#### **MVC Player of the Week**

#### Sara Rhine, Jr., F, Drake

Rhine, the MVC's top scorer coming into league play, posted back-to-back double-doubles, leading the Bulldogs to a pair of league road wins. She started the weekend with 22 points on 8-of-12 shooting to go with a seasonhigh 14 rebounds in the Bradley win. She added two assists, two blocks and two steals in just 20 minutes. Rhine then followed that performance with another 22 points on 9-of-18 shooting and 11 rebounds and one block

and one steal in 22 minutes in the win over Illinois State. Rhine leads the league in scoring at 19.0 points per game and field goal percentage at 58.8 and ranks second in rebounding at 8.6 per game. She has scored 20 or more points in five out of the past six games.

#### **MVC Newcomer of the Week**

#### Jasmine Franklin, Fr., F, Missouri State

Missouri State's Jasmine Franklin posted back-to-back double-doubles in home wins against Indiana State and Evansville, averaging 13.5 points, 10.5 rebounds and 2.0 blocks per game while shooting 67 percent from the field. Friday, Franklin shot 8-for-10 against Indiana State, connecting on eight consecutive attempts and finishing with 17 points and 11 boards. Sunday, the rookie had 10 points, 10 boards and three blocks in just 17

minutes of action against Evansville.

# **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Chelsea Brackmann (BRAD) - Brackmann averaged 16.5 points, 16.0 rebounds, 1.0 assist, 2.0 blocks and 1.5 steals while shooting 59 percent from the field in the first two conference games of the year. She opened the week with 11 points, nine rebounds. one assist and three steals in 25 minutes of action against Drake before turning in a historic performance against Northern Iowa. Brackmann matched the Bradley single-game record with 24 rebounds in Sunday's outing against UNI and added a seasonbest 22 points for just the third 20-20 performance in school history. In fact, Brackmann had the first 20-point, 20-rebound effort by a Brave since Shelli Braud in January 1988. Her 24 boards tied for the fifth-best total in Valley history and were the most in the MVC since 2009. Brackmann also had one assist and a career-best four blocks in the game, helping Bradley rally from 18 down early in the fourth quarter to force overtime. She scored Bradley's final four points in regulation, including the game-tying free throws with 15.5 seconds remaining, and blocked a potential game-winning shot at the buzzer. She scored eight points in the fourth and four in the overtime period.

Marley Miller (UE) - Opening Missouri Valley Conference competition, senior Marley Miller continued her strong form. Against Southern Illinois on Friday evening, Miller led the Aces with 16 points tying her career-highs in field goals made with seven and steals with three. On Sunday, Miller paced Evansville for the fourth-straight game, finishing tied for the team-high with 12 points while recording two rebounds and an assist. This season, the senior is averaging 10.2 points per game, while shooting 48% from the field and 41.8% from beyond the arc.

Tamara Lee (INS) - Tamara Lee averaged 12.5 points and shot 44.4 percent from the 3-point line as Indiana State split a pair of road games to open league play. The fifth-year player shot 38.1 percent from the field over the weekend and led the Sycamores with 17 points in ISU's 61-58 win at Southern Illinois Sunday. She swiped 8 steals and the guard grabbed seven rebounds while going 5-for-6 (.833) from the free throw line as she averaged 29.5 minutes per game. She sank a trio of 3s in that win at SIU, including a pair of bank shots with one coming from half court as the buzzer sounded.

Abby O'Connor (LUC) - Loyola sophomore forward Abby O'Connor continued her strong play of late, scoring a team-high 21 points in the Ramblers' 80-54 win over Valparaiso to open Missouri Valley Conference play on Sunday afternoon in Chicago. The South Bend, Ind. native tied a two-week-old career-high by knocking down five threes and fell just shy of a double-double, collecting nine rebounds to go along with three blocked shots. O'Connor, became the first Rambler since Taylor Johnson (2015-16) to post back-to-back games of 20-plus points, is averaging a team-best marks in both points (14.6 ppg), rebounds (7.1 rpg), and blocked shots (1.6 bpg).

