### Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

#### Owen Miller, Jr., SS, Illinois State

Miller batted .714 during the week (10-of-14) with four runs scored. Hit for the cycle in the series finale against Valparaiso, going 5-for-5 in the game. Had three RBI's during the week, while adding a stolen base. In the series opener he went 2-for-4 at the plate with an RBI. On Saturday he had a 3-for-5 outing with a run scored and an RBI. He also swiped his only base of the week in the middle game of the series.

He had a spectacular ending to the week by going 5-for-5 at the plate with three runs scored and driving in one run. He opened the game with a single in the first inning and followed with a solo home run in the second inning. He singled again in the fourth inning, before hitting a triple off the top of the center field wall in the sixth inning. In his final at-bat of the game, he doubled down the right field line to close out the cycle. He has nine multi-hit games in his last 11 contests, and he saw his batting average rise from .374 entering the week to its current standing of .397. Miller's five hits in the game are tied for the 12th-most hits in a game in the NCAA this season.

### Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

#### Dylan Coleman, Jr., RHP, Missouri State

Missouri State junior right-hander Dylan Coleman lifted the Bears to a 5-3 victory over Southern Illinois with eight strong innings in the opening game of the two clubs' series on Friday. Coleman matched a career high with 13 strikeouts, while allowing just two third-inning SIU runs on four hits to notch his eighth win of the season—and his 21st victory overall as a Bear. In the process, he became just the second pitcher in program history to reach the 100-strikeout plateau in back-to-back seasons, joining three-time All-American Nick Petree on that distinguished list.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Tim Millard (DBU)** – DBU redshirt-junior Tim Millard helped lead the Patriots to a 4-0 week after hitting a team-best .500 (8-for-16) with two home runs and seven RBI. Millard posted an .875 slugging percentage and a .550 on-base percentage to lead a Patriots' offensive attack that scored 41 runs in four games. In Saturday's win over Bradley, Millard hit his 12th home run of the year, which placed him atop the Missouri Valley Conference in home runs. It also marked Millard's 26th career home run, which ties him for the 10th most home runs in DBU Baseball's Division I era dating back to 2004.

**Kenton Crews (UE)** – In four games last week, Crews went 7-for-15 (.467 BA) including a 3-run triple against Tennessee-Martin. The Lincoln City, Ind. native also had an impressive .667 slugging percentage.

**Romero Harris (INS)** – Designated hitter Romero Harris has been a welcomed sight to the Sycamore lineup following an injury. Harris finished the week with a team-high .462 batting average, going 6-of-13 at the plate. The junior also led the squad in slugging percentage, collecting three extra-base hits in a weekend series with Evansville. Harris notched his eighth home run of the year in game one of the series. He went on to add a pair of doubles in the 14-9 series finale win for the Trees. In total, the Navarre, Ohio native scored three times and drove in three.

**Ben Whetstone (MSU)** – Sophomore first baseman Ben Whetstone led the Bears offense with a .455 average, playing pivotal roles in each of MSU's three weekend wins over Southern Illinois. Whetstone logged a pair of two-hit games, homering twice and driving in four runs in the series to help extend the Bears Valley home win streak to 24 straight games. He sparked the decisive rally in Friday's opener with a sixth-inning single as part of a 2-for-3 night, then ignited two more MSU scoring rallies in game two, going 2-for-4 with a home run, two runs scored and two RBIs. Finally, he belted the go-ahead two-run homer in Sunday's finale to help finish off the sweep.

**Jared Kengott (SIU)** – Jared Kengott, who had only made seven starts this season prior to the weekend, went 6-for-11 in the series at Missouri State. He hit .545 and slugged .727 thanks to two doubles. He also drove in a run and stole a base, and he played flawless defense while adding an outfield assist.

