NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Lasha Petree (BRAD) - Petree paced Bradley in scoring for the fifth time this season, scoring a game-high 19 points in just 17 minutes of action to help power the Braves to an 89-59 victory over Chicago State. She also added three rebounds, two assists and six steals in BU's 10th victory of the year. Petree scored 15 of her 19 points in the first quarter, including highlighting a 23-5 Bradley run to break open a tie game with 13 points and a pair of steals during a five-and-a-half-minute stretch. Her 19-point, six-steal effort marked the highest point total by a Brave with six or more steals in a game since Michelle Young had 24 points and six steals against Missouri on Dec. 6, 2014. Petree helped Bradley earn its school record 10th non-conference victory of the year and the Braves are 10-1 to open a season for the first time in program history.

Ashli O'Neal (INS) - Ashli O'Neal scored 16 points and shot 75% from the floor and 75% from the 3-point mark in Indiana State's win over Davenport on Dec. 30. O'Neal registered four steals, dished out two assists and easily reached double figures for the 10th time in 11 games this season while shooting 6-for-8 from the floor.

Brice Calip (MSU) - Brice Calip scored a team-high 10 points and grabbed a season-high seven rebounds in Sunday's 48-44 victory over Little Rock. Calip tallied six points and five boards in the second half and shot 4-for-4 from the foul line. She also added one assist against the Trojans.

Tamara Lee (INS) - Tamara Lee led all scorers with 17 points and shot 56% from the floor as Indiana State rolled to a big win over Davenport on Dec. 30. Lee swiped two steals, did not turn the ball over, dished out one assist and was perfect 5-for-5 from the free throw line.

Jasmine Franklin (MSU) - Jasmine Franklin had eight points, six rebounds and a blocked shot in Sunday's win against Little Rock. Franklin shot 2-for-3 from the floor and 4-for-4 at the foul line, including two free throws with 10 seconds left to seal the 48-44 victory.

MVC Players and Newcomers of the Week are selected each week during the women's basketball season. The players are announced on Monday afternoon and appear in a weekly press release. Nominees are provided by each school's sports information contact and voted on by a panel appointed by the league office.

And We're Off

The league's 90-game conference slate begins on Friday, Jan. 4, with four games on the calendar. The opening weekend is highlighted by a battle of the two of the league's top teams, as Drake will travel to Bradley on Friday evening.

Valley Streak

Drake has the longest win streak in the history of the Gateway/MVC for regular season contests. The impressive streak started Feb. 26, 2016 with a win over Loyola. The Bulldogs broke SIU's 37 game streak from 1985-1987 during the Gateway era with a win over Illinois State Feb. 25. The Bulldogs enter the season with back-to-back 18-0 league seasons.

Quick Starts Crucial

Since 1982-83, just three teams (Missouri State, champions in 1998-99, 1994-95 and 1990-91; Drake, champions in 1996-97 and co-champions in 1987-88; and Evansville, a 2007-08 co-champion) have won at least a share of the regular-season title without winning its regular-season opener. In fact, 13 of the last 18 regular-season champs (or co-champs) have opened 2-0 or better in MVC play, with Evansville in 2007-08, Missouri State in 2004-05, UNI in 2010-11, Missouri State in 2011-12 and UNI in 2015-16 serving as the only five exceptions.

Title Town

The league has had nine different regular-season champions in the past 12 seasons (SIU-2007, DU/UE/ILS-2008, ILS-2009, ILS-2010, UNI-2011; MSU-2012; WSU/CU-2013; INS/WSU-2014; WSU-2015; UNI-2016; DU-2017; DU-2018). Bradley, Loyola and Valparaiso are the only league teams not to have won a regular-season MVC championship.

For Starters

The 18-game conference schedule begins this week with four games on Jan. 4. Here's a look at how current MVC members have fared in conference-opening games in the last five seasons. Southern Illinois has the current longest winning streak in MVC openers, having won its last five conference debuts.

