Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Matt Brown, Sr., 3B, Missouri State

Missouri State senior third baseman Matt Brown led the Bears to a Valley title-clinching series win at DBU over the weekend, hitting .444 with three critical home runs, five RBI and six runs scored. Brown posted 2-for-4 performances in each of the Bears' two victories over the Patriots. In Friday's 9-5 win, he belted a home run and scored three times, before driving in three of the Bears' first six runs with his league-best eighth and ninth MVC round-trippers in Sunday's 10-4 decision.

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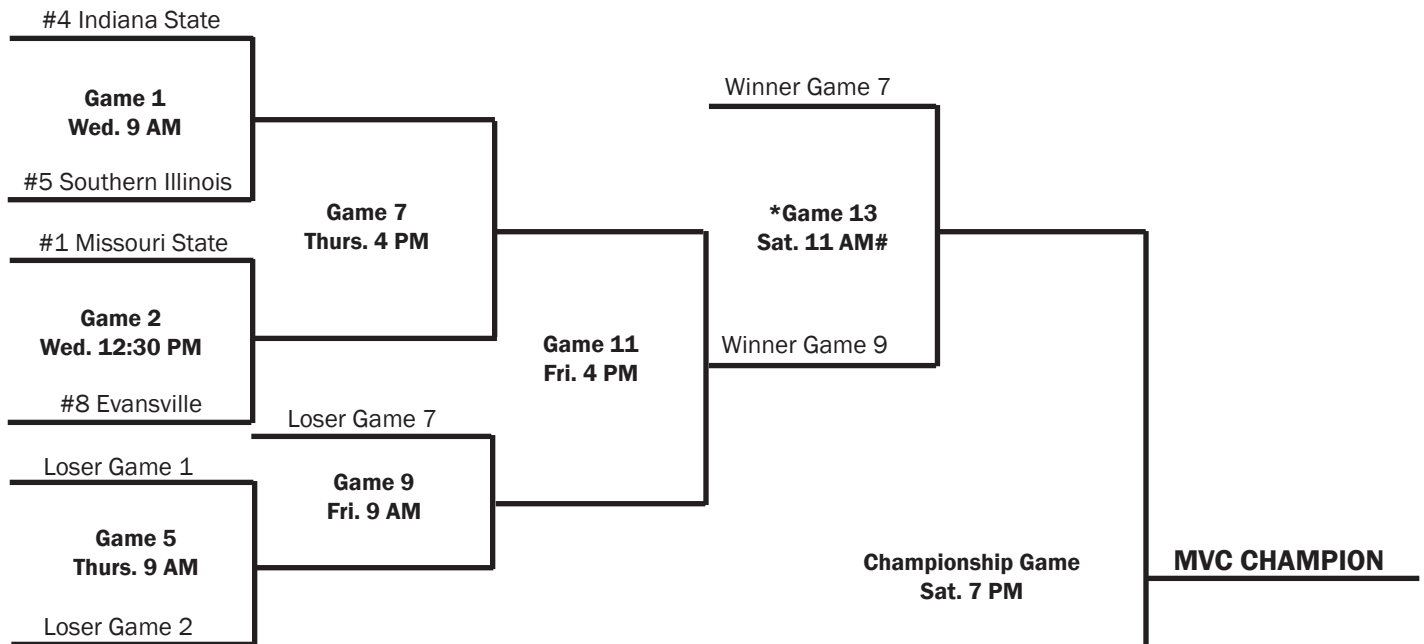


