### Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

#### Alex Lyon, Jr., IF, Southern Illinois

Southern Illinois' Alex Lyon went 8-for-18 (.444) with five RBI and five stolen bases during SIU's 4-0 week. He had two doubles and a triple to post a .667 slugging percentage and scored four runs in wins against SEMO and Evansville. He was a perfect five-for-five stealing bases and played flawless defense for the Salukis, and he added a sacrifice fly. In Sunday's sweep of Evansville, Lyon went 2-for-4 with four RBI, with a double and a triple.

### Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

#### Mitch Janssen, Jr., RHP, Bradley

Janssen made two starts during the week, helping the Braves to two of their three wins during the week. In his two outings, Janssen was 1-0 with a 0.87 ERA, working a combined 10.1 innings and allowing just one run on three hits (.091 BA) with three walks and 14 strikeouts. He began the week by working the first 3.2 innings at Illinois, where he exited after 72 pitches with a 3-1 lead after allowing the lone run on one hit with two walks and four strikeouts. The Braves went on to win Tuesday's game against the Illini, 5-4, in 11 innings. In an emergency start Saturday and working on just three days rest, Janssen responded with a career-best 10 strikeouts while holding Missouri State scoreless on two hits and a walk in his 6.2 innings. After Jeremy Eierman singled and was promptly thrown out trying to steal for the second out of the first inning, Janssen retired 18 straight Bears before allowing a two-out double by Drew Millas in the seventh. He retired 10 of those 18 consecutive batters by strikeout.

### NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Devlin Granberg (DBU)** – DBU senior Devlin Granberg hit a team-best .476 (9-for-19) for the Patriots last week. Granberg led the DBU offensive attack in seven categories including average (.476), hits (9), runs (5), slugging percentage (.579), on-base percentage (.500), total bases (11), and stolen bases (3). Granberg had a pair of doubles and four RBI during the week for DBU. The Patriots senior outfielder also extended his season-high hit streak to 15 games and has reached safely in 35 straight contests.

**Owen Miller (ILS)** – Batted .667 during the week (8-of-12), while scoring three times. He had a double, and an RBI, and had a slugging percentage of .750. He walked twice and didn't strike out, while hitting a sacrifice fly. Additionally he was perfect in the field in 15 chances during the three games. Had multiple hits in every game during the week, including three at Illinois Wesleyan, three at Butler, and two at home against Butler. Is on a current 15-game hitting streak, with his last game without a hit coming on April 6.

**Dane Giesler (INS)** – Indiana State's Dane Giesler sent three home runs over the fence in the last week, including a pair at Northern Illinois. Giesler finished with a .400 batting average to go with an .850 slugging percentage and a .478 on-base percentage. He led the team with six runs batted in, scored four times and drew a pair of walks. He also recorded a team-high three hits at Ball State for the Trees.

**Chad Jacob (VALPO)** – Jacob posted a team-high .429 average over four games this week, a breakout offensive week after he entered last Tuesday's game at Notre Dame with a .215 average. The Valpo senior had at least one hit in all four games this week against DBU and Notre Dame, including a season-high three hits in a Friday game that saw Jacob reach base in all four plate appearances.

**Trevor Conn (DBU)** – DBU redshirt-senior Trevor Conn threw a career-high 7.0 shutout innings on Saturday versus Valparaiso. In the Patriots' win over the Crusaders, Conn surrendered just six hits and walked one, while striking out three.

**Matt Walker (ILS)** – Pitched a career-high seven innings of shutout baseball at home against Butler on April 29. He struck out four and gave up five hits; however, just once did a baserunner reach third base in the game – an eventual 2-1 Illinois State win. Saw his ERA drop from 5.26 to 4.47 in the outing, as he had a game WHIP of 1.0 (five hits, two walks). His 98 pitches in the game were tied for his second-most this season. Illinois State is 8-3 this season in games in which he pitches.

**Weston Rivers (INS)** – Weston River put together another dominant week on the mound for the Sycamores. The lefty finished with a 0.75 ERA in 12 innings over the course of two starts. He allowed just three base hits and one earned run while holding opponents to a 0.77 average against. Rivers went five complete innings against Ball State Wednesday, allowing just one hit and an unearned run while striking out two Cardinals to pick up his second win of the year. Rivers made his fourth start of the season at No. 24 Louisville Sunday, allowing just one run and two hits to go with a pair of strikeouts in the no decision. Rivers retired 17-of-18 Louisville batters from the second to the seventh inning en route to the no-decision as ISU rallied to score three runs in the ninth to beat the Cardinals.

**Ty Buckner (MSU)** – Freshman right-hander Ty Buckner logged a pair of strong starts for the Bears last week, including a complete-game one-hitter in the rubber match of the Bears' MVC road series with Bradley. The St. Louis native took a no-hitter into the sixth inning, retiring the first nine BU hitters of the game and allowing only two baserunners through the first five frames. He struck out six and allowed just a sixth-inning triple in the first complete-game one-hitter by a Bear since Matt Hall throttled Arkansas in the second game of the 2015 NCAA Fayetteville Super Regional. Buckner, who struck out 11 in 11.1 combined innings last week, also started Tuesday's midweek contest with Mizzou, striking out five Tigers in his 4.1 innings.

**Michael Baird (SIU)** – Michael Baird pitched a complete-game shutout with 12 strikeouts in SIU's 2-0 win at Evansville on Friday night. Baird allowed just five hits and struck out 12 while walking only one—facing just six over the minimum in his complete game. Baird held the Aces to a .167 average, and the Aces only advanced a runner to third base twice during the game. Baird's 12 strikeouts were a career high as he completed his 27th career quality start and second career complete-game shutout.