Power Five Ahead

Drake finished the non-conference schedule with three Power Five wins on its resume as the Bulldogs beat South Carolina, Rutgers and Nebraska. The conference finished 3-13 against Power Five opponents with all but one of the games taking place on the road or a neutral court.

Vs. Top 25

Last season, the MVC went 0-9 against Top 25 opponents, breaking a streak of three-straight years with at least one win over a Top 25 team. Drake earned a 90-85 overtime win over No. 12/13 South Carolina in Vancouver in November. It was the highest ranked win over an opponent in the regular season by a Valley team since Missouri State beat No. 10 LSU on November 24, 2000. The league finished 1-8 vs. the Top 25 this year.

Against the Field

The MVC held a winning record against 10 leagues in non-conference play, including the America East (1-0), Big West (2-1), Colonial (2-0), Conference USA (4-3), Horizon (9-5), NEC (1-0), Ohio Valley (11-8), Summitt (9-5), Sun Belt (1-0) and WAC (6-1). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against the Atlantic 10 (2-2) and the SEC (1-1). The league finished above .500 in non-conference play for the first time since 2012-13 (59-55) and registered 60 non-league wins for the first time since 2010-11 (62-49).

Strength of Schedule

Drake and Missouri State have tested themselves with a difficult non-conference schedule. The Bulldogs have played the third toughest strength of schedule so far this season, while the Lady Bears' schedule ranks 47th nationally.

The New Girl Can Score

Bradley's Lasha Petree is the league's top scoring freshman, averaging 15.9 points per game to rank fifth overall in the MVC. Through games of Jan. 1, she currently ranks 7th nationally among all NCAA Division I freshmen.

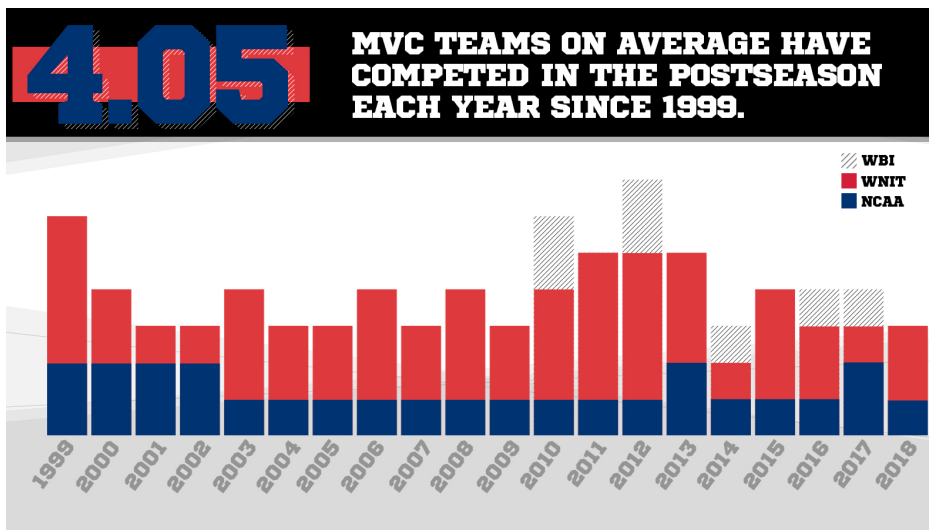

Rhine on McClain Watch List

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake junior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its second year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award will be narrowed to just 10.

Senior CLASS Award Candidate

Drake's Sammie Bachrodt has been named a candidate for the 2018-19 Senior CLASS Award. Bachrodt is among 30 NCAA Division I candidates in women's basketball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.



Postseason League

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 20 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2017-18. Drake fell at Texas A&M in the NCAA Tournament, while Missouri State and UNI each received bids into the WNIT. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 11 different seasons, including a pair of bids in the 2017 NCAA Tournament (Drake and UNI).

