Franklin shot 7-for-8 from the floor and 6-for-7 at the foul line against the Tigers, extending her streak of consecutive field goal makes to 17. She also added a steal in 29 minutes of action.

## **NOTEWORTHY**

In addition to the league's Player and Newcomer of the Week selections, several conference players had notable performances, including:

Tatum Koenig (BRAD) - Koenig scored a career-high 23 points on 8-of-10 shooting and also collected six rebounds and five assists to help highlight Bradley's 78-69 win over Jackson State as the Brayes extended their win streak to seven games. After scoring eight points in the first half. Koenig nearly matched her previous career-high scoring output of 16 points in the second half as she hit 6-of-7 shots in the final 20 minutes and had 15 second-half points. She helped Bradley push its home win streak to 10, which is tied for the second longest in school history and longest for the Braves since winning 10 straight home games between the 1980-81 and 1981-82 seasons.

Karli Rucker (UNI) - Karli Rucker scored 19 points against Omaha and nine against Creighton, including a game-tying threepointer in the final minute to help the Panthers go 2-0 on the week. Rucker was 8-15 from the field with four rebounds, four assists and two steals in the Panthers' 81-45 road win over Omaha Tuesday. UNI returned home for the final home non-conference game of the year. IUPUI took the lead on a three-pointer with 52 seconds left, on the ensuing possession, Rucker broke out of a shooting slump an buried a three-pointer to tie the game up at 50 with 40 second left. The Panthers went on to win the game 51-50 with Rucker grabbing the game-clinching steal with under a second to play.

Nicole Martin (SIU) - Nicole Martin scored a season-high 24 points on an efficient 10-of-17 shooting, which included her first three-pointer of the season, to go along with six rebounds in SIU's 76-66 win over Murray State on Sunday. Martin scored 13 of her team-high 24 points in the second half, which included eight in the third quarter. It marks the second time this season, and 10th time in her career, that the two-time All-MVC selection has scored 20-plus points in a game.

Shay Frederick (VALPO) - Frederick led all players in scoring as Valpo won its fourth consecutive game on Sunday with a blowout of UIC. The sophomore scored 12 of her 15 points in the first half, helping to stake the Crusaders to a 18-point halftime advantage.

Kristina Cavey (UNI) - Kristina Cavey averaged 10.5 points on 6-8 shooting from the field and 7-10 from the free-throw line, including the go-ahead free throw with .6 of a second left in the Panthers 51-50 win over IUPUI Sunday afternoon. Against Omaha, she had 11 points in 17 minutes and added a team-high seven rebounds. She also had two steals and no turnovers in the 81-45. win. Sunday, she scored 10 points and grabbed two rebounds and a steal. With the game tied at 50, she grabbed an offensive rebound and was fouled on the tip-in attempt with less than a second to play. She hit her second free throw to give UNI a 51-50

Awa Keita (SIU) - Awa Keita notched season-highs in points (7), rebounds (5), minutes played (16), and free throw attempts (7) in SIU's 76-66 win over Murray State on Sunday. The junior transfer was 2-for-2 from the field and added three free throws to help SIU's reserves outscore Murray State's bench, 13-to-6.

Carie Weinman (VALPO) - Weinman connected on multiple 3-pointers for the fourth consecutive game, all of which have been Valpo victories. She finished with eight points and a game-high four assists, the latter mark more than doubling her season total of three assists entering Sunday's win.

#### **Historic Conference RPI**

### The RPI Ratings Game

The latest weekly installment of the NCAA RPI Report (Dec. 17) has six Valley teams that rank in the top-60, including three in the top 30. Missouri State leads the way at No. 3 with Drake at No. 17 and Illinois State at No. 29. UNI (50), Loyola Chicago (53) and Bradley (56) round out the schools in the Top 60.

The Valley joins the Power Five conferences as the only leagues with at least six teams sitting in the Top 60 of the RPI.

#### **Power Five Success**

The MVC has secured eight wins over Power Five programs this season. The Valley is 8-10 vs. Power Five teams this season, almost tripling last season's win total of three. The Valley has a winning record against the Big 12 (2-1) and SEC (3-1) and sits 3-6 vs. the Big Ten and 0-2 vs. the Pac-12. The average margin of victory in the seven wins is 8.8 points per game. Missouri State has three, Drake two, UNI two and Illinois State one.