**Blake Billinger (VALPO)** – Billinger became the first player in the Missouri Valley Conference to enjoy a three homer game this season, doubling his season home run total from three to six on Tuesday at Western Michigan. He became the first Valpo player in 10 years with three home runs in a game. In addition, Billinger roped his league-leading 22nd double on Sunday at Illinois State, moving into sole possession of second in program history for doubles in a single season and pulling to within one of tying the program record.

**Luke Eldred (DBU)** – DBU redshirt-freshman Luke Eldred improved to 5-2 on the season after shutting out Bradley and allowing just one hit over 5.0 innings of work. Eldred needed just 69 pitches over 5.0 innings of work and walked just one batter on the day. In 42.1 innings this year, Eldred has now issued just one walk on the season.

**Tyler Whitbread (INS)** – Junior Tyler Whitbread made two appearances out of the bullpen for the Sycamores during a weekend series win against Evansville. The right-hander finished with four innings pitched, allowing just two hits and striking out a pair of Evansville batters. In total, Whitbread held UE scoreless while on the mound and held the Aces to a .154 batting average against over the two outings. The Camlachie, Ontario product went two and two-third innings in Friday's game, allowing just one baserunner and striking out two.

**Michael Baird (SIU)** – Michael Baird poured in his 28th career quality start at Missouri State on Friday night, allowing just two earned runs in 7.2 innings. He struck out nine while walking just two and held the Bears to a .185 average. The only two runs he gave up came on a wind-blown home run with 20-mph winds blowing out. In the last month, Baird has pitched against three top-40 RPI teams likely to make the NCAA Tournament—all on the road (@DBU, @Tennessee Tech, and @Missouri State), and he has a 1.93 ERA with 21 strikeouts over those three starts.

**Jon Tieman (VALPO)** – Tieman hurled his second complete game of the season, holding Illinois State to one run on eight hits to garner his fifth victory of the year. The Crusaders needed the strong effort from Tieman, as they edged the Redbirds 2-1 in Friday's series opener. Tieman pitched to contact for most of the game, as he did not garner his first strike out until the eighth inning and finished with four for the game. The right-hander displayed good control in his 132-pitch performance, issuing just two walks. Tieman's outing allowed Valpo to win for the first time all season when scoring fewer than five runs in a game.

## Back-to-Back

Missouri State is looking to become just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles, as Wichita State remains the only school to have ever accomplished this feat. The Shockers won back-to-back titles in 2007-2008, were winners of 14 consecutive regular-season championships from 1987-2000 (includes one shared championship with Southern Illinois in 1990).

The Bears are also looking to post the best two-year record in Valley history (since moving to expanded MVC schedule in 1985), currently sitting at 34-3 (.919) over the last two seasons in MVC play. The 1993 and 1994 Shockers hold the MVC record, going 36-5 (.878) over a two-season span.

## Streaking!

With a pair of sweeps over the weekend, DBU and Missouri State maintained their winning streaks. The Patriots beat #9 Texas Tech and swept Bradley to run their win streak to 7-straight, while Missouri State claimed a sweep of Southern Illinois to see its streak reach six-straight.

## Five in RPI's Top-100

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by DBU (No. 29), Missouri State (No. 42), Bradley (No. 79), Indiana State (No. 80) and Illinois State (No. 98).

## Valley RPI Ranks No. 10

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (May 14), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fourth. The Big Ten, Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt, Mountain West and MVC round out the top 10.

## Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 18 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a 7-8 mark against the Big 12, while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 6-13 vs. the Big Ten, 2-6 against the ACC and 0-9 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Southern Illinois has one Power Five win, while Bradley, Indiana State and Missouri State have two, Illinois State and Valparaiso three and DBU has five (Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas Tech, twice).

This week's schedule features one game against a Power Five team. On Tuesday, Indiana State will visit Missouri.

## Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Conference USA, Horizon, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against the American.

## Top 50 RPI Wins

Four league teams have won three or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 4-5 against the Top 50, while Bradley (4-8) also have four wins. Indiana State (3-9) and Valparaiso (3-6) have three wins vs. the Top 50.

