#### Aidan Megally, Sr., MF, Loyola

For the second match in a row, Loyola senior Aidan Megally notched two goals to guide Loyola in a 2-0 win at Northwestern. The senior also tallied a goal in Loyola's 2-0 win over Valparaiso on Saturday. ## **MVC Defensive Player of the Week**

## Greg Stratton, Jr., D, Missouri State

Defender Greg Stratton played a key role for the Missouri State defense that allowed just one goal in the Bears' sweep of conference opponents Drake and Bradley last week. Stratton and the MSU backline recorded the team's fourth straight shutout in a 3-0 win against Bradley on Wednesday, Oct. 9. The defense held the Braves to just two shots in the first half and six overall to preserve the clean sheet for MSU. The junior from Marietta, Ga. played the full 90 minutes in the Bears' 3-1 win over

Drake on Sunday, Oct. 13. The Bears extended their season-long streak of holding opponents scoreless in the second half and overtime. Stratton was one of eight MSU players to record a shot against Drake as the Bears posted a 17-3 shot advantage over the Bulldogs on Sunday.

## **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Erik Fahner (DU)** - Fahner notched the game-winning goal in Drake's 1-0 victory over Evansville on Oct. 9, a game that was called off in the 78th minute due to inclement weather. After the Bulldogs drew a penalty kick, Fahner coolly approached the spot, hesitated slightly in his approach to throw off the keeper's timing, and calmly struck the decisive goal into the lower-left corner of the net. It was the first goal of Fahner's career.

**Matthew Bentley (MSU)** - Matthew Bentley scored three goals in two matches this past week for No. 14 Missouri State as the Bears extended their perfect season with a pair of wins at home against Bradley and Drake. Bentley recorded his second straight brace in MSU's 3-0 win over Bradley on Wednesday, Oct. 9. The senior forward collected his third PK goal of the season in the Bears' 3-1 over Drake on Sunday, Oct. 13. Bentley has scored in three straight matches for MSU, tallying five of the Bears' 10 goals in the three-game stretch. In his first season at Missouri State, Bentley leads the conference with 17 total points on a team-high seven goals and three assists.

Liam Wilson (DU) - Wilson is the captain of Drake's backline, and his steady play helped the Bulldogs to blank Evansville in a 1-0 victory. The Bulldogs limited the Purple Aces to three shots on goal and one corner kick, and the clean sheet was their fifth of the season. Wilson also chipped in offensively against No. 14 Missouri State, heading home the equalizer on a free kick in the 44th minute for his first goal as a Bulldog.



## **MVC SOCCER NOTES**

## **Last Team Standing**

Missouri State extended its winning streak to 11 games with wins over Bradley and Drake last week. The Bears have opened their season with 11 straight wins for the first time in program history. The winning streak ranks first nationally and is one shy of the program's top streak of 12-straight in 1999.

Missouri State is the first MVC program to start a season 11-0-0 since SMU started the 2001 season 21-0-0 before suffering its only loss in the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals to St. John's.

The Bears are the only team still sitting perfect in all of NCAA Division I.

## **High Scoring Bears**

Missouri State has already scored 27 goals on the season, marking their best season output this decade, surpassing 26 goals in 2018 and 2011. The Bears have only led The Valley in scoring twice in league history, netting 59 goals in 1995 and 49 goals in 1999 (MVC Champs with 17-1-3 record).

#### **Road Winning Streak**

Missouri State enters this week with a sixmatch road winning streak as the Bears head to Bradley Saturday. The streak is tied for the second longest in all of NCAA Division I with Navy. St. Mary's (CA) has the longest at 7.

## **Team Academic Honors**

United Soccer Coaches announced on Oct. 3 the Team Academic Award Winners at the high school and college levels to recognize exemplary performance in the classroom during the 2018-19 academic year. College Team Academic Award recipients have a composite grade point of average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale for all players on the roster.

## **Polling**

Missouri State continues to appear in the national rankings this week, appearing at No. 14 in the latest United Soccer Coaches Top 25 poll, No. 22 in the TopDrawerSoccer. com Top 25 and No. 16 in the College Soccer News Top 30 poll. The No. 14 ranking marks the highest spot for the Bears since the 2005 team peaked at No. 9 during an eight-week stretch inside the top-25.

