Missouri Valley Conference Player of the Week

Dan Bolt, Jr., OF, Bradley

Bolt hit .500 (8-16) with four home runs and seven RBI during Bradley's 2-2 road swing to Illinois and DBU, while extending his personal hitting streak to 14 games. Bolt was 3-for-4 with a double and two home runs in Tuesday's 12-8 win at Illinois. Bolt was 1-for-4 in Friday's 2-1 win at DBU, scoring what proved to be the winning run after singling in the seventh inning. The junior started Saturday's doubleheader at DBU by going 2-for-3 with a home run, then finished the road trip by going 2-for-4

with a three-run home run in the first inning and a sacrifice bunt that positioned the eventual tying run in the seventh inning. Having raised his average 71 points during his current 14-game hitting streak, Bolt is batting .331 and now leads the Braves with eight home runs and a .581 slugging percentage, while sharing the team lead with 30 RBI.

Missouri Valley Conference Pitcher of the Week

Logan Wiley, Jr., RHP, Missouri State

Missouri State's Logan Wiley recorded his first complete-game effort as a Bear in Friday's 6-1 win that clinched a series win over New Orleans. The Springfield, Mo., native struck out a career-high nine hitters, scattered four hits and four walks while permitting just one unearned run to notch his second mound victory of the season. The junior right-hander retired the first seven hitters of the game in order, then set down eight in a row from the sixth through the eighth innings, including four-straight strikeouts during one stretch.

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NOTEWORTHY

In addition to the league's player and newcomer of the week selections, several conference players had notable performances, and they include:

Jackson Glenn (DBU) – Junior third baseman Jackson Glenn stayed hot with a five-for-16 week, including two home runs and a triple. Glenn was a double shy of the cycle and drove in a season-high six runs in Saturday's first game.

A.J. Fritz (UE) – Freshman outfielder A.J. Fritz has a mammoth week at the plate, batting .400, including a pair of home runs, as well as a pair of doubles, leading to an eye-popping 1.200 slugging percentage, while knocking in four RBIs.

Max Wright (INS) – Junior catcher Max Wright capped off a 7-for-12 performance at the plate with a three-run home run during a doubleheader sweep of Evansville Sunday. Wright finished his week with a .583 average, .917 slugging percentage and a .643 on-base percentage in four starts behind the plate. The Toronto, Ontario, native drove in five runs and scored four times as the Sycamores went 2-2 with a 2-1 series win over the Aces and a loss to #7-ranked Vanderbilt.

John Privitera (MSU) – John Privitera turned in a strong all-around effort last week, hitting .533 (8-for-15) with three multi-hit performances in four outings while assisting on six double plays and handling all 13 of his defensive chances without a miscue. The junior second baseman tripled twice and drove in a run as part of a 3-for-4 night against Missouri, before enjoying a memorable three-game set vs. New Orleans to help the Bears notch their third series win in the last four weekends. Privitera scored the go-ahead run while assisting on three of the Bears' four twin-killings in Thursday's series-opening victory, then drove in the first two runs of MSU's 6-1 win the following night. The Lee's Summit, Mo., product, who also walked four times on the week to register a team-leading .632 on-base percentage, capped the week by scoring three times and going 2-for-5 in the series finale.

Philip Archer (SIU) – Philip Archer hit a pair of home runs last week for Southern Illinois. Archer went 3-for-10 with two homers, four RBIs, and four runs scored. He slugged .900 and posted a .462 on-base percentage for the week.

Blake Billinger (VALPO) – Billinger led the team in batting average at .538 over four games this week to go along with four home runs, 10 RBIs, seven runs scored, 20 total bases and a 1.538 slugging percentage. He reached base at a .611 clip in a week where Valpo notched back-to-back wins for the first time this season. Billinger had his third career multi-homer game in Saturday's series finale at SIU Edwardsville and totaled three long balls in a doubleheader against the Cougars. He had three hits, four RBIs and three runs scored in the final game of the series. His three homers on Saturday allowed him to boost his season total nine and take over the Missouri Valley Conference lead.

