## **MVC Defensive Player of the Week**

## Ben Stroud, Sr., D, Missouri State

Ben Stroud anchored a Missouri State backline that recorded its fourth shutout of the season in a 4-0 win over Western Illinois on Thursday, Sept. 26. The senior defender joined the Bears' attack to score a pair of goals to collect his first career brace. Stroud scored his first goal of the season in the 43rd minute on a header off of a Greg Stratton cross following an MSU free kick. He notched his second header in the 69th minute on a corner kick to extend the Bears' lead to 3-0. Stroud

launched a career-high four shots in a match that MSU tallied a season-high 21 shots.

## **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Leroy Enzugusi (DU) - Enzugusi assisted on Drake's go-ahead goal in its 2-0 win over Valparaiso on Wednesday. He streaked up the field before threading the needle between two defenders with a through ball to Austin Smythe, who found the back of the net to give the Bulldogs the lead for good. Enzugusi scored a goal of his own in the 80th minute by collecting a long advance, evading the goalkeeper, who had aggressively come off his line, and then rocketing his team-best fourth goal of the year into the upper-right corner. In addition, he earned three free kicks inside Valpo's defensive third in a 12-minute span during the second half.

Josh Dolling (MSU) - Josh Dolling scored his MVC-leading fifth goal of the season in Missouri State's 4-0 win over non-conference foe Western Illinois on Thursday, Sept. 26. In the 84th minute, teammate Matthew Bentley found Dolling on the right side of the Leathernecks' box as the junior forward fired a shot past the WIU goalkeeper to seal the Bears' 4-0 win. Dolling finished the match with five shots with four of the shots being on goal. The 2018 MVC goal and points leader has continued the hot start to his junior campaign, leading the conference in both categories with five goals and 12 total points.

Liam Wilson (DU) - On Wednesday, Wilson was named to the College Soccer News National Team of the Week for his outstanding service as the stalwart of Drake's back line. Wilson played all 360 minutes of Drake's four-game shutout streak and contributes to victories in ways that don't always show up in the stat sheet. In the 68th minute against Valparaiso, Wilson hustled back in transition and dispossessed a Crusader attacker in the box before he could unleash a shot.

Frederik Reimer (UE) - In the lone match of the week for the Aces, Reimer made a career-high saves against Santa Clara on Sunday afternoon. Against the Broncos, Reimer made a career-best eight saves in the Aces' loss to Santa Clara. Reimer's 173 saves in his career place him in fifth in program history in saves.

**Marcel Kampman (LUC)** - Kampman recorded his second shutout of the season against Bradley this week and stood strong in the net with four saves against Drake. The Graduate Student only allowed one goal this week while tallying over 218 minutes between the posts.



## **MVC SOCCER NOTES**

#### No Place Like Home

MVC men's soccer programs have been extremely successful at home this non-conference season, sitting 11-3-2 on their home pitches. The start is the best in MVC men's soccer since the 2009 season when MVC programs went 16-4-2 at home in non-league play.

In conference matches, the visitors have held the advantage with home teams currently 3-4-1 on the season.

#### **Bears Remain Perfect**

Missouri State extended its winning streak to seven games with a 4-0 win at Western Illinois Thursday. The Bears have opened their season with seven straight wins for the first time since the 1995 team went 7-0 to begin the season. The seven-game winning streak is Missouri State's longest winning streak since 2017, matching the seven-game stretch that went from Sept. 13, 2017 to Oct. 7, 2017.

The Bears are one of four teams still sitting perfect in all of NCAA Division I, joining SMU, Navy and Virginia (Through Sept. 29).

## Streak Snapped

Drake's run of four-straight shutouts was snapped in their 2-1, double-overtime loss to Loyola on Sunday. Drake held opponents scoreless for 423:56, or just over seven hours of game time.

#### RPI Update

According to RPI Update (not official NCAA) Missouri State sits 25th in the RPI at this point with Loyola coming in at No. 38. The MVC ranks 12th as a conference.

#### Aces vs. Ranked MVC Opponents

On Saturday, the Aces will face nationally ranked Missouri State at Arad McCutchan Stadium. The last ranked MVC opponent the Aces faced was 13th-ranked Loyola on October 15 when Evansville and the Ramblers battled to a 1-1 draw. The Aces haven't lost to a ranked conference opponent at McCutchan since Nov. 3, 2012 against No. 16 Creighton.

## **National Team of the Week**

Loyola's Aidan Megally and Missouri State's Ben Stroud earned a spot on this week's 11-member College Soccer News Team of the Week. Megally scored twice including the game-winner in overtime in Loyola's 2-1 win over Drake. Stroud scored twice and anchored a shutout in MSU's 4-0 win over Western Illinois.

#### **Polling**

Missouri State continued to rise in the national rankings this week, appearing at No. 17 in the latest United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll, No. 19 in the TopDrawerSoccer.com Top 25 and No. 25 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll.

### **MVC** in Regional Rankings

The MVC has three teams currently ranked in the latest United Soccer Coaches West Regional rankings released on Tuesday (Oct. 1). Missouri State sits No. 2 in the region, while Loyola is ranked 6th & Drake 9th.

## **Valpo Redo**

Sunday's Missouri Valley Conference men's soccer game against Valparaiso at Bradley's Shea Stadium was cancelled in the 66th minute, 3-and-a-half hours after the game's initial kickoff, due to consistent lightning in the area, the result of a slow-moving storm that had produced a tornado warning in neighboring Fulton County. The game



will be replayed from its beginning Tuesday with a 7:30 p.m. kickoff from Valparaiso's Brown Field. As part of The Valley's double round-robin league schedule, the teams were slated to play the return game Oct. 27 at Valparaiso, but that game now will be played Oct. 27 at Shea Stadium.

#### **Extra Time**

Including three of this season's first seven games (0-0-3), 10 of Bradley's last 20 games have gone to extra time and the Braves have emerged from those games with a 3-1-6 (.600) record. During the 2018 season, Bradley saw eight of its 17 games go to overtime and the Braves escaped with a 3-1-4 (.625) record in the sudden-victory scenario.

Reimer's 174 career saves place him in fifth in Aces' history.

#### **Accurate Aces**

Evansville has been accurate on its shots this season, converting 51.2% of their shots in 2019. This places the Aces in 12th in the nation in shot accuracy and best in the MVC. Of Evansville's 90 shots, 46 of them have been on-goal, more than five percent better than the second-best team in the MVC, Missouri State (45.4%).