Hoops In the Heartland

The 2019 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the fourth-straight season.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 14-17) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

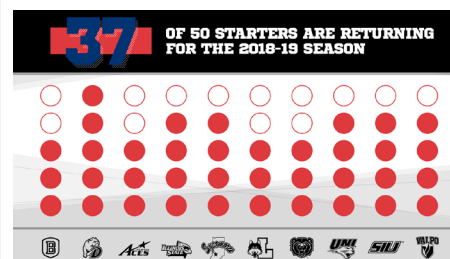
The MVC extended an agreement with the Quad Cities Convention & Visitors Bureau to conduct the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2019 tournament will mark the 12th-consecutive season in its 37-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

Starters Returning

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 37 of 50 starters return (74%) for the 2018-19 season. Defending champion Drake returns all five starters next season, while Illinois State, Indiana State, UNI, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso will see four starters return. Bradley, Evansville, Loyola and Missouri State will each see three starters return to the court.

Bradley closed out the non-conference portion of the schedule with a 10-1 record after posting an 89-59 home victory over Chicago State. The 10 non-conference victories are the most in program history and the Braves also won 10 games before Jan. 1 for the first time. Bradley is 10-1 to open a season for the first time in school history.



Home Win Streak

Last week's home win over Chicago State improved Bradley to 6-0 at Renaissance Coliseum to mark the longest home win streak since winning the final two home games of the 2007-08 season and the first seven home contests of 2008-09 campaign. That nine-game win streak was at three different venues, with the Braves winning the final two games played at Robertson Memorial Field House in 2007-08 along with the first six games at Illinois Central College in 2008-09 and an additional contest played at Richwoods High School that same season. Bradley has not had a home win streak of six or more games on campus since winning the first eight home games in 2001-02.

The Braves will play a team other than their travel partner to open league play for the first time since 2014-15. Bradley will face Drake in the conference opener for the first time since 2005-06 and sixth time overall (1-4).

Defensive Rarities

Sunday's 48-44 victory against Little Rock contained numerous rare defensive statistics. MSU's 48 points marked the team's fewest in a victory since a 47-44 win over Western Illinois in December 2006. Neither the Lady Bears (0-9) nor the Trojans (0-6) hit a 3-pointer in the game, a first for MSU since March 2012, and a first for an MSU opponent since December 2017. It was the first time that neither team connected from long range since March 13, 1993, when MSU went 0-for-4 and Southern Illinois went 0-for-5 in a 54-53 MSU victory in the MVC Tournament title game in Springfield.

Back to Chicago

Valpo is no stranger to Chicago this season as Sunday's conference opener against Loyola marks the team's third trip to Chi-Town. Valpo played at UIC on Nov. 7 to open the season and made the commute to Chicago State for a game on Nov. 29. The last time Valpo visited three different schools in Chicago in the same season was 2010-11, a year that featured a season-opening trip to DePaul as part of the preseason WNIT and Horizon League visits to Loyola and UIC.



Rambler Rivalry

Valpo had good success against Loyola a year ago, winning all three meetings including a 63-46 victory in the first round of the Missouri Valley Conference Tournament. That marked Valpo's first MVC Tournament triumph in any sport. It was also the first time the women's basketball program notched three wins against one team in the same season since 2003-2004.

Familiar Faces

Two years ago, Valpo sophomore Nicole Konieczny and Loyola sophomore Abby O'Connor were taking the floor as teammates with a state championship on the line. Now, the South Bend St. Joseph graduates oppose one another at the collegiate level. Konieczny scored nine points and O'Connor had eight in a 57-49 victory over North Harrison in the Class 3A state final at Bankers Life Fieldhouse in Indianapolis when O'Connor and Konieczny closed out their prep career together in style on Feb. 25, 2017. In addition, Loyola junior Tiara Wallace and Valpo freshman Ilysse Pitts had two years of overlap at Montini Catholic High School.