Mitch Janssen (BRAD) – Janssen continued his stellar senior season by blanking host Dallas Baptist into the sixth inning Friday night, keying Bradley's 2-1 win in the series opener against the Patriots ... While DBU scored 22 runs on 26 hits in the 17 innings in which Janssen did not pitch, Bradley's pilot pitcher grounded the Patriots on three hits in his 5.1 scoreless innings Friday ... Janssen walked four and struck out five while limiting DBU to three singles ... With his scoreless work Friday, Janssen ran his personal shutout streak to 17.1 innings ... Now boasting a 1.06 season ERA, Janssen has not allowed an earned run in any of his last four appearances, spanning 18.1 innings, and he not allowed more than two runs in any of his 11 outings this year.

MD Johnson (DBU) – DBU senior righty MD Johnson was key in the Patriots' series-tying win over Bradley on Saturday. Johnson threw 6.0 innings and allowed just one run on four hits with no walks and six strikeouts. The start was his third of the season with no walks allowed.

Matt Walker (ILS) – Matt Walker was outstanding in the series finale at SIU yesterday. Walker started the game for the Redbirds picking up the victory while recording a perfect ERA. The lefty went 6.0 innings, giving up six hits, allowing two runs, no earned runs while striking out nine batters, and walking none. The Morris, Illinois native helped earn Illinois State the sweep over Southern Illinois.

Collin Liberatore (INS) – Junior right-hander Collin Liberatore tossed eight complete innings during an 8-2 victory in game one of Sunday's doubleheader with Evansville. Liberatore was able to strikeout two Aces as he worked out of several innings with Evansville putting men on base. Allowing just two earned runs in the game, Liberatore improved to 7-0 on the season with the win.

Matt DeSomer (SIU) – Matt DeSomer pitched four perfect innings against Illinois State. He struck out three and did not allow a base runner, marking the best career appearance for the former Saluki Football quarterback.

Jon Tieman (VALPO) – Tieman surrendered just two hits over six shutout innings on Friday night, earning the win as Valpo blanked SIU Edwardsville 8-0. He recorded a career-high 12 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher in a single game since 2011. His efforts helped the Valpo pitching staff garner its first shutout since April 23, 2017.

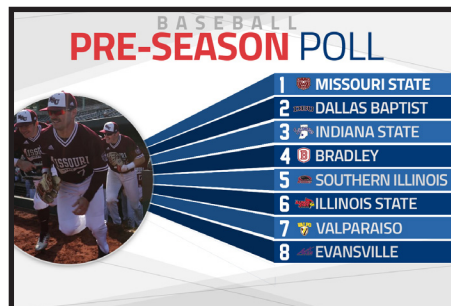

Four of the Power-Five conferences (SEC, Big 12, Pac-12, ACC) hold four of the top five positions, while the American sits fifth just ahead of The Valley.

The last time the MVC finished a season rated 6th in conference RPI was in 2015 when the league sent Bradley, DBU and Missouri State to the NCAA Tournament.

Five in RPI's Top-100

Five league teams continue to rank in the top-100 of the RPI, led by Illinois State (No. 29), DBU (No. 30), Evansville (No. 38), Indiana State (No. 41) and Bradley (No. 79).

Elite Company

The Valley has four teams ranking in the Top 45 of the RPI, joining four other leagues in the club. The SEC leads the nation with 11 teams in the RPI top 45, while the ACC (7), Big 12 (6), Pac-12 (6) and MVC (4) round out the elite club.

Wins Over Power Five

Entering this week's action, the MVC has earned 25 wins over members of Power Five conferences (25-36 record). The Valley sits 1-0 vs. the Pac-12, 2-0 vs. the ACC, 16-18 vs. the Big Ten, 4-9 vs. the Big 12 and 2-9 vs. the SEC.

Six of the eight MVC teams have earned wins against the Power Five. Indiana State leads the league with eight Power Five wins, including an 8-4 mark vs. the Big Ten. DBU has six Power Five wins, while Evansville has four. Illinois State has three, while Missouri State and Bradley each have a pair.

This week's schedule features four games against Power Five teams on Tuesday. Bradley will host Illinois, DBU will face TCU, Missouri State will head to Missouri and Valparaiso will travel to Notre Dame.

Top 25 Wins

The Valley has earned five Top 25 wins this season. Indiana State has a pair of Top 25 wins on the season. The Sycamores beat #25 Michigan on April 9 and #25 Illinois on March 26. DBU also has a pair, beating #19 TCU on April 9 and #20 Texas A&M on March 12. Illinois State has the league's fifth Top 25 win, beating #1 Vanderbilt on March 10.

