Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Devlin Granberg, Sr., OF, DBU

DBU senior outfielder Devlin Granberg hit .563 (9-for-16) last week with two home runs, six RBI, and extended his career-high hit streak to 12 games. The Patriots' senior outfielder helped lift the Patriots to a key road series win over No. 22 Sam Houston State by going 5-for-13 with six RBI in the three games against the Bearkats. For the week, Granberg led DBU in eight categories including hits (9), home runs (2), total bases (16), slugging percentage (1.000), walks (6), on-base percentage (.696), and stolen bases (2). Over his 12-game hit streak, is hitting .538.

Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

Dylan Coleman, Jr., RHP, Missouri State

Missouri State junior right-hander Dylan Coleman dominated CSUN for seven of his career-best eight innings Friday, striking out 11 and allowing just two runs (one earned) on four singles to earn his fourth win of the season. The Pototsi, Mo., native allowed just one baserunner through the first five innings, fanning eight Matadors in the process, then retired the final seven hitters he faced. His 11 strikeouts represented the fifth double-digit strikeout performance of his career and moved him into sole possession of ninth place on the Bears' career list.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Brendan Dougherty (BRAD) – In Bradley's lone game of the week, Dougherty was 2-for-3 with a walk, a triple, a home run, three runs scored and four RBI's, leading the Braves to a 16-1 home win versus Chicago State ... Dougherty walked and scored what proved to be the winning run in the second inning, then launched his first career home run, a 2-run shot, for a 6-0 lead in the third inning ... He added his first career triple in the fourth inning to plate two more runs.

Noah Sadler (ILS) – Batted .571 (4-of-7) with one run scored and two RBI's. He had a double and a triple among his four hits, and had a 1.000 slugging percentage over the weekend. He also walked once with no strikeouts, and had a .625 on-base percentage. He added a steal, and had a perfect fielding percentage (19 attempts, two assists, no errors).

Dane Giesler (INS) – Redshirt senior Dane Giesler started three games over the week and put together a .700 slugging percentage on five hits, which included a pair of doubles. Giesler finished the week 5-of-10 at the plate for a .500 batting percentage, drawing three walks for a .615 on-base percentage while driving in two runs and scoring two. Giesler was perfect in the field on 27 fielding chances.

Jeremy Eierman (MSU) – Junior shortstop Jeremy Eierman continued his torrid month of March, hitting .350 with three multi-hit performances, including a pair of home runs, nine RBIs and three steals to help MSU post a perfect 5-0 home stand this past week. Eierman homered twice and drove in the Bears' first seven runs in Sunday's 8-2 victory that completed a three-game sweep of CSUN, capping a weekend in which he went 5-or-12 with four runs scored and eight RBIs. The Warsaw, Mo., product either scored a run or drove one home in four of MSU's five go-ahead rallies. He started the week with a 2-for-4 effort that extended his career-best hit streak to 11 games, and ended it with his fourth multi-homer effort as a Bear to move into MSU's top 10 for career home runs.

Logan Blackfan (SIU) – Logan Blackfan went 6-for-16 (.375) with two doubles and six RBIs for the Salukis in a 3-1 week. Blackfan drew three walks to post a .474 on-base percentage and slugged .500. Blackfan had a hit in every game of the week and posted two multi-hit games. He also had at least one RBI in all four games to push his season total to 28 RBIs, which ranks second in the league.

Mitch Janssen (BRAD) – Janssen took a no-hitter into the fifth inning, before allowing an infield single with two outs in the fifth in Wednesday's start against Chicago State ... He ended up allowing one unearned run on the lone hit, while striking out a career-best nine in his 5.0 innings of work against the Cougars.

MacGregor Hines (DBU) – DBU redshirt sophomore MacGregor Hines went 1-0 and did not allow an earned run in his three appearances last week. Over 6.0 innings of work, Hines walked just one batter and struck out six. In the series opener at No. 22 Sam Houston State on Friday, Hines earned the win, allowing one unearned run in 1.1 innings. On Sunday, Hines made a predetermined start and surrendered one unearned run in 2.2 innings and struck out three.

Brady Huffman (ILS) – Had a 1.80 ERA in a hard-luck-loss to Creighton on Friday, March 23. Struck out five and gave up just three hits over five innings of work, an opposing batting average of .167. He walked three and gave up one earned run over his time.

Ethan Larrison (INS) – Indiana State right-hander Ethan Larrison tossed 4.1 innings in relief this week as the Sycamores continue to add to their winning streak. The Shelbyville, Indiana product picked up saves in each outing, for his sixth and seventh save of the season. Larrison struck out seven batters and allowed just one earned run over the week while holding the opposition to a .176 batting average.

