### Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

**Devlin Granberg, Sr., IF/OF, DBU**  
 DBU senior Devlin Granberg hit .625 (10-for-16) last week, helping lead the Patriots to a 4-1 mark in their five games. In front of a national audience on ESPNU Saturday versus Evansville, Granberg went 3-for-4 and belted a grand slam. For the week, Granberg led the Patriots' offensive attack in 10 categories including hits (10), runs (5), home runs (1), triples (1), RBI (7), total bases (16), walks (5), slugging percentage (.1000), on-base percentage (.727), and stolen bases (3). Granberg also extended his streak of reaching safely to 40 consecutive games.

**Trevor Conn, Sr., RHP, DBU**  
 DBU redshirt-senior Trevor Conn improved to a perfect 7-0 on the season, shutting out Evansville over a career-high 8.0 innings of work last Friday. In the Patriots' 3-1 win over the Purple Aces, Conn allowed just two hits and did not allow a run, while striking out five. In his 8.0 innings of work, Conn also issued just two walks. With his 8.0 shutout innings, Conn extended his scoreless streak to 17.1 innings.

### NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Andrew Ivelia (BRAD)** – Ivelia helped Bradley to a series win at Illinois State by batting .400 (6-15) with three home runs, a double and five RBI's ... In Friday's 9-6 win in 13 innings, Ivelia got the scoring started with a first-inning home run and finished 2-for-6 with a walk ... In Saturday's double-header opener, Ivelia banged out a season-best three hits (3-5), including a double and a home run ... In Saturday's series finale, Ivelia hit a first-inning sacrifice fly and added a 2-run home run, helping the Braves clinch the series with a 9-3 win.

**Troy Beilsmith (UE)** – Troy Beilsmith stayed red-hot for the Purple Aces last week, going 8-for-15 at the plate, including a home run and a double, while driving in a pair of runs and scoring three himself.

**John Rave (ILS)** – Batted .500 during the week (11-of-22) with seven runs scored, four doubles, and one triple, while driving in five. He had a slugging percentage of .773 over the five games (in which the Redbirds went 3-2), and an on-base percentage of .560. He had three walks, three strikeouts, and one sacrifice hit. He had at least two hits in every game during the week, including three in the opener against Bradley. Went 2-for-4 with two runs scored against Milwaukee, before going 2-for-3 with two more runs scored at Northern Illinois. In the opener against Bradley he went 3-for-7, and went 2-for-4 in each of the last two games of the series. He drove in three runs in the team's win against Bradley, and had a double in each of the three games against the Braves.

**Clay Dungan (INS)** – Indiana State infielder Clay Dungan paced the Sycamores over the last week with a .647 batting average over four starts. The junior recorded 11 base hits, including two doubles in 17 at bats while reaching base twice on walks and once on a hit-by-pitch for a .700 on base-percentage. He tied a career high with five hits at Butler and went on to record his 13th multi-hit game in the series finale at SIU with four base hits. Dungan accounted for nine runs during the week, scoring four times while driving in five. He was also 4-for-5 on stolen-base attempts.

**Drew Millas (MSU)** – Sophomore catcher/DH Drew Millas carried the Missouri State offense to another Valley series win over the weekend, hitting a blistering .538 (7-for-13) in the Bears' sweep of Valparaiso. Millas recorded multi-hit performances in all three games against the Crusaders, and hit .471 with two homers and five RBIs for the week. After homering in MSU's Tuesday game with Kansas, the Swansea, Ill., native registered two hits in Friday's series opener at Valpo, then went 3-for-4 and belted the deciding three-run homer in Saturday's game two victory. Millas finished his week with a 2-for-5 effort in Sunday's series finale, including a key double that ignited MSU's decisive four-run rally in the eighth inning.

**Alex Lyon (SIU)** – Alex Lyon hit .357 and slugged .643 for the Salukis last week. Lyon went 5-for-14 with a double, home run, RBI and three runs scored. He also stole two bases and did not commit an error.

**Boby Johnson (BRAD)** – Johnson allowed just an unearned run in 5.0 innings to earn the win in Bradley's 13-inning victory at Illinois State Friday night... Johnson's 5.0 IP represented his longest outing as a Brave and he struck out a season-best six, while allowing just three hits.