Alexa Willard (MSU) - Alexa Willard shot 67 percent from the floor and 71 percent from 3-point range in two games, averaging 18.5 points per contest. Willard had a career game Sunday against Evansville, with highs of 25 points and 11 field goals in an 11-for-15 shooting performance that included eight consecutive makes in the first half and a trio of 3-pointers. Friday, Willard went 5-for-9 with 12 points against Indiana State, adding two rebounds and steals on the weekend.

**Mikaela Morgan (UNI)** - Mikaela Morgan averaged 13 points and five rebounds to help UNI go 1-1 to open up Missouri Valley Conference Play. Morgan scored eight points on 3-5 shooting in the Panther's two-point loss to Illinois State. She added four rebounds in the win. Against Bradley, she scored a career-high 18 points and added six rebounds to help UNI to an 81-78 overtime road win over Bradley.

**Nicole Martin (SIU)** - Southern Illinois junior Nicole Martin averaged a league-best 24.5 points on 70.0% (21-for-30) shooting from the field, 9.0 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals in SIU; two home games over the weekend. She opened the weekend with her fourth career double-double, as she poured in 23 points on a near perfect 11-for-12 shooting to go along with 12 rebounds, two assists and two steals in SIU's 67-47 win over Evansville. The 2018 Preseason All-MVC selection followed with a career-high 26 points to go along with six rebounds, an assist, a steal and a block in a career-best 39 minutes against Indiana State on Sunday. The back-to-back 20-plus point outputs marked the second time that the Jefferson City, Mo. native has reached 20-plus points in consecutive games during her career and she has now reached double figures in 10 of SIU's 13 games this season.

Monica Burich (DU) - Colorado transfer Monica Burich averaged 7.0 points, 3.5 rebounds, 1.5 assists and 1.5 steals in the Bulldogs' pair of wins. Burich scored six points, grabbed five rebounds (three offensive), nabbed two steals and handed out two assists against the Braves in a career-high 21 minutes. She is averaging 4.4 points and 2.9 rebounds per game in her first season and has played in every game.

**A'Niah Griffin (UE)** - In the first two games of the conference season, freshman A'Niah Griffin continued to produce in her freshman campaign. Facing SIU, Griffin tallied four points and three rebounds in 22 minutes on the court, earning her seventh start of the season. Closing the weekend, Griffin scored a career-high 12 points and tallied a career-best six rebounds, while tying a career-high with three steals on the road at Missouri State on Sunday. On the year, Griffin sits fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 5.6 points per game, and has started eight of the last nine games for Evansville.

**TeTe Maggett (ILS)** - TeTe Maggett topped her personal best and led all scorers with 29 points as she guided the Redbirds to their first victory over UNI since 2014 on Friday. The North Chicago native was perfect from the charity stripe this weekend, netting 8-for-8 in two contests. She grabbed a career high three steals in win on Friday and added five this weekend. On Sunday, Maggett added 13 points, tallying her 10th consecutive double-digit game. t Indiana State, adding two rebounds and steals on the weekend.

Janae Gonzales (LUC) - Loyola freshman Janae Gonzales returned from a concussion in Sunday's 80-54 win over Valparaiso to open the Ramblers' Missouri Valley Conference slate. The Tolleson, Ariz. product didn't miss a beat, connecting on five of her seven attempts from beyond the three-point arc en route to finishing with 17 points. Gonzales, a two-time MVC Newcomer of the Week selection during the non-conference portion of Loyola's schedule, currently ranks third on the Rambler roster in scoring (11.3 ppg) and has knocked down a team-high 23 shots from distance.

