MVC Offensive Player of the Week

Ali Line, Sr., MB, Illinois State

Ali Line started all three matches for the Redbirds, as Illinois State went 3-0 to win the Top Dawg Challenge. The hometown hero was named the tournament's MVP after finishing the weekend with a team-best 26 kills on .438 hitting, averaging 2.60 kills per set. Line was one of two 'Birds to register a solo block, contributing six total blocks on the weekend. She reached double-digit kills against Eastern Illinois and Auburn to lead the team, while finishing second on the team against Butler. Line's 11 kills against the Panthers matched a career-high, dating

back to the 2016 season. She also matched a career-high in digs with four against Eastern Illinois, while finishing the weekend with a team-best 32.0 points for the Redbirds.

MVC Defensive Player of the Week

Elle Tubbs, Jr., MB, Drake

Drake junior Elle Tubbs was named to the Holy Cross Invitational All-Tournament team for helping lead the Bulldogs to three wins and the tournament title. In those 10 sets over three matches, she recorded 19 blocks with no errors to average 1.9 blocks per set. She also had a team-high 26 kills in the three matches and added five aces. Tubbs opened the tournament with five blocks in three sets against Rhode Island along with nine kills on 14 attempts. She followed that with five blocks in the four-set win over Holy Cross and returned on Sunday to record a staggering nine blocks in three sets along with seven kills against Columbia. Her nine

block assists match a career high and were the most by a Bulldog in two seasons.

MVC Freshman of the Week

Hannah Thompson, Fr., OH, Bradley

Thompson earned all-tournament honors at the CEFCU Invitational, helping Bradley to a 3-0 record. The 5-8 outside hitter averaged 3.00 kills and an impressive 6.45 digs per set in three victories. She opened the weekend with her second double-double of the year, tallying 16 kills and a season-best 29 digs to go with one assist, one ace and two blocks in a four-set victory over Western Illinois. Her 29 digs were the most by a Brave other than a libero since 2005. Thompson collected six kills and 23 digs in a three-set sweep of Toledo, helping Bradley break the school record for digs in a three-set match which had stood since 1988. She capped the

week with her team-best third double-double of the week with 11 kills and 19 digs, while hitting at .312 clip in a four-set win over George Washington. Thompson is just the fifth Brave in the last 27 years to tally at least 75 kills and 75 digs in the first six matches of a season.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and freshman of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Grace Schofield (DU) - Named MVP of the Holy Cross Invitational for her efforts in leading the Bulldogs to three wins and Holy Cross Invitational title ... Schofield hit .277 on the weekend with 24 kills in 10 sets on 65 attempts with just six errors ... she also added 23 digs and three blocks, including two solo in the team's wins ... in the tournament opener against Rhode Island, she hit .538 with seven kills on 13 attempts and no errors along with a pair of solo blocks ... she followed that with 11 kills and 14 digs in four sets against Holy Cross and six kills and five digs in the three-set win over Columbia.

Mildrelis Rodriguez (UE) - In four matches last week, Mildrelis Rodriguez did well in all facets of the game, notching 3.44 kills per set to go along with 3.12 digs per frame. She added a pair of service aces and five blocks. After an 8-kill, 9-dig effort against Southeast Missouri State, Rodriguez finished with a team-best 15 kills and 10 digs against undefeated Elon. In Saturday's first match against Gardner-Webb, Rodriguez had her best game of the season. In a 5-set win, she notched 20 kills and 17 digs before finishing the week with 12 kills and 14 digs against North Carolina Central. She was named to the All-Tournament Team for the weekend.

Laura Gross (INS) - Laura Gross was named to the Rocky Top Invitational All-Tournament Team after leading the Sycamores to a 2-1 mark and runners-up finish at the tournament. Gross led ISU with 36 kills (3.60 kills per set) and 48 digs (4.80 digs per set) while also assisting on three blocks. She posted a double-double in two of the three matches and Indiana State's 25-11 opening set win over Winthrop marked the largest margin of victory for ISU in a single set since 2015. She now has 26 career double-doubles, two of which came over the weekend