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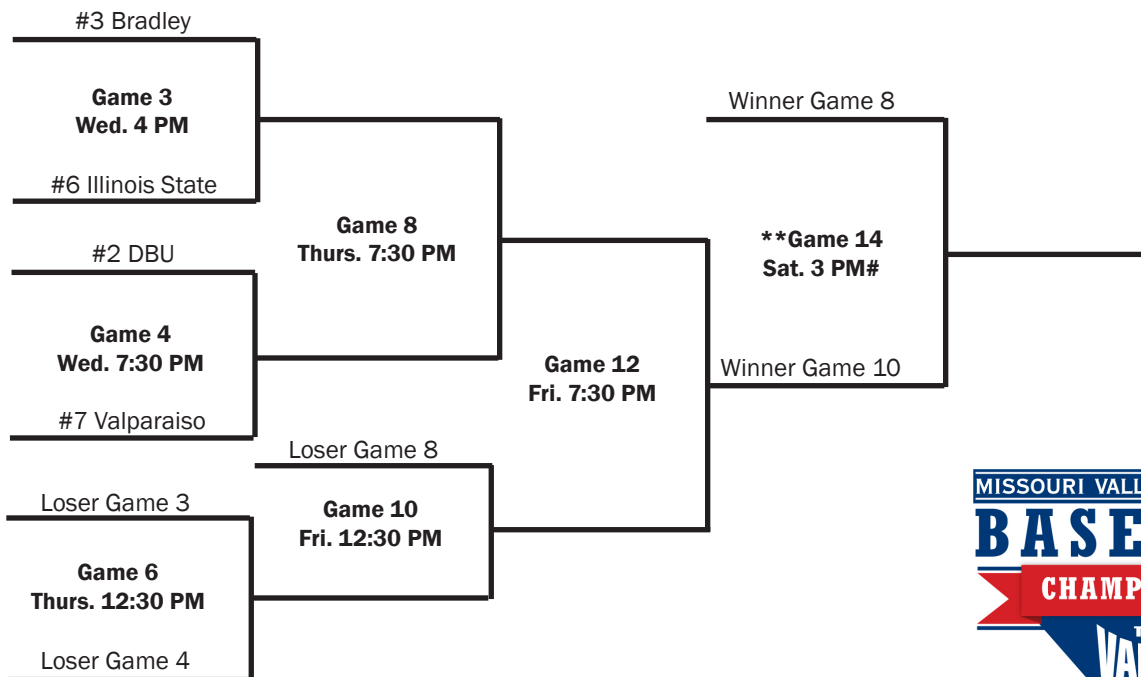

Tournament Set

Missouri State (18-3 MVC) earned the top seed at the Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Tournament, as the Bears claimed their sixth regular-season title in program history.

Dallas Baptist will be the No. 2 seed after registering a 16-5 MVC record.

Bradley claimed the No. 3 seed with an 11-10 MVC record, while Indiana State finished as the No. 4 seed at 11-10. The Sycamores will face No. 5 seed Southern Illinois in the opener after the Salukis finished 10-11 in league play.

Illinois State earned the No. 6 seed at 9-12, while Valparaiso finished as the No. 7 seed with a 6-15 conference record.

Evansville (3-18 MVC) will be the No. 8 seed in this week's MVC Tournament.

DBU to Host

Dallas Baptist University will serve as host for the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Championship for the first time in school history, from May 23-26. The 2018 event will take place at Horner Ballpark, which serves as the home field for the Patriots.

Three-Peat?

DBU will look for a third-straight title at the 2018 MVC Baseball Championship. Current league teams have won back-to-back titles four times in league history, – Southern Illinois (77-78); Indiana State (83-84); Missouri State (96-97); and DBU (16-17). The last school to win three-straight MVC Tourney titles was Wichita State, who claimed four-straight crowns from 2002-2005.

Tournament Top Dog

Indiana State boasts 67 MVC Tournament wins, the most in the league, while DBU holds the league's top winning percentage (.824) in tournament play.

Top Two Seeds Dominate

If history is any indication, being the No. 1 seed has its benefits as more MVC Tournament champions (17) have come from the top spot than any other seed dating back to 1981. The No. 2 seed has claimed 11 tournament titles, while no other seed has won more than four championships.

Patriots Tested at Home

DBU has been steady at Horner Ballpark this season, as the Patriots finished with a 23-7 record at home this season. The Patriots finished with a 7-2 mark at home during conference play, with Missouri State being the only league foe to win at Horner Ballpark this season.

Back-to-Back

Missouri State became just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles, joining Wichita State. The Shockers won back-to-back titles in 2007-2008, were winners of 14 consecutive regular-season championships from 1987-2000 (includes one shared championship with Southern Illinois in 1990).

The Bears also set a record for the best two-year record in Valley history (since moving to expanded MVC schedule in 1985). MSU posted a 36-4 (.900) mark over the last two seasons in MVC play. The 1993 and 1994 Shockers held the previous MVC record, going 36-5 (.878) over a two-season span.

Poll Position

Missouri State jumped into the Baseball America Top 25 Poll for the first time this season, appearing at No. 24 this week. The Bears also remain in the Collegiate Baseball's Top 30 Poll, sitting at No. 30 this week. DBU and Missouri State are also receiving votes in this week's USA Today Coaches Top 25 Poll and NCBWA Poll.