**Hunter Porterfield (UE)** – Senior relief pitcher Hunter Porterfield (LHP) continues to be lights out coming out of the Purple Aces bullpen. Last week, the southpaw made three appearances, not allowing a single run across 6.2 innings of work, while striking out six and scattering a pair of hits. Opposing batters hit just .095 against Porterfield last week.

**Trevor Cross (ILS)** – Appeared in three games during the week out of the bullpen, pitching a total of five innings. He struck out nine batters over those five innings, scattering five hits and allowing one earned run while walking one. He also picked up his first collegiate save at Milwaukee. Against the Panthers he pitched two innings, striking out four and walking just one. In the opening game against Bradley, he pitched 2.2 innings, striking out half of the eight outs he produced. In the series finale came in and got one out by strikeout.

**Weston Rivers (INS)** – Weston River put together another gem Sunday to help the Sycamores clinch the series at Southern Illinois. Rivers tossed seven and a third innings, allowing just one run on six hits to the Salukis. After returning from an injury midway through the year, the victory moved the redshirt senior to 3-0 on the season. Over his last three outings, Rivers has pitched 19.1 innings, allowed nine hits, two earned runs and struck out six.

**Connor Sechler (MSU)** – Freshman reliever Connor Sechler once again played a pivotal role in a 3-1 week for the Bears that included a three-game MVC series sweep of Valparaiso. The right-hander logged three scoreless outings in four total appearances, including locking up his fifth save in Friday's 6-5 win in the series opener at Valpo. Sechler held the Crusaders to one hit in 2.0 scoreless innings of that game, then closed out Saturday's game two victory with 2.0 more innings. Finally, the Bolivar, Mo., product earned the win in Sunday's 6-2 victory, tossing an inning and a third of scoreless relief to help lock up the Bears' 13th straight MVC series win or split since May 2016.

**Michael Baird (SIU)** – Michael Baird allowed just three hits in seven innings in Southern Illinois 3-2 win over Indiana State on Friday night. Baird struck out seven and limited the Sycamores to a .115 batting average. He did not allow an extra-base hit, and his game ERA was 1.29. Baird lowered his season ERA to 2.84, which is the best in the league with at least 50 innings, and Baird has thrown an MVC-leading 82.1 innings.

## Tight Races

Since the start of the 21-game conference schedule in 2010 (three-game series), the top two places in the regular-season standings have been separated by one game four times.

2010 - Wichita St. & Illinois St. 15-6

2011 - Creighton 15-6 & Wichita St. 14-7

2012 - Indiana St. 14-7 & Missouri St. 13-7

2014 - Evansville 15-6 & DBU/Indiana St. 14-7

## Back-to-Back

Missouri State is looking to become just the second Valley school to win back-to-back regular-season titles, as Wichita State remains the only league school to have ever accomplished this feat. The Shockers won back-to-back titles in 2007-2008, were winners of 14 consecutive regular-season championships from 1987-2000 (includes one shared championship with Southern Illinois in 1990).

The Bears are also looking to post the best two-year record in Valley history (since moving to expanded MVC schedule in 1985), currently sitting at 31-3 over the last two seasons in MVC play. The 1993 and 1994 Shockers hold the MVC record, going 36-5 over a two-season span.

## Five in RPI's Top-100

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by Missouri State (No. 52), DBU (No. 54), Indiana State (No. 63), Bradley (No. 70) and Illinois State (No. 89).

Another two teams, Southern Illinois (No. 136) and Valparaiso (No. 197), also rank in the RPI's top-200.

## Valley RPI Ranks No. 10

According to the latest RPI update from WarrenNolan.com (May 7), the Missouri Valley Conference ranks No. 10 amongst 31 leagues. Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, ACC and Pac-12) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fourth. The Big Ten, Atlantic Sun, Sun Belt, Mountain West and MVC round out the top 10.

## Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 17 wins over members of Power Five conferences. The Valley has a 6-8 mark against the Big 12, while going 3-4 vs. the Pac-12, 6-13 vs. the Big Ten, 2-6 against the ACC and 0-9 vs. the SEC.

