### MVC Offensive Player of the Week

#### Josh Dolling, So., F, Missouri State

Josh Dolling unleashed an historic night for the Missouri State men's soccer team against Santa Clara, helping the Bears to a 3-2 victory. In the double overtime thriller, Dolling recorded all three goals for the Bears, including the game winner at the 107-minute mark, finishing off the first hat trick match for a MSU men's soccer athlete since Sept. 9, 2005. His second goal of the night made Sports Center's Top-10, checking in at No. 3. Dolling added his fourth

goal of the week and seventh of the season against UMKC on Saturday. Dolling ended the week with four goals and one assist in two games. The Liverpool, United Kingdom native leads the Missouri Valley Conference in points (15), goals (7) and game winning goals (3). He is also ranked in the top-five nationally in game-winning-goals, goals per game, shots on goal per game and total goals.

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week

#### Josh Lagudah, Jr., GK, Loyola

Loyola junior Josh Lagudah made his first official start since August 27 and notched his second-straight shutout to help guide Loyola to a 2-0 win over SIUE. The junior goalkeeper recorded eight saves, the most by a Rambler in a match since Tim Dobrowolski had 11 against Drake back on Oct. 11, 2014. Lagudah was faced with constant pressure all night, with the Cougars compiling 20 shots in addition to Lagudah's eight saves - both season highs for the Maroon and Gold. The Australia native's two consecutive shutouts marked the first time a Loyola goalkeeper kept the net clear in two consecutive starts since Andrew Chekadanov logged two on Oct. 18-22, 2016.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Younes Dayekh (BRAD)** - Dayekh assisted both Bradley goals in Friday's 2-1 victory at Purdue Fort Wayne with a perfect free kick services ... Dayekh also provided constant pressure of his own on the Mastodons keeper, finishing the night with six shots, including five on goal ... Dayekh's five shots on goal were the most by a Brave in a game since Oct. 2, 2013 (Christian Okeke at #3 Northwestern) ... Dayekh is leads the team and now ranks second in The Valley with four assists this season.

**Cole Poppen (DU)** - Cole Poppen, a transfer from Tulsa University, converted a penalty kick early in overtime to send the Drake University men's soccer team past his former team, 2-1, Saturday, Sept. 15 afternoon at Hurricane Stadium in Tulsa, Okla. Poppen is tied for the team lead in goals with two and has the top assists total with five and top points mark with nine.

**Ben Weber (UE)** - In two road matches this week, junior forward Ben Weber scored a goal and posed an offensive threat for Evansville's opponents. Against Northern Kentucky on Tuesday, Weber tallied three shots as the Aces dropped a 3-0 match on the road to the Norse. On Sunday, Weber scored his second goal in there matches helping push the Aces to a 1-1 double-overtime draw with Mercer, recording three shots with one on-goal. The Weldon Spring, Mo. native has surpassed his shot total from 2017 and matched his goal total from his freshman and sophomore seasons as Weber has amassed 16 shots and two goals this season.

**Aidan Megally (LUC)** - Megally capitalized on a penalty kick in the 5th minute of Loyola's 2-0 victory over SIUE, immediately putting the Ramblers in the driver's seat with a lead they wouldn't relinquish. Megally's game-winning goal went down as his first point of the season, and was the first PK goal for the Ramblers since Fabian Lifka's PK score on Oct. 17, 2017 vs. DePaul. Megally is now one of four Ramblers to find the back of the net this season, and is responsible for one of two unassisted goals for the Ramblers in 2018.

**John Pollifrone (BRAD)** - Pollifrone made the most of his return home, leading a defensive unit that limited Purdue Fort Wayne to just four shots on goal in Friday's 2-1 victory ... A product of Fort Wayne's Bishop Dwenger Catholic High School, Pollifrone played the full 109-minutes, 6-seconds Friday in his home town and he is the only Bradley player who has played every second through the season's first seven games.

**Jake Laird (MSU)** - Jake Laird was the only MSU athlete to play every minute of the Bears undefeated week. Seeing 107 minutes against Santa Clara and all 90 minutes against UMKC, the senior was a driving force in the Bears defensive effort last week. The Bears held Santa Clara to nine shots in the double overtime battle, while holding UMKC to just three shots, with one being a penalty kick. Laird was the leader defensively, keeping the Bears undefeated during the week and through six games. The Bears are third in the conference in goals-against-average (1.00).