#### **Record Non-Con?**

Valley women's basketball has already eclipsed 60 wins in non-conference play with a few weeks remaining in the non-league season. Only five times previously since the 1992-93 season has the MVC claimed 60+ non-league wins in a season with the league record for non-con wins at 66 (2009-10).

#### Vs. Top 25

Last season, the MVC went 1-8 against Top 25 opponents during the non-conference season. The league currently sits 1-3 vs. the Top 25 this year with two more chances to claim a win this week. Loyola will host #16 DePaul on Friday, while #18 Missouri State will look for its second Top 25 win at #17 Gonzaga Friday.

The last time the MVC recorded two wins against the Top 25 during non-conference play was during the 2002-03 season (Drake vs. No. 18 Iowa State & UNI vs. No. 24 Iowa State).

#### **Hot Starts**

Three Valley teams are sitting with one or fewer losses this season.

Lovola's 9-0 start is the best in program history, surpassing the 1979-80 Ramblers' 5-0 start. The Ramblers are one of 12 NCAA Division I teams remaining without a loss this season. Loyola's nine straight wins are its most since going on a 10-game tear during the 1988-89 season.

Missouri State's 9-1 start is the best for the Lady Bears since opening the 2003-04 season 20-1.

Bradley is 8-1 or better to start a season for just the third time.

#### **Road Success**

Loyola Chicago is tied with UConn for the national lead with a 6-0 road record this season and is one of four teams with at least six road victories overall. Cleveland State is 7-1 on the road, while Duquesne

The Valley has posted a 24-20 overall road record this season. The 24 non-conference road wins is already the most this decade for The Valley (21 road wins in 2011-12 & 2012-13).

#### **Home Sweet Home**

Currently seven MVC teams remain unbeaten at home: Bradley (4-0), Drake (5-0), Illinois State (5-0), Loyola Chicago (3-0), Missouri State (5-0), UNI (4-0) and Valparaiso (2-0) have unblemished records on their home courts this season. The Valley currently holds a 34-5 (.872) mark at home this season.

### **High Percentage**

Drake enters this week ranking 9th nationally in Field Goal Percentage (48.0%). Drake finished 10th in FG% last year, 5th in 2017-18, and 2nd in 2016-17. UConn is the only other school to finish in the top 10 in the last three seasons. The Huskies currently sit 10th nationally.

#### Sharing the Rock

Drake enters the week averaging 22.4 assists per game, which ranks second nationally. Drake is the only team in the country to rank in the top three of Assists Per Game each of the previous three seasons. Loyola Chicago also ranks Top 20 nationally, coming in at No. 16 this week (18.9 apg).

#### Cleaning the Glass

Bradley has been dominating the glass during its 8-1 start to the season. The Braves rank 5th nationally, averaging 46.9 rpg. Bradley ranks second in the nation with 34.1 defensive rebounds per game. The Valley record for rebounds per game for a season was set by 1985 Drake (46.9).

#### **Strength of Schedule**

Three Valley teams have a SOS ranking in the Top 30 according to the NCAA (Dec. 16). Drake leads The Valley with a SOS of No. 17. Missouri State comes in this week ranked No. 25 with Illinois State (28) also ranking in the Top 30.

#### Poll Position

Missouri State remained No. 20 in this week's AP Top 25 Poll. It is the Lady Bears' first top 20 ranking in the AP poll since Mar. 13, 2001 (15th).

The Lady Bears sit 18th in the USA Today Coaches Top25 Poll (Dec 10). Drake also received votes last week.

#### Mid-Major Top-25 Poll

Drake, Missouri State and UNI all appear in the latest CollegeInsider.com Mid-Major Top 25 (Dec. 10). The Lady Bears sit second in the poll behind Gonzaga, while Drake sits sixth and UNI No. 23. Illinois State, Loyola and Bradley are all receiving votes this week.

### Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 15 leagues in non-conference play, including the American (2-1), America East (2-0), A10 (3-2), Big 12 (2-1), Horizon (6-2), Ivy (1-0), MAC (6-0), Mountain West (1-0), Ohio Valley (8-7), SEC (3-1) Southland (1-0), Summit (9-4), SWAC (1-0), West Coast (2-1) and WAC (3-0). The MVC holds at least a .500 mark against Conference USA (1-1). The MVC has a losing record to only the Big East (1-2), Big Ten (3-6), Big West (0-1) and Pac-12 (0-2).

