MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Jenna Szczesny, Sr., F, Loyola (Hoffman Estates, Ill.)

Loyola senior Jenna Szczesny scored two goals and dished out an assist to help lead the Ramblers to a 4-2 road victory over UNI to open Missouri Valley Conference play on Sunday afternoon in Waterloo, Iowa. After converting from the penalty spot in the 20th minute of play, Szczesny provided the assist on the eventual game-winning tally by fellow senior Madison Kimball in the 42nd minute before adding her second goal of the day during the early stages of the second half. The Hoffman Estates, Ill. product currently leads the Ramblers in goals (5), assists (4) and overall points (14).



MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Michaela Till, So., GK, Evansville (Avon, Ind.)

In the Aces' MVC opener, sophomore goalkeeper Michaela Till showed her strength between the posts. Facing an Indiana State side that came in to the match averaging over two goals per match and was fresh-off an eight-goal performance the previous weekend, Till kept the Sycamores off the scoreboard and helped lead the Aces to a 1-0 overtime win on Saturday. The junior made five saves in goal, bringing her season total to 54 and career total to 109, moving Till into 10th all-time at UE in career saves.



MVC Newcomer of the Week

Alison Walls, Fr. F, Drake (Kansas City, Mo.)

Freshman Alison Walls assisted on Shelley Lyjak's golden goal over Valpo Sunday. Walls had her shot blocked but got the ball back and passed it sideways to Lyjak who scored 15 yards out. Walls has played in all 11 matches this season and leads the squad in assists with two and is tied for the team lead in goals with two.

OFFENSE

Shelley Lyjak, Jr., F, Drake

Junior Shelley Lyjak scored a golden goal to beat Valpo, 1-0, after her teammate Alison Walls had her shot blocked but got the ball back and passed it sideways to Lyjak who was able to hold off her defender and send her shot high past Valparaiso goalkeeper, Kezia Gesell from 15 yards out. It is the first goal this season and third of her career.

Maggie Leazer, Jr., M, Evansville

Opening Missouri Valley Conference play, junior midfielder continued to show an increasing presence in the Purple Aces' attack. In Evansville's MVC-opener on Saturday, Leazer scored the Aces' game-winning goal in the 95th minute on her first shot of the afternoon giving UE its third victory of the season. After primarily playing as a defender during his first two seasons in the White and Purple, Leazer has scored twice during the 2018 campaign, recording eight shots with five on-goal. Both of Leazer's goals this season have been game-winners as Leazer also provided the win for the Aces in a 3-0 victory over Tennessee Tech on August 31.

Kate Del Fava, Jr., MF, Illinois State

Del Fava provided an offensive spark for the Redbirds, scoring two goals and adding an assist in a week that saw Illinois State go 2-0 and remain undefeated at home. In Wednesday night's contest versus Western Illinois, Del Fava scored in the sixth minute, side-stepping a defender to give the 'Birds an early lead. She would later assist on the game-winning goal, getting her head on a cross and redirecting it to junior Alix McArthur's feet to knock in. Del Fava would again jumpstart Illinois State's offense in Saturday's match against Missouri State, weaving through defenders and beating the keeper to net the equalizing goal in the first half. Del Fava picked up five points over the weekend and has now scored in each of the last three games.

Kelsey Yarrow, Sr., M, UNI

Kelsey Yarrow was a key element in both the Panthers goals on Sunday. Yarrow earned her second goal of the season on an unassisted ball in the 29th minute. Yarrow fed the ball to fellow Panther Brynell Yount in the 75th minute for Yount's first goal this season. Yarrow leads the Panthers with 27 shot attempts, with 12 shots on goal.

DEFENSE

Elaine Gorom, Sr., D, Drake

Senior Elaine Gorom played all 98 minutes in the Bulldogs' shutout of the Crusaders. Gorom, who has played a team-high 992 minutes this year, helped the Bulldogs earn their second shutout and three critical points to start league action. Gorom has started all 11 matches in 2018.

Haley Smith, Jr., GK, Illinois State

Smith combined for 11 saves on 21 shots faced in a week that saw Illinois State go 2-0 and extend their winning streak to four games. The goalkeeper allowed only one goal in each contest to help the Redbirds to their wins and remain undefeated at home this season. Smith collected 63 saves so far in her junior campaign.