**Nacho Miras (VALPO)** - Miras picked up his third career shutout and second of the season, going all 110 minutes in a scoreless draw against Western Illinois. He garnered five saves, including a full-extension, diving effort with two minutes remaining in the second overtime, denying the Leathernecks what would have been a golden goal.

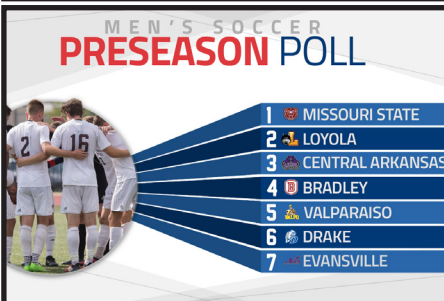

### Another Top 25 Win

Drake claimed a 2-1 overtime win over #23 ranked Tulsa on Saturday, earning the fourth Top 25 win for MVC men's soccer this season. The Valley holds a 4-2 record against Top 25 teams this season. On Friday, Evansville will welcome #2 Indiana to Arad McCutchan Stadium. The Aces have won their last three matchups against ranked opponents at home. The last time the MVC claimed five wins over Top 25 foes was in 2013, going 5-8-1 vs. the Top 25.

### Braves are Streaking

Through Sunday's action across the country, Bradley's 12-game unbeaten streak ranked as the third-longest such streak in the country ... With Stanford (21) and Denver (15) leading the pack, Bradley's 12-game ride since last October is the longest unbeaten streak by any team east of the Rocky Mountains.

### Improved Offense

Missouri State has kicked off the 2018 season on an offensive high note. Recording 14 goals in the first six matches, while in 2017 MSU only saw 15 goals all season. MSU paces the MVC in points (39), goals (14) and assists (11).

### National Team of the Week

Loyola's Josh Lagudah earned a spot as the goalkeeper on this week's 11-member College Soccer News Team of the Week, earning a shutout during a 2-0 win over SIUE.

### Climbing the Charts

With his goal against Saint Louis on Sunday night, UCA junior Niklas Brodacki now has 34 goals for his career, which ties him for third-most in program history, four back of second place and 14 off the lead. Brodacki, who already holds the Bears' Division I record for goals, currently ranks fifth in points (74), fourth in game-winning goals (9), is tied for second in penalty kicks made (5), and holds the program record for points per game (1.68) and goals per game (0.77). He is the current active NCAA leader in points per game (1.66) and goals per game (0.77).

### Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against seven leagues in non-conference play (American, Horizon, Ivy, Summit, Sun Belt, West Coast and WAC) and at least a .500 mark against the Big West and Southern.

### Against the 2017 NCAA Field

The Valley has won three matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament teams. Drake beat Butler and UIC, while Missouri State beat Omaha. The MVC sits 3-3-4 against NCAA tourney teams from a year ago with seven more chances on the schedule.

### Poll Position

Bradley is receiving votes in this week's College Soccer News poll and United Soccer Coaches poll, following a win over Purdue Fort Wayne.

### MVC in Regional Rankings

The MVC has three teams currently ranked in the latest United Soccer Coaches West Regional rankings released on Tuesday (Sept. 18). Bradley sits No. 4 in the region, while Missouri State (5th) and Drake (8) also appear in the poll.

## BRADLEY (5-0-2)

### Change of Pace

Friday's 2-1, double overtime win at Purdue Fort Wayne came in Bradley's seventh game of the year just 22 days into the season ... During the next 22-day segment of the season from Sept. 15-Oct. 6, the Braves will play just four games.



### East of the Rockies

Through Friday's action across the country, Bradley's 12-game unbeaten streak ranked as the third-longest such streak in the country ... With Stanford (20) and Denver (14) leading the pack, Bradley's 12-game ride since last October is the longest unbeaten streak by any team east of the Rocky Mountains.

### The Streak's Asterisk

Bradley's next opponent, Central Arkansas, can claim responsibility for an asterisk on Bradley's current 12-game unbeaten streak ... Though the teams officially played to a 1-1 draw in the semifinals of the 2017 MVC Men's Soccer Championship at Shea Stadium, UCA advanced to the finals by winning the PK shootout, 8-7.

### Sting After the Break

Bradley has not allowed a goal after halftime during any of the 12 games during its current unbeaten streak ... Loyola Chicago scored a pair of second-half goals in its 2-1 victory Oct. 21, 2017, marking the last time the Braves have surrendered a score after the intermission ... The 639 minutes of second-half and overtime play without allowing a goal during the 12-game unbeaten streak is equivalent to more than seven regulation games.