**Wes Gordon (VALPO)** – Gordon limited a DBU team that entered Sunday's game atop the Missouri Valley Conference to two runs on five hits in a complete-game victory, helping the Crusaders avoid a series sweep at the hands of the Patriots. He did not yield a run until the eighth inning against a formidable offense. This marked the first complete-game of Gordon's career. He struck out five and issued three walks.

## Four in RPI's Top-85

Four league teams continue to rank in the top-85 of the RPI, led by DBU (No. 42), Missouri State (No. 51), Bradley (No. 70) and Indiana State (No. 83).

Another three teams, Illinois State (No. 101), Southern Illinois (No. 134) and Valparaiso (No. 170), also rank in the RPI's top-175.

## Valley RPI Ranks No. 10

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (April 30), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits third. The Big Ten, Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt, Mountain West and MVC round out the top 10.

## Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has 17 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a .500 record vs. the Big 12 (6-6), while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 6-12 vs. the Big Ten, 2-6 against the ACC and 0-9 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Southern Illinois has one Power Five win, while Bradley, Indiana State and Missouri State have two, Illinois State and Valparaiso three and DBU four.

This week's schedule features three games against Power Five teams. On Tuesday, Southern Illinois will travel to Illinois. DBU will face TCU in Fort Worth on Wednesday, while Missouri State will play host to Kansas.

## Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Conference USA, Horizon, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against another two leagues (American and Big 12).

## Top 50 RPI Wins

Six league teams have won two or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 5-7 against the Top 50, while Valparaiso (3-3) has three wins. Bradley (2-4), Missouri State (2-7), Indiana State (2-7) and Illinois State (2-5) each have two wins.

## Another Top 25 Win

Indiana State earned its first win over a Top 25 opponent this season, beating #24 Louisville 3-1 on Sunday. The MVC has won nine games against top-25 opponents so far this season. DBU has five of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU and #4 Texas Tech. Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Bears beat #24 East Carolina, the Salukis beat #24 Illinois and the Crusaders beat #25 Illinois.

## Projected Field

Baseball America continues to have two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of April 25. The publication has DBU as a No. 3 seed in the Austin (Texas) Regional and Missouri State as a No. 3 seed in the Stanford Regional. The Bears are also currently listed as one of the "Last Four In".

## Winning in Tough Places

Indiana State became just the second team in the last three seasons to go to Louisville and win a non-conference game against the Cardinals. Only Texas Tech and Indiana State have won games inside Jim Patterson Stadium over the last three seasons as the Cardinals are 90-16 during the stretch.

## Patriot Power

DBU's offense currently ranks top-15 nationally in three power categories entering this week's action. The Patriots sit 5th in doubles per game (2.39), 15th in home runs per game (1.22) and 13th in slugging percentage (.469).

## Award Nominees Galore

The bevy of award watch lists has several MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman is among 40 players on the Golden Spikes Award mid-season watch list, which honors the top baseball player in the country.

Missouri State's Jake Fromson and Southern Illinois' Ryan Netemeyer are listed among 52 student-athletes on the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

DBU's Matt Duce, Illinois State's Collin Braithwaite and Valpo's Scott Kapers were named to the 2018 Johnny Bench Award watch list, given annually to the top Division I catcher. The list will be narrowed down to semifinalists on May 16.

Five MVC shortstops are among 53 Division I shortstops listed on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List. MSU's Jeremy Eierman, DBU's Jimmy Glowenke, SIU's Connor Kopach, Illinois State's Owen Miller and Valpo's Sam Shaikin are listed among the group. The Valley's five honorees only trails the ACC (9) and SEC (8) nationally.

## Preseason All-Americans

Two Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to the D1Baseball.com All-American team, as announced by the organization. Missouri State shortstop Jeremy Eierman was a first-team selection, while DBU outfielder Jameson Hannah was a third-team choice.

Eierman was also a first-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and a second-team selection by the NCBWA. MSU teammate Jake Fromson was also honored by Collegiate Baseball, earning second-team honors.

## Quick Starts Crucial

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule.

In the last eight seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

## Back-to-Back

Missouri State is looking to become just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles, as Wichita State remains the only league school to have ever accomplished this feat. The Shockers won back-to-back titles in 2007-2008, were winners of 14 consecutive regular-season championships from 1987-2000 (includes one shared championship with Southern Illinois in 1990).

#### Walk Off Winner...Again

For the third time in less than 30 days, the Illinois State Redbirds closed a series with a walk-off win, this time against Butler, on Apr. 29, when Derek Parola hit a sacrifice fly to center field, scoring Joe Aeilts who singled and advanced to third on a sacrifice bunt/error. The Redbirds also had series-ending walk-off wins against Southern Illinois (Mar. 31) and Dallas Baptist (Apr. 8).



#### Hit Streak

Illinois State junior shortstop Owen Miller is on a current 15-game hitting streak, the second-longest such streak by a Redbird player this season, second only to John Rave's 17-game mark snapped on April 4. During his hitting streak, over half of those games (eight total) he has had multiple hits. He has seen his batting average rise from .333 before the streak to its current total of .374, second-highest in the MVC this season.

#### Slick Fielding

The Redbirds this season have a fielding percentage of .979 (1,011 putouts, 370 assists, 29 errors). That is the 16th-best fielding percentage in the country this season, and best in the Missouri Valley Conference. Yale currently leads the country in fielding percentage at .985, just six thousandth's of a point ahead of Illinois State.

The Potosi, Mo., product picked up his league-leading seventh mound victory of the season last Friday with a 5-4 decision over Bradley, marking the 21st win of his Missouri State career. That total moved him into a tie for the No. 6 spot on MSU's career chart, while his nine strikeouts allowed him to climb to third on the Bears' all-time K's list (276).