Quinn Spieker (LUC) - Spieker helped Loyola to its first tournament title since September 2016, averaging 3.56 kills, 3.44 digs and 0.33 aces per set, while hitting .362 (32-7-69) in three matches at the Hampton Inn Rambler Challenge last weekend. The 6-foot-3 outside hitter was tabbed tournament MVP after posting two matches with double-digit kills, including her first double-double of 2018. She spearheaded a 3-0 victory over Furman on August 31, totaling 11 kills and 15 digs, while hitting a robust .429 (11-2-21), then went for 12 kills and eight digs in a sweep of Georgia State later that day. Spieker closed out the weekend with nine kills, eight digs and a pair of aces as Loyola swept Marshall for the tournament title. Spieker is contributing 2.75 kills and 2.40 digs per set, while hitting at a .341 (55-10-132) rate. The Ramblers have now won four matches in a row, their longest streak since a five-game run in October 2015. At 4-2 already this season, Loyola is just one win shy of matching its total from all of 2017.

Aubrey Cheffey (MSU) - Aubrey Cheffey earned MVP honors at the Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational after averaging 3.00 kills and 1.11 blocks per set with a .397 hitting percentage. Cheffey posted career highs of 18 kills and six blocks in Saturday's championship match, hitting .444 in the Bears' 3-1 win against Ball State. The junior hit .429 versus Grambling and .267 against Oral Roberts, totaling nine kills and four blocks in the two sweeps.

Maggie Nedoma (SIU) - Nedoma was named to the Saluki Invitational All-Tournament Team after she led the Salukis in kills in each of their three matches. In Southern's sweep of Alabama A&M, Nedoma hit at a .458 clip and put down 13 kills to go along with an ace and four digs. She followed with 16 kills, an ace and four digs against Miami (Ohio) and closed out the tournament with her sixth-straight double-digit kill output against Murray State. Nedoma put down 12 kills and added six digs against the Racers and finished the weekend with a team-best 4.10 kills per set average.

Sydney Bronner (VALPO) - Bronner earned All-Tournament Team honors as Valpo won the Chippewa Invitational last weekend, hitting at an impressive .488 clip while averaging 2.50 kills/set as Valpo dropped just one set in winning three straight matches. Bronner tallied a team-best 11 kills in the sweep of La Salle, hitting .562 for the match, and then hit .600 with 10 kills in the win over Central Michigan - the third-best hitting percentage in a four-set match by a Valpo player in program history.

Yavianliz Rosado (BRAD) - Rosado was named MVP of the 2018 CEFCU Invitational, helping Bradley to a perfect 3-0 record. She averaged a team-best 6.82 digs per set to go with 1.36 assists and 0.27 aces per set while helping the Braves limit opponents to a .144 hitting percentage. Rosado opened the weekend with 21 digs and six assists in a four-set victory over Western Illinois. In a sweep of Toledo, she broke her own school record for digs in a three-set match with a season-best 31 and helped the Braves break the school team mark for digs in a three-set match which stood since 1988. Rosado capped the week with 23 digs, three assists and three aces in a four-set victory over George Washington to help Bradley improve to 5-1 on the season. The 5-1 start to the season matches the best six-game start to a season in school history.

Courtney Pence (ILS) - Courtney Pence started all three matches for the Redbirds this weekend, as Illinois State went 3-0 to win the Top Dawg Challenge. The senior libero averaged 5.50 digs per set this weekend, collecting 55 throughout the three matches, including a weekend-high 26 against Eastern Illinois. Her season average of 5.71 digs per set currently ranks 18th overall in all of Division I. Pence also tallied her ninth career kill over the weekend, and her first in a three-set match since the Redbirds' game versus Baylor last season, against Auburn. She led the charge in Illinois State's efforts to hold Auburn to a .000 hitting percentage for the match.

Damadj Johnson (INS) - Damadj Johnson received all-tournament honors for the second straight weekend after leading Indiana State to a 2-1 mark and runner-up finish at the Rocky Top Invitational. The junior posted 14 total blocks (4-10) over the weekend and moved into sole possession of 10th all-time at Indiana State with her 209th career block assist. She averaged 1.40 blocks per set over the weekend, up from her 1.06 career average. Following her weekend of play in Knoxville, Johnson is now ranked 46th nationally in total blocks (29) and 58th nationally in blocks per set (1.32), leading the Valley in both categories.