#### **Rhine on McClain Watch List**

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Sara Rhine is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Katrina McClain Award. Named after the two-time All-American and 1987 National Player of the Year, the annual award in its third year recognizes the top power forwards in women's NCAA Division I college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

#### **Hittner on Drysdale Watch List**

The Naismith Memorial Basketball Hall of Fame and the WBCA announced that Drake senior Becca Hittner is one of 20 watch list candidates for the 2020 Ann Meyers Drysdale Award. Named after the first player, male or female, selected to the All-America Team in four-straight college seasons, the annual Drysdale award is in its third year and recognizes the top shooting guard in NCAA Division I women's college basketball. By mid-February, the watch list of 20 players for the 2020 award will be narrowed to just 10.

#### **Wade Award Watch List**

Drake's Becca Hittner and Sara Rhine have each been selected to the "Wade Watch" list of candidates for the 2020 Wade Trophy presented to the best player in college women's basketball, the WBCA announced Thursday. Drake joins Oregon, Stanford, UConn and Oregon State as the only schools with multiple players on the list.

#### **Wooden Award Watch List**

Drake senior Becca Hittner has been named to the John R. Wooden Award® presented by Wendy's® Women's Preseason Top 30 Watch List. The preseason list represents nine conferences: the Pac-12 leads all conferences with nine selections, followed by the SEC with six, the ACC and Big 12 with four apiece, the American and Big Ten with two each, and Conference USA, Ivy League, and Missouri Valley with one selection

## 1,000 Point Club

The Valley has four active players in the 1,000 point club. Sara Rhine sits fifth on the NCAA career scoring chart, while Hittner sits ninth. The duo is the second highest teammate scoring tandem in the country behind Oregon's Sabrina Ionescu and Ruthy Hebard.

### **Hoops In the Heartland**

The 2020 Missouri Valley Conference Women's Basketball Tournament will return to the TaxSlayer Center in Moline, III., for the fifth-straight

Affectionately coined "Hoops in the Heartland," the four-day event (Mar. 12-15) will showcase all 10 Missouri Valley Conference schools as they compete for the Valley's automatic berth into the NCAA Tournament.


The MVC's agreement with Visit Quad Cities will keep the MVC Women's Basketball Championship in TaxSlayer Center through at least 2021.

The 2020 tournament will mark the 13th-consecutive season in its 38-year history that the event will take place at a neutral site.

The Missouri Valley Conference is one of only seven conferences (out of 32 nationally) where the women's basketball tournament is played at a neutral site, separate from the men's championship (AAC, ACC, Big Ten, Big 12, MVC, Pac-12 and SEC are the others).

#### Postseason League

The MVC has seen an average of four league teams participate in postseason play in the last 21 seasons, including three teams reaching postseason play in 2018-19. Missouri State reached the Sweet Sixteen for the fourth time in program history, while Drake fell to Missouri in the First Round of the NCAA Tournament. UNI received a bid to the WNIT for the second-straight season. The Valley has earned multiple NCAA Tournament bids in 12 different seasons, including two out of the last three seasons.



#### Starters Returning

The Missouri Valley Conference will see 30 of 50 starters return (60%) for the 2019-20 season. The league will return nine of its top 10 in scoring, seven of its top 10 in rebounding and four of its top five in assists. The Valley will also have eight of its 11 All-MVC players return and five of its six honorable mention selections.

## **BRADLEY (8-1)**

#### On Point

Sophomore Tatum Koenig scored a career-high 23 points on 8-of-10 shooting and also had six rebounds, five assists and a steal to help highlight Tuesday's win against Jackson State. Koenig's 23 points topped her previous career high of 16 points from last December's game at Cleveland State. Koenig has scored in double



figures in each of the last two games after averaged 5.3 points per game in the first seven games of the season. In fact, over the last five games she has averaged 9.2 points, 4.6 assists, 5.4 rebounds and 1.0 steal per game. Koenig is also shooting 40 percent from three-point range over that five-game stretch.

Going Streaking

Bradley brings a seven-game win streak into the Roo Holiday Classic after a 78-69 victory over Jackson State last week and the Braves extended their home win streak to a Renaissance Coliseum record 10 games. The seven-game win streak is tied for the fourth longest win streak in program history. Three of the four previous times Bradley had a win streak of at least seven games the Braves went on to finish in the top half of the MVC standings with the lone exception in 2001-02. The 10-game home win streak is BU's longest since winning the final five home games of 1980-81 and the first five home contests of 1981-82. The longest home win streak in school history is a 12-game streak between the 1978-79 (5) and 1979-80 (7) campaigns.

