Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Drew Millas, So., C, Missouri State

Missouri State sophomore catcher/DH Drew Millas turned in another torrid stretch at the plate, hitting .533 (8-for-15) with a pair of home runs and seven RBI to help the Bears go 3-1 last week. Millas logged his third four-hit performance of the season against No. 3 Arkansas Tuesday, then drove in seven runs in the Bears' MVC series sweep of Illinois State. The Swansea, Illinois product went 2-for-3 with the decisive seventh-inning, three-run home run that snapped a 3-3 deadlock in

an eventual 6-3 Bears victory, then helped finish off the sweep with another home run and three more RBI in the finale—a 12-3 MSU win.

Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

Tyler Ward, Jr., RHP, Indiana State

Indiana State junior pitcher Tyler Ward put together a masterful performance Friday night as he pitched a complete game shutout against No. 23 DBU. Ward allowed just six hits to the high-powered Patriots offense that entered the game with 251 runs scored in 34 games. The right-hander shut down much of the DBU lineup with just five Patriots recording base hits. Ward also ended DBU leadoff man Jameson Hannah's 46-game reached base streak and his school record 35-game hitting

streak. Ward, a Santa Claus, Indiana native, improved to 6-3 on the season after striking out eight and walking just two Patriots. He also retired eight of the final nine batters he faced.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Luke Mangieri (BRAD) – Mangieri contributed to 12 runs in three games last week, batting .538 (7-13) with two doubles, two home runs, seven RBI's and seven runs scored ... Adding a walk to his plate appearances, Mangieri slugged 1.154 and enjoyed a .571 on-base percentage in the three games ... He started the week by going 3-for-5 with a double, a home run and three RBI's in Wednesday's 9-2 win against Western Illinois ... He followed up by going 3-for-4 with a double, a home run, four runs scored and four RBI's in Saturday's 17-0 win against RMU-Springfield.

Devlin Granberg (DBU) – DBU senior Devlin Granberg hit .438 (7-for-16) last week, helping the Patriots win a key road series at Indiana State. Granberg posted a team-best .500 on-base percentage, drove in three runs, and also scored three times. Granberg also compiled a .438 slugging percentage.

CJ Huntley (INS) – Junior outfielder CJ Huntley scored five runs and drove in four over the last week for the Sycamores. Huntley closed out his week with eight hits in 19 at bats for a .421 average. His .632 slugging percentage is tops on the team during the stretch. During Friday's series opening 6-0 win over No. 23 Dallas Baptist, Huntley finished a home run short of the cycle. He was perfect in the field in 15 fielding chances and finished with a .476 on-base percentage.

Logan Blackfan (SIU) – Logan Blackfan went 9-for-23 with two doubles, three home runs and 10 RBIs for Southern Illinois last week, slugging .870 on the week. Blackfan hit the game-winning three-run homer in SIU's last at-bat during an 11-9 win over Murray State on Wednesday. He had a two-homer game at No. 21 Tennessee Tech. He had three multi-hit games last week. Blackfan extended his active hitting streak to 20 games, the second-longest in the MVC this season and the longest for an SIU player since 2012 (Chris Serritella). His 10 RBIs pushed his season total to 48, which leads the MVC.

Giovanni Garbella (VALPO) – Garbella had seven hits in 15 at-bats (.467) while ripping a double and a homer as Valpo took three of four this week. He drove in six runs in four games and played a key role as Valpo knocked off No. 25 Illinois on Tuesday and then won its first Missouri Valley Conference series since joining the league over the weekend at Evansville. Garbella had a career-high four hits in the 11-7 victory over the nationally-ranked Fighting Illini on Tuesday. The Valpo senior also made significant contributions in Friday's 7-2 win over Evansville, launching his team-leading sixth home run of the season, racking up a season-high five RBIs (all in the first two innings) and recording his fifth straight multi-hit game.

Connor Sechler (MSU) – Freshman reliever Connor Sechler closed out a pair of Missouri State victories as part of the Bears' three-game Valley sweep of Illinois State over the weekend. Sechler held the Redbirds hitless over a combined 3 2/3 scoreless innings, fanning seven batters while earning his third and fourth saves of the season. The Bolivar, Mo., native struck out five hitters over the final 2.1 innings of the Bears' 4-2 victory in the series opener, then logged an inning and a third in game two, retiring all four ISU hitters he faced to lock up the 6-3 win.