Elle Van Grinsven (LUC) - In three matches last week, Van Grinsven tallied 1.22 blocks and 0.89 digs per set, while also hitting 255 (22-95.1), as Loyola went 3-0 to win the Hampton Inn Rambler Challenge. The 2017 MVC All-Freshman Team honoree opened the tourney with eight kills, five digs and five blocks in a sweep of Furman. She went on to add four blocks, a dig, nine kills and two aces in a 3-0 victory over Georgia State, then concluded play with a pair of blocks, two digs and five kills as Loyola extended its winning streak to four matches with a 3-0 win against Marshall in the championship match.

Emily Butters (MSU) - Emily Butters average 6.40 digs per set and was perfect in 44 service reception chances during MSU's Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational championship run. Butters began the weekend with 26 digs in a sweep of Oral Roberts, added six more versus Grambling, and capped the tournament with 32 digs against Ball State, tying the 10th-best match total in school history. The senior became the 10th player in MVC history with 2,000 career digs in the BSU match, while tying two more school records with her fifth match of 30 or more digs and 101st match in double figures. Butters added 13 assists and two aces on the weekend while anchoring an MSU defense that allowed a .061 attack efficiency.

Alison Thomas (SIU) - Thomas averaged 4.4 digs per set to lead the Saluki defense at their home invitational. Thomas finished with a career-best four aces to go along with 14 digs in Southerr's win over Alabama A&M and tallied a team-high 19 digs with four assists and two aces in the nightcap against Miami (Ohio). The Haymarket, Vanative added 11 digs against Murray State to close out the weekend.

Peyton McCarthy (VALPO) - McCarthy continued her stellar performance at the net blocking in Valpo's three victories last weekend averaging 1.50 blocks/set as the Crusaders claimed the Chippewa Invitational title. McCarthy's weekend was highlighted by her picking up a career-high eight blocks against DePaul despite playing just the first two sets in the sweep, tied for the third-most blocks in a three-set match by a Valpo player in the 25-point era. She added four blocks as well in the sweep of La Salle, and ranks second in The Valley with 1.48 blocks/set.

Cecilia Thon (UE) - Continuing the strong start to her college career, Cecilia Thon recorded 5.50 assists in leading UE to a 2-2 mark. She posted 15 assists and six digs against SEMO and added 15 more helpers against Elon. She picked her game up in the final two contests of the weekend, startingwith 30 assists and eight digs against Gardner Webb while finishing the week with 17 assists against NC Central.

Marissa Stockman (ILS) - Marissa Stockman played in all three matches, covering all but one set for the Redbirds this weekend, as Illinois State went 3-0 to win the Top Dawg Challenge. She hit a team-best. 545 with 19 kills to improve her season hitting percentage to a league-best. 473 - which also ranks as the 14th-best among all Division I players. Stockman recorded a team-high 6.5 blocks on the weekend, including a career-high four blocks, of Illinois State's 12.0 team total, against Auburn. The freshman finished second behind Line in points contributed this weekend (25.5) and led the way with an average of 1.44 blocks per set. Stockman also hit nearly .500 in all three matches.

Makayla Knoblauch (INS) - Makayla Knoblauch (pronounced: kuh-KNOB-LOW) averaged 11.10 assists per set as Indiana State went 2-1 and finished as runners-up at the Rocky Top Invitational hosted by Tennessee. The Sycamore freshman registered a season and career-best 48 assists against North Florida, the most by any freshman setter in the league in any match this past weekend. Knoblauch also was credited with 29 digs and 10 kills and helped orchestrate ISU's 25-11 set win over Winthrop, the largest margin of victory in a single set for the Sycamores since 2015. She currently ranks 39th nationally and second in the Valley in assists per set (10.91) while ranking 43rd nationally and third in the Valley in total assists (240).

Lauren Caprini (LUC) - Caprini had an impressive weekend at the Hampton Inn Rambler Challenge, helping Loyola to its first tournament title since 2016. The freshman libero put up 3.67 digs and 0.67 aces per set as the Ramblers swept three matches and extended their winning streak to four matches. In a three-set blanking of Furman on August 31, the 5-foot-7 rookie produced eight digs and a season-high four aces, and followed that effort with nine digs in a 3-0 victory over Georgia State that evening. Caprini saved her best for last, racking up a season-high 16 digs, while adding an ace, in a sweep of Marshall in the tournament championship match. For the year, Caprini is tallying 2.75 digs and 0.65 aces per set. The Ramblers have now won four matches in a row, their longest streak since a five-game run in October 2015. At 4-2 already this season, Loyola is just one win shy of matching its lettal from all of 2017.