Seven of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Southern Illinois has one Power Five win, while Bradley, Indiana State and Missouri State have two, Illinois State and Valparaiso three and DBU four.

This week's schedule features one game against a Power Five team. On Tuesday, DBU will head to Lubbock to face #12 Texas Tech.

## Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 14 leagues in non-conference play (Big East, Conference USA, Horizon, Ivy, Metro, MAC, Mountain West, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southern, Southland, SWAC, Summit and WAC), and at least a .500 record against the American.

## Top 50 RPI Wins

Two league teams have won two or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI (as of May 7). DBU sits 3-6 against the Top 50 (wins vs. Oklahoma, Oklahoma State, Texas Tech), while Bradley has a 2-3 record against the Top 50 (wins vs. Georgia Tech and Jacksonville).

## Top 25 Wins

The MVC has won nine games against top-25 opponents so far this season. DBU has five of those wins, beating #24 Oklahoma, #22 Sam Houston State (twice), #23 TCU and #4 Texas Tech. Indiana State, Missouri State, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso also have wins over Top 25 teams, as the Sycamores beat #24 Louisville, the Bears beat #24 East Carolina, the Salukis beat #24 Illinois and the Crusaders beat #25 Illinois.

## Projected Field

Baseball America continues to have two MVC teams in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of May 2. The publication has DBU as a No. 3 seed in the Stillwater (Oklahoma State) Regional and Missouri State as a No. 3 seed in the Fayetteville (Arkansas) Regional.

## One Run Success

Missouri State has proven to be proficient in close encounters this spring, with wins in 11 of its 12 one-run decisions, including a 5-0 mark in league play. That record represents a turnaround from the Bears' combined 9-15 record in one-run affairs over the previous two seasons. This season, the rest of the MVC is a combined 25-44 in one run games.

## Back-to-Back Batting Title?

DBU's Devlin Granberg boast the top batting average (.425) in the Missouri Valley Conference and is looking to become the first Patriot to hit .400 or better since Jason Krizan hit .413 in 2011. He is currently one of 14 players nationally hitting over .400 this season (ranks third). Granberg is also seeking to set the all-time career batting average record at DBU. In two seasons as a Patriot, Granberg owns a .392 average, which is currently 20 percentage points better than Krizan, who holds the current record with a .372 average. Only once in MVC history has a player won back-to-back batting titles as Wichita State's Pat Magness accomplished the honor during the 1997 (.409) and 1998 (.464) seasons. Granberg won the 2017 MVC batting title with a .359 average.

The senior currently leads the MVC in batting average (.425, 3rd in NCAA), slugging % (.654, 45th in NCAA), on-base % (.533, 4th in NCAA), hits (76, 9th in NCAA), RBI (54, 19th in NCAA), total bases (117, 28th in NCAA) and walks (39, 21st in NCAA).

## Patriot Power

DBU's offense currently ranks top-20 nationally in three power categories entering this week's action. The Patriots sit 6th in doubles per game (2.35), 20th in home runs per game (1.15) and 17th in slugging percentage (.464).

Southern Illinois senior Connor Kopach ranks second on the NCAA active career stolen base leaders chart. Kopach trails Rutgers' Jawuan Harris entering this week's action.

## NCAA Batting Average Leaders

DBU's Devlin Granberg ranks second on the NCAA active career batting average leaders chart.

## Winning in Tough Places

Indiana State became just the second team in the last three seasons to go to Louisville and win a non-conference game against the Cardinals. Only Texas Tech and Indiana State have won games inside Jim Patterson Stadium over the last three seasons as the Cardinals are 90-16 overall and 70-2 against non-conference foes during the stretch.

## Award Nominees Galore

The bevy of award watch lists has several MVC student-athletes as nominees for national awards.

Missouri State's Jeremy Eierman is among 40 players on the Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list, which honors the top baseball player in the country.

Missouri State's Jake Fromson and Southern Illinois' Ryan Netemeyer are listed among 52 student-athletes on the preseason NCBWA Stopper of the Year Award watch list, given to the top relief pitcher.