Four in RPI's Top-100

Four league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by Missouri State (No. 30), DBU (No. 37), Indiana State (No. 69), and Bradley (No. 81).

Valley RPI Ranks No. 10

According to the latest RPI from WarrenNolan.com (May 21), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fourth. The Big Ten, Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt, Mountain West and MVC round out the top 10.

Wins Over Power Five

During the regular season, the MVC earned 18 wins over members of Power Five conferences. Seven of the eight MVC teams earned wins against the Power Five. Southern Illinois had one Power Five win, while Bradley, Indiana State and Missouri State had two, Illinois State and Valparaiso three and DBU has five (Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, TCU, Texas Tech, twice).

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Conference USA, Horizon, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against the American.

Top 50 RPI Wins

Five league teams have won three or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 5-8 against the Top 50, while Bradley (4-8) and Indiana State (4-11) also have four wins. Missouri State (3-8) and Valparaiso (3-7) have three wins vs. the Top 50.

Top 25 Wins

The MVC won 10 games against top-25 opponents this season. DBU has six of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU, #4 Texas Tech and #9 Texas Tech. Indiana State, Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Sycamores beat #24 Louisville, the Bears beat #24 East Carolina, the Salukis beat #24 Illinois and the Crusaders beat #25 Illinois.

Projected Field

D1Baseball.com continues to have two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of May 16. The publication has DBU as a No. 3 seed in the Texas Tech Regional and Missouri State as a No. 3 seed in the East Carolina Regional. Baseball America also has DBU (No. 2 at Texas Tech) and Missouri State (No. 3 at East Carolina) in the field of 64.

One Run Success

Missouri State has proven to be proficient in close encounters this spring, with wins in 11 of its 12 one-run decisions, including a 5-0 mark in league play. That record represents a turnaround from the Bears' combined 9-15 record in one-run affairs over the previous two seasons. This season, the rest of the MVC is a combined 29-47 in one run games.

Patriot Power

DBU's offense currently ranks top-25 nationally in five major categories entering this week's action. The Patriots sit 7th in doubles (126), 20th in home runs (65), 23rd in on-base percentage (.395), 22nd in runs scored (379) and 13th in slugging percentage (.477).

Back-to-Back Batting Title?

DBU's Devlin Granberg boast the top batting average (.418) in the Missouri Valley Conference during the regular season and is looking to become the first Patriot to hit .400 or better since Jason Krizan hit .413 in 2011. He is currently one of 12 players nationally hitting over .400 this season (ranks 3rd). Granberg is also seeking to set the all-time career batting average record at DBU. In two seasons as a Patriot, Granberg owns a .391 average, which is currently 19 percentage points better than Krizan, who holds the current record with a .372 average. Only once in MVC history has a player won back-to-back batting titles as Wichita State's Pat Magness accomplished the honor during the 1997 (.409) and 1998 (.464) seasons. Granberg won the 2017 MVC batting title with a .359 average.

The senior currently leads the MVC in batting average (.418, 3rd in NCAA), on-base % (.529, 4th in NCAA), runs scored (57, 28th in NCAA), hits (87, 10th in NCAA), RBI (60, 21st in NCAA), total bases (134, 31st in NCAA) and walks (46, 20th in NCAA).

Southern Illinois senior Connor Kopach ranks first on the NCAA active career stolen base leaders chart. Kopach sits alongside Rutgers' Jawuan Harris entering this week's action.

Award Nominees Galore

The bevy of award watch lists has several MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman is among 40 players on the Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list, which honors the top baseball player in the country.

Missouri State's Jake Fromson and Southern Illinois' Ryan Netemeyer are listed among 52 student-athletes on the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

Bradley's Keaton Rice, DBU's Matt Duce, Illinois State's Collin Braithwaite and Valpo's Scott Kapers were named to the 2018 Johnny Bench Award watch list, given annually to the top Division I catcher. The list will be narrowed down to semifinalists on May 16.

Five MVC shortstops are among 53 Division I shortstops listed on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List. MSU's Jeremy Eierman, DBU's Jimmy Glowne, SIU's Connor Kopach, Illinois State's Owen Miller and Valpo's Sam Shaikin are listed among the group. The Valley's five honorees only trails the ACC (9) and SEC (8) nationally.

