MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Jenna Szczesny, Sr., F, Loyola (Hoffman Estates, Ill.)

Loyola senior Jenna Szczesny netted a goal and dished out an assist during Loyola's two-game California road trip this past weekend. In Friday's clash at Loyola Marymount, the Hoffman Estates, Ill. native scored her second goal of the season in the 80th minute. Two days later, she added an assist as part of a convincing 3-1 triumph over host CSU Bakersfield. Szczesny, a Preseason All-MVC honoree, currently has a Valley-best seven points (2 goals, 3 assists) to her name this season.



MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Jami Reichenberger, Sr., GK, UNI (Wichita, Kansas)

Jami Reichenberger continued her strong defense of the Panther goal, deflecting six shots on goal from Colorado State. Reichenberger had three saves against Colorado State. Against Wyoming, Reichenberger faced nine shots on goal with four saves. Wyoming had 21 shots against the Panther goal

In her third game as a Panther, Sophia Conant made a big impact for the Panthers looking for their first win of the season. In the 87th minute against a tough Colorado State team, Conant flicked the ball in on the right side of the net. This was Conant's first goal of the season.

OFFENSE

Caitlyn Eddy, Sr., MF, Indiana State

Indiana State's Caitlyn Eddy scored the Sycamores' first goal of the season on August 24 at SIU Edwardsville. It was perfect time for the St. Louis metro area native as she recorded her career goal at Indiana State in front of many local supporters. Eddy, who led the team with six assists last season, now is tied for the team lead with a goal and two points. She recorded two shots over the two match stretch against the Cougars and Iowa, including the one shot on goal. The Sycamores broke out offensively at SIUE with a trio of goals in the first half. Eddy's goal came just 2:24 into the match, which is believed to be the fourth fastest goal scored in school history.

Hannah McDevitt, Sr., MF, UNI

Helping to lead the offensive effort for the Panthers, senior Hannah McDevitt has started in all three games for the Panthers. McDevitt is second in the Panther stats for shots during a season with 6.

DEFENSE

Danielle Varner, So., D/MF, Indiana State (Henderson, Nev.)

Indiana State sophomore Danielle Varner was fantastic for the Sycamores as they split a weekend road series against SIU Edwardsville and Iowa. Varner continuously manned the back line for the Sycamores providing defensive support for goalkeeper Hannah Sullivan. Varner's defensive tactics allowed just 12 shots on goal out of 24 total shots. She continuously stopped opponent's offensive threats but intercepting passes and stopping dribbles in the box. Several offensive threats were thwarted in both matches before a shot was able to be attempted as she stole the ball and led ISU on a counter attack.

NEWCOMER

Sarah Clancy, Fr., MF, Indiana State

Indiana State freshman Sarah Clancy was solid in just her second week as a Sycamore. She provided support on the Sycamore back line and was charged with beginning the offensive attacks. Clancy twice had the first strike on an offensive attack against SIU Edwardsville which resulted in goals scored for the Sycamores.

Abby Swanson, Fr., MF, Loyola

Loyola freshman Abby Swanson netted the first goal of her collegiate career in Sunday's 3-1 win at CSU Bakersfield. The Downers Grove, Ill. product headed in what would prove to be the game-winning goal in the 20th minute, finishing off a free kick from junior Madison Laudeman in the 20th minute. Swanson, who has started in each of Loyola's first four games of the 2018 campaign, also saw action for 44 minutes of Friday's game against Loyola Marymount.

Kennady Orlick, F, Missouri State

Kennady Orlick scored the game winning goal at the 70-minute mark in the Bears' 1-0 shutout of Southeast Missouri State. The score marked her second of the season, both of which were deciding goals. She is tied with teammate Jordan Eickelman as the Bears' goal leader this season.

So Close Twice

Drake dropped back-to-back 1-0 road decisions this past week. Kansas State scored a second-half goal Thursday night in Manhattan, Kan. to avenge its loss to the Bulldogs in the Wildcats' 2016 debut season. South Dakota State scored a first-half goal Sunday in Brookings, S.D. to increase its series lead over Drake to 8-5-2.



Been Awhile

Drake's pair of 1-0 losses this past week at Kansas State and at South Dakota State marked a first for the program in five seasons. The last time the Bulldogs dropped consecutive 1-0 results was all the way back in 2013 when they lost to Western Illinois and UNI back-to-back.

On the Road Again

Drake will play two more road games this week when it visits UMKC Friday and North Dakota State Sunday afternoon. Following this week's road trip, Drake will get to play their home opener on Sept. 9 when Marquette visits the Cownie Soccer Complex. This six match road trip is the longest for the program since the 2014 season when it played five straight road contests.

Ready Eddy

Indiana State senior Caitlyn Eddy provided a quick strike for the Sycamore offense on August 24 as ISU used a trio of first half goals to own a 3-1 victory over SIU Edwardsville. Eddy's goal was the first of the year for the Sycamores and the first for her personally at Indiana State. It also came in quick fashion as she scored with just 2:24 elapsed off the clock. It was the fourth fastest goal scored in the 18-year history of the ISU women's soccer program and the fastest since Leah Galton found the back of the net against Hofstra in just 84 seconds on September 7, 2014. The fastest goal scored ever at ISU was Alison Gasparovich who scored in a 1:20 against Valparaiso on September 24, 2010.

A Trio of Goals In One Half For Sycamore Offense

Indiana State, who entered the SIU Edwardsville match without a goal scored during the opening weekend, tallied three in the first half against the Cougars. Caitlyn Eddy scored the fourth fastest goal in program history and was followed by Alina Steffen as well as Katie Wells as ISU eventually took a 3-1 lead into the half. It was the first time that the Sycamores have scored three goals in a half since they did it in both the first and second halves on September 24, 2017 at Chicago State.

Hannah Sullivan Scoreless Streak Snapped

Indiana State junior goalkeeper Hannah Sullivan put together an amazing scoreless streak as she didn't allow a goal for 198 minutes and 56 seconds between early in the first half at Northern Kentucky and late in the first half at SIU Edwardsville. In that time span she made 11 saves, stopping all 11 shots on goal over a two-match string.