**Cynthia Wolf (UNI)** - Cynthia Wolf averaged 9.5 points and 3.0 rebounds to help UNI go 1-1 on the opening weekend of MVC Play. She scored 12 points in just 12 minutes on the floor against Illinois State. She was 4-6 from the field and 3-5 from the three-point line. She also added a pair of rebounds. Against Bradley, she was 2-4 from the field and 1-1 from the three-point line. She added four rebounds.

## **Three Perfect in MVC Play**

Drake (2-0), Missouri State (2-0) and Loyola (1-0) remain perfect after the first weekend of league play. The three teams will put their undefeated MVC records on the line this weekend as Drake hosts Loyola and Valparaiso and Missouri State hosts Southern Illinois.

#### **Home Sweet Home**

Since 2002, home teams have won at least 55 (.611) of the 90 league contests in all but seven seasons (2003-04, 2006-07, 2013-14, 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18). The most wins by home teams in league play came in 2008 (61-29 at home in conference play). The league was 49-41 (.544) at home in league play last year, and has compiled a 5-4 (.556) mark so far in 2018-19.

#### 1,000 Point Club

Drake's Sammie Bachrodt became the sixth active MVC player and 33rd Bulldog to join the 1,000 Point Club. Bachrodt's 11 points against Bradley allowed her to become the fourth active Bulldog player to enter the club. The four active players are second nationally behind Marquette and Notre Dame (each with five).

## Valley Streak

Drake has the longest win streak in the history of the Gateway/MVC for regular season contests, winning 42-straight. The impressive streak started Feb. 26, 2016 with a win over Loyola. The Bulldogs broke SIU's 37 game streak from 1985-1987 during the Gateway era with a win over Illinois State last season. The streak is the second longest active streak against conference opponents, trailing only UConn's streak of 117 straight wins in the American.

#### **Power Five Ahead**

Drake finished the non-conference schedule with three Power Five wins on its resume as the Bulldogs beat South Carolina, Rutgers and Nebraska. The conference finished 3-13 against Power Five opponents with all but one of the games taking place on the road or a neutral court.

#### Vs. Top 25

Last season, the MVC went 0-9 against Top 25 opponents, breaking a streak of three-straight years with at least one win over a Top 25 team. Drake earned a 90-85 overtime win over No. 12/13 South Carolina in Vancouver in November, It was the highest ranked win over an opponent in the regular season by a Valley team since Missouri State beat No. 10 LSU on November 24, 2000. The league finished 1-8 vs. the Top 25 this year.

#### Against the Field

The MVC held a winning record against 10 leagues in non-conference play, including the America East (1-0), Big West (2-1), Colonial (2-0), Conference USA (4-3), Horizon (9-5), NEC (1-0), Ohio Valley (11-8), Summitt (9-5), Sun Belt (1-0) and WAC (6-1). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against the Atlantic 10 (2-2) and the SEC (1-1). The league finished above .500 in non-conference play for the first time since 2012-13 (59-55) and registered 60 nonleague wins for the first time since 2010-11 (62-49).

#### Strength of Schedule

Drake and Missouri State tested themselves with a difficult non-conference schedule. The Bulldogs played the third toughest non-conference strength of schedule this season (2nd overall toughest schedule), while the Lady Bears' schedule ranked 33rd nationally.

#### **Double Your Pleasure**

Bradley's Chelsea Brackmann is the only MVC player averaging a double-double this season. The junior is averaging 11.7 points and 11.4 rebounds per game (leads MVC, 17th nationally). Brackmann has six double-doubles on the season. Below are players with four or more double-doubles this sea-

## **Sharp Shooters**

A year after seeing Evansville lead the nation in free-throw percentage (82.0%), The Valley has two of the nation's top five teams in the category so far this season. Loyola currently leads the league and sits 3rd nationally, while UNI sits 5th.

Loyola's Abby O'Connor leads The Valley and ranks No. 2 nationally hitting 94.3% of her attempts. In 2012-13, UNI's Jacqui Kalin set the MVC record with a percentage of 95.5% for a season.