Top 50 RPI Wins

Four league teams have won three or more games against teams currently ranked in the Top 50 of the RPI. DBU sits 5-8 against the Top 50, while Evansville (5-9) also has five wins. Missouri State (3-16) and Indiana State (3-3) each have three wins.

Against the Field

The MVC holds a winning record against 13 leagues in non-conference play (ACC, Atlantic Sun, Colonial, Conference USA, Ivy, Metro Atlantic, Mid-American, Ohio Valley, Pac-12, Southern, Southland, Summit and WAC), and a .500 record against another two leagues (Horizon and Mountain West).

High Percentage

Indiana State enters the week with the 10th-best winning percentage in the nation (.763). The Sycamores' 29-9 mark features five losses which were by just one run.

Impressive Streak Ends

Bradley ran its winning streak to 12 games by rallying to win at Illinois Tuesday and downing DBU in the opening game of the weekend MVC series. The Patriots swept Saturday's doubleheader to snap Bradley's streak, which equaled the second longest in program history. Bradley had not won as many consecutive games since a 12-game ride from March 19-April 7, 1993. The 12-game streak is tied for the 8th longest in NCAA Division I this season.

Road Success

Entering this week's schedule, Illinois State is tied for second in the NCAA in road wins. The Redbirds have 16 road wins on the season which ranks tied for second with Creighton. Bryant leads the NCAA with 18 road wins this season.

Close Calls

The MVC has a 29-22 non-conference record in one run contests this season, including a 9-6 mark in extra inning contests. The MVC sits 15-15 in two run games. The conference holds a 44-37 record in games decided by two runs or fewer.

Projected NCAA Field

Baseball America has one MVC team in the projected NCAA field of 64 as of April 17. The publication has DBU as a No. 3 seed in the Fayetteville (Arkansas) Regional. Indiana State is currently listed among the "First Four Out", while Evansville is in the "Next Four Out."

Patriot Profile

DBU enters the week with a perfect record of 15-0 against teams with an RPI of 100+. The Patriots join UCLA (3-0), Arkansas (10-0), Louisville (11-0), Mississippi State (15-0), Kentucky (15-0) and Washington (8-0) as the only teams in Division I with zero losses to teams rated outside the RPI Top 100.

National Players of the Week

Bradley's Dan Bolt and Missouri State's Ben Whetstone earned a spot on this week's Collegiate Baseball's National Players of the Week list. Bolt belted four home runs with seven RBI over four games as he went 8-for-16 at the plate. In the process, he extended his hitting streak to 14 games. Whetstone clubbed three home runs and drove in 10 runs while scoring six runs.

Strong Arms

Bradley currently boasts the nation's second-best team ERA at 2.68. The Braves currently have three pitchers with 45+ innings of work with ERA's under 4.00. Mitch Janssen leads the Braves' staff with an ERA of 1.06 (5th nationally) in 51 innings of work.

Indiana State's staff is also enjoying a great season, sitting 11th nationally in team ERA (3.15).

Quick Starts Crucial

If your team has plans on sitting atop the MVC standings heading into the league's postseason tournament, you might want to get off to a good start as all but one team that has won the MVC regular season has won at least 15 games since 2010, the first year of a 21-game conference schedule.

In the last nine seasons, Indiana State is the only league team to win the MVC regular season title with fewer than 15 league victories, as the Sycamores won the Valley with a 14-7 record in 2012.

Multi-Bid League

Since the 1981 season (38 seasons), the MVC has placed multiple teams into the NCAA Tournament 25 times (66%). On seven occasions (1985, 1990, 1995, 1999, 2000, 2012, 2015) the MVC has put three teams into the NCAA field.

Indiana State has reached its 2018 regular season win total with 13 games remaining this season after a doubleheader sweep of Evansville Sunday. The Sycamores stand at 29-9 on the season after finishing the 2018 campaign at 31-24, including a pair of MVC Tournament victories.



Getting On Base

Three Sycamores rank in the top-10 in the Missouri Valley Conference in on-base percentage. Max Wright (.441) ranks fourth, Clay Dungan (.426) ranks seventh and Jake Means (.420) sits at eighth, respectively. Two of the three also sit in the top five in hit-by-pitch in the MVC with Means being beamed 11 times and Wright 10.

