Bradley's Andy Shadid delivered 10th-inning RBI's in both of Bradley's two wins last week. In Thursday's 5-3 victory at Austin Peay, Shadid came through with a two-run single in the 10th to lead the Braves to the road win in the opening game of the Nashville-area SAF Dirt Classic. Shadid was 1-for-4 with a stolen base in Sunday's 1-0 loss in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader at Middle Tennessee State. In Sunday's nightcap, Shadid was 2-for-5 with another stolen base and a RBI triple

in the 10th inning, lifting the Braves to a 2-1 win.

NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Luke Bandy (DBU) – DBU junior Luke Bandy paced the Patriots offensively, going 5-for-14 at the plate with a double, a home run, three RBIs and three runs scored. The center fielder from Bentonville, Arkansas, was pivotal in a 9-0 win over Minnesota on Friday, reaching base all five times he came to the plate, driving in two runs, and scoring twice.

Danny Borgstrom (UE) – Freshman second baseman Danny Borgstrom continued a torrid start to his collegiate career this past week, batting .400, while knocking in four RBIs in games against top-ranked Vanderbilt and Little Rock, including the icebreaker against the Trojans in game two of their doubleheader Sunday. Borgstrom leads the Aces in batting average (.364) and RBIs (7).

Roby Enriquez (INS) – Roby Enriquez closed out the weekend for the Sycamores with a .300 batting average going 3-10 at the plate with a double and two RBI. Enriquez scored two runs in three starts for ISU. Enriquez led the team with a .462 on-base percentage during the weekend sweep of the Hughes Brothers Challenge after being hit-by-pitch twice and drawing a walk to go along with three base hits.

Blake Billinger (VALPO) – Billinger belted two home runs in the first game of Sunday's doubleheader at Arkansas State, part of a three-hit effort in a 7-6, 11-inning defeat. He turned in the third multi-homer game by a Valley player this season while equaling his career high with five RBIs, which also tied for the most by an MVC player in a single game in 2019. Billinger's second home run was a go-ahead, two-run blow in the eighth inning.

Allan Beer (BRAD) – A fifth-year senior who redshirted the 2018 season, Beer has been impressive in his return to the mound in the closer role for the Braves in 2019 ... In his two appearances during Bradley's trip to the Nashville area for the SAF Dirt Classic, Beer earned the save in Thursday's 5-3, 10-innings win at Austin Peay and came back to earn a 3-inning victory in Sunday's 2-1, 10-innings win at Middle Tennessee State ... Beer struck out seven in his 4.0 innings of work in the two games and he became the fourth pitcher in Bradley history to reach double digits in career saves.

Shane Gray (UE) – Freshman right-hand pitcher Shane Gray continued to be dominant whether starting the game or coming out of the bullpen. On Wednesday, the newcomer got the start against #1 Vanderbilt and delivered a pair of shutout innings against the potent Commodore lineup. Then on Sunday, Gray came in out of the bullpen and allowed just one run on one hit, while striking out three in two innings of the Aces 3-1 victory over Little Rock.

Jeff Lindgren (ILS) – Jeff Lindgren started game one of the doubleheader at Central Arkansas on Sunday. On the mound, Lindgren threw six innings, giving up just two hits, walking one and striking out six. Lindgren dominated on the mound for the 'Birds as he faced 21 batters getting eight to fly out and three to groundout. The win moved Lindgren to 2-0 on the year, as Illinois State defeated Central Arkansas 8-0.

Tyler Whitbread (INS) – Right-hander Tyler Whitbread made his second start of 2019 Sunday in a 10-0 shutout win over Iona. He tossed a career high eight innings while allowing just one base hit to the Gaels. Whitbread was efficient on the mound, needing just 76 pitches to retire 23 of the 25 Iona batters he faced. The Camlachie, Ontario native struck out one Iona batter and walked one as he garnered his first win of the season.

Dylan Givens (SIU) – Junior right handed pitcher Dylan Givens made his second start of the 2019 season at Memphis on Sunday, Feb. 24. Givens allowed only five hits, one run (unearned) and one walk in a career-high eight innings. The junior also struck out three Memphis hitters and earned the win for SIU. It was his first win of the season. Through two starts this season, Givens is holding opposing batters to a .178 batting average and also possesses a 1.35 ERA and .92 WHIP.

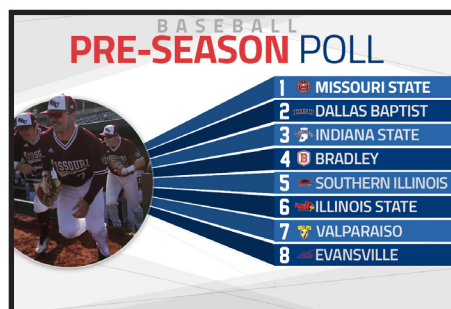

The Sycamores are currently on the tail end of the eight-game road swing to open the season as they take on Western Carolina for two games in the midweek, a 373-mile trip before making their way back to Terre Haute (1,756 round trip).

That's A Relief

While the Bears have held a lead in just one of their six contests this season to date, the Missouri State bullpen can boast of a recent track record of holding leads. Dating back to May 2014, the Bears relief corps has closed out 153 consecutive victories in which MSU has taken a lead into the ninth inning. The Bears bullpen has posted an uncharacteristic 7.31 staff ERA through the first six games, but two mainstays from last year—sophomore closer Connor Sechler and senior lefty Davis Schwab—have combined to log 7.2 innings of three-hit relief with 12 strikeouts.



Watch the Leather, Man

In addition to serving as a key cog in the Bears' lineup over the past two years, junior first baseman Ben Whetstone has proven to be one of the top defensive performers in The Valley as well. The Overland Park, Kan., native moved into the top spot on the Bears' career fielding percentage chart after registering his 25th straight game without a defensive miscue Sunday vs. Fresno State. His 0.993 fielding mark as a Bear narrowly leads Steve Seal (1969-70) in the No. 2 position with a 0.992 percentage among all MSU defenders with at least 150 career fielding chances.

Welcome Home

Missouri State will open its 2019 home slate Tuesday vs. Central Arkansas looking to extend a recent home-field advantage of unprecedented proportions in the history of the MSU program. The Bears have logged four of their top single-season home win totals since the 2015 season, going 17-6 at home last spring after a 21-7 home mark in 2017, a Hammons Field-record 22 victories in 2016 and the Bears' best-ever home win percentage at Hammons with a 19-3 (.864) mark in 2015. Those four seasons give the Bears a combined 79-24 (.767) home record over the four-year stretch. The Bears have won 38 of their last 53 regular-season non-conference home games, outscoring their non-league opponents by a 786-494 margin at Hammons Field since the start of the 2015 season.