#### **Non-Con Success**

Owning an 8-1 record heading into the final two non-conference games of the year, Bradley has as many as eight non-MVC victories for just the fifth time in program history. Overall, Bradley is 19-2 in its last 21 nonconference games after winning a school record 10 non-league games in 2018-19. Two of Bradley's last three seasons which included at least nine non-conference victories resulted in 20-win campaigns.

Playing before a program-record crown of 3,703 on "Field Trip Day with the Ramblers", Loyola moved to 9-0 following an 84-76 win over Bowling Green on Monday afternoon at Gentile Arena. Allison Day scored a career-high 20 points to pace a quartet of Ramblers in



double figures as Loyola remained one of the nation's 12 unbeaten teams.

#### **Bright Sunshiny Day**

As noted above, Allison Day led the Maroon & Gold in their aforementioned victory over Bowling Green. A 2018-19 selection to the MVC's All-Freshman Team, Day is arguably playing some of the best basketball of her career of late, averaging a team-best 16.0 points over the past five games while operating at a red-hot 52.2 percent (36-of-69) clip from the floor.

#### **Redline Rivalry**

Loyola's perfect record is set to face its sternest test to date on Friday evening, as No. 16/16 DePaul makes the short trip up from Lincoln Park. The Blue Demons have won 24 of the previous 25 meetings, with the lone Rambler victory during that stretch coming during the 2015-16 campaign. In last season's meeting between the two city rivals, Abby O'Connor poured in a career-high 31 points as DePaul escaped Rogers Park with a 102-76 victory.

## **#18/20 MISSOURI STATE (9-1)**

#### Ranked vs. Ranked

No. 18 Missouri State travels to 17th-ranked Gonzaga on Friday for a rare ranked versus ranked match-up for the Lady Bears. MSU is 8-8 all-time in games where both teams are ranked, most recently a loss to Purdue in the 2001 Final Four. The last such regular season



match-up took place on Dec. 16, 2000, when the 21st-ranked Lady Bears topped No. 16 Oklahoma by a 69-61 final in Springfield, and the last road win in a ranked vs. ranked game was at No. 7 Iowa in the 1992 NCAA Tournament second round.

#### What A Year

Friday is the one-year anniversary of the Lady Bears starting their current 33-4 run with a Dec. 20, 2018 victory against Louisiana Tech in Kansas City. From that date through Dec. 15 of this year, Missouri State trailed only Baylor (37) in total victories, tying with UConn at 33 and sitting a game ahead of Oregon and Stanford.

#### Franklin's Field Goals

Sophomore Jasmine Franklin completed MSU's three-game home stand shooting 22-of-24 from the field, including a streak of 17 consecutive makes that is believed to rank second in MSU history behind Kelly Mago's streak of 20 makes in 1988. Franklin has made two-thirds of her career shot attempts at JQH Arena, and though she needs more game to qualify for MSU career records, would currently place fourth in both career field goal percentage and rebound average.

## **VALPARAISO (5-3)**

#### **The Streak Continues**

Valpo's win over UIC on Sunday extended its winning streak to four consecutive games. For Valpo's last stretch of four straight wins over Division I opposition, you have to travel back to February/March 2007, when the Brown and Gold closed the regular season with five



consecutive victories and then won their Mid-Con Tournament opener for six straight wins.

#### **Doing it with Defense**

The 37 points Valpo surrendered to UIC on Sunday afternoon were the seventh-fewest given up by a Valpo squad in a single game in program history. It was Valpo's best defensive performance on the scoreboard since giving up just 32 points at Northern Kentucky on Feb. 11, 2016. It also marked Valpo's fewest points allowed against a non-conference Division I opponent in program history.

## **Big Wins**

Valpo's last two wins have come in dominating fashion, beating UDM by 19 and UIC by 26. The 26-point margin of victory over UIC was Valpo's largest against a Division I opponent in non-conference play since a 34-point win over Butler on Nov. 14, 2014. The last time the Brown and Gold enjoyed consecutive wins by at least 19 points came back in January of 2006, when they downed Centenary by 19 and Oral Roberts by 27.