Jamison Steege (SIU) – Jamison Steege threw seven shutout innings to lead Saluki Baseball to an 11-2 win over UC Irvine on Saturday at Itchy Jones Stadium. Steege allowed a leadoff single, then didn't allow another hit until there were two outs in the seventh inning. UC Irvine only had three runners in scoring position against Steege and none reached third base. He struck out three and induced one double play.

Jon Tieman (VALPO) – Valpo right-handed pitcher Jon Tieman pitched Valpo to a 9-2 win over in-state rival Butler on Friday. He yielded two runs on seven hits and one walk while striking out four in 7 1/3 innings. Tieman did not allow a run over the first seven innings and both runs charged to him scored after he had left the game. He sent down 11 straight batters from the third to the sixth. Tieman's outing came against a Big East foe Butler, a team that entered that game with a 16-3 record. He has displayed strong control in his last two starts, going 14 straight innings without allowing a walk until his lone base on balls in the seventh on Friday at Butler.

Five in RPI's Top-80

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-80 of the RPI, led by Indiana State (No. 24), Illinois State (No. 51), Bradley (No. 53), DBU (No. 72) and Missouri State (No. 76).

Another two teams, Southern Illinois (No. 142) and Valparaiso (No. 149), also rank in the RPI's top-150.

Valley RPI Ranks No. 9

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (March 26), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 9 amongst 31 leagues, keeping the same position from last week. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth.

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, The MVC has earned nine wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley sits 3-2 vs. the Pac-12, 3-5 vs. the Big 12, 2-5 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-5 vs. the SEC.

Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley, Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso each have one Power Five win, while DBU has two and Illinois State three.

Red Hot Sycamores

Indiana State has won nine-straight games entering this week's contests. The current streak ranks third nationally, sitting behind Saint Louis (14) and VCU (12). Next up for the Sycamores is #11 Indiana in Terre Haute on Wednesday.

Strength of Schedule

Illinois State ranks second among Missouri Valley Conference teams at 51 in the RPI, as produced by WarrenNolan.com. The Redbirds have easily posted The Valley's best strength of schedule to date, checking in at 30 (DBU is second in SOS at 63). Illinois State's opponents to date have combined for a 207-141 (.595) Division I record entering this week.

King Kopach

Southern Illinois' Connor Kopach ranks top 20 nationally in three different categories. The senior infielder leads the nation with 18 steals this season and ranks 17th in hits (39) and 18th in runs (29). Kopach ranks fourth in The Valley with a .390 batting average.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Conference USA, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Pac-12, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another league (American).

Winning Out West

Illinois State claimed a series win at Washington, taking three out of four games in the series. It marked just the second time in MVC history that a Valley team earned a series win (more than two games) on the road against a Pac-12 team. Missouri State is the only other league team to win a road series vs. the Pac-12, earning a series win at Oregon State in 2009 (2-1).

Still In the Running

Despite being held to single-digit runs in each of the last seven games, the Illinois State baseball team ranks 16th in the country in scoring, averaging 7.7 runs per game. The Redbirds also rank 16th in doubles per game, 18th in on-base percentage, 35th in total home runs, 44th in total doubles, and 54th in batting average. Individually, Owen Miller ranks 19th in runs per game (1.21), while John Rave's 1.63 hits per game ranks 32nd in the nation.

Streaking at Hammons

With five home victories last week, the Bears ran their 2018 home mark to 8-2 and extended their current Hammons Field win streak to six straight games. That streak represents the sixth different home win streak of at least six games since the start of the 2015 season. The Bears have logged their top two single-season home win totals over the last two years, going 21-7 at home last spring, following a Hammons Field record 22 victories in 2016. In 2015, MSU posted its best-ever showing at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark, giving the Bears a combined 70-21 (.769) home record since the start of the 2015 season.



Shutdown Staff

MSU pitching has locked into high gear over the last 12 games, posting a 2.75 team ERA and winning 10 of those outings. In all, nine different Bears hurlers have logged sub-3.00 ERAs over the same span, while the staff as a whole has limited the opposition to a .204 batting mark. A pair of freshmen have led the charge with Ty Buckner going 2-1 with a 2.06 ERA and Connor Sechler logging 7.2 scoreless innings over which he has fanned 13 batters without issuing a walk to go 2-0 with a save. The Bears have given up an average of 3.3 runs per outing and have yielded 10 or more hits just once during the same stretch.