Pitching Strong for Trees

The Indiana State pitching staff has been outstanding this season, combining for a 3.15 team ERA which is 11th nationally. As a team, ISU also ranks 15th nationally with a 1.20 WHIP and ninth with five shutouts. ISU pitching has hit just 11 batters which is second-best in the country. Five Sycamores have ERA's lower than 2.60 through 38 games. Starting pitcher Triston Polley has a 1.92 ERA in 10 starts and 65.2 innings while Jake Ridgway has a 2.35 ERA in over 19 appearances out of the bullpen.

Alright in April

Missouri State's offense has enjoyed a spring-like renewal in the month of April, registering a .291 team batting mark in its last 13 games since the turn of the calendar. The Bears, who hit just .209 while being outscored by a 202-101 margin in their first 26 games, have raised their team average to .29 points to .238 and out-homered the opposition by a 21-9 spread to slug .492 as a club in their 13 April contests.



Big Ben Chimes In

Bears first baseman Ben Whetstone enters the week riding a hot streak over which the junior has logged six multi-hit performances during a career-best 13-game hit streak. Whetstone clubbed three home runs and drove in 10 runs while scoring six of his own and helping the Bears turn seven double plays in their four games last week. The Overland Park, Kan., product has hit a team-best .388 (19-for-49) with four homers and 17 RBIs, while slugging .755 during his streak, which began on April 2. He leads the MVC in double plays turned (31) to go along with his .990 fielding percentage for the season.

Juniors Surging

The Bears' resurgence has been fueled by a suddenly hot junior corps consisting of Whetstone, Drew Millas, Jack Duffy and John Privitera, who have combined to hit .369 (76-for-206) during MSU's April hot streak at the plate. The same quartet has scored 46 of MSU's 95 runs and accounted for 46 of the team's 86 RBIs in the Bears' 13 April games as well. On the mound, fellow junior Logan Wiley has gone 2-0 with a 3.20 ERA, the first complete-game of his MSU career and 22 total strikeouts in 19.2 innings over three April starts.

Strikeouts By the Dozen

Valpo starting pitcher Jon Tieman helped Valpo to its first shutout victory since April 23, 2017, a 9-0 win over Wright State in the series opener against SIU Edwardsville on April 19, an 8-0 win. He recorded a career-high 12 strikeouts, the most by a Valpo pitcher in a game since Jon Gulbransen fanned 13 Chicago State Cougars on April 12, 2011. Both instances of a Valpo pitcher striking out 12 or more in a game over the last nine seasons have come by pitchers with the first name Jon against teams known as the Cougars. Tieman yielded just two hits over six frames to earn the victory.



Back-to-Back Three Hitters

Before limiting Western Michigan to three hits in an 11-1 victory on Tuesday, April 16, Valpo hadn't held the opposition to three hits or fewer in a game since May 10, 2015, when Ryan Fritze and Trevor Haas combined on a three-hit shutout of Youngstown State. Valpo pitching held the Broncos to three hits in that seven-inning, 10-run rule affair, and then followed it up with a second straight three-hitter on Friday, April 19 in an 8-0 win over SIU Edwardsville.

Billinger Bombs

They say home runs come in bunches, and that's proved to be the case for a pair of Valpo power bats over the last two weeks. After Sam Shaikin launched four home runs in a five-game span to usurp Blake Billinger for the team lead in dingers, Billinger put together a four-game stretch from April 16-20 during which he launched four home runs to take the team lead right back. By blasting three home runs in a doubleheader including his third career multi-homer game on April 20 at SIU Edwardsville, Billinger bolstered his home run total to nine and took over the Missouri Valley Conference lead. He has 16 career home runs in only his second season at Valpo after joining the program as a junior college transfer.