Preseason All-Americans

Two Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to the D1Baseball.com All-American team, as announced by the organization. Missouri State shortstop Jeremy Eierman was a first-team selection, while DBU outfielder Jameson Hannah was a third-team choice.

Eierman was also a first-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and a second-team selection by the NCBWA. MSU teammate Jake Fromson was also honored by Collegiate Baseball, earning second-team honors.

Academic All-District

Two Missouri Valley Conference baseball players have been named to the 2018 Google Cloud CoSIDA Academic All-District First Team, including Illinois State's Collin Braithwaite and DBU's Devlin Granberg. With two selections to the first team, both Valley student-athletes are now eligible for the inclusion on the Google Cloud Academic All-America® team selected by CoSIDA.

Granberg Named Howser Semifinalist

DBU outfielder Devlin Granberg was named a semifinalist for the 2018 NCBWA Dick Howser Trophy. The award, given to the top player in collegiate baseball, is based on two rounds of national voting, with the winner announced on June 15 prior to the start of the 2018 College World Series.

Multi-Bid League

Since the 1981 season (36 seasons), the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA Tournament 23 times (64%). On six occasions (1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015) the MVC has put three teams into the NCAA field.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Dalton Horstmeier (UE) – This past week Dalton Horstmeier erupted at the plate, going 9-for-15 at the plate (.600 batting average), putting up an eye-popping 1.067 slugging percentage with four doubles and a home run, while driving in ten RBI.

Collin Braithwaite (ILS) – Batted .364 during the three-game series with Evansville, scoring five runs with a double, two home runs, and seven runs batted. He also walked three times and had a .467 on-base percentage over the three games. Had a hit in all three games during the week, including two in the opener against Evansville. In the opener he went 2-of-4 at the plate while driving in a run and stealing a base. In the middle game of the series he went 1-for-4, but scored two runs and drive in four runs. He hit his first of two home runs during the week in the game, while later adding a sacrifice fly. In the series finale he went 1-for-3 at the plate, but scored three times and drove in two runs. He hit his second home run of the weekend in the series finale, while walking twice.

Jarrold Watkins (INS) – Jarrold Watkins put together one of his most complete weeks on the diamond this season over the last four games for the Sycamores. Watkins finished the week with a team-high .500 batting average, going 8-of-16 at the plate. The junior accounted for nine of the teams 37 runs on the week with six RBI and three runs scored. He also collected his team high 12th double at Mizzou. One of the best fielders on the team, Watkins assisted in all eight of the team's double plays in four games. Watkins collected multiple hits in each game at Valpo, going 3-of-3 with three RBI in game two.

Nikola Vasic (SIU) – Nikola Vasic went 6-for-14 (.429) with a triple, a home run and four RBIs for the Salukis last week. He reached in all four games and has reached in 51 of the last 53 games. His on-base percentage for the week was .500 and he struck out only one time while slugging .786.

Boby Johnson (BRAD) – In a series consistently interrupted by weather delays, Johnson guided the Braves to their 30th win of the season in the series opener at Southern Illinois ... After Thursday's game was suspended in the third inning, Johnson took over on the mound when play resumed Friday and responded with a career-best performance, helping Bradley to the 5-3 win ... Johnson worked a career-long 6.1 innings and struck out a career-best nine, while allowing just one unearned run on five hits.

Triston Polley (INS) – Southpaw Triston Polley improved to 7-2 on the year after a 6-3 series opening victory at Valparaiso Thursday afternoon. The junior went six innings against the Crusaders, allowing just two hits and striking out five batters.

Dylan Coleman (MSU) – Junior right-hander Dylan Coleman came up big for the Bears when it mattered most, turning in a dominant performance in MSU's MVC regular-season title clinching victory over DBU Thursday. Coleman scattered six hits and struck out nine Patriots over 6 2/3 innings to lock up his league-leading ninth victory of the season that secured a share of the Bears' third Valley title in four seasons. He also became just the third pitcher in Missouri State history to record 300 career strikeouts, while also moving into a tie for fourth place on the Bears' all-time wins list with the 23rd victory of his career.

With a pair of home runs over the weekend at Valpo, Giesler moved into a tie for fourth place in program history. The Jasper, Indiana native nearly broke the single season record a season ago with 17 home runs – good enough for second in program history.