## Top 25 Wins

The MVC has won 10 games against top-25 opponents this season. DBU has six of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU, #4 Texas Tech and #9 Texas Tech. Indiana State, Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Sycamores beat #24 Louisville, the Bears beat #24 East Carolina, the Salukis beat #24 Illinois and the Crusaders beat #25 Illinois.

## Projected Field

Baseball America continues to have two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of May 9. The publication has DBU as a No. 3 seed in the Auburn Regional and Missouri State as a No. 3 seed in the Chapel Hill (North Carolina) Regional. The Bears are also listed as one of the "Last Four" teams in the field. D1Baseball.com also has DBU (No. 3 in Fayetteville) and Missouri State (No. 3 in Stillwater) in the field of 64.

## One Run Success

Missouri State has proven to be proficient in close encounters this spring, with wins in 11 of its 12 one-run decisions, including a 5-0 mark in league play. That record represents a turnaround from the Bears' combined 9-15 record in one-run affairs over the previous two seasons. This season, the rest of the MVC is a combined 27-45 in one run games.

## Patriot Power

DBU's offense currently ranks top-25 nationally in five major categories entering this week's action. The Patriots sit 5th in doubles (120), 22nd in home runs (59), 25th in on-base percentage (.394), 21st in runs scored (358) and 14th in slugging percentage (.474).

## Back-to-Back Batting Title?

DBU's Devlin Granberg boast the top batting average (.409) in the Missouri Valley Conference and is looking to become the first Patriot to hit .400 or better since Jason Krizan hit .413 in 2011. He is currently one of 11 players nationally hitting over .400 this season (ranks 7th). Granberg is also seeking to set the all-time career batting average record at DBU. In two seasons as a Patriot, Granberg owns a .385 average, which is currently 13 percentage points better than Krizan, who holds the current record with a .372 average. Only once in MVC history has a player won back-to-back batting titles as Wichita State's Pat Magness accomplished the honor during the 1997 (.409) and 1998 (.464) seasons. Granberg won the 2017 MVC batting title with a .359 average.

The senior currently leads the MVC in batting average (.409, 7th in NCAA), slugging % (.616, 73rd in NCAA), on-base % (.518, 7th in NCAA), total bases (122, 42nd in NCAA) and walks (42, 23rd in NCAA).

## Winning in Tough Places

Indiana State became just the second team in the last three seasons to go to Louisville and win a non-conference game against the Cardinals. Only Texas Tech and Indiana State have won games inside Jim Patterson Stadium over the last three seasons as the Cardinals are 90-16 overall and 70-2 against non-conference foes during the stretch.

## Award Nominees Galore

The bevy of award watch lists has several MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman is among 40 players on the Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list, which honors the top baseball player in the country.

Missouri State's Jake Fromson and Southern Illinois' Ryan Netemeyer are listed among 52 student-athletes on the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

Bradley's Keaton Rice, DBU's Matt Duce, Illinois State's Collin Braithwaite and Valpo's Scott Kapers were named to the 2018 Johnny Bench Award watch list, given annually to the top Division I catcher. The list will be narrowed down to semifinalists on May 16.

Five MVC shortstops are among 53 Division I shortstops listed on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List. MSU's Jeremy Eierman, DBU's Jimmy Glownke, SIU's Connor Kopach, Illinois State's Owen Miller and Valpo's Sam Shaikin are listed among the group. The Valley's five honorees only trails the ACC (9) and SEC (8) nationally.

## Preseason All-Americans

Two Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to the D1Baseball.com All-American team, as announced by the organization. Missouri State shortstop Jeremy Eierman was a first-team selection, while DBU outfielder Jameson Hannah was a third-team choice.

Eierman was also a first-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and a second-team selection by the NCBWA. MSU teammate Jake Fromson was also honored by Collegiate Baseball, earning second-team honors.