Bradley's Keaton Rice, DBU's Matt Duce, Illinois State's Collin Braithwaite and Valpo's Scott Kapers were named to the 2018 Johnny Bench Award watch list, given annually to the top Division I catcher. The list will be narrowed down to semifinalists on May 16.

Five MVC shortstops are among 53 Division I shortstops listed on the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List. MSU's Jeremy Eierman, DBU's Jimmy Glowenke, SIU's Connor Kopach, Illinois State's Owen Miller and Valpo's Sam Shaikin are listed among the group. The Valley's five honorees only trails the ACC (9) and SEC (8) nationally.

## Preseason All-Americans

Two Missouri Valley Conference baseball players were named to the D1Baseball.com All-American team, as announced by the organization. Missouri State shortstop Jeremy Eierman was a first-team selection, while DBU outfielder Jameson Hannah was a third-team choice.

Eierman was also a first-team All-American by Collegiate Baseball and a second-team selection by the NCBWA. MSU teammate Jake Fromson was also honored by Collegiate Baseball, earning second-team honors.

## Winning Out West

Illinois State claimed a series win at Washington, taking three out of four games in the series. It marked just the second time in MVC history that a Valley team earned a series win (more than two games) on the road against a Pac-12 team. Missouri State is the only other league team to win a road series vs. the Pac-12, earning a series win at Oregon State in 2009 (2-1).

#### Walk This Way

#### Extra Innings

When the Redbirds went 13 innings with Bradley, it was the program's longest game in over two years. It was the fourth extra-inning game for Illinois State this season, the same total as last season. It was also the longest game for Illinois State baseball since March 20, 2016, an 18-inning loss against Milwaukee.

#### Baird's Impressive Run

SIU senior starter Michael Baird has suffered through two rough starts this season (Against Jacksonville State and Illinois his ERA was 10.45). But in his other 10 starts, Baird has been dominant. He has allowed just 14 earned runs in 72 innings, good for a 1.75 ERA. In Baird's last five starts—which includes starts against two of the nation's best offenses in Dallas Baptist and Tennessee Tech—Baird has a 1.25 ERA in 36 innings. Baird has eight quality starts this season and 27 in his illustrious career.



#### Netemeyer Turning It Around

SIU closer Ryan Netemeyer struggled at the start of the season, culminating with a blown save at Dallas Baptist that put his season ERA at 8.25. At that time, Netemeyer had five saves with four blown saves. Since then, Netemeyer has been dominant. In five appearances, Netemeyer is a perfect 4-for-4 on save opportunities and has not allowed a run. He has struck out 10 in just six innings while walking none, and opponents are hitting just .143 against him.

#### Wrapping Up Great Careers

Connor Kopach and Logan Blackfan are each going to finish their SIU careers among the top-10 in school history in career games played and at bats. Each of the seniors has started more than 200 career games and will have more than 800 career at-bats.

#### Billinger Bashing Baseballs

Valpo's Blake Billinger belted his league-leading 21st double of the season this weekend. He is the seventh player in program history and the first since 2010 with 20+ doubles in a campaign. There are still nine games remaining in the regular season, and Billinger is three doubles away from breaking the single-season program record of 23 set by Kyle Muhlsteff in 2010.



#### A Rare Occurrence

First-place Missouri State came to Emory G. Bauer Field and won three straight close games this weekend. This marked the first time since 2014 the Crusaders were swept in a three-game series on their home field. UIC was the last team to come to Valpo and accomplish that feat. This also marked just the second time this season and the first in Missouri Valley Conference play that the Crusaders have dropped all three games in a series.

#### Gordon Going Good

For some teams, Sunday starting pitching can be the biggest question mark of the weekend, but Wes Gordon has been statistically Valpo's strongest starting pitcher in conference play. Opponents are hitting just .238 against him in Valley games, while he owns a team-best MVC era of 3.00 in five starts. Gordon has allowed three earned runs or fewer in four of his five MVC starts, including outings against the top two teams in the league. He's allowed just 11 walks all season, tied for the fewest in The Valley among those who qualify.