Dylan Givens (SIU) – Dylan Givens pitched seven shutout innings, allowing just three hits in SIU's 3-2 win over Belmont on Tuesday at Itchy Jones Stadium. Givens limited the Bruins to a .125 batting average. Belmont led off the game with a double, and Givens didn't allow that run to score. After that, Belmont didn't advance another runner into scoring position for the duration of his appearance.

Jon Tieman (VALPO) – Tieman threw his first career complete game in Friday's 7-2 win over Evansville to open the three-game series. He scattered nine hits and permitted only two earned runs while racking up a season-high eight strikeouts. He earned his fourth win of the year, matching his season win total from his rookie campaign. The CG marked the third by a Valpo pitcher this season, all in the last three weeks.

Four in RPI's Top-100

Four league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by DBU (No. 41), Missouri State (No. 65), Bradley (No. 76) and Indiana State (No. 88).

Another three teams, Illinois State (No. 104), Southern Illinois (No. 127) and Valparaiso (No. 159), also rank in the RPI's top-175.

Valley RPI Ranks No. 10

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (April 23), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues, moving down one position from last week. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fourth. The Mountain West, Sun Belt, Atlantic Sun, Big Ten and MVC round out the top 10.

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 15 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a winning record vs. the Big 12 (6-5), while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 5-12 vs. the Big Ten, 1-3 against the ACC and 0-8 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Bradley, Indiana State and Southern Illinois each have one Power Five win, while Missouri State has two, Illinois State and Valparaiso has three and DBU four.

This week's schedule features seven games against Power Five teams. On Tuesday, Valparaiso will travel to Notre Dame, Missouri State will face Missouri, DBU will host Oklahoma State and Bradley will head to Illinois. Indiana State will face Louisville on the road for a three-game series over the weekend.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 15 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Big 12, Conference USA, Horizon, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another leagues (American).

Top 50 RPI Wins

Four league teams have won two or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 3-5 against the Top 50, while Bradley (2-4), Missouri State (2-6) and Illinois State (2-6) each have two wins.

Another Top 25 Win

Valparaiso earned its first win over a Top 25 opponent this season, beating #25 Illinois 11-7 Tuesday. The MVC has won eight games against top-25 opponents so far this season. DBU has five of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU and #4 Texas Tech. Missouri State and Southern Illinois also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Bears beat #24 East Carolina and the Salukis beat #24 Illinois.

Projected Field

Baseball America has two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of April 19. The publication has DBU as a No. 2 seed in the Corvallis (Oregon State) Regional and Missouri State as a No. 3 seed in the Fayetteville (Arkansas) Regional. The Bears are also currently listed as one of the "Last Four In".

Streaking at Horner

DBU holds an 18-4 home record during the 2018 season and has a current Horner Ballpark win streak of 8 consecutive victories since March 20. The streak includes wins over a pair of ranked opponents, beating #23 TCU and #4 Texas Tech. The Patriots will put that streak to the test against #23 Oklahoma State Tuesday.

Quick Starts Crucial

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule.

In the last eight seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

Back-to-Back

Missouri State is looking to become just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles, as Wichita State remains the only league school to have ever accomplished this feat. The Shockers won back-to-back titles in 2007-2008, were winners of 14 consecutive regular-season championships from 1987-2000 (includes one shared championship with Southern Illinois in 1990).

Bradley used nine pitchers during its three games last week and after Wednesday starter Mitch Janssen allowed two first-inning runs in Wednesday's 9-2 win against Western Illinois, the nine hurlers combined to finish the week on a streak of 22.2 consecutive scoreless innings ... Janssen induced an inning-ending double play after the Leathernecks struck for their two first-inning runs and the Braves did not allow another run, defeating Western Illinois 9-2 and sweeping RMU-Springfield 17-0 and 10-0, both in seven innings ... The scoreless streak currently is the third longest in program history and the team's longest since its record 34.1 innings of shutout baseball Feb. 15-27, 2015.



Illinois Road Trip

Bradley's two midweek games this week both will be played on the road against in-state competition, Tuesday night at Illinois and Wednesday afternoon at Chicago State ... The Braves are 5-0 against teams from the state of Illinois this season, including a 14-7 win April 4 at Western Illinois in their only in-state road game to date this season ... Bradley has won six consecutive in-state road games, including a 2-0 victory March 28, 2017 at Illinois, as well as 9-of-11 in-state road games since the start of the 2015 season: at Illinois (1-0), at Illinois State (2-1), at Northern Illinois (1-0), at Northwestern (0-1), at Southern Illinois (3-0), at SIU Edwardsville (1-0) and at Western Illinois (1-0).