Chloe Rear (UE) - Chloe Rear earned all-tournament honors in Missouri State's Dr. Mary Jo Wynn Invitational championship, capping the weekend with 37 assists, six kills, three digs and two blocks in the Bears' win over Ball State. Rear opened the tournament with 18 assists and eight digs versus Oral Roberts, and had two kills, 17 assists and five digs against Grambling. She averaged 0.8 kills, 1.6 digs, 7.2 assists and 0.2 blocks for the week.



Hot Starts

Currently nine of the 10 MVC programs sit at .500 or better this season with four programs off to some of their best starts in program history.

Preseason MVC favorite UNI is the lone team to sit below .500 on the season (2-4). The Panthers have played six consecutive matches against 2017 NCAA Tournament qualifiers and teams that were either ranked or receiving votes in the AVCA Top 25 poll. The Panthers' five opponents all reached the 2nd Round or deeper in last year's NCAA tourney.

Non-Conference Success

Since 2010, the Valley has posted a record above .500 in non-conference play every year except 2014 (55-57) and 2017 (61-66). The MVC is off to a 43-19 (.694) mark after the first two weeks of action. The Valley posted a league-best .756 non-conference win percentage in 2010.

The MVC holds a winning record against 15 leagues in non-conference play (A10, Atlantic Sun, Big East, Big South, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, MEAC, Northeast, Ohio Valley, Patriot, Southland, Summit, Sun Belt, SWAC), and at least a .500 record against another two (Conference USA, Horizon) through the first two weeks of the season.

Can't Hang

The MVC holds an unblemished record in non-conference action against 12 leagues, including A10 (3-0), Big East (3-0), Big South (3-0), lvy (1-0), Metro Atlantic (1-0), Mid-Eastern (2-0), Northeast (3-0), Patriot (1-0), Southland (4-0), Summit (4-0), Sun Belt (2-0) and SWAC (3-0).

The Valley has two wins over top-25 opponents this season as UNI topped #13 Creighton 3-0 and #5 Kentucky 3-2 in Los Angeles.

Elite D

Drake has limited opponents to just .074 hitting this season, ranking second nationally behind 5th ranked Penn State. The Bulldogs also rank fifth nationally in blocks per set, averaging 3.18/set. The Bulldogs and Nittany Lions are the only two teams nationally to rank top five nationally in both categories.

Tough to Kill

The Valley has three of the top four NCAA career digs leaders, with all likely to reach the 2,000-dig club. Pence and Butters are already two of 10 players in Valley history to reach the milestone. The MVC record is held by Ellie Blankenship of UNI (2,656).

Bears Stay Hot at Home

Missouri State extended its home winning streak to 13 matches over the weekend, two shy of the school record set in 1987-88 and again in 2002-03. The Bears also won 19 consecutive sets at home before that streak ended Saturday against Ball State.

MVC Career Digs Watch

Illinois State senior Courtney Pence moved into fourth place on the all-time MVC career digs list over the weekend. Pence tallied 55 digs in matches vs. Eastern Illinois, Auburn and Butler. Pence is 13 digs away from passing Evansville's Katie Klages (2010-13) for third place on the list.

The Braves have had six other 5-1 starts to season with the most recent occurrence in 2015. The other 5-1 starts to season scame in 2013, 2012, 2000, 1994 & 1993, with the 2013 and 2000 squads the only teams in program history to open a season 6-1.



Digging the Night Away

Senior libero Yavianliz Rosado was named MVP of the 2018 CEFCU Invitational after averaging an impressive 6.82 digs per set in Bradley victories over Western Illinois, Toledo and George Washington over the weekend. Rosado, who leads the MVC and is 14th in the nation in digs per set at 5.87, had 21 or more digs in all three outings. In fact, she collected 31 digs in a three-set victory over Toledo to break her own school record for digs in a three-set match of 27 she set last year against UNI (Oct. 29, 2017). Bradley ranks 16th in the country in digs per set (19.74) and notched 85 digs in Saturday's sweep of Toledo to top the previous school mark for digs in a three-set contest (84) last done against Western Illinois on Nov. 2, 1988.