## Multi-Bid League

Since the 1981 season (36 seasons), the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA Tournament 24 times (67%). On seven occasions (1985, 1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015) the MVC has put three teams into the NCAA field.

## Valley Road Wins

After finishing 6-14 in Valley play last year, Bradley already owns seven MVC road wins this season. The Braves were 0-9 in MVC road games last season and went 0-11 away from home against Valley competition when you include the two MVC Tournament losses in Springfield, MO. In the 38 seasons since recorded Missouri Valley Conference play resumed in 1981, Bradley is guaranteed a winning Valley road record for just the fifth time.



## Quickest to 30

Bradley takes a 29-15 record into the week, leaving the Braves with at least six more games to reach 30 wins for the season. In the 118th season of Bradley Baseball, the Braves have won as many as 30 games in a season just 15 times, most recently in 2015. Tuesday's non-conference finale at SIUE be Bradley's 45th game of the year. Of the 15 30-win seasons in program history, the Braves reached their 30th win by the 45th game only four times, most recently in the 42nd game of the 1996 season.

## Owning the Land of Lincoln

Going back to the May 4-5 series at Illinois State, Bradley is finishing the regular season by playing eight of its final 11 games against Illinois public schools Illinois State, SIUE and Southern Illinois. The Braves are 41-15 (.732) against Illinois teams since the start of the 2014 season, including a 10-1 record this season. Included in that record is a 31-13 (.705) mark against eight of the nine Illinois NCAA Division I "state" schools (no games vs Eastern Illinois). Bradley finishes the regular season by visiting SIUE and Southern Illinois.

## Streaking at Hammons

MSU, which last suffered a regular-season home setback to an MVC opponent on May 8, 2016 vs. SIU, has hit .331 and outscored the opposition by a 211-80 margin over the course of the streak.



## Eierman Making History

Bears junior All-American Jeremy Eierman added another chapter to his illustrious MSU career Saturday, when the shortstop became the first member of Missouri State's career 40-40 club. Eierman led off the Bears' three-run sixth inning with the 40th round-tripper of his MSU career to become the first player in Bears history to record both 40 homers and 40 stolen bases. For good measure, he closed his home season out in style, belting a two-run shot in perhaps his final Hammons Field at-bat in the bottom of the eighth inning of Sunday's 8-3 victory.

## Thrice Would Be Nice

Missouri State will take a one-game lead over DBU in the MVC standings into the two clubs' series this weekend in Dallas. The Bears are aiming for their third MVC regular-season title in the last four seasons and their sixth overall since joining the league in 1991. Wichita State was the last Valley team to win three regular-season titles in a four-year span, claiming league crowns in 2008, 2009 and 2010.

The Salukis have finished fourth each of the last two years and were picked fourth in this year's preseason poll. ## Billinger Belting Doubles

Valpo's Blake Billinger is on the verge of etching his name atop the program's single-season doubles list. He has 22 doubles this season – already second most in program history – and needs just one to tie and two to break Kyle Muhlsteff's single-season program record of 23 established in 2010.



## Billinger Bombs

Blake Billinger homered in three consecutive plate appearances last Tuesday at Western Michigan, becoming the first Valpo player to launch three home runs in a game since Andrew Quinnette in 2008. Earlier this season, Billinger also became the first Valpo player with a three-double game since Quinnette in 2008. He was the first player in The Valley with a three-homer game this year and the 23rd nationally. Billinger became the first Valpo player since Quinnette in 2008 with 12 total bases in a single game on Tuesday.

## More Tuesday Tidbits

Valpo and Western Michigan combined for 64 total bases, the most in a Valpo game since Valpo and Butler combined for 73 on April 26, 2008. Valpo totaled 35 bases, the most by the Crusaders since they had 40 on April 3, 2010 against Chicago State. Valpo had six hit batters on Tuesday, the team's most since at least 2005. The Crusaders also set 2018 game highs in home runs with four and matched two other games (against Milwaukee and Grand Canyon) for the season high for hits with 18.