Multiple Six-Game Streaks

Bradley begins the week riding a 6-game winning streak ... Earlier this season, the Braves enjoyed an 8-game winning streak from Feb. 17-March 4 ... Bradley has not enjoyed two winning streaks of at least six games in the same season since 2007, when the Braves rode winning streaks of seven games (March 13-22) and 10 games (April 22-May 12) to a 32-21 final record.

Brown Building Momentum

Bears third baseman Matt Brown has locked his game into high gear over the last three weeks, turning in a hot streak at the plate that has seen the senior post a career-best 10-game hit streak since April 6. Brown has hit .353 (12-for-34) with three home runs and 12 RBIs over the course of the streak. Since March 14, Brown has logged a team-best .479 on-base percentage to help the Bears win 16 of their 22 contests.



Streaking Again

After registering a record-setting 22-game win streak in Missouri Valley Conference play over the previous two seasons, the Bears have continued their winning ways at home this spring to fashion yet another memorable string of victories. With their three-game sweep of Illinois State over the weekend, the Bears stretched their Hammons Field win streak to 21 straight regular-season wins over Valley foes. MSU, which last suffered a home setback to an MVC opponent on May 8, 2016 vs. Southern Illinois, has hit .338 and outscored the opposition by a 184-65 margin over the course of the streak.

Guttin Gains Ground

With Missouri State's 6-3 win over Illinois State Saturday, Bears head coach Keith Guttin moved past former Southern Illinois coach Itchy Jones into sole possession of the No. 21 spot on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list. With a career record of 1,244-770 (.618), Guttin needs 11 more wins to catch Jack Stallings (Wake Forest, Florida State and Georgia Southern) and move into the top 20. Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranks sixth among all active Division I head coaches.

Blackfan's Hitting Streak

Logan Blackfan extended his active hitting streak to 20 games, the second-longest in the MVC this season and the longest for an SIU player since 2012 (Chris Serritella). He is the 11th player in the NCAA to record a 20-game hitting streak this year. Blackfan's streak is tied for the fifth-longest in SIU history.



Netemeyer Back on Track

SIU's all-time saves leader, Ryan Netemeyer, blew a save at No. 24 Dallas Baptist on April 14, but he bounced back last week. In three innings, Netemeyer limited opponents to 1-for-10 from the plate with seven strikeouts. Two of those three innings came against No. 21 Tennessee Tech, which is leading the nation in almost every offensive category, including batting average, home runs, and runs per game. Netemeyer struck out five in two innings and did not allow a walk or a run against TTU.

Ranked vs. Unranked

Southern Illinois has lost six of its last eight games, but all six losses are against ranked opponents. Since March 5, SIU is just 1-8 against ranked opponents, but the Salukis are 16-4 against unranked opponents to keep the overall record at 20-20.

Top 25 Win

On the exact 55-year anniversary of Valpo's most recent win over Illinois, the Crusaders beat the No. 25 Fighting Illini 11-7 last Tuesday in Champagne. It marked just the second time all season Illinois had lost a game by more than three runs. The Crusaders also beat a Top 25 team in 2016, topping No. 25 Dallas Baptist 6-1. Illinois entered the game ranked 25th by Baseball America, 27th in the RPI and 17th by Collegiate Baseball Newspaper. Illinois had won five straight and 22 of its previous 27. The 11 runs are the most Illinois has given up in a loss all year.



Early Offense

Valpo has scored a first-inning run in five straight games, jumping out to the early edge before the Crusader starting pitcher ever takes the mound in each of those contests. This past week, the Crusaders made early exits for opposing hurlers a trend. They bounced Illinois' starter from the game before he recorded an out and scored four earned runs against him on Tuesday. In the weekend series, Evansville's starters lasted 3 2/3 innings, one inning and 1/3 of an inning against the Valpo offense.

Providing Relief

Valpo senior Hayden Kissee had a strong week out of the Valpo bullpen. First, he worked two scoreless frames to gain the win against nationally-ranked Illinois on Tuesday, his first victory of the season. Then, the right-hander worked out of a challenging jam after inheriting two baserunners with nobody out in the seventh inning in Sunday's 6-1 win over Evansville. Kissee induced a double play, got out of the inning with a shallow fly ball and went on to pitch three scoreless frames to close out Valpo's first conference series win since joining the MVC. Kissee was awarded his first save of the season.