## Taking Care of the Ball

SIU's Brittney Patrick currently leads The Valley, and ranks 8th nationally, in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.40). Patrick's 5.2 assists per game also leads the MVC and ranks 45th nationally while she also leads the league in total assists (68). SIU has only once had a player lead the league in assists per game (Cartaesha Macklin, 2013) and Patrick's 3.40 assist-to-turnover ratio would be a school record and would be the highest ratio in the MVC since at least the 2002-03 season.

## **Sharing the Rock**

Over the past five seasons, Drake has ranked in the top 10 every season in the NCAA in assists per game, including leading the nation a year ago. The Bulldogs are once again sharing the basketball as they enter the week No. 2 in the country averaging 22.3 assists per contest.

## **Pounding the Glass**

Bradley's Chelsea Brackmann highlighted Sunday's overtime contest against UNI with just the third 20-20 performance in school history. Brackmann, who scored a season-best 22 points, tied the Bradley single-game record with 24 rebounds. Brackmann's 24 boards are the second most in the country this season and tied for the fifth most in MVC history. No MVC player has collected 24 rebounds in a game since 2009 and she had the first 20-20 effort in a conference game dating back to a 26-point, 21-rebound performance by Dyana Pierre (SIU) vs. Northern Iowa on Feb. 8, 2015. The last 20-20 effort by a Bradley player was Shelli Braud at UNI on Jan. 17, 1988 (32 points & 21 reb.).

#### **Rhine on McClain Watch List**


The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake junior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its second year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2019 Katrina McClain Award will be narrowed to just 10.

#### **Senior CLASS Award Candidate**

Drake's Sammie Bachrodt has been named a candidate for the 2018-19 Senior CLASS Award. Bachrodt is among 30 NCAA Division I candidates in women's basketball for the award which recognizes notable achievements in four areas of excellence – community, classroom, character and competition.

#### **Title Town**

The league has had nine different regular-season champions in the past 12 seasons (SIU-2007, DU/UE/ILS-2008, ILS-2009, ILS-2010, UNI-2011; MSU-2012; WSU/CU-2013; INS/WSU-2014; WSU-2015; UNI-2016; DU-2017; DU-2018). Bradley, Loyola and Valparaiso are the only league teams not to have won a regular-season MVC championship.



#### **Postseason League**

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 20 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2017-18. Drake fell at Texas A&M in the NCAA Tournament, while Missouri State and UNI each received bids into the WNIT. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 11 different seasons, including a pair of bids in the 2017 NCAA Tournament (Drake and UNI).

## **Hoops In the Heartland**

The 2019 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, Ill., for the fourth-straight season.

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 14-17) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.

The MVC extended an agreement with the Quad Cities Convention & Visitors Bureau to conduct the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2019 tournament will mark the 12th-consecutive season in its 37-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

## **Starters Returning**

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 37 of 50 starters return (74%) for the 2018-19 season. Defending champion Drake returns all five starters next season, while Illinois State, Indiana State, UNI, Southern Illinois and Valparaiso will see four starters return. Bradley, Evansville, Loyola and Missouri State will each see three starters return to the court.

# **BRADLEY (10-3, 0-2 MVC)**

#### **Consistent Effort**

Sophomore Gabi Haack has scored in double figures in 12 of 13 games this season and 14 of the last 15 games dating back to last season. In fact, her only game not scoring in double figures this season was a nine-point effort against Rockhurst. Haack has scored 10 or more



points in 11 consecutive games for the longest streak by a Brave since Monica Rogers scored at least 10 points in the final 11 contests of the 2008-09 campaign. The last Brave to score 10 points or more in 12 consecutive games was Sara Bailey, who reached double digits in scoring in the final eight games of 2000-01 and first four contests of 2001-02. Bailey also had a streak of 16 consecutive games in double figures during her sophomore season (2000-01).

