### MVC Offensive Player of the Week



#### Roman Schindler, Sr., F, Bradley

Schindler's first two points of the 2019 campaign helped lift the Braves to a pair of Missouri Valley Conference victories last week. Now Bradley's active leader with eight career assists, Schindler assisted the game-winning goal in each of the two games last week, a 2-1 double-overtime win at Valparaiso and a 1-0 victory against Drake. In Tuesday's win at Valparaiso, Schindler played a cross in from the right flank to help set up TJ Rea's game-winner with just 1:47 left to play. In Saturday's 1-0 Homecoming win against Drake, Schindler rose above the fray to head a Jha'Lon Johnson service back in front of the goal, where Cameron Strang knocked home the game's lone goal at 55:34.

### MVC Defensive Player of the Week



#### Michael Creek, Jr., GK, Missouri State

Missouri State goalkeeper Michael Creek played 168:63 minutes between the pipes in back-to-back shutouts posted by the Bears this past week. He kept non-pipeline opponent Omaha off the scoreboard in MSU's 1-0 double overtime win against the Mavericks on Tuesday, Oct. 1. Creek played all 106:08 minutes for the Bears and recorded three saves in the match, including an impressive diving save in the 64th minute to preserve the shutout for MSU. The junior from St. Louis collected a season-high four saves in the Bears' 4-0 win over Evansville on Saturday, Oct. 5. Creek has made all nine starts for MSU this season, securing clean sheets in six of those matches.

## NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

**Matthew Bentley (MSU)** - Matthew Bentley scored a pair of goals in the first half of Missouri State's 4-0 win over Evansville on Saturday, Oct. 5. Bentley delivered the first two goals of the match for MSU, beginning with a penalty kick in the 17th minute to bag his second PK goal of the year. He followed minutes later with his fourth goal of the season, collecting a pass from teammate Ian Jones and firing a shot past the Evansville goalkeeper. Bentley played 83 minutes and added a shot in the Bears' 1-0 double overtime win against Omaha on Tuesday, Oct. 1. In his first season with the Bears, the senior forward has 10 points on four goals and two assists with 11 total shots. With his two-goal performance against UE, Bentley has scored all four of his goals this season against MVC opponents, scoring a goal in back-to-back matches against Valparaiso and Loyola.

**Cameron Strang (BRAD)** - Strang was inserted into the lineup Sept. 21 at Drake and now has served as a starting back in each of Bradley's last four games, while playing all 308 minutes during the current 3-game unbeaten (2-0-1) unbeaten streak ... In addition to limiting Valparaiso and Drake each to four shots on goal in the two wins last week, Strang netted the game-winning goal in Saturday's 1-0 Homecoming victory against Drake ... His first career goal Saturday night came on one of the defender's five shots in the two games.

**Luke Anderson (DU)** - Anderson tied his career best by recording four saves against Bradley in Drake's lone match of the week. He made a remarkable save in the 18th minute when he came off his line to close down a Bradley attacker in the box, shutting off the angle and reacting quickly to parry away the near-post attempt. The save was one of three Anderson made in the first 20 minutes as he resisted Bradley's early pressure.

## MVC SOCCER NOTES

### No Place Like Home

MVC men's soccer programs have been extremely successful at home this non-conference season, sitting 12-3-2 on their home pitches. The start is the best in MVC men's soccer since the 2009 season when MVC programs went 16-4-2 at home in non-league play.

In conference matches, the visitors have held the advantage with home teams currently 4-6-1 on the season.

### Bears Remain Perfect

Missouri State extended its winning streak to nine games with wins over Omaha and Evansville last week. The Bears have opened their season with nine straight wins for the first time in program history. The winning streak ranks third nationally behind Navy's 15-match streak and Virginia's 10-match streak.

Missouri State is the first MVC program to start a season 9-0-0 since SMU started the 2001 season 21-0-0 before suffering its only loss in the NCAA Tournament Quarterfinals to St. John's.

The Bears are one of three teams still sitting perfect in all of NCAA Division I, joining Navy and Virginia (Through Oct. 7).

### RPI Update

According to RPI Update (not official NCAA) Missouri State sits 34th in the RPI at this point with Loyola coming in at No. 46. The MVC ranks 13th as a conference.

### Team Academic Honors

United Soccer Coaches announced on Oct. 3 the Team Academic Award Winners at the high school and college levels to recognize exemplary performance in the classroom during the 2018-19 academic year. College Team Academic Award recipients have a composite grade point of average of 3.0 or better on a 4.0 scale for all players on the roster.

### Game Winning Firsts

Both of Bradley's game-winning goals last week came on first-time tallies ... Fourth-year junior forward TJ Rea netted the winner Tuesday night at Valparaiso by punching home his first career goal at 108:13 for the 2-1 victory ... Appearing in his fourth career game, freshman defender Cameron Strang provided the game's lone goal in the 56th minute of Saturday's 1-0 Homecoming win against Drake for his first career goal.



### Historic Schedule Quirk

When Bradley and Valparaiso made up last Sunday's abandoned game Tuesday night at Valparaiso, the switch set up a historic run of road games for the Braves ... Last Tuesday's game officially went down as a fourth consecutive road game for the Braves, who now are involved in an 8-game stretch that has them playing seven true road games ... Bradley has not played 7-of-8 games away from home in the same season since 1990 ... The switch also means the Braves are playing five of their first six Missouri Valley Conference games on the road ... On the bright side, the Braves have picked up three points in their first three Valley road games and will close the season with their final four Valley games at home..

### Nationally Ranked Valley Rival

Bradley will visit undefeated and nationally-ranked Missouri State (9-0-0) Wednesday night ... The road game against the Bears will be Bradley's first against a nationally-ranked opponent since a 2-1 loss Sept. 10, 2017 at #17 Omaha ... Bradley will be looking for its first win against a nationally-ranked team in five tries since its 3-2, overtime win at #3 Northwestern Oct. 2, 2013 ... The Braves are seeking their first win against a nationally-ranked Valley rival since knocking off #12 Creighton, 3-2, in the semifinals of the 2010 MVC Tournament at Shea Stadium ... Bradley also dealt then-No. 10 Creighton a 2-1 defeat Nov. 6, 2010 for its last road win against a nationally-ranked Valley opponent.

### #14 MISSOURI STATE (9-0, 3-0 MVC)

#### Still Perfect

No. 17 Missouri State continued its historic start to 2019, winning a 1-0 double OT thriller against Omaha on Tuesday, Oct 1 and notched a four-goal first half in a 4-0 win over Evansville on Saturday, Oct. 5. MSU is one of three Division-I teams to remain perfect in 2019 as Virginia and Navy are the only other teams to boast spotless records.



#### Historic Start

The Bears' winning streak now sits at nine games, becoming the first Missouri Valley Conference team to start 9-0 since SMU in 2001.
