach Lisa Fortier and her husband and assistant Craig – on Sunday, while LA Tech has co-head coaches in Brooke and Scott Stoehr. MSU also played LT on March 15 of last season, meaning Missouri State will play three of 11 games against programs with spouses on the coaching staff.

Another Coaching Connection

MSU will play a Lady Bear alum on Friday when it meets SIU Edwardsville in Kansas City. SIUE head coach Paula Buscher was Missouri State's starting point guard during the 1984 and 1985 seasons, finishing her career third in school history with 264 assists, a number that still ranks 19th at MSU. It will be the 30th time Missouri State has played a Buscher-coached team, most of those coming during her 12 seasons at Bradley, and the Lady Bears are 19-10 in those games.

Hall of Fame

Head coach Cindy Stein has been selected for enshrinement into the Illinois Basketball Coaches Association Hall of Fame. A native of Peoria, Ill., Stein attended Richwoods High School and went 20-2 as a senior. She played her collegiate ball in the state of Illinois, first at Illinois Central College where the basketball team advanced to the NJCAA National Tournament in back-to-back seasons and Stein became just the fourth player in school history to earn All-America honors with a turn on the second-team in 1981. From there, Stein transferred to the University of Illinois, where the Illini went 35-24 during her two seasons and advanced to the second round of the 1982 NCAA Tournament. Stein dished out 323 assists during her two seasons at U of I, which still ranks eighth in program history.

Racking Up Rebounds

When Valpo outdid North Dakota State on the boards 41-31 on Monday, it marked the first time this season the team won the rebounding battle. In addition, the +10 rebounding margin marked Valpo's best since Feb. 11, 2018 at Loyola. The day also featured numerous



personal rebounding milestones as Addison Stoller (10), Meredith Hamlet (8), Ella Ellenson (8) and Ilysse Pitts (8) all set or matched personal season bests.

Close Calls

This Valpo team has faced no shortage of close, late-game situations this season. Valpo has already played in seven games decided by six points or fewer through the first 10 games of the year. Valpo played in four games the entire season decided by six points or fewer a year ago. In 2016-17, the team played in seven such games and eight in 2015-16.

Guarding the Arc

Valpo held North Dakota State to 11.1 percent (2-of-18) from 3-point range on Sunday night. That was already the fourth time this season Valpo held an opponent to two made 3s or fewer (at Illinois, at Morehead State, at Chicago State, vs. North Dakota State). The last time Valpo limited the opponent to two made 3s or fewer four or more times in a season was 2006-2007. Valpo has achieved that feat in just 10 games this year. Making Sunday even more impressive is the fact that the Bison had made three 3s or more in every game this season and narrowly extended their long streak of games with two or more made 3s to 92. The 11.1 percent from 3 for North Dakota State was a season best for the Valpo defense and marked the lowest 3-point field goal percentage by an opponent since Feb. 2 of last season, when Bradley shot 10.5 percent from distance.