#### **MVC** in Regional Rankings

The MVC has four teams currently ranked in the latest United Soccer Coaches West Regional rankings released on Tuesday (Oct. 15). Missouri State moved up to the top spot in the region and sits No. 1, while Loyola (6th), Drake (9th) and Bradley (10th) also sit in the poll.

#### No Place Like Home

MVC men's soccer programs have been extremely successful at home during non-conference play, sitting 12-3-2 on their home pitches. The record is the best in MVC men's soccer since the 2009 season when MVC programs went 16-4-2 at home in non-league play.

## **BRADLEY (4-4-3, 3-2-1 MVC)**

## **Road Heavy Start**

Despite playing five of its first six Missouri Valley Conference games on the road, Bradley emerged from its league road travels with 10 points in the league standings. Seven of those points came in the five road games, where the Braves went 2-2-1. With a win against Drake in its lone Valley home game to date, Bradley will close the double



round robin conference schedule with four home games, starting Saturday night against #14 Missouri State.

## **Road Trip Not Complete**

Although the Braves have completed their conference travels, Bradley is far from done with its road schedule. Bradley will complete a 3-games-in-7-days road swing Tuesday afternoon by visiting former Valley coaching rival Bob Warming and his Omaha Mavericks. Following Tuesday's trip to Omaha, Bradley still will have non-conference road games remaining Nov. 1 at Northern Kentucky and Nov. 4 at Western Illinois.

## **Win Streak**

After wins over Northwestern and Valparaiso this week, the Ramblers are on their longest winning streak of the season, winning three-straight. The last time Loyola won three-straight was their

## **Season High Shots**

Loyola outshot Valparaiso 19-6 on Saturday, which registered as a season-high for the Maroon & Gold. Of the 19 shots taken by 10 different Ramblers, 10 shots were on goal. Senior Aidan Megally leads Loyola with 40 shots this season, which sits second in the MVC.

## **Kings of Chicago**

Loyola will look for a sweep of its three local rivals in its non-conference finale against UIC on Tuesday. The Ramblers have already defeated crosstown foes DePaul and Northwestern this season, while UIC went 1-1, falling to Northwestern in overtime. Loyola has won four of its last seven matches over UIC.

## **#14 MISSOURI STATE (11-0, 5-0 MVC)**

#### **Still Perfect**

Missouri State extended its perfect season as the only unbeaten, untied team remaining in all of Division-I men's soccer. The 11-game winning streak is one game shy of matching the program's longest winning streak set in 1999. The 5-0 start to MVC play is MSU's best Valley run to start a season since 2013.



#### Milestone Win

Head coach, Jon Leamy recorded his 100th career conference victory on Sunday against Drake. Leamy is the Valley's all-time leader in conference wins, holding a 100-72-23 record in league play.

#### **Elite on Both Ends**

The Bears' attack ranks seventh in the nation and leads the conference in scoring offense with 78 total points on 27 goals and 24 assists. MSU has allowed the third fewest goals in Division-I with four goals allowed this season for an MVC-best 0.356 goals against average. Missouri State joins #2 SMU as the only two teams to rank Top 10 nationally in both goals per game and goals allowed per game.

## **Holst Atop Valley**

Valpo goalkeeper Edvin Holst is the Missouri Valley Conference leader in both total saves (45) and saves per game (5.63), also ranking among the national leaders in those areas. He has been active behind a youthful back line, making key contributions as a rookie. The last Valpo keeper to lead a league in



saves was Ryan Schwarz in 2007. The standard for reaching the Top 10 in program history for single-season saves is 102, which currently occupies 10th (Marc Cilifone 2001).

## **Frequent Foe**

With the completion of Saturday's game, an all-time series that goes back to 1983 between Valpo and Loyola has officially continued in 2019. This marks the 13th consecutive year the two teams have played one another, making the Ramblers the only opponent that Valpo has played in every year of Mike Avery's head coaching tenure.

#### **Road Grind Continues**

When it comes to hitting the road, Valpo has faced a schedule that consists of exclusively winning sides so far this season. None of the team's seven away fixtures to date have come against teams that entered the match with a losing record. Saturday's match is the third in a stretch of five straight on the road. This week presents yet another challenge as Milwaukee stands at 3-1-1 at home and 5-6-1 overall. If the Panthers win their game at Eastern Illinois on Tuesday afternoon, Valpo will face an eighth straight road fixture against a side with a .500 or better overall record on Saturday.