Wear It

Roberto Enriquez holds just a .224 batting average but the junior outfielder finds a way to reach base with 19 walks and 25 hit-by-pitches this season for a .286 on-base percentage. Enriquez ranks second in the nation in hit-by-pitches and first in HBP's per game with a 0.53 mark. He leads the MVC by nine HBP's. In a weekend series against Evansville, Enriquez was hit five times over three games.

He Doesn't Go Down Easy

Jarrod Watkins is second on the team with a .314 batting average over 50 starts. Another area the junior sits atop the team is in his strikeout numbers or lack thereof. Watkins is the toughest batter to strikeout in the Missouri Valley Conference at a 11.1 at bats per strikeout rating. In 207 at bats, Watkins has struck out just 18 times. He sits 51st nationally in the category.

Tournament Time

Missouri State enters the 2018 MVC Championship 51-47 all-time at the tourney, including titles in 1996, 1997 and 2015. The Bears have won at least one game in each Championship appearance since 1994, totaling all 51 of their tourney wins in their last 22 trips to the meet. Coupled with its 23-5 mark at the Mid-Continent Conference Tournament, MSU is 74-52 all-time at league meets as a Division I program. The Bears have gone a combined 11-4 in the last three MVC Championships, going 3-2 last year as the host and winning four straight elimination games to reach the title game in 2016, after posting a 4-0 run at the 2015 Championship to claim their third MVC Tourney crown.



In Rare Company

With a career record of 1,254-774 (.618), Bears head coach Keith Guttin needs just one more win to catch Jack Stallings (Wake Forest, Florida State and Georgia Southern) and move into the top 20 on the NCAA's Division I career coaching wins list. Guttin is the second-winningest coach in MVC history, while his win total ranks sixth among all active Division I head coaches.

Coleman Climbing

Junior right-hander Dylan Coleman improved his position on several MSU career lists with a clutch performance at DBU to help the Bears clinch their third MVC regular-season title in four years last Thursday. The Potosi, Mo., product picked up his league-leading ninth mound victory of the season with his 9-5 decision over the Patriots, marking the 23rd win of his Missouri State career. That total moves him into the fourth spot on MSU's career chart, just one victory shy of Kirby Cannon's career total in the No. 3 spot. Coleman, who leads the Valley with 113 K's on the year, also became just the third Bear hurler to record 300 career strikeouts, and enters the MVC Championship needing just five more K's to catch Nick Petree (306) in the No. 2 position on the chart.

Southern Illinois has 125 bases this season, which ranks fourth in the nation and is more than twice as many as the next-closest MVC team (DBU is second in the league with 62 steals). At SIU, this year's 125 steals are the third-most ever at Southern Illinois and most since the 1975 team stole 135 bases. Four of the top six individual base stealers in the MVC are Salukis, including the conference's two leaders, Connor Kopach and Alex Lyon. The rest of the MVC has followed SIU's lead—the other seven teams in the league have stolen 40 percent more bases this year than in 2016, the year before SIU implemented its aggressive base-running style.

SIU has four seniors among the nation's best during their careers. Among active players, Connor Kopach ranks second nationally in career steals; Logan Blackfan ranks third nationally in career doubles; Ryan Netemeyer ranks second in career saves; and Michael Baird ranks fifth in career innings pitched.

DBU will serve as host for the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Championship for the first time in school history, from May 23-26. The 2018 event will take place at Horner Ballpark, which serves as the home field for the Patriots. Horner Ballpark was ranked as the 20th best stadium in college baseball by D1Baseball.com in 2016. With a capacity of 2,000 persons, Horner Ballpark contains four guest suites available for rental, a pavilion down the leftfield line for large groups, and party plazas along both sides of the concourse available for medium sized gatherings.

For the ninth consecutive season, the 2018 Missouri Valley Conference Baseball Championship will welcome all eight league members to compete for the Valley's automatic berth to the NCAA Tournament. The format will divide the eight teams into two pods based on regular-season finish (Seeds 1, 4, 5 and 8; Seeds 2, 3, 6 and 7). Each four-team bracket will be a double-elimination format, with the winners squaring off in a one-game championship on Saturday evening.

Games are played at 9 a.m., 12:30 p.m., 4 p.m. and 7:30 p.m. each of the first three days, two "if necessary" games at 11 a.m. and 3 p.m. on Saturday, with the championship game on Saturday evening at 7 p.m. All times are listed as Central Time (CT). Every game during the four-day event will be available live on The Valley on ESPN3.