NEWCOMER

Hannah Mueller, Fr., MF, Illinois State

Mueller had a breakout game in Illinois State's win over Western Illinois on Wednesday night, netting her first career goal in the 74th minute to put the Redbirds up 3-1. Six minutes later, Mueller would steal the ball from a defender and beat the goalkeeper to tally her second goal of the game and the first brace of the year for the Redbirds. Illinois State would go on to defeat Western Illinois, 4-1, and protect their undefeated home record this season.

EVANSVILLE (3-7-1, 1-0-0 MVC)

Till Enters the Record Book

With five saves in Evansville's 1-0 victory over Indiana State in its MVC opener, sophomore goalkeeper Michaela Till moved into the Aces' record book. Till's five saves on Saturday increased her season total to 54 and her career total to 109, putting her in 10th all-time in program history in career saves. The sophomore also sits in 10th in games played in a career, appearing in 25 matches in her Aces' career.



Top 10 in The Valley

A pair of Aces appear in the top 10 of individual statistical categories for the MVC. Both seniors Montana Portenier (sixth) and Molly Lear (10th) are in the top 10 in the conference in shots with Portenier recording 21 on the season and Lear recording 18 this year. Portenier also sits in a tie for ninth in assists with two, while junior Maggie Leazer is tied for second with two game-winning goals. Till finds herself in the top 10 in multiple goalkeeping categories including saves (fourth), saves per game (fourth), shutouts (tied for fourth), and goals-against average (eighth).

Generating Chances

The last two matches for the Aces at Arad McCutchan Stadium have featured an increased attack from Evansville. Against Purdue Fort Wayne on September 14 and Indiana State on Saturday, UE recorded 48 shots, recording 27 shots against the Mastodons and 21 against the Sycamores. Previous to this season, Evansville hadn't recorded a 20-shot match since November 8, 2015 with a 22-shot performance against Loyola in the 2015 MVC Tournament Championship Game.

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INDIANA STATE (6-4-2, 0-1-0 MVC)

Leading The Valley And Near The Top In Defense

The Indiana State leads the league with 23 goals scored, which is three more goals than the next closest team -- Illinois State has 20. The Sycamores are averaging 1.917 goals per match which also leads the conference. Indiana State's defense has been stout as well as they allow just 1.000 goals per match which is tops in the league. Indiana State's 58 corner kicks on the season are the best in the Missouri Valley Conference.



Homestand Over, Back To The Road

Of Indiana State's six victories so far this season, four have come on the road. The Sycamores went undefeated over four consecutive road matches -- marking the first time that has happened in program history -- before falling on September 22 at Evansville in the MVC opener. The Sycamores' four road wins are the most for the program since 2012. The Indiana State school record of five road victories in one season was set back in 2006.

Katie Wells Record Book Watch

Senior Katie Wells, an Indianapolis (Warren Central HS) native currently ranks second best in school history with 56 career points scored and second all-time with 0.88 points scored per match. Her 19 career goals are tied for third most in school history. She is only 14 points off Laura Podolski's school record for career points scored. With her next goal, she will tie Maddie Orf for second all-time in career goals scored and is only six behind the school record, currently held by Lauren Podolski. She also owns 18 career assists which is second-best on the ISU career chart and only two behind Podolski for a share of the school record. Wells is vying to become just the third Sycamore in program history to record at least 20 career goals scored. Additionally her 51 career shots on goal are the fifth most ever at ISU.

Loyola opened Missouri Valley Conference play with an impressive 4-2 win over UNI on Sunday afternoon at the Cedar Valley Soccer Complex in Waterloo, Iowa. The victory marked the Maroon & Gold's first regular-season road triumph over the Panthers in program history and extended Loyola's winning streak in the series to three.



Dynamic Duo

The senior pairing of Jenna Szczesny and Madison Kimball provided the offensive fireworks in the Ramblers' aforementioned victory over UNI on Sunday afternoon. Szczesny tallied the fourth two-goal performance of her career and dished out an assist, while Kimball chipped in two goals of her own to bring her season total in the category to four, eclipsing her previous career high of three that was set during her junior season.

Loyola will look for its second 2-0 start to Valley play in as many years on Saturday evening when it visits Memorial Stadium to take on Indiana State.