Well Rounded

Freshman outside hitter Hannah Thompson has certainly had a bit impact early on for the Braves, ranking second on the team in kills (3.35) and digs (4.61) per set. In fact, Thompson is one of just two players to rank in the top 10 in the MVC in both kills (5th) and digs (6th), joining Indiana State senior Laura Gross. Thompson has a team-best three double-doubles on the year and was named to the CEFCU Invitational All-Tournament team this past weekend after averaging 3.00 kills and 6.45 digs per set. She collected 29 digs in Friday's four-set victory over Western Illinois for the most digs by a Bradley player other than a libero since Briony Hammet had a school record 38 digs at Evansville on Oct. 22, 2005.

ILLINOIS STATE (5-1)

Strong Start

Illinois State is currently sitting at 5-1 through the first two weeks of the season – its best start since the 2013 campaign. The Redbirds have yet to go to a fifth set, making it the first time since the 2007 season that Illinois State has done this. In 2007, Illinois State didn't play in a five-set match until its 13th match into the season. The



Redbirds' three sweeps in their first six games marks the second time in four years that Illinois State has done so, as the Redbirds swept three-straight opponents in their first six matches during the 2015 season.

Hometown Hero

Ali Line was named the Top Dawg Challenge's Most Valuable Player after finishing the weekend with a team-best 26 kills on .438 hitting, averaging 2.60 kills per set. Line was one of two 'Birds to register a solo block, contributing six total blocks on the weekend. She reached double-digit kills against Eastern Illinois and Auburn to lead the team, while finishing second on the team in the category against Butler. Line's 11 kills against the Panthers matched a career-high for the senior, dating back to the 2016 season. She also matched a career-high in digs with four against Eastern Illinois, while finishing the weekend with a team-best 32.0 points for the Redbirds. At the conclusion of this weekend, Line is currently seventh overall in the MVC in hitting percentage.

Uncharted Territory

Illinois State is set to head west for the Cougar Challenge, hosted by No. 23 Washington State, this coming weekend. The Redbirds have only played the Cougars twice, dropping both matches at home in 1988, and will be playing Stony Brook and McNeese for the first time in ISU's program history. Illinois State's appearance in the State of Washington will be the Redbirds'' first time ever playing a match in the Evergreen State.

Maggie Nedoma finished first on the team with 41 kills during SIU's three matches at the Saluki Invitational en route to earning All-Tournament Team recognition. The sophomore from Brook Park, Ohio led the Salukis in kills all three matches and averaged 4.10 kills per set. She has an active streak of six-straight matches with double-digit kills and has 91 kills through six matches. Her 91 kills are the fifth-most in the conference thus far this season while her six-straight matches with double-digit kills to start the season are the most since Andrea Estrada opened the 2015 season with six-straight double-digit kill outputs.

High Efficiency

Another Tourney Title

Valpo's four-set win over Central Michigan on Saturday secured the Chippewa Invitational tournament championship, continuing a long run of tournament success for the Crusader program. In Carin Avery's 17th year as head coach at Valpo, the program has now claimed 25 in-season tournament titles. Dating back to last year, Valpo has won three of the last four in-season tournaments it has competed in.



Ketcham Reaches Milestone

Senior Allison Ketcham has quite simply been the most prolific non-libero in the back row, no matter the conference Valpo has been in, throughout her career, and she reached another milestone last weekend. Ketcham surpassed 1,500 career digs in Valpo's win over DePaul, just the eighth player in program history to reach the mark. She is now just 132 digs away from becoming the highest-ranking non-libero in digs in Crusader history.

Talk About Efficient

For a program renowned for its defense and which led the nation last year in digs/set, Valpo's attack has been strong through the first two weekends of the season never more so than in Saturday's win over Central Michigan. Valpo hit at a .396 clip for the match, finishing with 64 kills and just 11 hitting errors on 134 total attacks. The .396 hitting percentage is the best mark for a four-set match by a Valpo squad in the rally-scoring era, and second-best overall in a four-set match in program history. It also marked Valpo's best hitting percentage in any length match since the Brown and Gold hit .419 versus Chicago State in September of 2015.