#### **Road Success**

Bradley's first Missouri Valley Conference victory has come on the road each of the last two years and four of the last five seasons. In fact, the Braves have picked up their first Valley win away from home in five of the last seven years. Bradley is 5-4 on the road in the month of January under head coach Andrea Gorski. This season, the Braves have four wins away from home (3 road & 1 neutral), which is the third most in the MVC behind only Drake (7) and Indiana State (5).

### **Heading East**

Sunday's game at Indiana State will mark Bradley's fifth game of the year in the Eastern Time Zone. The Braves have not played five games in the Eastern Time Zone since 2011-12 and Bradley's three wins in the Eastern Time Zone (at Florida Atlantic, vs. Delaware & at Cleveland St.) are the team's most since going 4-2 during that same 2011-12 campaign.

## **DRAKE (10-4, 2-0 MVC)**

#### **Another in the Club**

Senior Sammie Bachrodt became the 33rd player in program history to score 1,000 or more career points with her 11 points in the Bulldogs' win over Bradley. Bachrodt is the fourth Bulldog to have 1,000 or more points, joining Maddy Dean, Becca Hittner and Sara



Rhine. There are only two other 1,000-point or more scorers in the MVC. Over the weekend, she moved to No. 6 all-time in career steals at Drake with seven in the two games with 222 steals.

#### **Double-Double**

Rhine, the MVC's top scorer coming into league play, posted back-to-back double-doubles in the team's wins. She started the weekend with 22 points on 8-of-12 shooting to go with a season-high 14 rebounds (1 off her career high) in the Bradley win. She added two assists, two blocks and two steals in just 20 minutes. Rhine then followed that performance with another 22 points on 9-of-18 shooting and 11 rebounds and one block and one steal in 22 minutes in the win over Illinois State. In the two games, Rhine made a 9-of-10 from the free throw line. Rhine leads the league in scoring at 19.0 points per game and field goal percentage at 58.8 and ranks second in rebounding at 8.6 per game. She has scored 20 or more points in five out of the past six games and a team-high seven this season.

#### **Assist You Continues**

Drake, one of the top teams in the nation in assists going into the first weekend of MVC play, tallied 47 in the two games. The Bulldogs made 56 field goals and assisted on 80 percent of its makes.

#### **Landmark Win**

Illinois State captured its seventh-straight win and first victory over UNI since 2014 on Friday. ISU has dropped the previous 10 matchups against the Panthers. The streak of seven wins is the longest since the 2012-13 season.

#### **Defense**

Illinois State leads the Valley and sits top 100 in the nation in scoring defense, only allowing 59.7 points per game. # **INDIANA STATE (7-6, 1-1 MVC)**

#### **Queens Returns**

The Queens of the Comeback returned to the hard-wood as Missouri Valley Conference play opened up. Indiana State overcame a nine-point second half deficit to rally for a 61-58 win at Southern Illinois on Jan. 6. This marks the fourth game this season that Indiana



State has rallied from a second half deficit for a win with all four wins coming on the road.

#### **Success in Small Margins**

This year Indiana State has started to find more success in games decided by small margins than they have in recent memory. The Sycamores have posted a 5-1 mark this season in games decided by 10 or fewer points, matching the same number of wins in that category from a year ago. ISU has not posted a winning record in those close games since the 2014-15 season, when they went 8-6 (.571) in such contests.

### **Swipe Right (and Left)**

Indiana State is putting its defensive pressure on opponents and coming away with added possessions because of it. Early on this season the Sycamores are averaging 10.9 steals per game, the most an Indiana State team has averaged for a season since averaging 11.4 per game in 2004-05. That mark ranks the Trees 36th in the nation and first in the Valley.