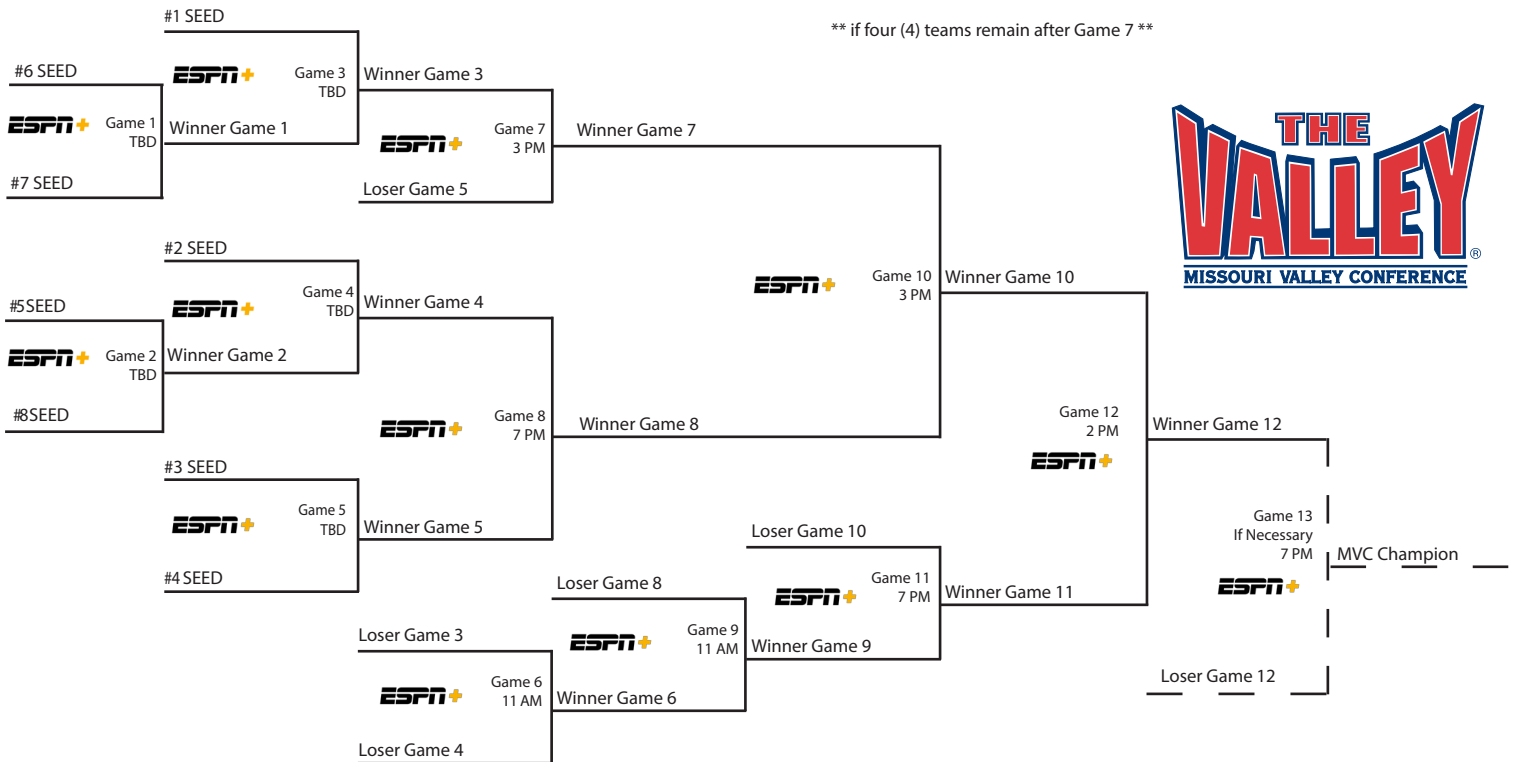

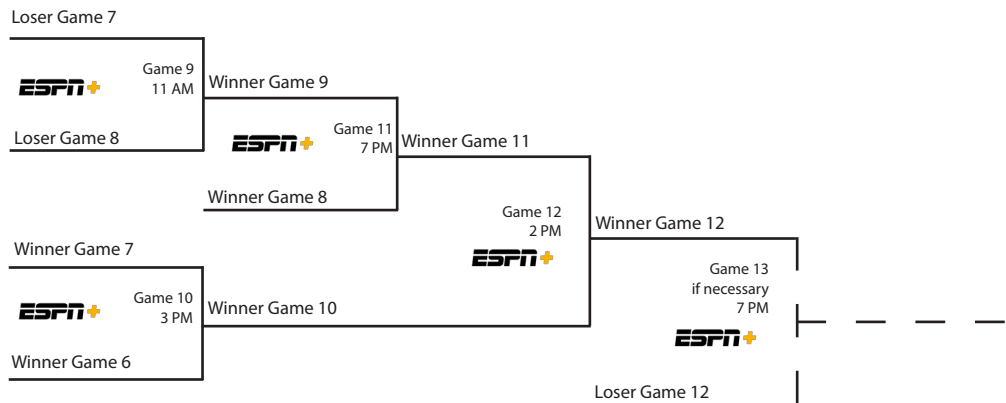