# **MISSOURI STATE (6-7, 2-0 MVC)**

#### **Lady Bears Tie JQH Streak**

Missouri State won its 10th straight home MVC game on Sunday, tying school's longest such streak at JQH Arena and the fifth-longest in school history. MSU also won 10 consecutive home league contests from Feb. 25, 2011 to March 1, 2012. Since the current streak



began on Jan. 7, 2018, the Lady Bears have won all 10 games by double digits, averaging 77.3 points per game compared to 55.2 for opponents with a .469 field goal percentage and plus-11.7 rebounding margin.

#### **Solid League Start**

MSU won its first two MVC games for third time in the last four seasons and 13th time in 27 years in the Valley. After the previous twelve 2-0 starts, the Lady Bears have won the regular season four times, finished second six times, and placed third twice.

#### **Franklin Continues to Impress**

Jasmine Franklin leads the Lady Bears in both rebounding and field goal percentage, and could be the first freshman to do so in either category since Casey Garrison a decade ago. Franklin's .582 field goal percentage is on pace to rank eighth in school history and first among freshmen. Jackie Dudley owns the freshman mark, shooting 56.9 percent in the 1976-77 season.

# **SOUTHERN ILLINOIS (8-5, 1-1 MVC)**

#### **Conference Openers**

With SIU's win over Evansville, Southern improved to 6-0 in conference openers under head coach Cindy Stein. SIU's six-straight wins in conference openers are a school record since conference play began in 1982. Southern previously won five-straight Gateway



Conference openers under Cindy Scott from 1982-87 while SIU's six conference opening wins under Stein are more wins in conference openers than the Salukis had in the 15 seasons (1998-2013) prior to her arrival.

## **Nearly Perfect**

Nicole Martin made her first 11 attempts from the floor in the win over Evansville and finished 11-for-12. Martin's 91.7% shooting was the best by a Saluki with at least 10 attempts since Dyana Pierre made 14-of-14 attempts from the floor in SIU's win over Murray State on Dec. 16, 2014. Nationally, it's tied for the fifth-best shooting performance of the season, and it ranks second to Sara Rhine's 10-for-10 night against NAIA foe Clarke University for tops in the league.

#### **Taking Care of the Ball**

Brittney Patrick currently leads the Valley, and ranks 8th nationally, in assist-to-turnover ratio (3.40). Patrick's 5.2 assists per game also leads the MVC and ranks 45th nationally while she also leads the league in total assists (68). SIU has only once had a player lead the league in assists per game (Cartaesha Macklin, 2013) and Patrick's 3.40 assist-to-turnover ratio would be a school record and would be the highest ratio in the MVC since at least the 2002-03 season.

# VALPARAISO (4-9, 0-1 MVC)

#### **Valuing Possessions**

Valpo has won or tied the turnover battle nine times in the first 13 games of the season. The team committed a season-low seven turnovers in the conference opener at Loyola. Valpo has limited the turnover total to single-digits in back-to-back games as the team made



just nine, then a season low, on Dec. 21 vs. Bowling Green. The seven turnovers against Loyola was the team's lowest turnover total in a single game since making just six on Dec. 12, 2015 vs. Miami (Ohio). The last time Valpo had consecutive games with fewer than 10 turnovers was 2008 (Feb. 2 nine vs. Cleveland State; Feb. 7 four vs. Loyola). Valpo has a turnover margin of +1.8 per game as the program will try to finish the season with a positive turnover margin for the first time since 2009-2010.

#### **Stoller Shines Bright**

After an injury-riddled first two seasons in a Valpo uniform, redshirt sophomore Addison Stoller has been a bright spot for Valpo this season. She has scored in double figures in six of her last seven games and has scored nine points or more in 12 of the team's 13 games this season. A model of consistency for Valpo, Stoller has also had six rebounds or more on nine occasions and leads the team in rebounding at 6.8 caroms per contest.

#### **Road Warriors**

When this lowa road swing is said and done, Valpo still won't have played a home game in conference play. This marks the first time Valpo has started a league slate with three straight tilts away from home since 2010-2011, when the team started at Butler before visiting Detroit and Wright State.
